It has been awhile since we shared with our readers some of the letters and newspaper/periodical clippings received by the ministry. Dear Brother Zola:

I just walked back from the mail box and could not read *An Unrepentant Zionist* fast enough. I anticipated every word you wrote and can almost say I knew what the next line was going to reveal. The entire article was completely on target. Nothing more needs to be said, but AMEN!!

Zola, if you were officially known as a political activist, yellow journalist, radical university professor, or any other strain of "professional dissenter" by the CIA, NSA, etc., I am sure there would be a price on your head. But I think it is a safe assumption that you are probably considered a "man of the cloth" by most who do not agree with you, and, therefore, your bold and unequivocal refusal to print politically correct editorials is viewed as simply your right to express yourself in our free society. Time is short, however, before the world begins to realize that God's real army, the faithful in Y'shua, is ready to lose everything, including freedom, family and even life to honor God's requirement to bless and support his people. Therefore, the view

that you are perhaps "harmless" to the enemy is short-lived.

Knowing full well that we "battle not against flesh and blood but principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places," I am acutely aware in my spirit that you are in grave danger. Therefore, I am going to submit to the leading of the Ruach Ha Kodesh and pray specifically for your continued health and safety and will ask others to do so also. A silencing of your voice would please the dark forces, and I feel that it is appropriate to appeal to our Heavenly Father for "extra" protection for those who are on the

front lines. Those whose selfish lives are no threat to the unholy spirit are not at risk.

Many who have a public voice throughout the world do not **openly** question the status quo denial of the plight of God's Chosen People. This includes even some messianic leaders who would rather not ruffle any feathers lest they be questioned regarding their stance or worse yet ignored.

I can at least comprehend their motives and ignorance though. Just a few years ago, I would have asked the naive question, "Don't I see that terrorism comes from both sides?" but not of someone debating Israeli/Arab issues (because I had no interest in or knowledge of such things). I would have posed it to the person who was wisely looking beyond the symptoms of a "bandwagon" social issue or demonstration of violence, and was inquiring about the root cause of the situation. By posing the above question to them, I would have been "admitting," paradoxically, that their wisdom discernment ranged beyond my ability to comprehend. This is precisely why your article was not accepted by the press. We know that no one can know anything of God except that He reveals it to him! The knowledge, through revelation, of facts as opposed to fiction regarding Jews is simply not a reality for so many because the adversary has succeeded in blinding them. As you know, this includes even Jews, who, like sheep to the slaughter, believe they are "safe" in America and that the world will not let another Holocaust happen. The answer to opening their eyes (or anyone else's) will not come by power (of man's written word), nor by might (of man's spoken word), but by His Spirit. I am in contact with many, including Jews, who are so impressed with the land for peace ideology and who are thankful that Rabin is at the helm so that "all this needless suffering has a better chance to end." I could be frustrated and alienate myself from the whole duped world, but my Heavenly Father has my eyes fixed on **His** purpose and plans, and in these last days I am seeing that this deception of the masses is coming to the "beginning of the end." I am thankful that you and all those you work with have chosen to obey and speak the truth as you function according to the calling to which He has brought you.

For your obedience, I am sure you and your staff have paid dearly, and will continue to pay. As a messianic Gentile, grafted into the rich Olive Tree of Israel, I am discovering my Jewish roots, and I am devouring as much as I can in the way of books, commentaries, etc. to learn the history and significance of being a Jew. I am saddened to say I am finding out that even in the messianic community there is division regarding agreement on doctrine, teachings, leaders, etc.; but, of course, Scripture foretells all this anyway. I am compelled to keep my eye on the goal, to run the race and not get sidetracked.

Thank you for sharing with me every month so that my knowledge of the Holy One of Israel and His plan for the redemption of all mankind through the Tribe of Judah is increased. May God richly bless you, your family and all your staff.

Part II

Zionism - The Primary Vehicle of Restoration Out of the Dispersion

The primary tool God has used to bring about the restoration of Israel is the movement of Zionism. Zionism is the religious, sociological and political movement that promotes the return of the Jewish people to the Land of Israel. There is something in the breast of most, if not all, Jewish people that is not complete outside the Promised Land:

How shall we sing the Lord's song in a foreign land? If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget her cunning. If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth; if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief joy (Psalms 137:4-6).

This attraction has been intact since the Dispersion began with the Destruction of the Second Temple by the Romans in A.D. 70, shortly after Christ's first coming. The attraction, however, has been suppressed all these centuries by the reality of Jerusalem's subjugation. As our Lord predicted, Jerusalem has been "trodden under the feet of the Gentiles" all during this time.

The Treading of Jerusalem by the Gentiles

First it was the Romans who trod down Jerusalem, then the Byzantines, then the Moslems under the auspices of the Arabs, Mamelukes or the Turks. There were also the European Crusaders, who controlled Jerusalem for 100 years, and some other parts of the Biblical Lands for another 100 years. For most of this 19-century-long period, though, the Land has been under some type of Moslem control. Furthermore, the Moslems have firmly planted the Dome of the Rock and the Al Aksa Mosque on the Temple Mount overlooking Jerusalem.

The Jewish Dream of a Restored Israel

Throughout the Dispersion, there have always been some Jewish people living in the Land. Mostly they lived in Galilee, but sometimes they were able to get to the remaining shrine of their revered Temple Mount, the Western Wall in Jerusalem. There was always the religious conviction that the Jews would ultimately return to the Land "en masse" in the Days of the Messiah. Maimonides and other famous rabbis fostered this teaching. They had the firm belief that when the Messiah comes, there will be universal peace.

There were a few aborted and short-lived attempts at migration. For instance, many Jews attempted to return to Jerusalem during the reign of Emperor Julian the Apostate (4th Century) and at the time of Sabbatai Zvi (17th Century). However, there was no serious

movement back to Israel until the Zionists began their organizing movements in the latter half of the 19th Century. In the 20th Century, Zionism has resulted in more than million of the world's 15 million Jews now living in the Promised Land!

What Is Zionism?

As Israel is unique among the nations, so Zionism is unique among movements. It has many facets and is complex. The encyclopedia defines Zionism as "a movement aimed at establishing a national Jewish state in Palestine, the ancient Jewish homeland" (World Book Encyclopedia, 1969, Vol. 20, p. 499).

A NOTE FROM ZOLA

Dear Friends,

Happy Birthday to you and yours! I refer of course to Pentecost, the birthday of the Church which has just occurred as I



dictate this letter. My Pentecost was very unusual this year since I was invited to a small church in Humble, Texas, which honors Israel in very meaningful ways, singing Hebrew songs and presenting authentic Israeli dancing. I was very gratified to tell the story of Peter's mighty sermon in Acts II to that particular congregation.

The church was so small that the pastor elected to hold an outdoor service on the front lawn — very appropriate to this harvest festival — and a speaker's stand and chairs were set out in plain view of the highway. I had the impression that some people drifted in, and during my teaching some young men in a speeding pickup truck shouted, "I believe!" as they roared around a curb on two wheels past our service. "Help me thou mine unbelief!" I shouted back. But, anyway, we were a witness.

The world saw us where we worshipped but I wonder if the church really did. Pentecost Sunday had dawned with a rainstorm and as our 2:00 p.m. service approached, there was some nervousness about the weather. The pastor made a call to five different churches and asked if we might retreat to any of their auditoriums with our audience if latter rains came. In each case, he was turned down. One associate pastor "Judaism and said. Of course not, Christianity don't mix." Rather like at the Inn in Bethlehem, there was no room for the Believers in any of those churches in Humble, Texas.

It struck me that if Christianity and Judaism don't mix. Peter himself wouldn't have been able to preach in those churches on Pentecost Sunday, and I wonder if our Lord, the King of the Jews, has ever been there. We've come a long way since "the apostles and brethren that were in Judæa, heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God" (Acts 11:1). When those church fathers, all Jewish of course, as were the 3,000 Jews saved on the Jewish holiday of Pentecost at the Jewish Temple, gave some thought that Gentiles had heard testimony of Christ, they reacted very differently from this pastor and "held their peace, and glorified God, saying, 'Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life" (Acts 11:18). The Gentile Believers were perfectly welcome in their Jewish church.

If the Rapture comes in the next minute, those pastors and their congregations will individually undergo a face-to-face interview with the one who said, "Inasmuch as you have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me" (II Cor. 5:10; Mt. 25:40). Would they have allowed our Jewish Savior to come in out of the rain?

Paul's writings make a lot more sense now when he says that he will use all means to reach the lost.
- 3) The Western Wall was the biggest spiritual surprise. I don't know what I expected but it was smaller than I visualized it. I remember our going there, going through metal detectors ...

It is even more complex than that definition suggests. Zionism is a religious, sociological and political movement that promotes the return of the Jewish people to the Land of Israel.

It is religious, because it is based on Biblical promises and rabbinic interpretations about the restoration of Israel. In the beginning of Zionism, the leaders actually considered the idea of bringing the Jewish people of the world to one of the countries of Africa. The religious leaders soon weighed in with objections that the only country that would appeal universally to the Jewish people would be the ancient land of Israel. Four thousand years of religious and historical associations would attract them from all over the world to the Land of their ancestors. There was also the appeal of the hope of the The Biblical prophets had prophesied that the Messiah would one day come, bless the Jewish people in the Land, and bring peace to the whole world.

Zionism is sociological as well. The attraction of the ancient Land alone probably would not be enough to motivate the Jewish people. They would have to leave their homelands, businesses and professions to undertake the rigors of pioneer life in a harsh The founder of Zionism, environment. Theodore Herzl, realized in the Dreyfus trial in Paris in 1894, that anti-Semitism was an active force even in the enlightened country It took ruthless and massive of France. persecution in Russia, Europe and the Arab nations for the Jews to leave and seek a haven in a new Land. Israel became a safe haven to which they could escape from ageold gentile persecution. The motivating persecutions of the 19th Century began with the pogroms of Russia and Eastern Europe and came to a horrendous head in the death camps of the Nazis. Millions of Jewish people became convinced that the only way they could survive was if they had the safety valve of a Land of their own.

Zionism is a political movement as well. Once the Jews returned to the Land of Canaan, who would provide protection for Would the nations who had persecuted the Jews for centuries now become their defenders since they were back in the Land? Very unlikely! To be a valid return, there would have to be a new state of Israel, with its own government and army. This is political. Zionism could not be a permanent reality without the political element. It took all the organizational skills of the returned Jewish people to create an economy, a democratic government and a dependable army. To the astonishment of the world, the heretofore peaceful Jews forged a citizen army that has become a military wonder. This small but powerfully skilled army has waged four full-scale wars and many lesser conflicts in a hostile Arab environment that the Russian Communist Empire supported for many years.

All three elements, religious, sociological and political, are important parts of Zionism. It has taken all these to motivate millions of Jews to return to the Land, build up the economy and protect Israel from its many enemies.

My quarrel is not with the letter writer but with the newspaper that would print such a spiteful and ignorant letter. Our interest in the issue in this ministry is in regard to prophecy, and especially the Lord's ominous warning to Israel, "Ye shall be hated of all nations" (Matt. 24:9).

Keep in mind, believers, that the Olivet Discourse from which the above prophecy comes is addressed to the Tribulation Period unbelievers. 
