## An Unrepentant Zionist

These are interesting days for an unrepentant Zionist. Those who know me as one who thinks that 100% of the land of Israel belongs to the Jews and that 100% of the problems over there are caused by the Palestinians continue to approach me about the incident at Hebron. Don't I now see how violent the Israelis really are, they ask me? Don't I see that terrorism comes from both sides?

No, what has happened is that after 46 years of nonstop Arab terrorism against Israel, America, various European nations, etc., the Palestinians have finally provoked a single reprisal, and now that they see what incoming terrorism is like, they don't like it one bit.

This article, rejected by the *Dallas Morning News*, is in answer to the remarkable writing of

Bassem Ajami in their March 6 Sunday Reader Section. In his "Massacre Poses Questions for Israelis," Mr. Ajami attempts to prove not that Israelis are as bad as Palestinians in terms of violence

and terror, but actually much worse. Even people who understand the technique of "the big lie" and its usefulness in propaganda must blush as Ajami attempts to show that the Jews came to Israel in order to conduct "pogroms" against the Palestinians. In his thinking it would make the Jews feel better to take retribution on folks they found in Israel for what they had suffered back in Russia (Dr. Baruch Goldstein who perpetrated the awful shootings at Hebron was an American — born and bred). Totally unmoved by truth, Ajami considers the Israelis to be the terrorists. He thinks "the Palestinians have been at the receiving end most of the time."

Ajami's article takes the position that Zionist "Revisionists saw that the Jewish state should

revive the myth of ancient Jewish military power." I have certainly heard the

Jews accused of every conceivable shortcoming in this world, ancient and modern, but military power is a new one. Admittedly, little Israel, outnumbered 200 million to 4 million by Arabs and attacked over and over and over again as fast as those enemies can rearm, needs to keep a standing army in these times. But going back all the way to King David, some 3,000 years, the Jews have been persecuted everywhere, a consequence of their weakness. To be called powerful and violent by the inventors and perfecters of terrorism, the Palestinians, is an odd compliment.

Ajami runs down a time-honored list of supposed Jewish atrocities, none observed by outsiders and none provable. When accusing people of terrorism, I would rather refer to events that the man on the street can appreciate,

like, say shooting the Munich athletes in their backs, blowing up Pan Am 103, the World Trade Center bombing, the scud missiles falling on utterly innocent non-combatants in Tel Aviv (and the Palestinian cheers), the European airport massacres, the hundreds of incursions into Galilee from Lebanon, the stabbings on the streets of Jerusalem and on and on with the daily fare of the most inveterate terrorists on the face of the earth — the Palestinians. Mr. Ajami might ask himself just why the Israeli settlers are armed. Do they go hunting out there in the West Bank deserts or do they have a maniacal enemy that considers it an honor, meritorious of martyrdom, to attack innocent civilians as they till their fields or drive the roads?

Let's tell it like it is. Israel was indeed a nation of some strength in the

Middle East during the reigns of King David and King Solomon; but that period was marked by perfect

peace with the surrounding nations and with the sojourners in the land itself. But a divided and weakened Israel was subsequently conquered by much greater powers — Babylon, Persia, Greece and Rome, and finally most of the Jewish people were dispersed out of their land. Some seven centuries after the birth of Christ, the first Moslem, Mohammed, was born. We should note that the coming of Islam was predated by 1,600 years by King David and about 2,600 years by Abraham, the Jewish patriarch! Islam is important because it is the pronouncements of that faith which license its followers to invade and occupy other people's lands. The Israel the original Moslems squatted on was covered with ancient Jewish relics attesting to the prior title of Jewish people of more than two millennia.

A legend eventually arose that Mohammed visited Jerusalem and rode his horse to heaven from a certain rock in that city, the Holy City of the Jews. The Koran does not mention Jerusalem even once, but it was considered expedient to place the story there so that some religious claim to the land might be imagined. Zealotry and the Arab thirst for territory took it from there.

The rightful owners of the land were away a long time, not returning until A.D. 1948 in any numbers, but then developments were rapid. The Jews declared independence, seven Arab nations attacked them overnight and what has been

virtually a nonstop attempt to dig out the Jewish "cancer" from their ancient homeland began. The inept Arab armies failed at every attempt to dislodge Israel.





If the biblical sanctions that give the land to the Jews are ignored and if the obvious prior title established by the archaeology is ignored, then the Jews at least have won the land in military conquest (like we European immigrants won this continent we call the United States).

These propaganda-created people began a campaign of hatred against the Israelis, though they lived better than Arabs in any Arab country in the world. Their "crushed by oppressors" act culminated in the intifada, in which they sent children against soldiers (in view of international television cameras), and the Israelis were stymied. You have to hand it to the Israelis, they were the most gentle of "oppressors."

I don't recall American settlers using rubber bullets or tear gas on the Indians. I believe when there was what we called "an uprising" in this country, we simply shot them all dead. The Israelis were patient and casualties were relatively few as riot control goes these days.



History is replete with Jewish primacy in these areas and so is the archaeology. The Dead Sea Scrolls, ancient Jewish commentaries on even older Jewish manuscripts, predating Mohammed by almost a thousand years, were discovered deep within the West Bank. Ironically, all covenants given to the patriarchs establishing Jewish ownership through Abraham, Isaac and Jacob were pronounced in this area. But when I went there to tape a television series called "Israel by Divine Right," I myself for the first time in my life had to carry a gun.

In my 43 tours of the Holy Land, I have dealt with what are called Palestinian people many times, and I count some of them as my friends. I am not without feelings for "have-nots" anywhere in this world. And I certainly deplore what happened at Hebron as being far beneath Jewish standards or the standards of civilized people anywhere. I am sorry for the Moslems murdered at their worship in Hebron, as I was sorry for the Jews murdered at their worship in Istanbul recently. I commiserated as the President of Israel went to Hebron to bow his head in apology, but I did not see Yassar Arafat do the same.

I am sorry to say it, but there is a moral difference between the Israelis and the Palestinians, just as there is a moral difference between the western democracies and totalitarian dictatorships. Israel is a democracy of free people that wish to have this very tiny land as their home, adrift in a score of Arab dictatorships who will write anything, say anything, or kill anyone in their mindless hatred of the Jewish people.

## Letters to Zola

In our March issue we ran an open letter from Zola to the pastor of a large Dallas church on the subject of evangelism to the Jewish people and missions to Israel. The pastor recently replied and we are printing his letter below. It is an encouraging letter. *Thank you so very much for your recent letter and especially for your encouragement for our ministry. I am a great admirer of yours, and I am grateful for the incredible ministry God has given you.*

*You are quite right to point out that our mission to the Jewish population is quite lacking. Frankly, most of us in the church today are quite concerned about the salvation of God's people, Israel, but have very limited strategies as to how to accomplish that goal. As a result of your letter, I am challenging our staff to seek ways to change that. We have a few Jewish members in our church who are strong believers in our Lord. I trust their input will help us. We are burdened for all the people of our community.*

*As far as our outreach mission to Israel itself, at this point we are dependent upon the mission program of the Southern Baptist Convention.*



## “MESSIAH ACCORDING TO ISAIAH”


Conclusion - Part IV

We paused in our study of the prophet Isaiah's message to reflect on the timeless poetry of a shepherd boy who would become King of all Israel. We saw how the words of King David, written some three thousand years ago, were still relevant and emotionally moving to believers today. This month we will see the relevance and consequence of the prophet Isaiah's words concerning the Son of King David, our Lord Jesus the Messiah, in the last entry of our series.

To refresh your memories, let's review what information we have gathered thus far from this prince of prophets concerning the King of the Jews. We have learned that the Messiah would be the ultimate prophet, highest priest and supreme King of Israel and the nations. As the Davidic figure par excellence, He would accomplish great things in the name of God. His greatest work, however, would be completed in his role of suffering servant. His messianic mission could be completed only through intense, personal suffering on behalf of humanity. What was that two-fold divine mission He was to accomplish? That of comforting and restoring Israel's greatness coupled with extending salvation to the entire world.

Through the suffering of the Messiah who would make intercession before God on behalf of all people, it would be possible for a great messianic age to be ushered in and the kingdom of God to be truly established

on earth. We left off last time on this note of sorrow: that the Messiah would in some way have to be completely and totally rejected by His own people, Israel. This of course, is exactly what happened to Jesus Christ six hundred years following Isaiah's prophecy.



Isaiah records in some detail the intense and brutal suffering of the Messiah. Although He is flawlessly obedient to God's directives, He willingly allows Himself to be beaten, abused, mocked, spit upon and humiliated (50:5-6). The awesome 53rd chapter of Isaiah stands as a Scriptural monument to

record the acute suffering of the Messiah.

Isaiah tells his readers that the Messiah had no attractiveness or impressive appearance to reveal the King He was (53:2); He hadn't the merest trappings of royalty about Him. He was thought to be stricken, afflicted and smitten of God (53:4-5). The people believed that the man's sufferings were brought on by his own sin. The Messiah will be cruelly pierced through and crushed, chastened and scourged. Yet, paradoxically, through His suffering He bears the people's griefs, carries their sorrows and heals them (53:5-6). It is for their transgressions and iniquities that He willingly suffers, not for His own (53:4). It is at this point that the most startling revelation of all is announced by Isaiah. It is the shocking disclosure that the Messiah would not merely suffer, He would die. Although the nation has sinned and disobeyed their God, God Himself caused the

punishment for the nation's iniquity to fall on the Messiah (53:5-6). He is killed in the prime of life, although He had done no violence or lied or committed any sin. Messiah's grave, although assigned to be with wicked men, i.e., criminals, was with the rich instead (53:9). He was a good man, but was not recognized as such by the people.

However, it was the Lord's sovereign plan for Him to be crushed. This was in order for Him in his office as High Priest to do the unprecedented: to render Himself as the ultimate and final guilt offering (53:10). He was counted among sinners, pouring Himself out to death, yet through His sacrifice made intercession for sinners by bearing their sins (53:12).

Through the suffering and death of the Messiah, His self-sacrifice, Isaiah records in 53:10-12 that He will be exalted and glorified. In some way, the Messiah who was killed must be raised up again. Continuing in 53:10, we learn that although the Messiah has just died, He will somehow prolong His days and live again! He will be blessed by the Lord for His obedience. He is called the Righteous One, The Lord's Servant, who through bearing the sins of others has justified the many. Also, back in 52:13-15, we see that Messiah will prosper, be high and lifted up, and greatly exalted, even though His appearance is marred and disfigured. As Highest Priest, He will sprinkle many nations, and the world will finally comprehend who the Messiah is and what He has accomplished.

Our Lord Jesus Christ, the Messiah, fulfilled these very prophecies through His life, death and resurrection. Our Savior took the sins

of the world upon Himself when He suffered on the cross. His death paid the price for all our moral shortcomings and failures in the sight of God. By His death He has justified us, made us righteous before God. But the story doesn't end with Christ's death. Our God brought His Servant back to life on the third day, never to die again, and the Messiah is awaiting that great moment when God will send Him back to Earth as the majestic King of the nations. At that time as supreme King and Highest Priest He will establish His eternal Kingdom.

It comes as no surprise that the method by which the ancient rabbis and interpreters of Scripture correlated the many messianic passages in the prophets was to conclude that there were to be two completely different Messiahs.

One would come to suffer and the other to conquer and rule; one would be priest and the other would be king. The many seemingly contradictory Messianic prophecies in Isaiah are perhaps confusing to those unaware of Jesus and his two separate comings. While a great deal of information concerning the Messiah is presented in Isaiah, as we have seen over four lessons, nonetheless an incomplete and hazy portrait of the Messiah emerges by just limiting oneself to that prophetic report. Yet, thankfully, we are not limited to the prophecy of Isaiah concerning Messiah, but have all the Scriptures through which we may clearly see the prophetic fulfillment of Messiah in Jesus.
