STATE O' THE MINISTRY

Most of us are focused on the birth of our Lord and spending time with our families. Some of us are squeezing in last-minute tax breaks.

we don't know what God has in store for us until we get there. Consequently our plan has had the latitude that living by faith requires. And we are responsive to your votes.

This can be an apprehensive time for non-profit organizations like ours. Many ministerial advisors say that how we ask for funds now will determine how effective our outreach can be for the next several months.

Imagine how fast a biblical ship would go if only three percent of its crew were rowing!

Some letters from our viewers have suggested that our fund appeals should occur only annually. "Make a plan," they say, "and a budget." "Stick to your strategy," they advise, "and you shouldn't have any shortfalls." How appealing: spending from a reservoir and having bills paid before they're even incurred.

Most people, however, prefer to make donations throughout the year, and we haven't had a "reservoir" since day one. This has allowed you to "vote" for the TV programs, series and newsletters you find most worthwhile. Also, many times

It's exciting for us to give you new TV programs each week. That's not always God's will, however, and many of our programs carry messages worth repeating. A number of you have said you enjoy our reruns.

If you've been reading our newsletters regularly, you know that we don't have cyclical "crises" requiring emergency help. We were able to interrupt production of the *Tell It On the Mountains* series to chronicle some pressing news developments, and we thank you for your help with the extra invoices.

God's guidance has kept us out of any real lurches since 1978. As a matter of fact, we're celebrating our fifteenth anniversary this December!

Last month, my father, Zola, mentioned that only 3% of our TV audience supports us. We also hear from some of the other 97%.

Some write in to say that they're simply too poor to do more than pray for us, and believe me, we need those prayers. Others let us know they want to support Israel directly. To them I recommend planting trees through the Jewish National Fund (1-800-247-2818) or purchasing Israeli bonds (1-800-229-9650 ext. 849). We've been condemned for not distributing food. There's a terrific ministry for feeding the homeless: The Ruff House, P.O. Box 426 in Hutchins, TX 75141.

We've been chastised for talking too much about Israel and Jewish people and been admonished to "get back to the Bible." One woman told Zola that she could no longer respect Jesus, knowing He's Jewish, even though He's her savior! We get Bible questions, requests for counseling and even research assignments from those who don't want to make a trip to the library.

Sometimes I wonder how we are able to accomplish so much for so many with so little. With a staff of twelve, we broadcast a weekly national TV program, publish two monthly newsletters for nearly 35,000 readers, process 7,000 pieces of mail per month and ship almost 70,000 Bible teaching items per

year. God is definitely with us!

Many believe that by paying no corporate taxes we have an easy time. But, we're carrying a lot of what secular companies would call "dead weight." Imagine how fast a biblical warship would go if only three percent of its crew were rowing!

In our case, the cargo we're carrying is inestimably precious: the destination of hundreds of thousands, perhaps millions of souls. This ship offers free passage to infirm brothers and sisters who love our newsletters but can't afford their own sustenance. For the curious channel hoppers who don't realize that the Bible is interesting or that Israel is so beautiful, we say, "Come on board; no ticket necessary." To those in jail and those whose churches teach only from the New

Testament, our boat takes them through the Old Testament and all the way to Israel--even if they

have no passport.

Friend, if you're on board and you're enjoying the ride, please, will you take an oar for awhile? Help us get this cargo of viewers and readers to the Kingdom of God, and your rowing will be bountifully rewarded!

In terms of the damage report that Scottie gives Captain Kirk on *Star Trek*, our ship is going as fast as she can, and we're taking a few hits. Spiritual warfare is no laughing matter, and Satan does not play fair. Occasionally a supplier or an employee will go awry, and we see that for what it is: severe resentment from the dark side that we're spreading the Word of God, from coast to coast, in all fifty states and abroad.

Zola has had some suspenseful episodes with his heart trouble this summer. Many TV stations and networks have increased our airtime rates. And, in the day-to-day struggle of just keeping the various irons in the fire, we've seen the resilient and ugly presence of God's prime enemy.

Nonetheless, we continue *and continue* to overcome. Through God we overcome. We have recently recruited two of the most incredibly sweet and efficient office workers you could imagine. We've further sped up our computer system and incorporated 9-digit ZIP codes and bar codes that economize and quicken our bulk rate mailings. We've renewed our lease for four more years at a rate that reflects that our building management is on God's team.

Thanks to you, we've made a new album this year and 34 more TV programs! We've taken four tours to Israel and persuaded a considerable number of TV stations to promote Israel tourism and Israel in general at no cost to Israel! We've also answered more Bible questions by mail and handled more 1-800 orders for Bible materials than ever before.

The bottom line is that this has been the most challenging and most productive year since God gave birth to this ministry, and you are--or can be--a part of something wonderful.

As a business school graduate, I would want to see some numbers if I were reading the *Levitt Letter* for the first time. First of all, 62% of our budget goes right to TV production and airtime. Printing and postage consume 19%. Our staff expenses including benefits total only

14%, and our miscellaneous expenses are about 5%. Our fund-raising expenses are zero.

Frankly you don't need to see our audited financial statements to be safe in making a generous year-end gift to this ministry (of course you're welcome to them for the asking). You see our TV programs from Israel and our newsletters with news the secular media will never provide. You also have access to a supply of Bible teaching materials that can enlighten you and inspire you about as much as a seminary degree if not more so.

When you sit before God on Judgement Day, you will be able to say you studied His Word, you learned about Israel and you fed His sheep. Welcome aboard, mate!

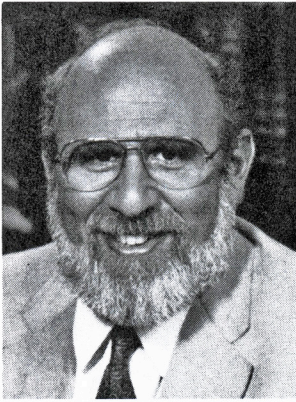

broadcasters covering the negative side of the story. Most Israelis whom we talked to were dead set against the peace agreement, and with good scriptural reasons. We interrupted our "Mountains" series for programs called "Signs of the End."

And that is what we do. What started out as a very quiet ministry explaining Israel and the Jewish roots to Christian people has somehow placed us on the front lines of what has proved to be a very real shooting war.

If we're to go on giving the quality of coverage to current events that we have during 1993, we really have to ask for your increasing support. There is no question that this contemporary kind of programming appeals to unbelieving viewers and acts as a tremendous witness, but it's obviously costly.

I was shocked to learn recently that the small percentage of our viewing audience that has supported the program is actually declining. I don't mind providing free television to several groups of people: unbelievers in general, Jewish people who need the truth about Israel, and shut-ins and others of the poor who truly cannot afford to support ministries. But I must draw the line, as did Paul, at encouraging the perfectly able church to partake in the blessings but not support the ministry. New Testament teaching is exactly the opposite: If we are blessed, then we are to contribute.

And in plainer words we can not continue on many stations that do not support us. Disappointed viewers write in all the time to ask why the program has gone off when they have never sent a gift, however small, to keep it on.

Dear Friends,

As usual at the end of the year I want to ask you to look ahead with me to what lies before our ministry. Obviously, we are very busy with the latest developments in Israel, and 1993 showed us a prime example of how versatile and how ready to act any ministry must be these days. We were as surprised as anyone else that the Israeli government would suddenly give land to the PLO for promises of peace. I still have moments when I think I am going to wake up from this bad dream.

As you know, we were already airing our "Tell It On the Mountains" series when Arafat became a statesman and a peacemaker without warning. Our job was to shine as bright a light as possible on this suspicious event and see if it might in some way answer to prophecy. Deception is key to the end times; the Antichrist will depend on it for his power over world governments. Conceivably Arafat, thirty years a professional terrorist, will appear to change his spots and deceive Israel into providing him a base of operations within the Promised Land.

We went quickly to location, taking our crew with our Fall Festival Tour, to interview key personalities connected to this unpredictable prophetic development. From protesters at the Wall to the Mayor of Jericho, we found everyone as stymied as we were. And it occurred to us, as time went by, that we were among the very few

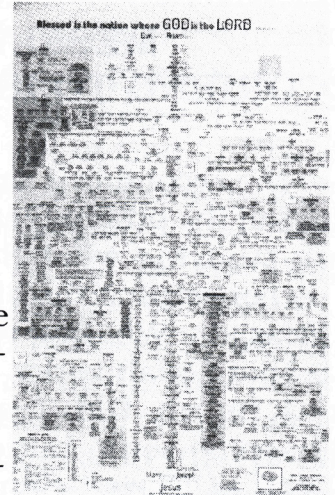

A Look at the Book

"MESSIAH ACCORDING TO ISAIAH" - Part II

This is the second in a series based on the writings of the prophet Isaiah. Specifically, we are studying what this great prophet tells us concerning the life and ministry of our Messiah. What is remarkable about this is that Isaiah is not a New Testament book; it is an Old Testament message written some seven hundred years before the birth of Christ! Centuries before the Messiah Jesus would come to His people, His prophet Isaiah prepared the nation of Israel with a tremendous amount of information concerning what to expect from the Messiah. Although Isaiah doesn't specifically spell out all the details, he does provide many clues, insights and particulars about what the Messiah and His ministry would be like.

Last time we focused on Isaiah's revelation of the coming Messiah's humanity, deity, royalty and Davidic lineage. This month we will examine Messiah's roles as prophet, priest and servant. Remember, this is just an overview, not a detailed analysis, so we won't be discussing any one area for too long. Just fasten your seat belts as we sweep across the Messianic map Isaiah has laid out for us!

In ancient Israel, there were three holy offices - positions that were set apart and distinct from all other positions in the nation. These three offices were that of prophet, priest and king. We have already seen Isaiah's revelation that the Messiah,

who will somehow be both man and God, would be king of united Israel. As a descendant of King David, He would rule from David's throne; the ultimate man, the ultimate king, the ultimate Davidic figure.

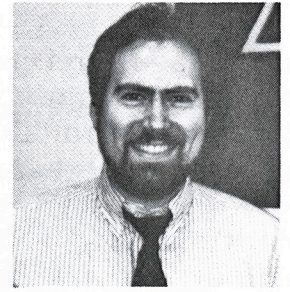
Just as King David functioned in positions other than that of king of Israel, so will the definitive Davidic king. David also functioned in the role of priest, not a Levitical priest, but one after the order of the king of righteousness, Melchizedek (Psalm 110:4). As the chief agent of God's kingdom in Israel, David performed many

priestly, worship-related activities. For example, David supervised the ark of the covenant (2

Sam. 6), prayed and interceded on behalf of the people (the Davidic Psalms), guided the Levitical music ministry (1 Chron. 6:31; 15:16), wrote Levitical liturgy (2 Chron. 16 and many other psalms) and generally administered the work of the priests (1 Chron. 23).

In Isaiah 53:10, we learn that Messiah would represent the people to God and intercede on their behalf. He would accomplish this not by offering an animal sacrifice (as a Levitical priest would) but by offering Himself as a sacrifice for their sins. As the definitive priest after the order of the "king of righteousness," Messiah would pay the ultimate price and offer the supreme gift of worship to God.

King David, as the author of many of the Psalms, was also a prophet. In fact, he is called a prophet in the New Testament by no less an authority than Peter himself (Acts 2:30). In the same way, Messiah would also be a great prophet. Moses foretold of a great prophet who would be like himself and come some time after his ministry (Deut. 18:15). In fact, the preeminent Jewish messianic expectation has always been for the great prophet of God who would deliver his people and establish the Kingdom of God. Isaiah presents this great prophet in 61:1-2 as bringing good news to the afflicted, binding up the brokenhearted, proclaiming liberty and the favorable year of the Lord as well as a day of vengeance. Isaiah makes it crystal clear that Messiah would fulfill the prophetic office in the Spirit and anointing of the Lord. These promises from the Old Testament are the very same ministries Jesus enacted in the New Testament (Luke 4). Therefore, we see that the Messiah, according to Isaiah, would execute all three holy offices - king, priest and prophet.

There is also another Messianic title found in Isaiah's writings. This is of particular significance because it is a title which both Messiah and Israel share. The title is that of the Lord's Servant. This is a topic which, by itself, could sustain a whole series of articles. The importance of this particular aspect of Messiah's ministry cannot be overemphasized. In a sense, Messiah is not only the perfect Davidic representation but also the perfect embodiment of the nation of Israel. The Lord promises through Isaiah that Messiah will succeed where Israel failed. He will fulfill God's will within Israel and among the nations.

Contained in several large passages of Isaiah (42:1-7; 49:1-7; 52:13-53:12) are what are called the great "Servant Songs." In these sections the prophet describes the ultimate Servant of God. The Servant will perform the will of God in His power and righteousness. The Servant/Messiah will be gentle, submissive and obedient (42:2; 50:6; 53:7). He is also vaguely described as a costly cornerstone and foundation to be believed in (28:16). In His short ministry, Jesus was proven to be the ultimate servant of the Lord. His life was a fulfillment of the promised attributes of Isaiah's Messianic Servant. Because He was able to succeed where the collective nation of Israel failed, we believers have a true foundation and cornerstone for our faith.

These descriptions lead us directly into the ministry and accomplishments of the Messiah, but for those deeds and what they will lead to, namely the suffering, death and exaltation of Messiah, we must be patient until next month!

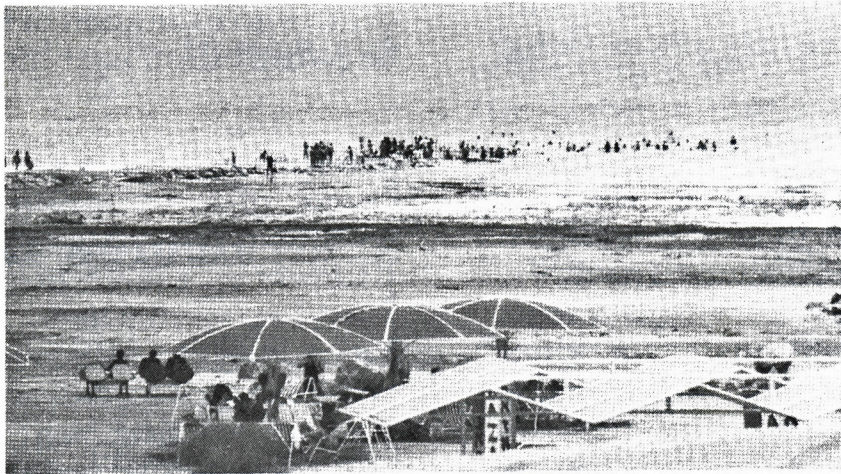
