Last Independence Day, I suggested 56 reasons why I love Israel. With the trepidation of embarking on a sequel, I venture forth with 57 additional reasons — in no particular order.

A Tale of Three Democracies

A picture in the May 20-26 *International Jerusalem Post* shocked me. It shows a throng of Palestinian women called “female Hamas members in Lebanon” carrying posters in the shape of a map of Israel from the Mediterranean to the Jordan and from the northern border to the Red Sea, and the cutouts are red and green. Combined with the black robes on the women, they comprise the three colors of the Palestinian flag. On the cutouts of Israel is the word “return” in Arabic and English. The message, obviously, is that the entire land be “given back” to its “original owners,” the “Palestinian people.”

Mexicans are not yet walking down the streets of Mexico City demanding the "return" of the entire United States to their control, but this demonstration may not be far off.

The whole display is a lie, of course. The land of Israel was given to the Jews some 4,000 years ago in God's covenant with Abraham, and at least some of their population has lived there all of that time. Muhammed was born at the end of the sixth century AD, some 2,600 years after the Jews were awarded the land and established successful societies there, as Scripture attests.

But it puts one in mind of the dangers of operating a democracy in the presence of oncoming illegal aliens. The Arabs in Israel who call themselves "Palestinians" largely came over the borders like Hispanics come over our border with Mexico. And aliens here do not seep in a little at a time — they come in great force, not to assimilate and become Americans, but quite possibly to re-establish Mexican territories in the United States.

And after all, were not Texas and California once Mexican territories? Indeed, much of our southwest was purchased or won from Mexico and its patron Spain in various transactions, but the Spanish names are still there (Texas, for example, or San Francisco and Los Angeles). And while the relationship has been benign, loyalties are ever shifting.

But the analogy is not exact. In Israel, the Arabs never "owned" any of the land. They were not the natives supplanted by the Jewish people as they often claim. The shoe is really on the other foot, with the illegal aliens laying claim to land owned by the natives. And by simply increasing their population and continuing terrorism, and never beginning to assimilate into the Israeli democracy, they hope to achieve the goal of the Hamas poster carriers — total ownership of all of Israel.

But my point is not really about infiltration of hostile elements, but the simple inability of democracies to defend themselves. In plain words, Americans and Israelis are modern, progressive peoples with a wish to treat minorities fairly, and take up arms only as a last resort. As a result of their kindness, both societies are being assaulted by aliens who inevitably hope to take control of those countries.

NEWSWEEK put U.S. flag in trash on foreign cover

New allegations of anti-Americanism hit mag reeling from Koran scandal.

With *Newsweek* still reeling from its forced retraction of the Koran-in-the-toilet story, the magazine is now under fire for publishing what some see as staunchly anti-American covers in foreign editions.

International edition of Feb. 2 *Newsweek*

For instance, while a Japanese edition of *Newsweek* dated Feb. 2 published a cover story featuring an American flag in a trash can under the headline “The day America died,” and the international edition featured a photo of President Bush with the headline, “America Leads... But Is Anyone Following?,” the U.S. edition cover story was an “Oscar Confidential” featuring Hilary Swank, Jamie Foxx and Leonardo DiCaprio.



The cover story in the foreign editions, titled, “Dream on, America,” about what *Newsweek* characterized as “the world’s rejection of the American way of life,” did not run in the U.S. edition of the magazine.

of the magazine is raising the ire of bloggers for its illustration of a dirtied American flag, its staff broken and discarded in a trash can.

“I think they have crossed the line into outright treason,” wrote one blogger. “It’s time to see some of these enemy propagandists hanging from the end of a rope.”

Some *Newsweek* international readers noticed that the story didn’t run in the U.S.

“Why didn’t this fine story run in my U.S. edition?” wrote one letter writer in the March 14 edition.



“*Newsweek’s* false, retracted story about American guards flushing the Koran down a toilet at Guantanamo doesn’t necessarily mean the magazine’s staff hates America or Bush, or wants us to lose in Iraq,” wrote Riding Sun. “To be charitable, let’s just chalk that one up to sloppy journalism. But I’m at a loss to explain this.”

Both the Japanese and international editions featured cover stories by Andrew Moravcsik. But that piece did not run in the U.S. edition.

“It’s one thing for *Newsweek* to actively promote the notion that America is a ‘dead,’ ‘rotting’ country overseas,” wrote Riding Sun. “But it’s quite another thing indeed to hide those efforts from its American readers. If *Newsweek* really thinks America is dead, and our flag belongs in the trash, why won’t it tell us?”

Nothing Has Changed

Just at press time, Mahmoud Abbas, the new Palestinian dictator, showed up at the White House. There'll be space later on to examine what he said, but let's understand that we've heard it all before.

President Bush received Abbas under three false assumptions. The first, of course, is the bogus nature of the "Palestinians" as a real nationality. No one who went to high school before 1964 could be fooled. The Palestinian people were invented with the inception of Arafat and the PLO, and did not exist before that. (Previous Palestinians — or people who lived in Palestine — were comprised principally of Jews and included sundry Arabs, Druze, Armenians, and a variety of passing transients.) The name of the country was simply given by the Romans and co-opted by Arafat's people — in effect, illegal aliens.

Secondly, the President continually insists that the Palestinian people "deserve" a nation, a good economy (largely financed by US taxpayers, of course), etc. If anyone anywhere can tell me why this bunch of pretenders to someone else's land deserves anything at all, I would be interested. The so-called peace process amounts to two words effective mainly at the gas station, where our Saudi masters evidently give forth some leniency on oil prices when we behave this way.

And the third assumption is that Abbas was "democratically elected," in the President's words. Let's be very clear about this: there is not now, nor has there ever been, a democratic election in a Muslim country unless the American military was occupying it. Abbas was voted into office by people who did what they were told, as always.

The key error of the twentieth century, which culminated in such atrocities as the World Trade Center, was the constant kowtowing to Muslim dictators, and I'm afraid nothing has changed.

King Ahab Lives!

On the subject of the Gaza pullout, Israeli president Moshe Katsav made the following statement quoted in the *International Jerusalem Post*, May 6-12 edition:

We have no prophet, or voice from Heaven, or anyone connecting us directly to God and mediating between us. It is preferable, therefore, that the argument take place in the realm of security and diplomatic issues.

Katsav is not the first "King of Israel" to fail to appreciate prophets. King Ahab, as a matter of fact, had hundreds of his own paid by the crown to prophesy good news (before the ten northern tribes were carried off by the Assyrians).

As to a voice from Heaven, the Old Testament is full of that. Jewish people have heard from God from Abraham to the present day, when they have been in touch with Him.

And finally, the denial of a mediator, which the Messiah, the Real King of Israel is, unfortunately is typical of unbelievers everywhere.

The argument over settlements, security, diplomacy, etc., is better conducted through the realm of God.

Of course, the president in Israel is a figurehead attending to formalities like foreign funerals, etc. Prime Minister Ariel Sharon takes care of business in the realm of "security and diplomatic issues." But Sharon recently was pleased to receive a Jewish Believer, former CBN attorney Jay Sekulow. Among others in that delegation were Michael Little, President of CBN, Paul Crouch, founder

and President of Trinity Broadcasting Network (TBN), and Ted Haggard, president of the National Association of Evangelicals.

As long as the prime minister is in some degree connected to the Almighty, the president matters no more than the faithless King Ahab.

World Affairs Tomorrow

Fox News Watch recently criticized the broadcast networks, particularly ABC News, for giving so much time to the *American Idol* scandal story. They made the point that irrelevancies dominate the news all the time. Are we not tired of the various abductions (and non-abductions), the Michael Jackson trial, the various court cases and crimes, and so on, which dominate these broadcasts?

But the granddaddy of them all — the story that has taken up more international news time over more irrelevancy than any other in thirty years — is the constant reportage of supposed problems in Israel. I say supposed problems because Israel has the problems of any American city — murderers and police who pursue them. But that's all. There's no war there, nor has there been since 1973. There's no real political issue, although everyone talks about it, because, of course, the Palestinians, however they are treated, have no bearing on world commerce, on the Arab failures, on the U.S., European, Russian, or Chinese positions in the world, etc.

Rather, this “sexy” story has occupied an enormous amount of news time, reporting on a country, which, if it sank into the sea tomorrow with all citizens of both sides aboard, would make no difference whatever in world affairs. That would be awful and, of course, Biblically, it will not happen.

Ironically, this country that is now irrelevant but reported on daily, is to become the head of the nations in the Kingdom to come. And perhaps the media’s attention is unconsciously focused there simply because of that. Israel will be the capital of the only righteous government this world has ever known, and the home of all converted Believers, Christian, Jewish, Muslim, and otherwise. And in that sense, it will be most important.

But, while the news has slowed tourism to Israel, given our sister democracy a black eye, and riled up an enormous amount of Arabs and Muslims throughout the world to paroxysms of hatred, the place doesn’t really matter in world affairs today.

What matters is world affairs tomorrow!

Bombs Are Bombs

I’ve received a number of letters commenting on a remark I made on television that compared terrorist bombings in Israel with those in the United States. The point of the letters was to object to my characterizing the “violence” in the Holy Land as being less than the attacks in our country. I was told in no uncertain terms that bombs are bombs and are always tragic.

Well, I certainly know that, and I would be the last to minimize disasters caused by terrorism. What I was comparing were the casualty rates and the relative sizes of the attacks. Not to be callous or unsympathetic to Israel, I would still point out that the World Trade Center bombing and the attack on the Pentagon were

both bigger and more disastrous than all the bombs exploded in Israel since 1948. One individual carrying one bomb simply cannot cause that kind of destruction.

Stories keep circulating on the web about whether the Oklahoma City bombing had a Middle Eastern component. Reportedly, Timothy McVeigh was in touch with Islamic bombers. We will continue to follow that story as the evidence develops. If that’s true, it will expose another phenomenon of our society that never happens in Israel — covering up for Muslim terrorists.

With that said, the news keeps on coming about American children and teenage girls being abducted, and many times killed. We can’t miss the fact that all national and international news stops while the news channels follow some police hunt for a survivor or a body. We then often visit the arrest and the trial, and the case seems to keep going until the next one happens. How deplorable that we have this continuous hostility toward our own kids!

To my knowledge, this never happens in Israel. I receive dispatches from Jerusalem and Tel Aviv daily, and I never see a story like that.

Now, I’m not trying to open another can of worms about one society having fewer crimes than another, but instead to point out that while America is a successful melting pot of many kinds of people, Israel has basically only two kinds. In the Holy Land, you’re either a loyal Jewish citizen or you are an Arab outsider trying to get the land. That has the effect of one large family defending itself against a legion of criminals.

That is why there are so few crimes against persons of any kind in Israel relative to the United States. We have an ongoing parade of terrible abductions and assaults on our children, where they virtually have none.

Illustrating this *mishpocha*, or “family” feeling is a story from one summer when I rented a room in a residential neighborhood in Jerusalem. My landlady was up in years, and one day a very old man came to the front gate asking for her. He must have been in his 90s. I opened the gate and notified my landlady of her visitor. She talked with him for a while and then drove away with him in her car. Afterwards she explained, “That’s my father. He’s supposed to stay in the old folk’s home, but he’s good at escaping. Usually he doesn’t come here; he gets mixed up and goes to some completely different house. The people there ask his name and then look up all the Berkoviches in Jerusalem and patiently telephone them all saying ‘Your father is here. Where should we bring him?’ I’m surprised that he made it to the right house this time.”

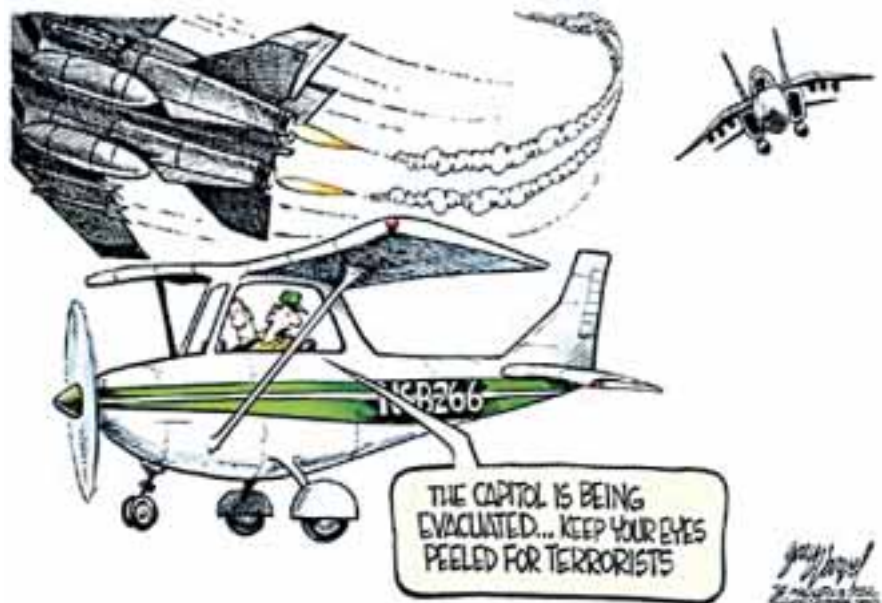
The Alabama Baptist

Levitt, who has 50 books in print, held the attention of the congregation for over two hours as he talked about evangelism, a future Palestinian state, hatred of the Jews, the return of Jesus, and Armageddon. He also answered questions from the audience on the building of the 3rd temple, the location of the Ark of the Covenant and his opinions on world leaders.

Some of those present were already supporters of Zola Levitt Ministries, based in Dallas, Texas, and subscribe to his newsletter or watch his weekly 30-minute television program, Zola Levitt Presents, which airs on television stations across the nation. Some also had traveled with Levitt on one of his 80 trips to Israel.

Levitt is a Believer in the Biblical concept outlined in Romans 1:16, "First to the Jew and also to the gentile."

Although educating people about Israel, the Jews and end-time prophecy is a core issue in Levitt's ministry, more important is evangelism, Levitt said.

"This is the perfect time to share the gospel with unbelievers. The Lord said, 'In the days of Noah,' and it is already raining," he said.

Anthony Copeland, pastor of Immanuel, said Christians should be aware of end-time events. "There's a need for us to be aware of what's going on in the Middle East," he said. "And it is good for our church members to be exposed to a Jewish Believer."

Though Levitt had spent his childhood learning the laws in the synagogue, his life dramatically changed in 1971 when he accepted Jesus Christ as the Messiah. For almost 35 years, Levitt has urged Christians to witness to Jewish friends and embrace the Jewish people. "If you have a problem with the Jews, know that when you get to heaven you will meet the King of the Jews," he said.

Levitt warned Christians about the anti-Semitism in the world, but credited the strife to spiritual battles. "The hatred of Israel is amazing. Since it goes all the way back to Pharaoh, it is spiritual."

He said the Jewish people have always been special to God and the devil seeks to get rid of them. "He can't win this battle, but he uses all the punches he can," Levitt said.

We are watching in Iraq a microcosm of the same thing. It's kind of a fast-forward picture sped up by the recent establishment of democracy in Baghdad and the immediate incursion of hostile aliens from Iran, Syria and Saudi Arabia. These particular aliens do not wait around to increase their population and slowly overwhelm the host country. Rather, they get to immediate work with bombs and guns, meaning to overcome the fledgling democracy.

“...Scribes, Pharisees, Hypocrites!”

It is clear now that *Newsweek's* reckless publication of the anonymous, undocumented charge, that U.S. officials at Guantanamo had flushed a Koran down a toilet as an interrogation technique, has provided what has come to be known in pedagogic circles as a “teachable moment.”

As the death toll from anti-American riots in Afghanistan and elsewhere mounted, the blame game began in earnest. Supporters of the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq, wearied by the proclivity of the press to focus on American mistakes, such as the Abu Ghraib prison scandal, while playing down events such as the public beheading of civilian contractors in Iraq, quickly grasped *Newsweek's* recalcitrant retraction as evidence of the mainstream media's predisposition to portray the military in a negative light.

Opponents of the war countered that the administration, by interfering in Islamic nations' affairs, had created the conditions that have led to such bloody demonstrations, and therefore deserves the lion's share of blame. Frankly, few found this argument believable as the incontrovertible facts of the case are that a rumor was published as fact, prompting the murder of at least 18 people, the injury of many more, and the endangerment of American lives.

“*Newsweek* lied. People died.” was the headline penned by Michelle Malkin.

Having painted themselves into a corner, defenders of the fourth estate searched for a new culprit and, astonishingly, found it in radical Islam. For the first time, the message of the media was that, just perhaps, the murderous savages who slaughter innocent people over any perceived slight to Islam might, themselves, be the root cause of the conflict between many Muslims and... well... everybody else.

Certainly, this has not been the case in recent years.

When the Israeli government, as a goodwill gesture toward the Palestinian Authority, withdrew from Nablus in 2000, a well organized mob seized the opportunity to loot, desecrate and burn the tomb of the patriarch Joseph, the son of Jacob, and murdered a rabbi attempting to save a Torah within. Though the tomb had been

entrusted to the Jewish state under the terms of the Oslo Accord, and the perpetrators were protected by the PA, there was no international outcry over the insult to Judaism. In fact, commentators bemoaned the so-called “cycle of violence” — even as Palestinian authorities illegally dismantled the wreckage of the ancient site and built a mosque in its place.

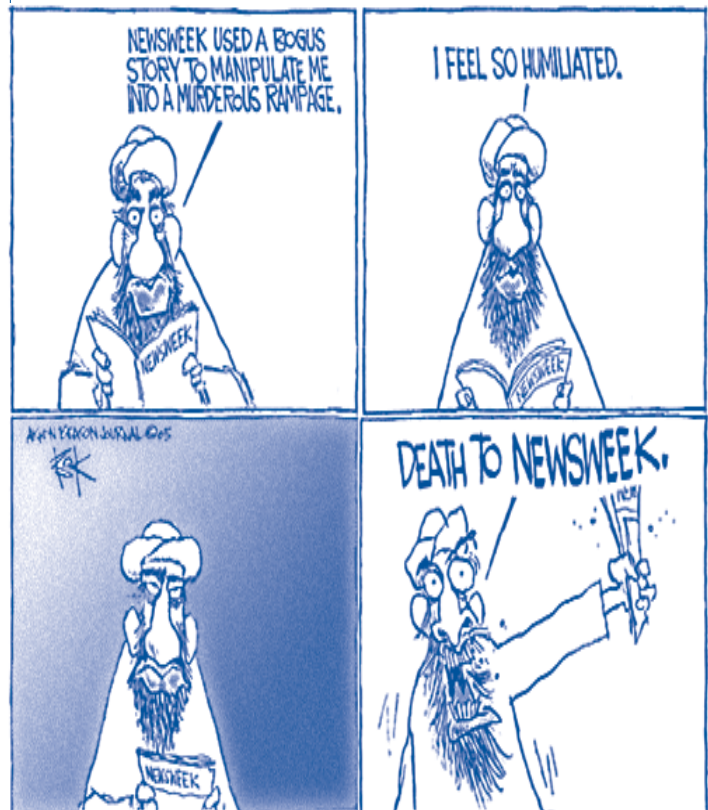
Similarly, neither the international community nor the media seemed to find anything about the massacre by Hamas in Netanya, Israel of 30 men women and children during a Passover seder in 2002 that would cause them to view the terrorists as anything other than insurgents in a legitimate struggle. In fact, the terrorist group Hamas, whose publicly-stated *raison d'être* is the destruction of Israel, is still honored with full legal recognition by the government of France and other European countries.

The hypocrisy exhibited by Muslims who demand that all non-Muslims treat the icons of their religion with exaggerated reverence is illuminated by silence regarding the destruction, by the Afghan Taliban, of a pair of priceless 1,500 year old Buddhist statues.

The demand by Muslims that all people treat the Koran with perfect piety is contradicted by their approval of the Saudi government's burning of any Christian or Jewish Bibles found in their country.

Outrage over mistreatment of Muslim terrorists is belied by either tacit or explicit approval of the terrorism itself.

Ambassadors of Messiah to Israel

March 2005’s Gospel outreach to Israel did not begin there, but on the plane going over there from JFK Airport in New York City. Paul Colley, a personal friend, missionary, and co-laborer in Christ for twenty-one years, accompanied me on this outreach.

Once Paul and I boarded our flight bound for Tel Aviv, Israel, we immediately felt led by the Holy Spirit to pray that any Jewish person sitting next to us on the flight would be especially open to a witness about Yeshua being the Messiah of Israel. Not long after that prayer was said, two men sat next to us. One man was named Joseph. He sat next to Paul on the long flight to Israel. He was a middle-aged man with an Orthodox background. He was very genial, tolerant and open to our bearing testimony about *Yeshua* being the Jewish Messiah. He asked us about our reasons for traveling to Israel. Paul and I told him that we were sent by several ministries (Zola Levitt, Brit Hadashah and the Shalom, Shalom Messianic congregation) that support Israel and send us there to spread the good news of Yeshua the Messiah’s first coming and His soon return to the land of Israel as King of kings and Lord of lords.



The man sitting next to me was a cordial fellow from *Beit Shemesh* (House of the Sun) (a small city located one hour southwest of Jerusalem). The man’s name was Opher.

He informed us that he was a pantomime artist who did mute dramas of the great Bible characters in the

Old Testament like Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. He showed us a presentation on his mini-DVD player. After viewing his reenactment of the *Akedah* (Abraham offering up his son Isaac), I shared with Opher that this was a Messianic type of *Abba* (God) offering up for Israel and the world his one and only unique Son for our sins. Opher quickly surmised we were Believers in Yeshua.

Paul and I affirmed that not only did we believe He is the Messiah, but that all of Jesus’ first followers were Jewish. I then gave him a Gospel tract in Hebrew that gave a list of all the major prophecies made about Messiah in the *Tanach* and the corresponding fulfillment by Yeshua in the Brit Hadashah (the Hebrew phrase for The New Testa-



ment). Opher wanted to go through some of these prophecies with us. At this point in our conversation, a young Orthodox man from the Chabad movement rudely interrupted our conversation. He had been sitting in the row in front of us. This man was attempting to discourage and dissuade Opher from hearing the Gospel. The Chabad movement promotes the ridiculous notion that the late Rabbi Menachem Schneerson of Brooklyn New York was the Messiah.

The picture above of Schneerson published in Jerusalem says of Him in Hebrew: “Long live the King and the Messiah.”)

I bluntly challenged this man and told him in no uncertain terms that all the evidence from Scripture and Jewish history indubitably points to Jesus of Nazareth being the only One who is the Messiah foretold by Moses and the Prophets. The young man replied by claiming that *Yeshua* could not be the Messiah since his father was not Jewish.

By this, I assumed that this man was reflecting a tradition of Orthodox Judaism from the Talmud that teaches Jesus' father was a Roman soldier named Pantera who had an illicit relationship with his mother Mary. This was further verified when the man told me to read the Gemara, which is the second part of the *Talmud*, providing commentary and explanation of it. A *pilpul* (a theological debate in Jewish circles) began to develop between this intrusive fellow and me.

My reply was to say that *Yeshua's* Father was God and His lineage was indeed Jewish on His mother's side. I went on to inform him that Joseph, particularly, could not have been the natural father since he came from King Jeconiah's genealogical line (see Matthew 1:12), which God cursed and spoke through the prophet Jeremiah that none of Jeconiah's descendants would ever sit on the throne of David as King of Israel! *"O earth, earth, earth, hear the word of the Lord. Thus says the Lord: 'Write this man down as childless, a man who shall not prosper in his days; for none of his descendants shall prosper, sitting on the throne of David, and ruling Judah anymore,"* (Jeremiah 22:29-30).

Thus, Joseph, the legal father of Jesus, could not have been the physical father of Jesus because of this curse pronounced on Jeconiah's descendants. That would include Joseph and prevent him or his children from reigning on the throne of David as King of Israel.

But Jesus was not affected by this curse, because his physical Jewish descent came from David through his mother Mary, who conceived him by the supernatural power of the Holy Spirit (Matt. 1:18; Luke 3:21-38).

When asked, the Orthodox man expressed complete ignorance about this key prophecy in Jeremiah 22:29-30. So I went on to say to this man that Jesus could not have had Joseph as his physical father. Furthermore, the prophets foretold that the Messiah would be the Son of God and therefore have God as His father (see Psalm 2:6-8; Isaiah 7:14)! The Orthodox man angrily expressed his bewilderment over this. When I point-blank asked him if he had read the evidence for *Yeshua* being the Messiah as historically written by Jewish eyewitnesses in the New Testament, he, of course, smugly answered, "no." Then I replied, "You can't very well dismiss something you are ignorant of, nor have honestly investigated."

After this, the man said nothing more to me. Satan, no doubt, was using his interruption to discourage Opher from investigating these important matters for himself. Nevertheless, Opher accepted a copy of the New Testament in Hebrew and a Gospel tract as well. Pray now that nothing or no one will keep him from coming to faith in the Messiah Jesus. ❀

Those who demand special protections for Muslims in America and the West are utterly discredited by the fact that no Islamic nation affords equal rights for Christians and Jews, and many actively persecute them.

To this day, most of the Islamic world is silent concerning the desecration of the Bethlehem Church of the Nativity (believed to be the site of Jesus' birthplace) by Palestinian militants. Let me be clear, even if a Koran had been flushed down a Guantanamo toilet, it doesn't matter. If one person's life can be saved by using the superstitions of Islam, or any other religion, to extract information from known terrorists, then it is proper.

Personally, I am more than willing to treat Islam with respect and esteem — when Islam affords the same to human rights and life. It is past time, however, that we stopped pretending that those responsible for the wanton murder of anyone who stands in the way of Islamofascist totalitarianism have any right to have their rituals elevated to sacred status. If showing Saddam Hussein in his skivvies helps destroy the fear and myth of invincibility that such a monster engendered, I have to wonder how he would look on the end of a leash. ❀

The resolution points out that U.S. law already states it is a matter of United States policy that Jerusalem should be the undivided capital of Israel.

Muslim Sensitivities

Gary Bauer's *End of Day Report*



During the debate over *Newsweek's* "Koran in the toilet story," a curious thing happened. Virtually everyone accepted the idea that it was a natural thing for Muslims to riot in Afghanistan (with 17 people dying as a result) over the news report. Those on the left accused the U.S. military of being "insensitive" to Muslims and those on the right accused *Newsweek* of trying to incite Muslims by reporting the story. In either case, Muslim violence got a pass.

A few commentators are now beginning to ask some questions about this analysis and its flaws. Diane West, writing in *The Washington Times*, observes that radical Muslims aren't "sensitive" at all when it comes to other faiths. She goes through the litany: Albanian Muslims, March 2004, destroying 30 Orthodox churches in Kosovo; Taliban Muslims, 2001, dynamiting Buddha statues in Afghanistan; Palestinian Muslims in 2000 destroying Joseph's Tomb in Nablus; and let's not forget the 2002 armed occupation by Palestinian Muslims of the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem, where pages from Bibles were used as toilet paper!

Diane West also pointed out something that has grated on me in the last week. A number of government officials, trying to repair the damage from the *Newsweek* story, have referred to the Holy Koran. As Ms. West observes, I don't recall that adjective being used to describe the Bible by any of our government officials.

Newsweek made a mistake, but let's not fall into the trap of believing the jihadists need an excuse for murder and mayhem. They didn't need one on September 11th.

Hospitals in four states have reported that individuals, appearing to be of Middle Eastern descent, have entered their facilities masquerading as doctors. They ask questions about bed capacity, emergency services and often request a private tour of the facilities. When asked for credentials, they leave. The Department of Homeland Security has issued a special bulletin to U.S. hospitals to be on guard. Once again, we are

reminded that our enemy is still working feverishly to bring more sorrows to our nation.

Pat the Terrorist

Try Connecting the Dots

Several times recently, a hospital in Bethlehem has been brought to our attention. The *Hospital de la Sainte Famille* or Holy Family Hospital was first praised by the very anti-Israel Episcopal priest, Rev. GDV Wiebe SSC., PhD. He claimed that Israeli checkpoints in Bethlehem stopped patients from reaching this hospital. There are, of course, no Israeli checkpoints in Bethlehem, which was turned over to the Palestinians in 1995.

Secondly, it was recently announced that this same hospital has petitioned the U.S. Congress for \$3.5 million in aid to continue its work. And finally, it was announced at the death of Pope John Paul II that this was one of his favorite charities which he recommended to the 1.2 billion Catholics.

I was impressed by the magnitude of this hospital, and, obviously, it is not easy to criticize a charity work of this kind. No one opposes medical care at nominal prices for the poor, and this hospital serves the Palestinians of Bethlehem, Bejara and the Hebron area. While all Arabs in Israel are freely admitted to the excellent Israeli hospitals, it is certainly a good thing that they have built and are operating a structure using such a volume of international gifts of charity.

But imagine my shock when I discovered that it contains only 28 beds! Sandra and I have toured the hospitals of Jerusalem, Tel Aviv and Tiberias. They were impressive indeed. The Hadassah Hospital in Jerusalem has 1,100 beds, and some of the most important medical research in the world goes on there. That particular hospital solicits donations from Jewish people, but in the whole world, there are only 15 million Jews.

Palestinians receive more foreign aid per capita than any other people in the world. Millions and millions of dollars are pouring into this diminutive building in Bethlehem, a town barely more than a crossroads. Where does the money go? If it pays for 28 beds, they must be very impressive beds.

We have previously published that the hospital claims to treat patients “regardless of religious preference.” But that is totally irrelevant in Bethlehem where the Christians have all but been run off and no Jewish person would ever set foot on pain of instant death.

Hadassah Nominated for Nobel Peace Prize

By contrast, the Hadassah Medical Organization has excelled in promoting peace in the region by their commitment to equal treatment for all people despite

treating more terror victims than any other medical center. They are the model of cooperation and coexistence set by their mixed staff of people of all faiths. The medical organization’s ongoing initiatives in creating bridges for peace even throughout the Intifada has earned them international acclaim leading to nomination for the 2005 Nobel Peace Prize. If financial aid is funneled to any hospital in the region, who is more worthy than Hadassah?

At the same time, the Palestinian terrorists continue upgrading their weapons, digging high-priced tunnels from Egypt to import them, and are somehow able to pay for high-tech rocketry and the like.

“There has Never Been an Arab Palestine”

Now that Mahmoud Abbas has President Bush's ear, he is reportedly planning to launch a fresh uprising against Israel. Geo-Strategy Direct reports that Abbas hopes Israel will respond with “terrorist force and organized fire.”

A Christian author and Bible prophecy expert says attempts to make peace in the Middle East are a fraud — because “peace” for the Palestinians, he says, is the destruction of Israel.

So these people [the Palestinian leaders] are not a few fanatics; these are real Muslims. And Islam teaches that all of that land belongs to the Arabs.”

Hunt explains that the Palestinians will always claim Israel's land belongs to them because Arabs believe Ishmael, not Isaac, is the “son of promise” who was offered on the altar at Mount Moriah — and Islam teaches that once Muslims have controlled an area, they can never give it up.

President Bush recently pledged \$200 million in aid to the Palestinians to help promote a Mid-East peace agreement. ✦

Those Arabs living in Israel and areas under the Jewish state's overall control enjoy far greater freedoms than any of their brethren throughout the Middle East, a prominent Iraqi political figure said recently. “I am sure that the Palestinian [Arabs] in Israel have more rights than in any other Arab country; and even the Iraqi citizens during the time of Saddam [Hussein],” Mithal al-Alusi, leader of the Democratic Party of the Iraqi Nation, said in an interview with *The Jerusalem Post*.

Alusi based his assessment on firsthand knowledge, after making a controversial visit to Israel last September to attend an international counter-terrorism conference.

“I was interested to know how they [Israel] deal with problems and with terror. Why should we have war between Iraq and Israel? How can I forget that there is

a modern state in the area which has had success in the democratic process and the economy?” he explained.

At the time, Alusi was head of Iraq's De-Ba'athification Commission, but his trip to Israel gained him numerous enemies in a nation still officially at war with the Jewish state and cost him his high-ranking position. He has since survived an assassination attempt and been reduced to a political outsider. His two sons were less fortunate, having been gunned down by terrorists in February.

“Before I went, I knew I would have huge trouble in Baghdad, I was very sure I would lose my political position. And I was very sure that I was a target for the terrorists, but these taboos [against relations with Israel] should be broken, must be broken,” Alusi insisted.

Alusi is not alone in his observation of the favorable treatment of Arabs under Israel. Even Palestinian Arabs, despite all their anti-Israel rhetoric, often admit to preferring Jewish rule to their own Palestinian Authority, noted famed columnist Daniel Pipes in an editorial published by *The Jerusalem Post* recently.

Pipes listed several examples from the past decade. Regarding the rule of law, Pipes quoted Haydar Abd ash-Shafi, a noted Arab leader in Gaza, as once observing the relief felt among the populace when the IDF would impose general curfews in order to quiet local infighting.

Musa Abu Marzouk of Hamas once pointed out that in Israel, the “opposition criticized [Prime Minister Ehud] Barak and they were not arrested — but in our case the PA arrests people as the first order of business.” Pipes goes on to quote a Christian Palestinian with no great love for Israel, who was nevertheless forced to admit that “Israeli laws protect us” as a minority.

Were a Palestinian Arab state to come into existence, “we [would] undergo the same [persecution at the hands of Muslims] as our Lebanese brothers or the Copts in Egypt,” that same Christian lamented. Iyad as-Sarraj, a prominent psychiatrist and director of the Gaza Community Mental Health Program, confessed that “during the Israeli occupation, I was 100 times freer [than under the PA].” ■

These excerpts from sermons in May of this year show that Palestinian Authority brainwashing remains unchanged in the post-Arafat era. — Zola

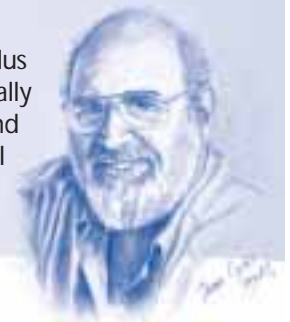

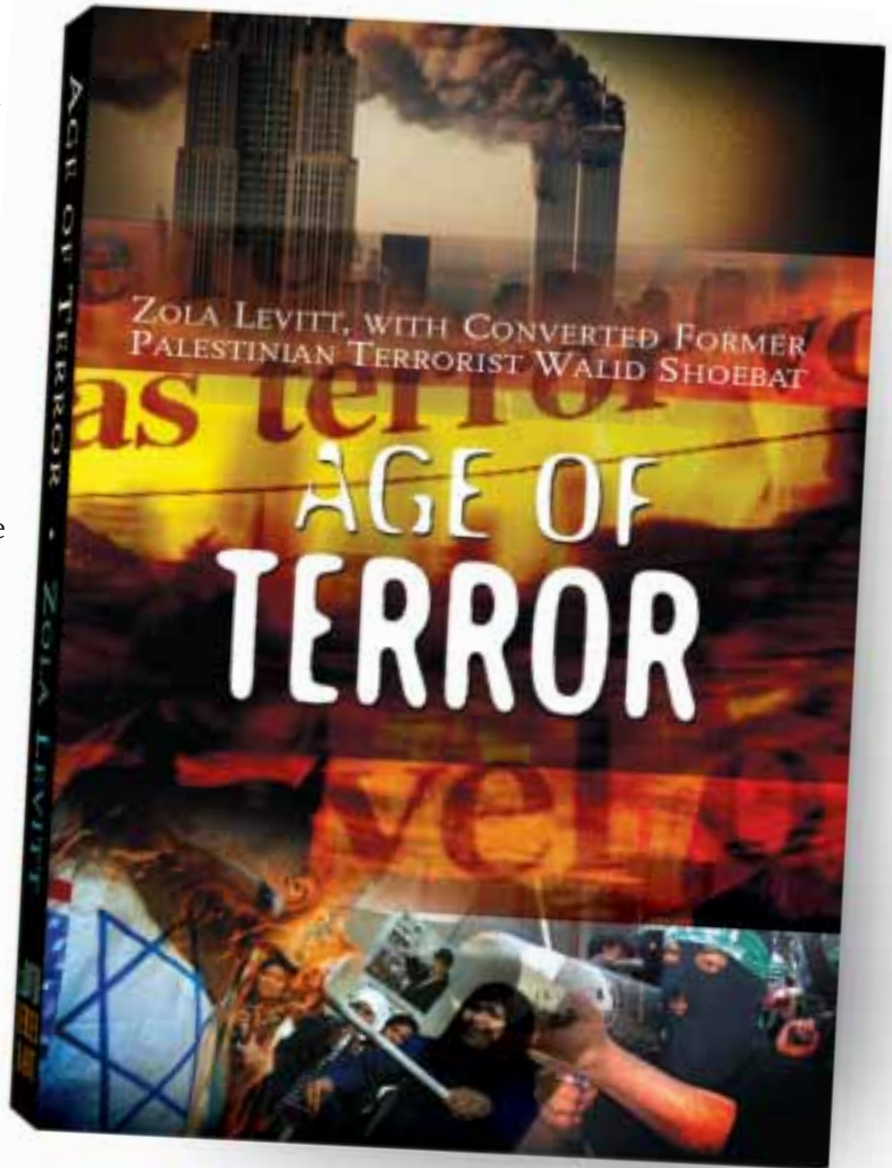

The Jewish Canary

September 11th strengthened the bond between the United States and Israel. Ilan Berman, Vice President for Policy at the American Foreign Policy Council, explained: "Israel's stable, pro-Western and democratic character, its robust defense infrastructure and modern military, and its strategic location in the volatile Middle East have only grown in importance to the United States since September 11." Both nations are also engaged in a war against the same terrorism. But unlike the United States, the legitimacy of the Jewish State is still questioned on a daily basis.

September 11th has also put academia on the defensive. Many professors defended the forces that perpetrated the attacks under guises of liberalism and freedom of speech. Some argued that bin Laden's motivation somehow included concern about world poverty or that the U.S. itself precipitated the attacks — anything other than bin Laden's medieval fanaticism. As George Orwell wrote, "some ideas are so stupid that only intellectuals could believe them." The stupidity that Orwell referred to has shadowed the views of many academics when it comes to how they portray the relationship between Jews and the Muslim world. The victimizer has become the victim, and liberal political correctness has become its smokescreen.

For example, Ward Churchill, chairman of the Ethnic Studies Department at the University of Colorado, earlier this year depicted the 3000 people massacred at the World Trade Center on 9/11 as "little Eichmanns." Nicholas De Genova, an assistant professor at Columbia University, declared at an anti-war rally in March 2003, that "U.S. patriotism is inseparable from...white supremacy" and then expressed the "wish for a million Mogadishus in Iraq" referring to the 1993 incident in Somalia when eighteen U.S. troops were killed.

At a rally in San Francisco organized by the far left group International A.N.S.W.E.R., Hatem Bazian, a senior lecturer in Islamic studies at Berkeley, declared "It's about time that we have an intifada in this country that changes fundamentally the political dynamics here." These incidents, and the



academic boycotts, divestment petitions, and other discriminatory actions against Israel, are precursors to a general reexamination of issues surrounding academic freedom, campus extremism, including incitement to violence, university autonomy, and classroom politicization. The division between academia and the rest of society grows larger and larger.

College campuses have become podiums for those hostile to Israel, as different human rights, anti-globalization, and anti-imperialism groups that have adopted the Palestinian cause as the single most important confront academics. As Phyllis Chesler, author of *The New Anti-Semitism*, states:

American campuses have bred a new and diabolical McCarthyism. Academics now have the right to teach brazen lies, which they expect to be protected in the name of free speech. Worse, when an academic tries to teach the truth — the truth — about Israel or about America, or about Jews, [he or she] will be ostracized, bullied, demonized, and accused (by the new McCarthyites) of leading a McCarthyite witch hunt against left-wing freedom of expression, which, in my view, is really the censorship of any view that does not conform to a left-wing and anti-American view.

Vote for Hitler!

A Palestinian thug with the nickname "Hitler," presumably for his efficiency at murdering Jews, is running for office in the upcoming Palestinian election. He claims to qualify for the Palestinian government because he has protected his people, has opposed Israel, and has many friends in the community.

He is on Israel's most-wanted list and the Israeli Defense Force commented that win or lose in the election, Hitler will be pursued by them until, like other such terrorists, he is captured or killed.

It's hard to put this in a comparison to our own country, but it would be far worse than David Duke, noted Louisiana Nazi, running for congress since Duke reportedly hasn't killed anyone, not even a Jew.

In academic circles, individual scholars' views are often turned into a political litmus test. For example, Fouad Ajami, the articulate interpreter of Arab culture and politics who teaches at Johns Hopkins University, has been subject to scathing attacks from Arab critics such as Asad Abu Khalil in a review of Ajami's book *The Vanished Imam*. And Daniel Pipes has noted that *The Nation* asked a Jewish leftist, Andrew N. Rubin, to critique Ajami's book for being too supportive of Israel.

What's worse, money from the United Arab Emirates and Saudi Arabia is being pumped into departments vis-à-vis chairs, grants and fellowships. They determine what topics related to the Middle East are taught. The liberal Left that dominates many campuses is more than ready to accept these funds and to promote the implicitly anti-American agenda they bring. Only some of these gifts are brought to the public's attention, as in the case

of the Harvard School of Divinity, which returned a \$2.5 million gift from the president of the United Arab Emirates, who also funds vicious anti-Semitic and anti-American groups. If not for the efforts of students such as Rachel Fish, who exposed the gift, I doubt that the administration would have returned this gift.

Academia has made Jews the canary in the coal mine in the sense that if universities are indicators of social trends, and anti-Semitism is becoming more acceptable there in the guise of anti-Zionism, then there is a problem society-wide. Our students must recognize that there is never justice in terrorism. It is unacceptable that some should even speak of eliminating a living and breathing state like Israel. But you'd be surprised how common such statements are on campus. These advocates are the ones that should be on the defensive.

Officially Declaring His Glory!

Hebraic Insight

Within the earliest Jewish traditions, groups of scholars *counted* the number of times each letter appeared in the Scriptures (as well as the number of words, verses, paragraphs, etc.). These textual specialists were called *Soferim* (counters). The Soferim ensured that Torah scrolls (and the other books of the Tanakh) were identical, noting any unusual words and spellings and replicating them exactly through their scribal arts. Many Jews believe that Ezra the Scribe instituted many of the practices of the Soferim.

In this verse, we are told that the heavens are “recounting” the glory of God—the word *mesaperim* comes from the same Hebrew root as does *soferim*. Every detail of the universe, from great cosmic events to the bloom of a lily in the field, recounts the glory of God and is carefully written in His book—*ma’aseh vereshit*—the works of creation.

Parallel to this idea, the heavenly expanse (*raki'a*) is “telling”

of the work of God’s hands—the Hebrew word *Maggid* means to explain or declare something in a conspicuous or obvious way, such as plainly telling the solution of a riddle. In Jewish tradition, the part of the Passover seder where the story of the Exodus from Egypt is clearly explained to the children at the table is called the *Maggid*.

Just as the order, precision, and enormous complexity of the physical universe reveal the glory and excellencies of the Creator, so the vast heavenly expanse conspicuously displays the work of God’s hands. And though mankind may suppress this constant narrative through willful ignorance, they are forever without excuse, “for what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. For the invisible attributes of God, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, are clearly perceived in the things that have been made” (Romans 1:18-20).

A Lesson in Palestinian Propaganda

In the age of instant news via the wire services, global television and radio, the Palestinians have become masters of disinformation. They can send a twisted story around the world and by the time the *facts* come to light, it's already old news. A case in point was the killing of three Palestinian teenagers by Israeli troops along the border fence on the Gaza-Egypt-Israel frontier. Soldiers detected the youths in a restricted zone, and when they refused orders to halt, they opened fire.

The event rattled the cease-fire, sending bulletins around the world. Within minutes, Palestinian officials and witnesses fabricated a story that the boys, aged 15 and 16, were playing soccer and went to chase a ball in a closed military zone. It was another brutal act of the "occupation" against "innocent" kids who were just playing soccer.

But many hours later, the truth came out. According to an Israeli army investigation, a group of five teenagers tried to sneak across the border into Egypt. Three were killed, but two others who were captured told army interrogators that they were on a mission to *smuggle weapons* from Egypt to Palestinian terror groups in Gaza!

The terrorists who sent these kids to their deaths responded by firing 70 mortar shells at Jewish settlements in Gaza. So it was hardly an innocent soccer game. Just a good excuse to wreck the cease-fire.

Intifada III after Gaza Pullout?

Israeli security chiefs expect the outbreak of the third intifada (uprising) a few weeks after the pullout from Gaza this summer. Army intelligence believes the Palestinians will keep the peace in Gaza for awhile, but resume terrorist attacks on soldiers and settlers in Judea and Samaria.



In the meantime, the terror groups are using the cease-fire to rearm.

"We must behave peacefully at first so that Israel withdraws from Gaza," Adel, a Palestinian from the village of Halhoul near Hebron, told *Israel Today*. "As soon as Israel leaves Gaza, we'll make sure that it will pull out of the West Bank next."

And judging from the weapons smuggling going on in Gaza, it probably won't be long before it erupts too. The army says that from July 2004 to February 2005, about 3,000 assault rifles and more than 400,000 bullets were smuggled through tunnels from Egypt into Gaza, along with 400 pistols, 600 kilos (1,320 pounds) of explosives and about 200 anti-tank rockets. Israeli forces apprehend only about 30 percent of the weapons smuggled annually.

Pope Coverage enrages Islamic Militants

Arab satellite television stations gave long hours of live coverage to the death of Pope John Paul II, giving Arab viewers a rare look at Christianity. But the lavish airtime generated an angry response from Muslim fundamentalists.

"This is too much, it is unbelievable," said Gamal Sultan, editor of the Egyptian journal *Al-Manar*, a mouthpiece of Islamic fundamentalists. "How can the death of a non-Muslim be a loss to the Muslim world?"

The militants were especially angry that the Pope was praised by some Muslim leaders. "His death is a great loss not only to the Catholic Church, but to the Islamic world," said Sheikh Mohammed Sayed Tantawi, the leader of Al-Azhar, a top Islamic institution in Cairo.

Sheikh Youssef al-Qaradawi, a prominent Islamic cleric in Qatar, described the Pope as "a man of peace." "We pray for God to compensate the Christian nation for his loss," he said on the popular Arab TV station *Al-Jazeera*.

That outraged fundamentalists. "They are hypocrites," said Sultan. "They want to appease the West."

Islamic websites were even more critical. "How is it," wrote a participant on a Web forum, "that these clerics... heap praise on an infidel and an enemy of Islam?"

Yoni and Eitan

Four and a half years ago, the lives of Mike and Bev Bayless, Messianic Jewish from England, changed dramatically when their three-year-old son Yoni was diagnosed with autism. Because he was a friendly, lively toddler, it had never occurred to them. But tests revealed that Yoni had pervasive development disorder (PPD), a type of autism.



Like Yoni, their second son, Eitan, was an exceptionally beautiful baby. But when they noticed that he didn't talk much with his playmates, they took him for tests and

he, too, was diagnosed with autism. "The very week we found out was a very heavy week," Mike told *Israel Today*. "You kind of wonder what's going on and why."

But the Lord's hand was upon them, and they found an opening in a gan *tikshoret* (kindergarten for children with "special needs") just a 10-minute walk from their apartment.

Since then, they have learned that Jerusalem is among the top three cities worldwide for treating autistic kids. Because they have two autistic children, they're the first family in Jerusalem to receive social services at home. Three afternoons a week, an experienced helper comes to the house to work with the boys.

Bev admits that raising them is a day-to-day process, but she says God has helped them every step of the way. With a second autistic child, Bev's mother in England told her, "I expect you'll come home now where they can get proper treatment." Bev responded, "Mom, we are home."

Attacking Caterpillar *Israel Today*

The World Council of Churches is calling upon its 500,000 members, representing 340 Christian denominations, to divert from companies involved in "illegal activities connected with the Israeli occupation" in the "West Bank" and Gaza Strip. One company singled out for criticism is Caterpillar corporation, which makes bulldozers used by Israel to demolish the homes of Palestinians involved in terrorism. The Council recommended that members sell their shares in companies that profit from Israeli policies in the territories.

We think this is very problematic," said Israeli Foreign Ministry spokesman Mark Regav. "Now, when... "Facts on the Ground"

Jaffa Gate & the Old City

For those confused about the scandal surrounding Irineos I, the Greek Orthodox Patriarch in Jerusalem, the main issue is the same as most conflicts here: land. Irineos I is accused of trying to sell and rent land owned by the Greek Patriarchate in east Jerusalem to Jews, and the Greek Orthodox here and abroad have come out vocally against him. To be fair, Irineos I has denied the allegations, insisting instead that it was someone else within the church brokering the deals. However, this denial has not calmed calls for his removal, a move which seems imminent after the Patriarch of Constantinople, the head of Christian Orthodoxy, dispatched a letter which could be interpreted as a dismissal, a move supported by the Palestinian cabinet.

Who are the Greek Orthodox here that have demonstrated against this alleged land deal? The Greek Orthodox churches in Israel are primarily made up of the Greek clergy members, a few permanent residents, some tourists, and many local Arabs. Palestinian Christians are generally Greek Orthodox or Catholic, both of which have replacement theology as a central doctrine, and don't hide their contempt for Israel and the Jewish people. Pope John Paul II made great strides in improving relations between Jews and Catholics, and Pope Benedict XXVI has promised to do the same. However, for both Greek Orthodox and Catholics, a major change in church doctrine is going to have to accompany any outstretching of hands in order to reconcile centuries of tainted relations.

For Palestinian "Christians" living in the Holy Land, no amount of reconciliation seems to be enough. Their minds are already set against Israel due to their Palestinian upbringing, and the Orthodox and Catholic churches here don't teach them the importance of Israel and the Jewish people. In the past several years, the PA has made great efforts to embrace Christians in the Holy Land in an effort to improve their image with the primarily Christian Western world. These efforts include Arafat, and now Abbas, attending Christmas mass in Bethlehem, a Save Jerusalem campaign featuring Muslim and Christian symbols, and several high profile meetings between PA and church leaders.

Some of the land involved in the alleged deals included properties in the Old City around the Jaffa Gate, a predominantly Arab area. The local Arab Greek Orthodox

are afraid of an increased Israeli presence in such a politically sensitive area. Such an increase would contribute to "facts on the ground" that would strengthen Israeli claims to the area in any final status negotiations.

The local Greek Orthodox Church members, again primarily Arabs, are using the church as an extension of their political battle against Israel and the Jews. The PA has expressed its support for the removal of Irineos I, and the Greek Orthodox Church outside of Israel is now fully onboard with this as well. Christians in Israel and abroad are now fully in the middle of this struggle between Jews and Muslims, with evangelicals supporting Israel, and Christian Orthodoxy supporting the Muslim Arabs. While there are undoubtedly exceptions, this is the general trend of Christian support, and in this struggle there is much more at stake than just land. ✦

Beware The Feds

Kalid Hamideh used to help support a Palestinian widow and her eight children. But the Dallas lawyer's monthly contributions stopped abruptly after the 2001 raid on the Holy Land Foundation for Relief and Development, the Muslim charity through which he made his donations.

Since the September 11 terrorist attacks, the U.S. government has shut down several major Islamic charities, alleging some of their money went to al-Qaeda, Hamas or other terrorist organizations. The crackdown has caused tremendous anxiety among Muslims, with many fearful that a simple act of charity could lead to federal agents knocking at their door.

"The number one thing that has happened in our community since 9-11 is everybody is just scared," said Mr. Hamideh, who attends the Dallas Central Mosque.

"There is overwhelming fear that 'If I contribute to anything and that group turns out to be on the government's hit list, am I going to get prosecuted?'"

Faced with the government's refusal to vet charities, national Muslim leaders are taking matters into their own hands. During a recent Chicago meeting, they established a council that will set standards for its member charities, mosques and other nonprofits.

Muslims policing themselves is a hopeless procedure. They've earned the suspicion that they have gotten because so many of their charities turn out to be funding organizations for terrorism. Please see our "Try Connecting the Dots" article on page 19. — Zola
