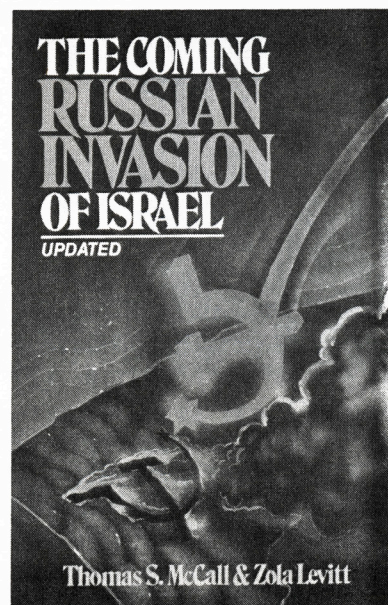

Salesmen Without a Product

Q: *Shouldn't the Church be more concerned with reaching larger and more receptive groups of people than the Jews?*

A: Although it may appear to be more desirable to concentrate mission efforts where receptivity to the Gospel is high (e.g. Africa), or on populations yet to be significantly penetrated with the Gospel (e.g. Moslems), the Bible seems to prescribe a different strategy. According to Scripture, the highest mission priority for the Church is to evangelize to the Jewish people.

There are several reasons for this priority. First, GOD ORDAINED A SPECIFIC ORDER FOR THE DEPLOYMENT OF THE GOSPEL — “TO THE JEW FIRST.” This is expressed by both Jesus and Paul, and acted in example by the apostles. In Luke’s recording of the Great Commission (Luke 24:47; Acts 1:8), our Lord told His disciples to witness to the whole world, but to do so to the Jews first. All too often this has become the Great “Omission,” as the Church has forgotten the priority of Jewish witnessing.

Paul further affirms this basic principle in Romans 1:16 (“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth: to the Jew first, and also the Greek”) and shows that he meant what he wrote by acting on it himself (Acts 13:46). Paul invariably visited the synagogues to begin his ministry in the cities of the Empire. “To the Jew first” was clearly the order followed by all of the apostles in sharing the Gospel.

Secondly, THE ROLE OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE IN GOD’S PROGRAM IS TO BE A LIGHT UNTO THE GENTILES. The Jewish people have always been the people of a cause. That cause, historically and biblically, has been to serve God and proclaim Him to the nations. God told His friend Abraham that his descendants would be “a blessing to all nations” and so the Jewish people have always been noticeable and influential everywhere they went in the world. But unfortunately, many Jewish people today have forsaken the Lord, and have replaced their zeal for Him with a zeal for civil liberties, Zionism or any number of other causes.

They are salesmen without a product! They were originally destined to “sell” Christ. We Jews are activists by Divine design — we spend our lives striving for fulfillment, striving to serve something greater than ourselves. Only the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob will satisfy, and yet most of us find Judaism insufficient to meet our deepest longings.

The answer for Jewish people is to be found in their Messiah, Jesus Christ. Incidentally, once Jews return to their Messiah, it is this drive to serve a great cause that makes them such effective evangelists. The salvation of

Jewish people inevitably results in exponential Gentile salvation as well, because the role of Jewish people in God’s program is to be a shining light. He will yet use their testimony during the Tribulation (Rev. 7:4).

Third, SALVATION HAS COME THROUGH THE JEWS (John 4:22). The Bible and the Church have also come through the Jews (Rom 9:6,7). Most importantly, Jesus Christ came through the Jews. Yeshua Ha Mashiach is the Jewish Messiah. There would seem to be a certain implied indebtedness and commitment to the Jew’s salvation on the part of the Church, particularly as they are partakers in the Jewish spiritual benefits (Eph. 2:11-1, 3:4-7; Rom. 11:15-27).

The Jewish people have all too often been ignored and neglected by the Church. Paul explains in Romans 11 that salvation has come to the Gentiles in order to provoke the Jews to jealousy. But instead of making them jealous, instead of making them desirous to know their Messiah, the Church historically has chosen to persecute the Jews mercilessly. As a result, among Jews today there is no stronger profane term than, “Jesus Christ”! Where the Church’s responsibility was to turn Jewish people *toward* their Messiah, they have been turned hatefully *against* Him. I have not met many Jewish brethren who are moved to jealousy by the Christianity they see about them.

Particularly disturbing is that this powerful and insidious anti-Semitism has been incited by some of the Church’s most revered theologians and leaders. These include Chrysostom, Aquinas, Calvin, Luther, and the list could go on ad nauseam of those leaders in the church who have condemned the Jews as unworthy of evangelism! This anti-Semitic philosophy still pervades much of the Church, less overtly perhaps than in the bombastic diatribes against the Jews of yesteryear, but may still be seen, for instance, rearing its ugly head in Christian publications or certain liberal churches on occasion. This lambasting must be stopped and its repercussions reversed. The Abrahamic Covenant is still in effect — “And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee” (Gen 12:3).

Zechariah writes of a future time, prior to the second advent, when two-thirds of the Jewish population will be exterminated. Today there are sixteen million Jewish people worldwide. If what Zechariah wrote about were to happen today, it would mean the eternal damnation of over ten million of God’s Chosen People — unless they have a chance to respond to their Messiah prior to this second Holocaust. Most Jewish people have *never* heard a clear presentation of the Gospel. Since, particularly in America, Jews and Christians live among one another as neighbors, this is inexcusable. Believers don’t have to

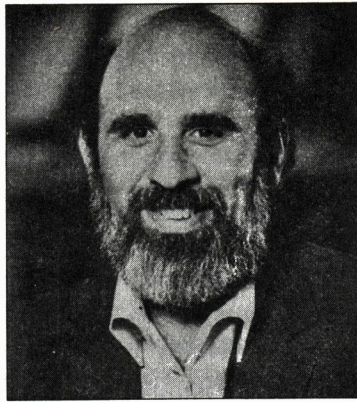
A CALENDAR FOR A SOUL!

take the fullest advantage of this opportunity.

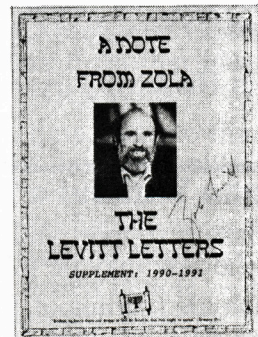

raise mission support and travel overseas to share the Gospel with these people. Neither prejudice nor apathy toward the Jew may be tolerated any longer by those of us who heed the Biblical call to evangelize.

Zechariah also writes of the Lord's continued love and concern for His chosen nation, and about their future. “In those days ten men from all the nations will grasp the garment of a Jew, saying, ‘Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you’” (8:23). God has not rejected or forgotten the Jew — we dare not either. It is important to be witnesses to the lost billions around the world — but in doing so, let's remember the family of the One whose life and message we bear witness to.

As He Himself put it: “Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me” (Mt. 25:40).

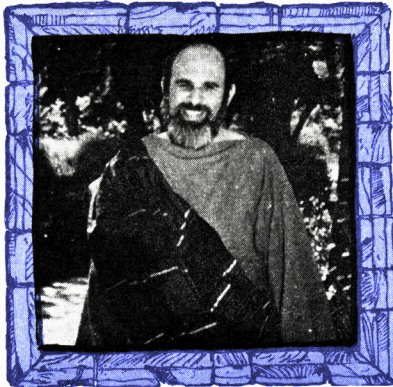

Hebrew Lesson

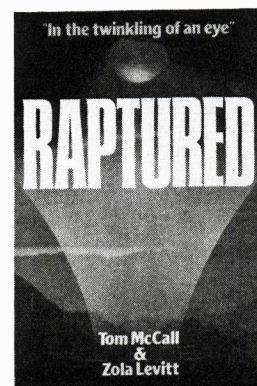

Hebrew is a language of consonants — no vowels. In Biblical times, as today, Hebrew was read with no vowels. Can you imagine trying to read the newspaper with no vowels? (Try rdng ths sntnc wth vwls.) Scribes, carefully preserving the ancient text and pronunciation for future generations, added vowels several centuries after the Bible was finished. Hebrew vowels appear in combination with consonants, usually under the letters. Note how vowels are written in the following familiar passage:

שְׁאֲלוּ שְׁלוֹם יְרוּשָׁלַיִם

*Sha-alu Shalom Yerushalaim
 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem
 (Psalm 122:6a)*
