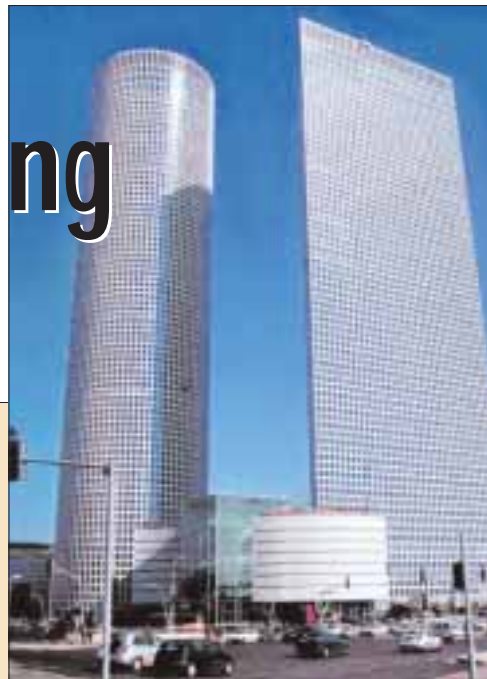

The New Terms of Terror

It’s not surprising that the escalation of modern Islamist terror has changed even our language, bringing new terms and words into our vocabulary. Along with WMD (Weapons of Mass Destruction) and “9/11,” we now have “3/11” — referring to the synchronized bombings of Madrid commuter trains exactly two and a half years after the US attacks and three days before Spanish elections.

In the statement claiming al-Qaeda responsibility for the Madrid massacre, Spanish voters were warned that if they did not repudiate the conservative Popular Party of Prime Minister Jose Maria Aznar for supporting the liberation of both Afghanistan and Iraq, further attacks on civilians would follow. Until that moment, polls showed

15. Israeli militants murder a Jew by accident and then apologize on grounds that they thought he was an Arab — to the silence of Israeli society.
16. Israeli public figures routinely threaten the US with terror attacks, bin Laden is a folk hero in Tel Aviv, and Israeli citizens celebrate on news that 3,000 Americans have been murdered.
17. Jewish assassins murder American diplomats and are given *de facto* sanctuary by Israeli society.
18. Israeli citizens express support for Saddam Hussein's supporters in Iraq in their efforts to kill Americans.

So until then, I think most Americans can see the moral differences in the present struggle. ✨

Aznar's Popular Party leading with a comfortable margin.

The Spanish Socialist Party won the elections by a wide margin and al-Qaeda websites are crowing that they have overthrown Aznar and his party. The new Prime Minister Jose Luis Rodriguez Zapatero, as expected, announced after the elections that Spanish troops would be withdrawn from Iraq in May.

The Socialist Party's reason for withdrawing from the war, explicitly stated by both American and Spanish anti-war activists, is an instructive logic chain. Working backwards, it goes like this: 1) Spain was attacked only because it supported America's war on terror; 2) America was attacked only because it is not "evenhanded" in the Palestinian-Israeli conflict; 3) Israel has been attacked only because it does not implement an equitable two-state solution.

Every link in this intellectual construct is preposterous. On its very surface, it is disproved by Islamist terror attacks on Turkey, Greece, and Indonesia — none having joined America in Iraq.

Yasser Arafat and his publicity-savvy lieutenants have often parroted the line that the US is biased in favor of Israel, and therefore deserving of attacks, but the case can easily be made that America has actually restrained Israel from properly defending itself from its sworn enemies. Clearly, President Bush's doctrine that "whoever harbors a terrorist is a terrorist" is not applied to the Palestinian Authority (PA), which not only harbors terrorists, but finances and directs their attacks against Israelis.

Even the PA saves its "two-state solution" rhetoric for the Western media. In Arabic, the Palestinian state media continue to call for genocide. Their very "national anthem" is a paean to the revenge they swear to take on the Jews for daring to have established a homeland in a region Muslims consider their birthright.

The racist aspect of Islamofascism was proven by the PA's official alliance with both the Taliban, in Afghanistan, and Saddam Hussein, in Iraq. In this strange worldview, it is better for hundreds of thousands of Arabs and Muslims to die unspeakable deaths at the hands of other Arabs and Muslims, than to endure the presence of free, peaceful, and democratic Jews in their neighborhood.

Consider the grotesque images presented by the mass demonstrations organized by the PA in Gaza and the West Bank to celebrate and support Osama bin Laden and Saddam Hussein, and pray for their victory over America.

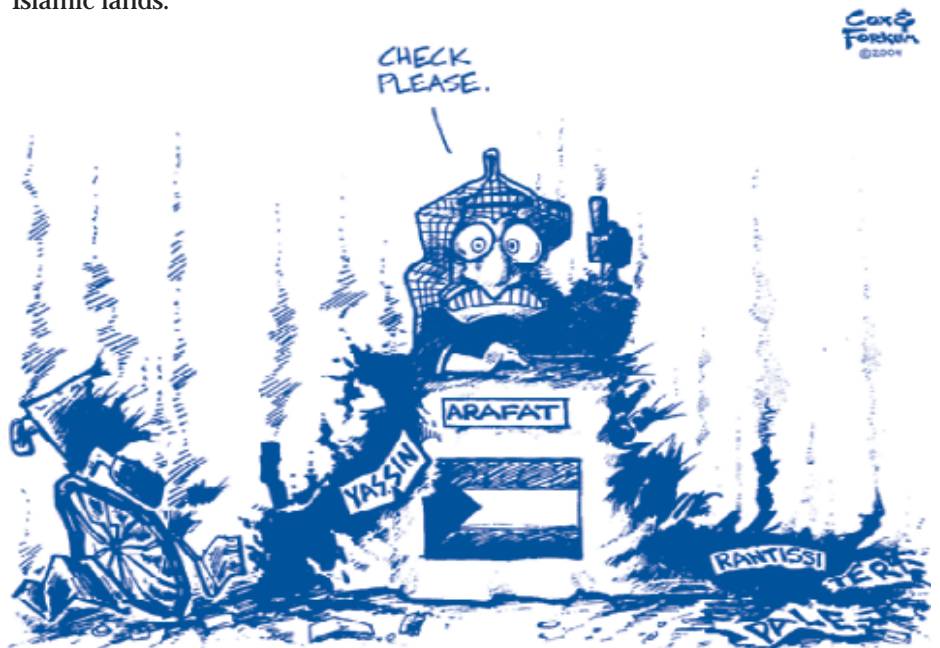
Those who blame Israel for not successfully negotiating with these people are imposing a kind of fantasy psychoanalysis on the Arab world, ignoring the proud bigotry and hatred at its center and blaming Israel instead. Even al-Qaeda's own literature rejects the idea that Islamic terrorism has anything to do with Israel. According to Islamists, the Jewish homeland is only the first of many nations that must be destroyed so the Islamic Caliphate can be reestablished. Democracy, according to official al-Qaeda publications, is the real threat to their reconquest of all formerly Islamic lands.

This brings us to an old term, newly revived by the need to understand Islamofascism. That term is *irredentism*, and it refers to the political belief in the right to annex any land that was ever controlled by a specific nation or ethnic group.

Long before September 11, 2001, al-Qaeda had set its sights on Spain as a means of undoing the ejection of the Moors in 1492. Recent position papers, or *fatwas*, by al-Qaeda rank the recovery of Spain as their second most important goal, behind Turkey, but before Italy and Vienna. Bin Laden, himself, referred in a recent communication to the defeat of the Moors at the hands of King Ferdinand of Aragon as "the tragedy of Andalusia" and swore to avenge that ancient slight.

Spain, by recoiling from the terrorists' threats, has sent the message that Westerners, at least in Europe, can be scared into obedience. Lamentably, the new term of terrorism, 3/11, seems destined to signify the successful use of terrorism to intimidate and manipulate an entire democratic country's political process.

Let's pray that it doesn't happen in America. ✨

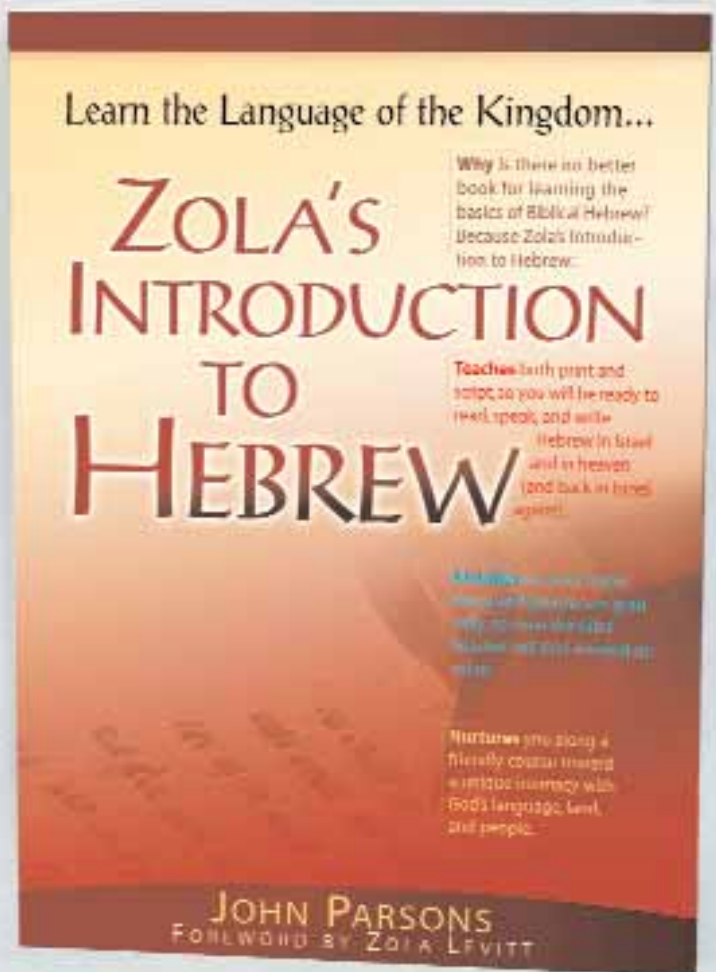

Upswing in Tourism

The dramatic upswing in tourism to Israel has continued during 2004. This upsurge in tourists traveling to the Holy Land is an astounding 61% increase over a year ago, according to Israel's Central Bureau of Statistics and the Israel Tourism Ministry's Department of Statistics and Databases. In just the first two months of 2004, more than 180,000 tourists visited Israel.

Israel Tourism Minister Benny Elon, encouraged by the continued increase in tourism, made clear the fundamental connection between the Israeli economy and tourism, saying, "Tourism is the number one generator of growth in the Israeli economy. Every million tourists bring 9 billion new Israeli shekels into the country, and create 45,000 jobs." — IMT, *The Jewish Press*

Jesus, the Homicide Bomber?

Abdel Rantisi was the new leader of Hamas. It was a match made in hell. Rantisi was at least truthful about his goal — he didn't talk about Israel retreating to its 1967 borders. He wanted Israel gone — completely.

Freedom of Religion

In his book, *Islam, Muhammad and the Koran*, Dr. Labib Mikhail, an Egyptian who moved to the US, notes: "The Koran commands Muslims to fight non-Muslims until they exterminate all religions so that Islam will be the world's only religion." In the Koran, Surat Al-Baqarah 2:193 says: "And fight them until there is no more Fitnah (disbelief and worshipping of others along with Allah) and (all and every kind of) worship is for Allah (alone). But if they cease, let there be no transgression except against As-Zatimun (the polytheists and wrongdoers)."

To a devout Muslim, a polytheist is a Christian, who believes that God is three persons in one. Mikhail writes in his book: "...freedom of religion was granted (throughout Arabia) to all religions before Islam. When Islam subdued all Arabia, freedom of religion was eliminated, and Islam became the only religion until this day."

Watch the "BIRDY"

The Israel Defense Forces are equipping their units with new spy drones (miniature robotic airplanes), the "BIRDY" and the "Spy There," both small enough to fit in a soldier's backpack, with the lighter weighing less than a can of soda. The drones are equipped with miniature video cameras and give almost immediate access to aerial photographs.

The lighter BIRDY can be carried and launched by a single soldier, who guides the drone by clicking coordinates on a laptop computer. It has a three-mile range. Two prototype micro-drones are also being tested. These tiny spy planes weigh a mere 9 ounces and 18 ounces respectively. — Associated Press

"A 'Marked' Man"

Israeli Prime Minister Ariel Sharon said his pledge to the United States not to harm Yasser Arafat no longer holds, declaring that the Palestinian leader is a potential target for assassination. Sharon said that three years ago he promised President Bush that Israel would not harm Arafat, but since then, circumstances had changed.

Asked by the Army Radio interviewer if Arafat and Sheik Nasrallah were to be targeted, Sharon replied, "Whoever aims to kill Jews, whoever sends murderers to kill Jews, is marked for death." Israel accuses Arafat of not only ignoring violent groups operating from territory under his control, but also actively encouraging attacks against Israelis. — Associated Press ★

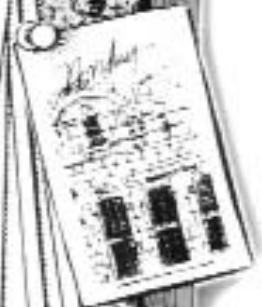

A recent article in *The Wall Street Journal*, "In Indonesia, AIDS Education Clashes with Islam," noted that this disease has become a serious health problem in this Muslim nation, and that clerics there are preventing health warnings from being made on TV and other news media.

As mentioned in an earlier *Levitt Letter*, AIDS might very well enable the King of the East to create the massive 200-million-man army that will sweep into Israel, as stated in Revelation. The dictator will point out to those sick men that what they need is women, and that women are available across the borders (China has been killing off its girl babies and has a scarcity of women). No further urging will be necessary.

This same *Wall Street Journal* article also quoted one cleric as saying, "In Islam, if someone has extramarital sex, he would be stoned severely." (Which begs the question as to how one might be stoned lightly. It also makes one wonder how they might be contracting AIDS.)

I would suggest that the way to stop the progress of this disease is to spread Christianity in the area, since AIDS is virtually nonexistent in the believing Christian community.

As we went to press, the situation in Iraq really heated up. This was not entirely unexpected as we approach the June 30th date when we will allegedly hand over Iraq to a new government.

I will stand with that; régime change in Iraq and almost all the other Arab countries is a fine ideal. Hanging around and trying to establish democracy is really very hard to do, and much beyond the personnel we have placed there. The fact is we are simply occupying a country and trying to prove that we are good friends and helpful folks, while a good percentage

of that country would like to shoot us in the back and get rid of us. Democracy is simply unknown to Arabs, now or in history, and it cannot be established by force. We ought to be moving into régime change in the other terrorist nations: Saudi Arabia, Iran, Syria, and the Palestinian Authority, at the least.

What would happen to Iraq if we simply left the place? It would probably deteriorate to a typical feudal Arab society, but in the end, it would be far better off than it was under Saddam Hussein.

We have bigger fish to fry. We did this task of régime change competently. Let's get on to the other jobs that lie before us.

As to our war on terrorism, I had a conversation with a gal who has worked with El-Al, the Israeli airline, and who has lived in Israel for a long time. I said, "If we don't start this war on terrorism, we could lose it." And she replied, "Oh, no. It's way too late.

They're everywhere. There's no way to make a cohesive war against them."

On that I would disagree. We can make a start by disrupting the Iranian-Syrian-Palestinian axis I have described in the past. But she has a point. They are everywhere, like ants. There's no time to lose and we may have waited too long, according to some observers.

"They [terrorists] are everywhere, like ants."

On March 19th, George Bush said, "Terrorists have struck in Israel." Everyone please send that comment to *The New York Times*, *USA Today*, and your local paper. There really are terrorists in Israel, not "militants," "freedom fighters," "activists," etc., etc.

All of Israel, with more than six mil-

lion people, had only 376 murders in 2003, including the 213 killed by terrorists. Washington, DC, with a population of 570,898 (according to the US Census Bureau) had 247 murders last year. If Israel had Washington's rate, it would have had almost 3,000 murders. And so, from what is known as the "murder capital of the US," our state

A United Methodist Protests

Dear Zola:

In your January *Personal Letter*, you included an article from Alan concerning Israel and the United Methodists that I would like to address.

First of all, there is no doubt that some of our general agencies do tend to be quite liberal in their thinking and that our thirteen seminaries, by and large, are theologically liberal. Nevertheless, my alma mater, for instance, Asbury Theological Seminary in Wilmore, Kentucky, is Biblically sound. I would admit that ATS does not have an official theological position on the State of Israel as it relates to the Scripture today but, even so, it is not anti-Israel.

What's more, there are many United Methodists who understand God's Chosen People as the Jewish people and the Promised Land as Israel. My Biblical studies at Asbury (based on the inductive method) have not dissuaded me from my stance for Israel. On the contrary, they have actually given me the tools to defend her.

Alan gives undue weight to the testimonies of five missionaries as if they represented the totality of the United Methodist position. At the same time, certain decisions taken by the General Conference and other boards against Israel are not so much out of an anti-Semitic sentiment (especially if we understand anti-Semitism as meaning *all* Jews) as a lack of understanding among the general UM membership. What I mean is that the issue of the return of Israel to the Land (and Bible prophecy in general) has not been of great concern to Methodists historically or even today, at least not along these lines. Even John Wesley only mentions the Jewish people a handful of times. In the last fifty years, as Biblical prophecy and the State of Israel have come to the forefront, I think that, as a denomination, we were ill-prepared to respond soundly.

Finally, Zola, Alan's comment that the United Methodist Church's membership has declined due to the curse of not blessing Israel is outrageous! The statement is utterly simplistic and naïve. As a student of United Methodism, he should know that our decline is much more complicated than that. Besides, the Gospel is far more comprehensive than teaching and preaching Biblical prophecy alone. Of course, I am convinced that today's Jerusalem is the burdensome stone foretold by Zechariah, but I am unwilling (as are others) to jump aboard on account of the ideas of some United Methodist leaders on many issues. Who then will announce to the people called Methodists the prophets' message concerning Israel today?

Dear Rev. SB:

You claim that “the courses are Biblically sound” at the Methodist Asbury Theological Seminary, but then you say that the school “does not have an official position on the state of Israel as it relates to the Scripture today.” You point out, “The issue of the return of Israel to the Land, and Bible prophecy in general, has not been of great concern to Methodists historically or even today.” Do I need to point out our Lord's standard for Tribulation period Believers: “Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these *my brethren*, ye have done it unto me” (Matthew 25:40)? How would your seminary answer that one?

My dear brother, do you understand that Israel is God's timepiece and educated Christians are watching it, holding their breath, waiting for the End Times? How can you not have some position on the Chosen People and the Promised Land?

Secondly, the testimony of all five United Methodist missionaries in Israel really does speak for your church's position. If one or two even said a kind word about the Chosen People or the Promised Land, I would have appreciated it. But every one is anti-Israel down to the bone, and that's all there is to that.

And finally, how do you know that the decline in your membership is not due to your failure to bless Israel? I

don't think you can say this idea is "outrageous" since, frankly, evangelical churches are burgeoning today evidently because they are doing the will of the Lord in terms of blessing Israel and the Jewish People. That goes for our ministry as well. You point out that "the Gospel is far more comprehensive than teaching and preaching Biblical prophecy alone," and certainly that's true. Saudi Royals Still Funding al-Qaeda

Prominent members of the Saudi royal family continue to supply millions of dollars to al-Qaeda and related groups, US officials said, according to Geostrategy-Direct, the global intelligence service. The money is funneled through so-called charities, such as the Al Haramayn Islamic Foundation.

The US Treasury Department ordered banks to freeze accounts of the Oregon and Missouri branches of Al Haramayn. An affidavit filed in US District Court in Oregon asserted Al Haramayn was used to relay \$131,000 from Saudi Arabia to al-Qaeda-aligned fighters in Chechnya. The affidavit also reported a federal grand jury investigation of Al Haramayn.

"We have to stop the princes soliciting support among the radical militants in Saudi Arabia," former CIA official Robert Bauer told the International Commission on Religious Freedom in November 2003. "We have to stop them from giving money. We have to encourage them to start reforms throughout the kingdom or it's going to bring the whole system down." — Robert Morton, WorldNetDaily.com

New Questions About Saudi Money

A federal investigation into the bank accounts of the Saudi Embassy in Washington has identified more than \$27 million in "suspicious" transactions — including hundreds of thousands of dollars paid to Muslim charities, and to clerics and Saudi students who are being scrutinized for possible links to terrorist activity.

The probe also has uncovered large wire transfers overseas by the Saudi ambassador to the United States, Prince Bandar bin Sultan. The transactions recently prompted the Saudi Embassy's longtime bank, the Riggs Bank of Washington, DC, to drop the Saudis as a client after embassy officials were "unable to provide an explanation that was satisfying," says a source familiar with the discussions. — Michael Isikoff, *Newsweek*

Spinning the News

Late in March, an article, "The Israelis Disarm a Boy with a Bomb," appeared in *The New York Times*, presenting the story this way: "With a bomb hidden under his sweater, a Palestinian boy in his teens, Hussam Abdo, approached Israeli soldiers at the same checkpoint, near Nablus, where last week another boy was captured with a bomb in his pack. As an Associated Press TV cameraman, who also happened to be waiting at the checkpoint, recorded the scene, the soldiers made the youth reveal the explosives and then strip. They seized the boy, and later safely detonated the bomb."

That story was accompanied with pictures on the front page of the *Times*, taking almost a third of the cover of what many say is the most important newspaper in the world. One color photo shows a soldier aiming a rifle at this pathetic little boy, the next shows the boy with his hands on his head, the bomb showing, the next is the most touching of all, with the boy in his underpants only while a tall soldier towers over him, and then the last shows two soldiers and the boy, now wearing a soldier's jacket. (The *Times* must have made a mistake here, revealing that a soldier had given him a jacket to cover him up, thereby showing compassion.) The final picture shows the bomb being blown up.

The coverage of *The Wall Street Journal* of the same incident, without pictures, was presented this way: "A West Bank drama unfolded, as a teenage suicide bomber decided to live and Israeli soldiers used a robot to pass him scissors to cut away his explosives-packed vest." That's all.

Meanwhile, *The Jerusalem Post* covered this story with a full page, explaining all of the above (but without *The New York Times'* bias).

“Outright Condemnation”

Lord Carey, the former Archbishop of Canterbury, launched a trenchant attack on Islamic culture recently, saying it was authoritarian, inflexible and underachieving. He also denounced moderate Muslims for failing unequivocally to condemn the “evil” of suicide bombers.

Dr. Carey acknowledged that most Muslims are peaceful people, but he attacked the “glaring absence” of democracy in Muslim countries and suggested that they had contributed little of major significance to world culture for centuries.

He said that terrorist acts, such as the September 11 attacks on America and the Madrid bombings, raised difficult questions. Contrasting Western democracy with Islamic societies, he said: “Throughout the Middle East and North Africa, we find authoritarian regimes with deeply entrenched leadership, some of which rose to power at the point of a gun and are retained in power by massive investment in security forces.

“Whether they are military dictatorships or traditional sovereignties, each ruler seems committed to retaining power and privilege.”

He urged Europeans and Americans to resist claims that Islamic states were morally, spiritually, and culturally superior. “Although we owe much to Islam handing on to the West many of the treasures of Greek thought, the beginnings of calculus, and Aristotelian thought during the period known in the West as the Dark Ages, it is sad to relate that no great invention has come for many hundred years from Muslim countries,” he said.

“This is a puzzle, because Muslim peoples are not bereft of brilliant minds. They have much to contribute to the human family and we look forward to the close cooperation that might make this possible.”

Dr. Carey said that while Christianity and Judaism had a long history of often painful critical scholarship, Islamic theology was only now being challenged to be more open to examination. “In the first few centuries of the Islamic era, Islamic theologians sought to meet the challenge, but during the past 500 years, critical scholarship has declined, leading to strong resistance to modernity.”

He said: “We look to them to condemn suicide bombers and terrorists who use Islam as a weapon to destabilize and destroy innocent lives. Sadly, apart from a few courageous examples, very few Muslim leaders condemn clearly and unconditionally the evil of suicide bombers who kill innocent people.

“We need to hear outright condemnation of theologies that state that suicide bombers are martyrs and enter a martyr’s reward.... It will do us little good if the West simply believes that the answer is to put an end to Osama bin Laden. Rather, we must put an end to conditions, distortions and misinformation that create him and his many emulators.” ★

In the first case, we have a newspaper that piously criticizes the Israelis, making a story that leaves the reader with the impression of big, tough soldiers and a wretched little boy. And, if readers don’t read the story carefully, they come away with the idea that the boy has been abused. *The Wall Street Journal* supplies that it wasn’t a question of catching the boy, but rather that “he decided to live,” confessing that he had a bomb under his shirt, and then scissors were used to cut it away. It was a non-incident, but the *Times* exploited it to abuse Israel. The *Journal* showed that the soldiers helped the boy to live.

USA Today supplied an interview with the Israeli commanding officer, Lt. Tamir Milard. The officer stated, “He told us he didn’t want to die. He didn’t want to blow up.” Lt. Col. Guy also noted that while Abdo’s purpose was to kill soldiers, he also would have killed or injured some of the two to three hundred innocent Palestinians who were also there at the checkpoint.

Both *USA Today* and *The Wall Street Journal* understood that this was a willing surrender by the bomber. That was clear on the scene. *The New York Times* transform it into the victimizing of a teenage Palestinian, while making Israel appear to be a very dangerous place. ★

An "Impediment to Peace"

The world reaction to the killing of the Hamas founder and "spiritual leader" Sheik Ahmed Yassin demonstrates the bias, double standard, and even hatred that many nations harbor against Israel. The fact that this man was confined to a wheelchair did not stop him from establishing a terror organization whose only goal is to kill as many Israelis as possible by ordering attacks against innocent civilians. However, according to the majority of nations in the world, and even the UN Human Rights Commission, the killing of this terrorist leader was an illegal act that only serves to disrupt the "peace" process and fuel hatred in the region.

At the same time that Yassin was killed, in the United States an independent congressional inquiry was being held to determine who was responsible for failing to prevent the 9/11 attacks. One thing that particularly interested many of the members of the inquiry was that if we knew in the years before 9/11 (after the first attack on the World Trade Center, the US embassies in Africa, and the *USS Cole*) where Osama bin Laden was, and how great a potential threat he posed, why didn't we kill him then?

The very same week that Israel kills one of its greatest terrorist threats, some Americans condemn this act in one breath, and then in the next, condemn the Bush and Clinton administrations and the intelligence community for not killing our own greatest terrorist threat. However, kudos to the US for blocking yet another anti-Israel resolution in the UN Security Council.

The killing of Yassin also came as Spaniards were still burying and mourning the 191 killed in the greatest terror attacks that country has ever seen. In the wake of the attacks, the EU formed an anti-terror commission determined to prevent attacks by aggressively pursuing terror networks. Yet, after sharing in the tragedy and pain wrought by Islamic terrorists, the European countries were still quick to issue some of the harshest condemnations against Israel. The new Spanish government of PM Jose Luis Rodriguez Zapatero has already signaled their capitulation to terror, which will only serve to encourage the terror groups to increase their attacks.

About a month after the killing of Yassin, Israel killed his successor Abdel Aziz Rantisi in a similar missile strike. Rantisi constantly preached the doctrine of hatred, praised homicide bombers, and actively sought the complete

destruction of Israel. And again, the world condemnations poured in against Israel for taking action against this terrorist leader.

Just as the media gave great lip service to Yassin as the "spiritual leader" of Hamas, this time the media painted Rantisi as the poor pediatrician who lived under constant Israeli occupation throughout his life in Gaza.

Make no mistake who these men were: they led, funded, trained, and dispatched their terrorists with the express mission to kill as many Israeli men, women, and children as possible. While the killings of Yassin and Rantisi make it more difficult for the Hamas leaders to operate, the organization remains undeterred in its pursuit of death and terror. World condemnations of Israel and Sharon's own Gaza disengagement plan only serve to encourage Hamas and enhance the prestige and support it currently enjoys in the Muslim world. ✨

"Merely A Killing"

Witnessing the gruesome attacks on four Americans in Fallujah in April would thoroughly sicken any fellow American — except for one very prominent American-Muslim organization, the Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR). In a statement issued shortly after the gory murders, CAIR said that it "condemned the mutilation of those killed in Iraq." The slaughter of these men was not "murder," though; it was merely a "killing."

Nowhere in the statement, in fact, did CAIR condemn the murder of the four Americans. Nowhere in the statement did CAIR condemn setting on fire the cars the men were driving. Nowhere in the statement did CAIR condemn the parading of the charred bodies through the street or the hanging of one of the headless corpses from a bridge over the Euphrates River as the locals stoned it. — Joel Mowbray, FrontPageMagazine.com ✨

According to Scripture...

Who Owns the Land? PART III

While I've noted that many valid points are made in the newly republished book *Who Owns the Land?* (written by Dr. Stanley Ellisen in 1991, and recently revised by The Moody Bible Institute's Dr. Charles Dyer in 2003), there are also some definite errors and shortcomings in it that must be pointed out. For example, Dyer states that "judged on biblical grounds, the nation today does not pass divine muster as a nation living in covenant obedience to God. The promise to possess the land is directly tied to the nation's response to Messiah." But there is not just one covenant, there are several. There are the Mosaic, the Abrahamic, the Davidic, and the New Covenants.

Only one of these, the Mosaic Covenant, is conditioned on obedience from Israel. The other covenants are unconditional, and are based solely on the faithfulness and grace of the Lord toward His Covenant People. The New Covenant has to do with Israel's relationship to the Messiah, and predicts that the nation would reject Him at His First Coming, but would receive Him at His Second Coming.

The Abrahamic Covenant gives the *ownership* of the Land, unconditionally, to the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. This ownership is irrevocable and forever, as long as this earth stands. Israel does not have to do anything to obtain ownership of the Land. They already have it. However, ownership of the Land is different from *possession* of the Land.

The Mosaic Covenant spells out how Israel can earn the right to possess the Land, which they already own by divine grant. All they have to do is keep the Law of Moses — all 613 rules. If they do that, God would be obligated to arrange for them to have possession of the Land in abundant blessing. Possession, then, would not be a matter of grace, but of contractual obligation. The problem, of course, is that Israel has never kept the Law to the point

where God was obligated to arrange for their possession of the Land. Thus, Israel has never deserved the right to possess the Land.

Nevertheless, Israel has possessed the Land in history as a nation for some 1,500 years, even though they were in constant disobedience to the Mosaic Law. How can this be? By God's grace. The Abrahamic, Davidic, and New Covenants are grace covenants. When Daniel prays for the return of the Jewish people to the Land to rebuild the Temple at the close of the Babylonian captivity, his plea to the Lord was not based on Israel's obedience, but on God's grace:

O my God, incline Thine ear and hear! Open Thine eyes and see our desolations and the city which is called by Thy name; for we are not presenting our supplications before Thee on account of any merits of our own, but on account of Thy great compassion. O Lord, hear! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, listen and take action! For Thine own sake, O my God, do not delay, because Thy city and Thy people are called by Thy name. (Daniel 9:18-19)

Why should it be any different today? Israel's stunning restoration to the Land in our time has nothing to do with Israel's obedience, but has everything to do with God's faithfulness and grace to His Covenant People. We must have an understanding of all the covenants God has with Israel, especially the grace covenants. After all, where would the Church be if God restricted His blessings and grace based only upon the obedience of believers?

While Dyer finally concludes that Christians should support Israel, it appears to be with a somewhat grudging attitude, as though it were distasteful to support a people who do not accept Jesus as the Messiah. But if we can only support a nation that has a majority who believe in Christ and are born-again, how can we support the nationhood of the United States or any other country today?

It seems that the proper attitude for Christians is to rejoice over the current restoration of Israel in unbelief as the most stunning evidence that Christ's return is ever nearer. If the Lord is setting the stage now for the events of the Tribulation, then the Rapture of the Church (which must come before the Tribulation) is surely imminent. Furthermore, the day of the Redemption of Israel, when Israel will indeed receive Christ, is drawing ever closer as well.

We should therefore rejoice over the modern state of Israel, back its possession of the Land in every way, support the Israeli believers in Christ, and make pilgrimage trips to Israel to see the wonders of the Land of the Bible. It is a privilege, not a sullen occasion, to be living in a time when the Lord is setting the stage for End Time events. ✨

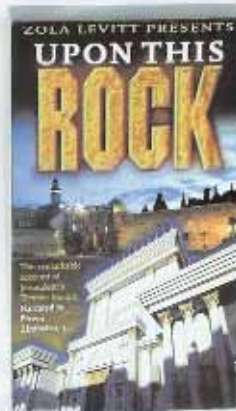
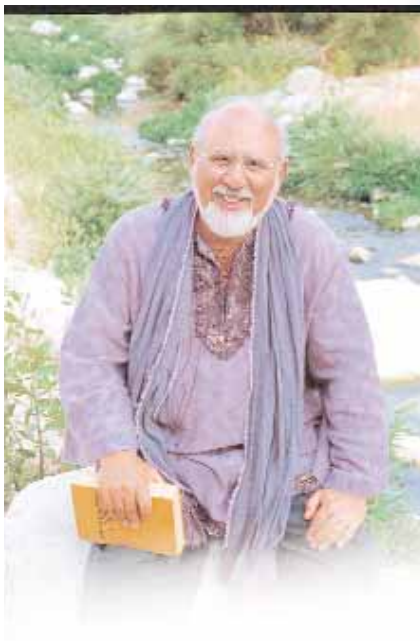
