### Somalia

The situation in Somalia is not precisely a sign of the end, except in regard to the "betrayal and offense" of Matthew 24:10. A look at the map accompanying this article will show that this otherwise unimportant nation possesses an unfortunate location. Gifted with a long

seacoast and good flying and sailing weather, it happens to be located just south of the most sensitive areas of the very troubled Middle East.

Have we taken over a sovereign nation just to keep an eye on our oil supplies?

Last winter the *Levitt Letter* predicted that we were never going to leave Somalia. At that time President Bush had announced a brief mission based on feeding some hungry people. Since then we have managed to create the sort of complications that require us to stay around at length. In the meanwhile, we are establishing a veritable military base with easy access to Saudi Arabia, Egypt, Israel, the Arab Emirates and the Persian Gulf nations of Iraq and Iran.

Could it be that we have just taken for ourselves a Middle Eastern nation in order to keep an eye on the vast Persian Gulf oil fields and the inevitable conflicts surrounding our ally, Israel? Since the Israelis and the Arabs are notably sensitive about giving up land, we had to go to the nearest "easy movein." Note that when the carrier Kitty Hawk attacked Baghdad a few months ago, it departed from Somalia.

With all the smoke screen arguments about what our mission is and how right or wrong we are to be pursuing it, it


seems that no one has troubled to glance at a map, where our real reason for this occupation is obvious. Just as we kept large contingents of troops in the Philippines to keep an eye on Asia, and in Germany to keep an eye on Europe, we are now having to keep an eye on our oil supplies.

## A Look at the Book

#### "MESSIAH ACCORDING TO ISAIAH" - Part I


Due to the overwhelmingly favorable response we received on the last series in this column on the minor prophets, it seems appropriate to once again delve into the vast theological wealth of the prophets. This month, we begin a series based on the writings of the "prince of prophets," Isaiah, specifically what we can glean from his message concerning the Messiah. Since Isaiah is a vast and profound book, in this series we will just be touching upon some of his great Messianic themes and insights. To probe

more deeply into this prophetic masterpiece would keep this series going indefinitely!

From Isaiah's point of view, the Messiah Isaiah doesn't was yet to come. specifically tell his contemporary readers/listeners that in seven hundred years they could expect a carpenter from Nazareth to be the Messiah, but the

Isaiah, whose name means "the Lord saves," lived during the time of the divided kingdom (upon Solomon's death, his kingdom split into Israel and Judah). Isaiah spent most of his ministry in Jerusalem in the southern kingdom of Judah, approximately 700 years before Christ. During his ministry the northern kingdom of Israel was conquered by Assyria, and much of Isaiah's message concerns a warning to Judah that the same fate awaited it if the nation did not repent. Babylon would be the nation to lead Judah into this promised captivity.

However, the message of Isaiah does not only contain assurances of judgment and exile. The prophet is equally concerned with the promise of God's restoration and compassion. Isaiah paints a portrait of an

when He did come.

"Messiah" is an English transliteration of a Hebrew word which means "anointed "Messiah" and "Christ" have identical meanings. (The word "Christ" is the English transliteration of the Greek word for Messiah. Another way of referring to "Jesus Christ" is "Jesus, the Messiah" or "Jesus, the Anointed One.") Throughout his writings, Isaiah depicts a multifaceted, several-dimensional mosaic of the coming Messiah's qualities. prophet has literally saturated his work with references to Messiah. One has only to read through any few chapters to confirm this fact. We will briefly survey some of the major characteristics Isaiah furnishes.

The first clue we are given as to who the Messiah will be and what he will be like is found in 7:14. There is much debate as to how to accurately interpret this verse, whether the woman referred to is a virgin or Isaiah was speaking of a contemporary woman or someone in the far future. However, since it is to be a miraculous sign given by God, I believe this passage teaches that the Messiah will be a human child born of a virgin. Of particular note, this child is to be given the designation, "God with us"—"Immanuel" in Hebrew. Jesus was the ultimate Immanuel, "God with us."

In Isaiah's chapter 9, beginning in verse 2, we are told that people who are in darkness and in the shadow of death will have a great light shine on them. This will be the result of the coming of Messiah, which will bring joy to Israel and salvation to the nations. Many rabbis through the centuries have agreed that this "light" written of is the Messiah. This interpretation is borne out in vs. 6-7, where the following four great qualities of the Messiah are enumerated.

First, it is reiterated that he will be born a child. This affirms his *humanity*. Second and most strikingly, within the same sentence we are told that he will also somehow be *Deity*; he is called "mighty God" and "everlasting Father." Isaiah teaches that the coming Messiah will in some way be both God and man.

Third, Messiah will also be *King*. He is called here "wonderful Counselor, Prince of peace," and we are told that there will be no end to the increase of the government, which will rest upon his shoulders. Isaiah is careful to specify which government is being referring to. It

is the government of the united kingdom of Israel and it is David's throne from which Messiah will rule. This is the fourth great quality of Messiah. Indeed. that Messiah is a descendent of David and thereby rightful heir to the covenantal promises to David can be seen in Isaiah The prophet indicates that 11:1-10. Messiah will in some way be the "perfect David" who will rule with the spirit of God, understanding, wisdom, counsel. strength and the fear of the Lord. He will be a righteous and faithful King who will not only rule Israel but the whole world. The Messianic Kingdom will encompass a world transformed into a paradise on Earth (11:1-10; 55:4).


Having just returned from Israel, I find it exhilarating to review the prophetic message concerning the King who will rule from David's throne in Jerusalem. This month we have focused on a few of the great characteristics of Messiah found in the opening portion of Isaiah's message. Next month we will focus on the Messianic attributes of prophet, priest and servant, and we will conclude with an examination of Isaiah's forecast of Messiah's marvelous accomplishments.

I have a personal request for those of you who like our music. The price of producing original music continues to rise like everything else these days. If we are to continue bringing you new albums, I have to ask you to please purchase them. So many of you write to say that you enjoy hearing the music along with the TV program; surely a cassette tape for your home or car would be a nice thing to have or to give to someone. The music is Scriptural and intended as a witness, and frankly it would make my heart glad if you would allow me to minister to more people

this way. Thanks.

As we near our fifteenth anniversary, we rely on you more and more. In the past tightening our belt in one place would supply funding for another, and we would often have to rob Isaac to pay Jacob. As things are now, however, the Lord has seen fit to expand our outreach such that each separate ministry totally depends on Him and His willing people for its support. Our pledge to you is to cover Israel and the End Times, and that often makes us jump and run even in the middle of a new series. The expenses for Tell It On the Mountains were not even met when we had to film Signs of the End, and we are now caught in a proverbial "double bind." If we don't receive very significant year-end gifts, we will not be able to make new programming in 1994. That hurts, because we are in the most dramatic times of modern Israel's existence!

Year-end giving of course grants you the maximum tax deduction on your money and also serves our purposes very well. I have a feeling that spring will bring many new prophetic developments in a world that is conforming very closely to what Scripture has foretold. In plain words we truly need your prayers and your support more than ever before and for the best of all causes.

If you want to check the situation in Israel for yourself, our next tour will depart March 6, 1994. We will offer our Dead Sea/Eilat extension along with our regular itinerary. 

#### **Hebrew Lesson**

Hebrew is a language of consonants— no vowels. In biblical times, as today, Hebrew was read with no vowels. Can you imagine trying to read the newspaper with no vowels? (Try rdng ths sntnc witht vwls.) Scribes, carefully preserving the ancient text and pronunciation for future generations, added vowels several centuries after the Bible was finished. Hebrew vowels appear in combination with consonants, usually under the letters. Note how vowels are written in the following familiar passage:
