Iraq: The Truth

America can’t abandon 27 million Iraqis to 10,000 terrorists.

(Nov. 29, 2005) I have just returned from my fourth trip to Iraq in the past 17 months and can report real progress there. More work needs to be done, of course, but the Iraqi people are in reach of a watershed transformation from the primitive, killing tyranny of Saddam to modern, self-governing, self-securing nationhood — unless the great American military that has given them and us this unexpected opportunity is prematurely withdrawn.

Progress is visible and practical. In the Kurdish North, there is continuing security and growing prosperity. The primarily Shiite South remains largely free of terrorism, receives much more electric power and other public

services than it did under Saddam, and is experiencing greater economic activity.

There are many more cars on the streets, satellite television dishes on the roofs, and literally millions more cell phones in Iraqi hands than before. All of that says the Iraqi economy is growing. And Sunni candidates are actively campaigning for seats in the National Assembly. People are working

The State of the Ministry

Zola’s father, my grandfather Joseph Levitt, lived until 1962, when I was two years old. According to Zola, granddad would take me for rides in his Plymouth and talk to me about everything under the sun. He was a brilliant businessman and an intellect. As an impoverished immigrant to the U.S. in 1911, he sold neckties from the sidewalk in front of a clothing store. Their management came outside and hired him. Three years later, he owned that company.

Zola recalls that my grandfather was scrupulously honest, and always wore a tie when doing his books on Sunday afternoons. He took pride in being an entrepreneur and was thankful for his freedom in America, not to

their way toward a functioning society and economy in the midst of a very brutal, inhumane, sustained terrorist war against the civilian population and the Iraqi and American military there to protect it.

It is a war between 27 million and 10,000; 27 million Iraqis who want to live lives of freedom, opportunity and prosperity and roughly 10,000 terrorists who are either Saddam loyalists, Iraqi Islamic extremists or al-Qaeda foreign fighters who know their wretched causes will be set back if Iraq becomes free and modern. The terrorists are intent on stopping this by instigating a civil war to produce the chaos that will allow Iraq to replace Afghanistan as the base for their fanatical war-making. We are fighting on the side of the 27 million because the outcome of this war is critically important to the security and freedom of America. If the terrorists win, they will be emboldened to strike us directly again and to further undermine the growing stability and progress in the Middle East, which has long been a major American national and economic security priority.

In the face of terrorist threats and escalating violence, eight million Iraqis voted for their interim national government in January, almost 10 million participated in the referendum on their new constitution in October, and even more than that are expected to vote in the elections for a full-term government on Dec. 15. Every time the 27 million Iraqis have been given the chance since Saddam was overthrown, they have voted for self-government and hope over the violence and hatred the 10,000 terrorists offer them. Most encouraging has been the behavior of the Sunni community, which, when disappointed by the proposed constitution, registered to vote and went to the polls instead of taking up arms and going to the streets. Last week, I was thrilled to see a vigorous political campaign, and a large number of independent television stations and newspapers covering it.

None of these remarkable changes would have happened without the coalition forces led by the U.S. And, I am convinced, almost all of the progress in Iraq and throughout the Middle East will be lost if those forces are withdrawn

faster than the Iraqi military is capable of securing the country.

The leaders of Iraq's duly elected government understand this, and they asked me for reassurance about America's commitment. The question is whether the American people and enough of their representatives in Congress from both parties understand this. I am disappointed by Democrats who are more focused on how President Bush took America into the war in Iraq almost three years ago, and by Republicans who are more worried about whether the war will bring them down in next November's elections, than they are concerned about how we continue the progress in Iraq in the months and years ahead.

Here is an ironic finding I brought back from Iraq. While U.S. public opinion polls show serious declines in support for the war and increasing pessimism about how it will end, polls conducted by Iraqis for Iraqi universities show increasing optimism. Two-thirds say they are better off than they were under Saddam, and a resounding 82% are confident their lives in Iraq will be better a year from now than they are today. What a colossal mistake it would be for America's bipartisan political leadership to choose this moment in history to lose its will and, in the famous phrase, to seize defeat from the jaws of the coming victory.

We are now embedding a core of coalition forces in every Iraqi fighting unit, which makes each unit more effective and acts as a multiplier of our forces. Progress

mention refuge from the anti-Semitism that he had left behind in Riga, Latvia.

Grandfather was short, bald, outspoken and, according to my relatives in Pittsburgh, generous with his family. At his funeral, the rabbi spoke about pillars. He described the massive, outer ones, built for show, designed to enhance the appearance of public buildings. Then he described the sort of pillars that aren't seen, the stronger ones that do the heaviest work of supporting a structure from within. My grandfather Joe, the rabbi explained, was one of our community's inconspicuous inner pillars. (See our book *Jesus — the Jew's Jew* for a more complete story on this remarkable man.)

Equally respectable, Jerry Hodges is one of this ministry's behind-the-scenes pillars. He began loyally supporting this ministry in 1986 after reading one of our newsletters in which Zola commented that it would be a good time to help other outreaches for a while since this ministry was doing okay. For nearly twenty years, Jerry has saved that newsletter along with another that he received from another ministry. Now he works at Berg Productions, where they produce *Zola Levitt Presents* and purchase our airtime.

The other ministry's newsletter, it so happens, was a professionally written fundraising piece — slick and contrived. Its frantic appeal implied that their walls would tumble down if readers didn't mail checks ASAP. You have probably experienced this sort of perennial "boy cries wolf" melodrama and find it repugnant. *Levitt Letter* content probably would confuse the readers who fall for that razzle-dazzle hype. May God bless them, nonetheless, who so humbly and generously give, despite lacking the wisdom of serpents.

Jerry is no fool. Beyond that, he is one of the most gifted and dedicated employees that I have witnessed during my 18-year tenure with this ministry. Satan must rue the day when Jerry, with all of his love for the ministry, joined forces with Berg several years ago. It has been since then that our stewardship in the broadcasting department has soared to new levels of excellence. Let me explain.

If the truth be told, most of our donors more enthusiastically support the production of new TV programs than the airtime expenses which carry the teaching to the airwaves. TV airtime, however, is the Goliath among all of this ministry's invoices. We must produce high-caliber, on-location TV programs to capture the attention of channel surfers and build regular audiences, but we would still be defeated if we were to settle for lame airtimes or overpay for slots that should be negotiated down.

Jerry has applied and honed his God-given gifts to

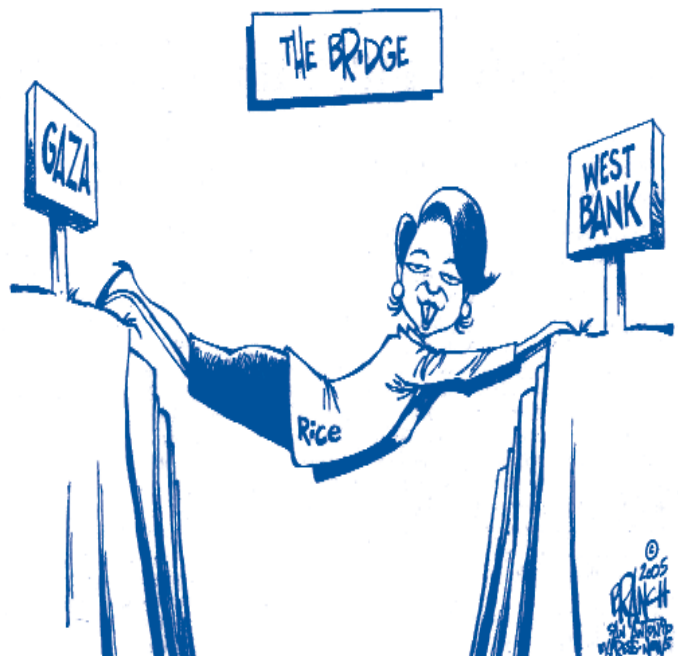
repeatedly and cumulatively improve our channel line-ups. He has been just as tightfisted with this ministry's syndication dollar as Ken, our TV producer, has been with our production budget (and that's really saying something). Jerry's secret weapon has been simply doing his homework. By the time we select and contract for an airtime, we know about the station's audience and the particular timeslot's lead-ins and lead-outs. We have also assessed the station's degree of good will toward Christ and this ministry.

2005 has been a monumental success in terms of our establishing a foothold on PAX. In November of 2003, when we undertook this Thursday morning airtime, we knew that we had signed on for the financial equivalent of a rodeo ride on a very rebellious bull. Surprisingly, in TV broadcasting, it takes fully eighteen months to seed and cultivate a new mission field before it will carry its own weight financially. We accomplished this very feat on PAX. What a major-league success to increase our airtime budget and audience by nearly 70% in one fell swoop. What a cause for celebration!

One way to celebrate is to keep an eye on www.charitynavigator.org. As of this newsletter's press run, they had already given us a 4-star rating — their best (please see page 4). They are on the verge of incorporating our 2004 financial figures, which are even better, since that was our full year of broadcasting on PAX.

Eluding Charity Navigator's rating system, however, is the unbeatable efficiency of our approach to ministry: bringing Bible-teaching by a messianic Jew, at Biblical sites in Israel, to American living rooms and computer screens (click on "Zola on Internet TV" at www.levitt.com) at low costs per household.

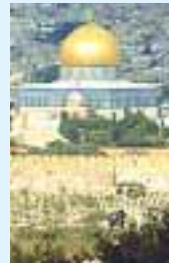

in “clearing” and “holding” is being made. The Sixth Infantry Division of the Iraqi Security Forces now controls and polices more than one-third of Baghdad on its own. Coalition and Iraqi forces have together cleared the previously terrorist-controlled cities of Fallujah, Mosul and Tal Afar, and most of the border with Syria. Those areas are now being “held” secure by the Iraqi military themselves. Iraqi and coalition forces are jointly carrying out a mission to clear Ramadi, now the most dangerous city in Al-Anbar province, at the west end of the Sunni Triangle.

Nationwide, American military leaders estimate that about one-third of the approximately 100,000 members of the Iraqi military are able to “lead the fight” themselves with logistical support from the U.S., and that that number should double by next year. If that happens, American military forces could begin a drawdown in numbers proportional to the increasing self-sufficiency of the Iraqi forces in 2006. If all goes well, I believe we can have a much smaller American military presence there by the end of 2006 or in 2007, but it is also likely that our presence will need to be significant in Iraq, or nearby, for years to come.

I cannot say enough about the U.S. Army and Marines who are carrying most of the fight for us in Iraq. They are courageous, smart, effective, innovative, very honorable, and very proud. After a Thanksgiving meal with a great group of Marines at Camp Fallujah in western Iraq, I asked their commander whether the morale of his troops had been hurt by the growing public dissent in America over the war in Iraq. His answer was insightful, instructive and inspirational: “I would guess that if

the opposition and division at home go on a lot longer, and get a lot deeper, it might have some effect, but, Senator, my Marines are motivated by their devotion to each other and the cause, not by political debates.”

Thank you, General. That is a powerful message for the rest of America and its leadership at this critical moment in our nation’s history. Semper Fi (always faithful).

Israel: No Nuclear Iran

Israeli leaders warned they would never allow Iran to come into possession of nuclear weapons, but insisted that diplomacy was the best way to confront their arch enemies in Tehran. "Israel, and not only Israel, cannot accept a situation in which Iran would be in possession of nuclear weapons," Prime Minister Ariel Sharon told journalists in Tel Aviv.

"We must do everything possible to prepare for such a situation. But Israel is not spearheading any campaign" against Iran's suspected nuclear weapons ambitions, he added.

"It is not only a danger for Israel, but for the Middle East as a whole and for other countries. The challenge posed by Iran is not only a danger for Israel, but for the entire free world, and the United States and the Europeans are aware of this danger."

Since the downfall of Saddam Hussein's regime in Iraq, Israel has come to regard Iran as its number one enemy.

Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad caused an international backlash in October when he called for

the Jewish state to be "wiped off the map." In a bid to defuse the row, the Iranian foreign ministry said that Tehran had "never resorted to, nor threatened to resort to force against another country."

Israel, which has never admitted having, but is widely believed to possess around 200 nuclear warheads, carried out an air strike against Iraq's French-built Osirak nuclear plant in 1981.

Israel has repeatedly warned Iran may be close to developing a nuclear weapon, with Foreign Minister Silvan Shalom saying in October that Iran might be as little as six months away from having the necessary means. A senior defense official said in an interview published in the *Maariv* daily that Israel would have to "resign itself" to the idea of a nuclear Iran.

US Vice President Dick Cheney fueled speculation about a possible pre-emptive Israeli strike in a television interview during 2005. "Given the fact that Iran has a stated policy that their objective is the destruction of Israel, the Israelis might well decide to act first, and let the rest of the world worry about cleaning up the diplomatic mess afterwards," he said.

To be sure, America, like Britain, has obnoxious, dissembling Islamic lobby groups, but, as the years go by, you can't help but notice important differences between U.S. and other Western Muslims. The number of British, Canadian and European Islamists captured in Afghanistan and elsewhere, for example, has not been matched by any equivalent numbers among American passport holders. Important figures in the 9/11 conspiracy, plus Ahmed Ressaam (the millennium bomber), plus Richard Reid (the shoe bomber), plus the July 7th London bombers were all graduates of the Euro-Canadian welfare system. Say what you like about John Walker Lindh, but at least the great Marin County jihadist took up arms against America on his parents' dime, not the taxpayers'.

Beyond that, there seem to be no American equivalents of the uglier phenomena of European multiculturalism — the Muslim gang rapists in France or the Muslim mobs in Yorkshire, who on the night of September 11, 2001 rampaged through the streets banging on the hoods of cars and demanding the drivers join them in cheering Osama bin Laden. You wouldn't do that here. The reason seems obvious: If you tried to do that to a pick-up truck in Texas, you'd get your head blown off. The bullying, intimidating side of Muslim immigration in Europe seems to be wholly absent here — in part at least because the assertiveness of the individual American citizen makes it a riskier proposition.

That's also the lesson of 9/11. The first three planes were effectively an airborne European Union, where the rights of the citizens had been appropriated by the FAA's flying nanny state. On the fourth, Flight 93, Todd Beamer and others reclaimed those rights, and demonstrated that they could exercise them more efficiently than government.

The modern social-democratic state is so corrosive of its citizens' will and so enervating in its elevation of secondary priorities (welfare, paid vacation) over primary ones (family, national defense) that most of them will not survive this great existential struggle. In America, a wartime president should understand that this is no time to increase his own citizenry's addiction to entitlement. A government big enough to give you everything you want is big enough to take away everything you have, starting with your sense of self-reliance. ■

“Remember Allah Always”

Dear Zola:

I just read this story on the website of afa.net and I thought I would pass it along.

The Ninth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals recently heard oral arguments in *Eklund v. Byron Union School District*, a case in which several parents and children represented by the Thomas More Law Center challenged the school district's practice of teach-

ing 12-year-old students to “become Muslims.”

The Law Center contends the actions of the school in question crossed a constitutional line to begin indoctrinating students, impermissibly placing them in the position of being trainees in Islam. For three weeks, the students were placed in Islamic city groups, took Islamic names, wore identification tags that displayed their new Islamic name along with the Muslim star and crescent moon symbols. As part of the exercise, the children received materials instructing them to “Remember Allah always,” completed the “Five Pillars” of Islamic faith, and also memorized and recited the basmala, an Islamic phrase from the Koran, which they also wrote out on banners to be hung in the classroom.

A federal district court judge in San Francisco had previously determined that the school district had not violated the Constitution of the United States with these activities. But according to Thomas More Law Center chief counsel Richard Thompson, “There is a double standard at play in this case. If the students had done similar activities in a class on Christianity, a constitutional violation would surely have been found.” If the district's practice is upheld on appeal, Thompson says all public schools should begin teaching classes on Christianity in the same manner as the Islam class was taught in this case.

The takeover goes on. — Zola

Critics...

Dear Zola:

I stumbled onto your website while doing some research and I must say that you are just as disingenuous as Jews for Jesus. You are nothing more than a front for Christianity in order to lure Jews into converting to Christianity. It is so lame. Theologically you are no different than Evangelical Christians. Except you have the Jewish window-dressing. If you believe in Jesus you may still lineage

The Long War on Terrorism

The Marines' Hymn begins “From the halls of Montezuma to the shores of Tripoli.” Those shores in Tripoli gave us quite a few problems around 1800 AD. Libyan pirates from that Mediterranean port were demanding tribute from U.S. vessels, and our new federal government was

barely a decade old. A review of the book by Joshua E. London called *Victory in Tripoli* in the October 24 *National Review* tells how “President Thomas Jefferson understood early on what was necessary: ‘I know that nothing will stop the eternal increase demands from these pirates but the presence of an armed force.’”

The situation was so similar to what we have today. Nothing stops the Saudi Arabians from exporting their radical Islamic ways to American, European and other mosques around the world, and, of course, their terrorism in the World Trade Center attack. But they demand tribute from us in the way of oil purchases (the oil, of course, was discovered by Americans and other westerners, and the know-how was imparted to the Saudi Arabians basically by us and our allies).

The review ends on a happy note: “There would be much failure and frustration before victory finally came...” (London's fascinating account gives us cause for hope that even long, twilight struggles can, after twists and turns of ugly politics, end in victory).

While the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan seem more than justified, one still wonders about our modern day pirates in Saudi Arabia, Syria and Iran.

IV The Marriage

Now we are ready to marry the Lord.

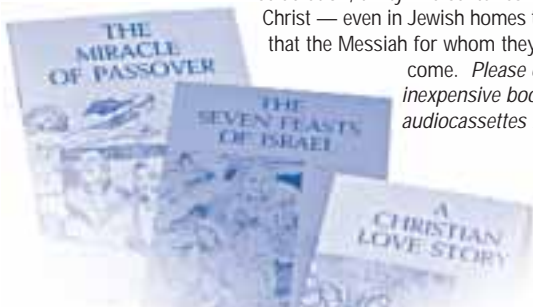
It's fascinating to compare these events with Israel's wedding traditions in Christ's time. There was a seven-day honeymoon in a bridal chamber for the bride and groom, preceding the marriage supper. This pertains exactly to the seven years in Heaven and the Judgment Seat of Christ, leading up to marriage with Him. (The Jewish wedding and all of its Gospel implications are explained fully in the booklet, *A Christian Love Story*.)

John covers the marriage scene for us in two glorious verses (Rev. 19:7-8). The white linen bridal gowns we shall wear fulfill a fascinating Bible type that reaches back to the Tabernacle of ancient Israel (Exodus 25-30). In the Tabernacle, plain white linen symbolized pure righteousness. The linen curtains around the entire Tabernacle, the tent, as it were, were pure white. Therefore, no one could enter through the sides or rear, because no one was perfectly righteous. The door of the Tabernacle was sewn with the colors of Christ — scarlet, purple, and blue threads, indicating sacrifice, royalty, and Heaven. The Israelites entered by the door, so symbolically, they were entering by means of the Messiah.

Jesus said, *I am the door: by Me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture* (John 10:9). Messianic colors were worn by the priests, and also appeared in the hangings of various courts and in roof coverings.

A Note From Zola



But now, the Church shall wear white! — “Fine linen, clean and white, for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.” That we now appear in pure white testifies to our final perfection. Paul compared earthly marriage to Christ's marrying the Church (Eph. 5:21-33). Ultimately, we will see the result of the apostles' exhortation of the infant Church.

After we marry the Lord, we'll reign with Him in His Kingdom on earth. This is exactly the way the bride returned with her groom after an Israeli marriage, to housing he had arranged for them — outside of his father's house. (Some teach that the wedding will be on earth after we return, and others have it in Heaven with the marriage supper on earth (Rev. 19:7-8).

V The Return

Jesus' return to earth is glorious in the Scriptures (Rev.19:11-16). The Church initially comes as an army to stop the battle of Armageddon.

After that battle will come the judgment of those who lived during the Tribulation, and the rewarding of those who refused the mark of the Antichrist (Rev. 20:4-5).

John exults in our taking part in this first resurrection and reigning with Christ through the Kingdom Age (v. 6).

While still on earth, Jesus taught more on this judgment, which serves as an immigration office into the Kingdom. He means to judge every soul alive during the seven years of the Tribulation. All nations will be before Him, the Believers separated from the unbelievers *as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats*. (See Matt. 25:31-34.)

The Believers will be surprised they had so honored Jesus (Matt. 25:37-40). If the nations of the world, even during the Tribulation, express faith in Christ by caring for His brethren (the 144,000 of Israel who witness

during that hard time), they will be saved. But the judgment is equal, and devastating, upon those who failed to honor the Lord during the reign of the Anti-christ (vs. 45-46).

The Old Testament saints are also gathered at the start of the Kingdom Age, so the Kingdom begins with rather a mixed crowd, who yet all share sincere belief in their Messiah and King (Romans 3:25).

Since the Believers of the Tribulation Period did not come to faith before the Rapture, they were not changed, but remain as before, marrying and giving in marriage, and giving birth to ordinary, fleshly sinners “born of Adam.” In the end, some of these will disobey the Lord’s commands, and Scripture poses certain penalties (e.g., Zech. 14:16-19).

These mischief-makers in the Kingdom, having multiplied, will be rallied by Satan in the very last battle at the end of the thousand years (Rev. 20:7-9). This, Satan’s last rebellion, is unsuccessful, and the Great White Throne of Judgment is set up for all who were confined with him, and the unbelievers of all ages (vs. 11-15). The “second death” referred to is avoided by Believers, who are exonerated and do not have to appear in the Judgment.

VI The Kingdom

This great millennium is the true reward of the Church, and will be quite a different age than we are experiencing now. Things will be socially “upside-down.” It will be “sophisticated” to be a Christian, foolish to be an unbeliever. The King Himself shall reign in Jerusalem with us, His Queen.

Jesus took all His teaching from the Old Testament; there was no New Testament at the time He taught His disciples “the things pertaining to the Kingdom.” The great passages of Isaiah and the other prophets make clear this magnificent age of God’s triumph. The New Testament therefore assumes its readers understand the Kingdom, and so, it virtually begins with the Sermon on the Mount, teaching both admission

to and laws of the Kingdom, and then its joys (the Beatitudes, in Matt. 5, etc.). See Isaiah 11:4-9.

Isaiah 12 contains the most beautiful and concise description of the Kingdom in the whole Bible. The themes of the Kingdom are the constant company of the Messiah, total triumph of the saints, and justice and mercy throughout the earth.

VII Eternity

After the Kingdom and the Great White Throne of Judgment, the Believers live on in eternity. God will change Heaven, earth, and Jerusalem (Rev. 21:1-3 — no more seas or water, and therefore no more life as we now know it.

The very end of the Scriptures, as John describes in his Revelation, become symbolic, and almost incomprehensible. We can sample John’s description of eternity in Rev. 21:1-7. One notable feature is that there will be no Temple (v. 22). There is no need for further sacrifice, or, in effect, for further worship. Everyone will be at one with God, and approach Him directly, as did Adam before the fall.

Another interesting feature of eternity is new light. Light was the first thing God created, but now there will be no need of the sun or moon, because God and the Lamb provide the light (Rev. 21:23).

But perhaps the most striking feature of all is that there will be no evil — anywhere. While there was a certain amount of rebellion even in the Kingdom, eternity will be utterly free of it (Rev. 21:26-27).

And remember, this is only the beginning!

John, after seeing all these things, wrote that the thing to do was to pray now for the soon coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. John the Apostle, New Testament Saint, and member of the Church awaited the Rapture fervently — and so should we. The conclusion of the Bible is a more-than-fitting conclusion for this discussion. John's final prayer must be our ultimate prayer. In view of all he had seen in this stunning Revelation of Jesus Christ, John uttered simply:

He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen (Rev. 22:20-21).

Such teaching as that above is our bread and butter as we pursue our outreach. At this time each year, I must ask you to please remember this ministry in your year-end giving. In fact, the idea that this Palestinian-made cancer would target Arab Muslims is so inconceivable to most Arabs that many now believe the terror attack in Amman was orchestrated by Jews (the Israeli *Mossad* [secret service]).

Of course, Arab Muslim men, women and children are blown up almost weekly in Iraq, but, hey, that's OK because the monsters doing it hate America and seek Israel's annihilation. And in much of the Muslim and leftist worlds — hatred of America and Israel gets you a moral pass. In the Arab/Muslim worlds (with individual exceptions, of course), as among the world's leftists, an act is almost incapable of being judged evil if it is committed by those who hate America (especially the America of George W. Bush) or Israel.

In a previous column, I proposed that supporters of the war in Iraq ask opponents of the war just one question: Without in any way compromising your opposition to the war, would you at least acknowledge that the people we are fighting in Iraq are evil? Virtually every one of the many letters I received from readers opposed to the war was incapable of answering in the positive. By fighting America and George W. Bush, the “insurgents” are essentially inoculated against any moral judgment.

Likewise it has been nearly impossible for the Arab, Muslim and leftist worlds to morally condemn the blowing up of Israelis.

“Palestinians have no Apache helicopters — what do you expect them to do?”

“They are simply resisting occupation.”

“The Israelis are also terrorists.”

These arguments of the Left, the Arab world and countless other Muslims have given the Islamic terrorists the moral green light to continue their atrocities.

Until, that is, they inflicted one of these atrocities on Arabs in the land of the Palestinians. So, at least for the time being, the sight of charred and dismembered Arab families at a wedding has trumped the anti-Americanism and anti-Zionism of Abu Musab al-Zarqawi's killers.

The Oldest Church

Prisoners excavating a site near the Biblical Armageddon uncovered what archaeologists said may be the Holy Land's oldest church.

Told to dig in an area where the Prisons' Authority wants to build new wards for 1,200 Palestinian security prisoners, the criminals uncovered mosaics that experts said was the floor of a church from the third century, decades before Constantine legalized Christianity across the Byzantine Empire.

"What's clear is that it's the oldest archaeological remains of a church in Israel, maybe even in the entire region, whether in the entire world, it's still too early to say," said Yotam Tepper, the excavation's head archaeologist.

Israeli officials were giddy at the news, with Prime Minister Ariel Sharon calling the church "an amazing story."

Vatican officials also hailed the find.

"A discovery of this kind will make Israel more interesting to all Christians, for the Church all over the world," said Archbishop Pietro Sambi, the Vatican's envoy to Jerusalem. "If it's true that the church and the beautiful mosaics are from the third century, it would be one of the most ancient churches in the Middle East."

Two mosaics inside the church — one covered with fish, an ancient Christian symbol that predates the cross — tell the story of a Roman officer and a woman named Aketous who donated money to build the church in the memory "of the God, Jesus Christ."

Pottery remnants from the third-century, the style of Greek writing used in the inscriptions, ancient geometric patterns in the mosaics, and the depiction of fish, rather than the cross, indicate that the church was no longer used by the fourth century, Tepper said.



"The times, they are a'changin'"

Israel Today

It didn't take long for Palestinian terrorists to test Israel's resolve following the pullout from the Gaza Strip. Within

days, the Islamic group Hamas launched a barrage of 40 rockets at Israeli border communities.

Israel's response was swift. Defense Minister Shaul Mofaz ordered a "crushing blow" on Gaza. Israeli helicopters went into immediate action, firing missiles at terrorist targets night after night, including weapons factories, bridges, offices, and warehouses.

Israel extended the raids to Judea and Samaria, after a 50-year-old Israeli man, Sasson Nuriel, was kidnapped and killed in Ramallah. Imitating Islamic terrorists in Iraq, Hamas released a video of the man pleading for his life and urging Israel to release Palestinian prisoners. In the sweeps that followed the abduction, more than 400 Hamas and Islamic Jihad terrorists were arrested.

The tough military response was a sign that Israel is setting out new rules of deterrence in the wake of the Gaza pullout. "The times they are a changin'," said government spokesman Ra'anana Glissin. "We are now deployed behind our international border and any attack against Israel is an attack against the sovereignty of the State of Israel, for which we have all the justification to exercise our right of self-defense."

The world seemed to recognize that right. The US said it understood the Israeli reaction, and in sharp contrast to past Israeli army operations, the UN, Europe, and even the Arab world were silent. One reason is that the air strikes showed surgical precision, and no civilians were killed.

Now there is widespread condemnation of Zarqawi's terror in Jordan. There is even a fear that the name of Islam will suffer. Unfortunately, however, it is only because Zarqawi was foolish enough to massacre Jordanian civilians, and not confine his massacres to Iraqis and non-Arabs. What has aroused Arab voices against Zarqawi has nothing to do with the immorality of blowing up people celebrating at a wedding — it has to do with the immorality of blowing up Muslims celebrating at a wedding.

Nevertheless, it is possible that a moral awakening of sorts may be taking place in parts of the Arab world. *The London Telegraph* reports that “Munder Moomeni, a 38-year-old former soldier who lives next to Zarqawi's house, 13 Ramzi Street, described his former neighbor as ‘a bastard.’ ‘By killing Jordanians here in Jordan, civilian Jordanians going to a wedding, they did something that not even a Jew would do,’ he said.”

That a neighbor and former supporter of Zarqawi publicly acknowledged that Jews would not engage in such terror may be a first step toward the moral awakening that the Arab world needs even more than oil revenues.

It may even come to realize the greatest truth regarding terror and evil: People who blow up Israeli weddings and cut Americans' throats are very bad people. And if you don't fight them, they will eventually blow you up, too.



The Slap Heard Round the World

For weeks, millions of French citizens cowered in their homes, baffled and frightened as organized gangs from Muslim neighborhoods used cell phones, text messaging and motorbikes to plan and carry out precision strikes against French property and institutions. Typically, a gang of attackers would converge on a carefully selected location at a precise time. One arsonist would break a window while another lit a makeshift fuse in a glass bottle full of gasoline before tossing the Molotov cocktail into a car or building. Before the police could even be summoned, the perpetrators were usually far away.

Euphemistically labeled “riots,” this organized gangsterism was a collective slap in the face of those, French and otherwise, who believed that France would be spared Muslim violence in return for the country’s steadfast endorsement of Palestinian complaints against Israel and its opposition to the democratization of Iraq. This “slap heard round the world” has left the French and their ideological adjuncts in a state of confusion and denial.

We do not know, in fact, how many cars, shopping centers, schools, community centers, churches and synagogues were burned — as the French government and press made the conscious and public decision not to report details about the destruction in hopes that, denied publicity, the nationwide violence would simply wither away. After more than three weeks, however, the strategy of ignoring the insurgency had failed, so the French government took the logical next step, and declared the riots “over.”

When confronted with evidence that, nightly, a hundred or more cars were still being destroyed and buildings continued to burn, they dismissed these dismal statistics as “normal.” Armed guards patrolled the Eiffel tower and the *Champs-Elysee* but, if President Chirac’s administration was to be believed, it meant nothing. *Rien*.

It also meant nothing that the vast majority of those filling French nights with terror were North African Muslims, as evidenced by the painstaking efforts by the French government and press to refer to them only as Africans or “youths,” lest Islamic sensibilities be offended. Much of the American press voluntarily cooperated with the French news blackout, purposefully downplaying and understating both the scope and the nature of what many rioters themselves called a civil war.

Muslim sensibilities were, nonetheless, offended, resulting in an outpouring of indignation and blame aimed not at the rioters, but at the French for having created the conditions that led to the violence. This was ironic, to say the least, as even unemployed French Muslims have better living conditions, due to one of the most generous welfare systems in the world, than many of the Islamic countries from whence the criticism came. Moreover, even peaceful anti-government demonstrators in much of the Islamic world have a habit of disappearing in the middle of the night — forever. Still, many Western pundits joined in blaming the French government for not having been more inclusive toward their immigrant Muslim population.

This interpretation of root causes, however, was belied by the rioters themselves, who have demanded not inclusion, but separation. Many in the Muslim communities do not, in fact, want anything to do with French culture and have already succeeded in winning *de facto* recognition of the Islamic customs of polygamy, wife beating and forced marriage. Now, many are proposing that the solution to “social unrest” in France is the official recognition of Islamic sharia law and a system of self-governing *millets* (legally protected religious minorities) based on the Ottoman model.

Not Worth Printing

“The Palestinian Authority tells us that for the first time since 2000, more Palestinians were killed over the course of a year by fellow Palestinians than by Israelis.”

The above statement from page 12 of the November 7 *National Review* is interesting, but not worth printing. The implication is that, somehow, Israelis have let up on their killing of Palestinians. But the *fact* is the Palestinians kill more of their own in *every* year than Israelis do. Despite the worldwide propaganda, Israelis kill very few Palestinians, and persecute none of them at all. Israelis are doing police work, taking out murderers, just as American cops do. This difficult process sometimes results in collateral casualties, as with the American army in Iraq, for example. But, as also with our army, that leads to trouble for soldiers. A wanton killing of a civilian by an Israeli soldier leads to a court martial. The other way around, of course, is the Palestinian’s daily bread.

But we should appreciate that Palestinians have always killed their own in the spirit of the insurrectionists in Iraq, blowing up their own Muslims in their own markets and mosques. Palestinians have always killed whomever is around them, as have most other Arabs, because this gives a feeling of importance to the devalued individual Arab personality. Also, the Israelis receive quite a bit of cooperation from within Palestinian villages; they tend to locate key terrorists by paying Palestinian informers. When these informers are discovered by Palestinians, they are killed in the most public ways, such as their bodies being strung up on a cable in a city square or hung against a public wall, etc.

But many times Palestinians have used the “collaborator” excuse to simply kill enemies in family feuds, and so forth. “Honor killings,” in which women and even young girls are victimized, also infect their society.

As someone knowledgeable about the area for almost 35 years, I can assure you that Palestinians kill more Palestinians than Israelis ever have in any year. But, in view of the article in *National Review*, they have, for some reason, finally said so.

And it probably should be pointed out that if Israel really wanted to kill the Palestinians, as the whole world believes they actually do, the job would be over in a very short time. That answers why the upcoming invasion of Gog and Magog is such a quick, virtually twenty four-hour affair. The Israelis are very strong, very fair, and very reluctant to fight. They have bent over backwards seeking peace — but when provoked, especially by a superior force as in 1967 or 1973, Israelis will defend

themselves with valor and effectiveness. And that will happen in Ezekiel’s prophesied invasion, to say the least.

In one paragraph, I could encapsulate that matters will rapidly get worse in Israel with the Palestinians continuing their terrorism to a point where they will try a frontal assault on Israel. Israel will put a stop to that attack, and virtually all of the Palestinians within reach, and that will provoke the much larger Muslim invasion called Gog and Magog (Ezekiel 38 & 39). In that invasion, Israel will defend itself, perhaps with nuclear weapons (*I will rain upon him... great hailstones, fire, and brimstone*, Ezekiel 38:22). That invasion, in turn, will lead to the Antichrist and Armageddon.

But for the moment, the reader can reassure himself that the idea of Arabs in Israel killing more Arabs than Israelis do has been going on perhaps for a century.

Enter the Antichrist?

The Bigger Jihad

"Now the bigger jihad (holy war) is about to begin," Palestinian leader Mahmoud Abbas declared after Israel had withdrawn from the Gaza strip.

In an article in the Palestinian newspaper *Al Hayat Al Jadida*, Abbas said: "The 'small jihad' — fighting against the occupiers — has come to an end. Now the 'bigger jihad' — rebuilding, developing, establishing security and calm for the Palestinian people — has begun. It was Palestinian sacrifices that accomplished the withdrawal," he said.

Abbas praised the 'martyrs' (shahids) and their families, saying that they prepared the way for Palestinians to see the end of the occupation. Speaking of the wounded and disabled, he said: "One has to take care of them — not just society, but also the Palestinian Authority.

That's why we gave them five percent of the jobs in the public tender, to strengthen their position as part of society."

The daily newspaper *Al Hayat Al Jadida* reported that in his address to the Palestinian youth, Abbas said that the withdrawal of Jewish settlers from Gaza foretells of a solution for the West Bank [Judea and Samaria] and Jerusalem as well. He also spoke of the [so-called] Palestinian refugees, saying the problem needs to be solved fairly.

In conversations with the wounded in Gaza, the Palestinian leader repeatedly referred to Palestinians standing on the threshold of a 'bigger holy war'. "The land the settlers left is a national land, and no one has the right to use it as private land. We have to invest into this land in a way that favors all our people." For the Palestinian Authority, the Gaza withdrawal is simply the first step of their takeover of all of Judea, Samaria and Jerusalem.

Praising the residents of Rafah for the sacrifices they bore at the border with Egypt, Abbas promised that everyone who lost his home during the intifada (uprising) will have a new house. "The most important step after the disengagement is thinking about how our land can be protected and established."

During a meeting with Palestinian Christian priests following the presidential elections, Abbas already began using the same mantra: "the small holy war has ended and the bigger holy war, trying to achieve peace, has begun."

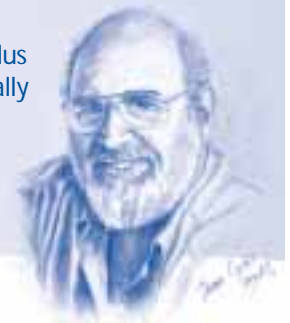

In other words, some French Muslims are threatening renewed and increased violence, an intifada, unless they are given their own Palestinian style nation within France.

 Enough with the threats!

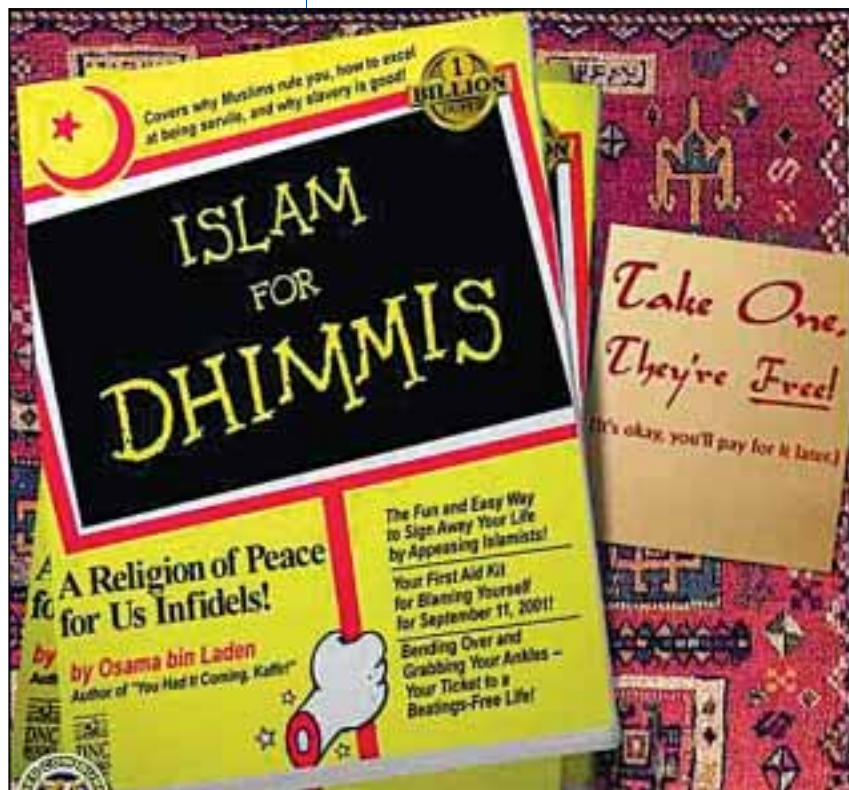
"It's time for an independent Muslim state to be created."

Preaching, Muslim style ...

"God Bless Osama"

A Palestinian cleric from one of the most popular mosques in the Gaza Strip recently asked his congregation to pray for al-Qaeda chief Osama bin Laden and his deputy Abu Musab al-Zarqawi, explaining the global terror leaders share the Palestinian goals of destroying Israel and ending "American world domination."

The reports are the latest evidence of ideological links between Palestinian groups and al-Qaeda, with Israeli security officials saying bin Laden's network infiltrated Gaza after the Israeli departure and is currently operating from the territory.

"May Allah guard and bless Sheikh Osama bin Laden and Sheikh Abu Musab al-Zarqawi, who are both leading the jihad against the Zionist entity and against American domination of the world. Pray for Sheikh bin Laden and Sheikh Zarqawi," said Dr. Jamil Mutaweh, a leader of the large Abu Dur Mosque in Khan Yunis.

Khan Yunis, a southern Gaza city, is one of the most populated Palestinian towns. Mutaweh made the comments during a Friday sermon at the mosque, which was particularly crowded, Palestinian sources say, because it was the second day of *Eid al-Fitr*, a three day Muslim holiday that marks the end of Ramadan.

Sources close to the Palestinian Authority told WND the PA has been made aware of Mutaweh's comments and is deciding whether to investigate. Mutaweh's sermon seems to stress an ideological link between al-Qaeda and Palestinian groups.

"Al-Qaeda operatives took advantage of the opened Rafah border [with Egypt immediately following Israel's withdrawal from the area] and entered Gaza," said Maj. Gen. Aharon Zeevi Farkash, chief of intelligence for the Israeli Defense Forces.

Following Israel's troop withdrawal Sept. 12, Gaza's border with Egypt was wide open, with thousands of Palestinians — including known terrorists — passing freely from one side to the other for a period of at least six days.

Egyptian officials attempted to close the border several times, but Hamas and other terror groups managed to reopen the crossing, once using a controlled explosion along the border fence and another time ramming a dump truck through the border wall.

Palestinian officials admitted to reporters that terror groups were able to smuggle tons of weapons into Gaza, including explosives, ammunition and rocket-propelled grenades that had long been stockpiled in Sinai, but denied al-Qaeda was present. ❖

American Suicide

Jihad through *Da'wa* [conversion of non-Muslims] in the form of domestic Islamic education has gotten a boost from an unlikely source, the U.S. government.

The administration has just presented the New Horizons Islamic School in Pasadena, California the United States Department of Education's "Blue Ribbon for Excellence" award.

This first ever award to a Muslim school appears to validate the predictions which cleric Yusuf Qaradawi made a decade ago, at a Muslim Youth conference in Ohio.

"...Some countries will fall to the armed Islamic jihad, but in others, such as the United States, victory will come through *Da'wa* — the teaching of Islam to non-Muslims — which will trigger Westerners to convert to Islam 'in droves.' We will conquer America not by the sword but by *Da'wa*."

Qawadari has since been banned from the U.S. due to his terror connections, but his vision of *Da'wa* transforming America into a United States of Allah, is reflected in the curriculum used in schools like that of New Horizons and as developed by affiliates such as ISNA [The Islamic Society of North America], the BIAE [The Board of Islamic and Arabic Education] and the UK based IBERR [International Board for Education Research and Resources].

The BIAE, based in Los Angeles, which plans the curriculum of the New Horizons School, together with the Islamic Center of Southern California, even offers an Islamized version of the Pledge of Alliance on their website. It begins with the phrase — "As an American Muslim I pledge alliance to ALLAH and his Prophet." www.biae.net/pledge.html

Another component of the Wahhabist-funded domestic Islamic educational network is The Islamic Schools League, the mission of which reflects the role of Islamic education inculcating the *fard* [religious obligation] to convert non-Muslims to Islam:

“For the League, the success of Islamic schools is not an option; it is a must. Our vision is achievable. Our mission requires that we all work together in support of Islamic schools. Ultimately this service is to Allah.”

The Da’wa agenda is also promoted by the Bureau for Islamic and Arabic Education (BIAE), which “aims to increase the impact of Islam on the daily life of both Muslims and non-Muslims everywhere.”

As the curriculum provider for the Islamic School of Pasadena, the BIAE underscores the conflict of interests between Islamic education and the goals of the US Department of Education. The latter insisting that, “schools singled out for national honors will now reflect the goals of our nation’s new education reforms for high standards and accountability.”

Instead of presenting the ISNA-backed, Pasadena New

Horizons Islamic School with a Blue Ribbon award, the United States Department of Education should be asking the Senate Finance Committee — which listed ISNA as a group which “promotes and finances terrorism” — about the implications of this school’s association with it.

A new generation of ISNA-educated students — indoctrinated from an early age in the importance of establishing an American caliphate — is emerging from schools like New Horizon, where previously one had to look to Pakistan for similar models.

Failure on the part of the Department of Education to exercise due diligence — rescinding New Horizon’s award — will mean that Wahhabism has become legitimized as the template for future Islamic education in North America.

The Source of True Life

Hebraic Insight:

Mekor Chayim – Source of Life

Long before Plato, King David proclaimed that there was a “divided line” between the realm of the temporal world and realm of the eternal world. The temporal world was finite, subject to change, and pointed beyond itself to an eternal world, which was the source of real significance, meaning, and life itself. Unlike Plato, however, the temporal world was not unimportant, since how each of us lived within the intersection of these two realms defined our own posture of faith — and therefore our ultimate destiny.

In the ancient Middle East, a fountain of water provided a source of life (*mekor chayim*) to people. Water was often carried off to be stored in jars or “cisterns” for use in everyday life. On a spiritual level, however, a fountain of water represented the source of true life in the midst of neediness, spiritlessness, and the fecklessness that marked human existence.

The LORD calls Himself *mekor mayim chayim* (“the Fountain of living waters”), but warned us that attempting to draw life from the temporal realm was as futile as trying to use broken jars to hold

EU: "Christ" shall be spelled with a lowercase "c." *Canada Free Press*

German news site, www.kath.net, is reporting that in addition to the "Christ" rule, new guidelines also indicate the Dutch word for "Jews" (*Joden*) is to be spelled with a capital "J" when referring to nationality and with a lower-case "j" when referring to the religion. The EU changes become mandatory in August of 2006. There are no penalties set out for those who insist on continuing to spell Christ with a capital "C."

A new poll finds two-thirds of Britons said they believe in the existence of ghosts and spirits, but only 55 percent said they believe in the existence of God. Meanwhile, 26 percent believe in UFOs, 19 percent in reincarnation and 4 percent in the Loch Ness Monster.

The political Left in America constantly attempts to blur the differences between Western civilization and Islamofascism.

The latest example comes from the *Toronto Sun*, which reports that *Hardball* host Chris Matthews recently told an audience of Canadian college students: "The period between 9/11 and Iraq was not a good time for America. Here is an excerpt: "Playing an Internet video one evening last year, an Egyptian radical living in Milan reveled as the head of an American, Nicholas Berg, was sawed off by his Iraqi captors. 'Go to hell, enemy of God!' shouted the man, Rabei Osman Sayed Ahmed, as Mr. Berg's screams were broadcast. 'Kill him! Kill him! Yes, like that! Cut his throat properly. Cut his head off! If I had been there, I would have burned him to make him already feel what hell was like. Cut off his head! God is great! God is great!'"

I wonder if Mr. Matthews can explain that "perspective" to Nick Berg's family. There is no other word to describe this "perspective," but evil. Chris Matthews used to understand this, but he sounds very confused these days.

"Some Things are Worth Fighting For"

Krauthammer in *The Washington Post*. They should reconsider. Scowcroft, who served under the first President Bush, has come out strongly against the war in Iraq, calling it an utterly unrealistic boondoggle, cooked up by a cabal of neoconservatives. Scowcroft, you see, is from the "realism" school of foreign policy, where US interests trump all, and what dictators do to their own people is, frankly, none of our business. It sounds practical and painless, but let's recall where this policy really leads us.

In 1991, as US and coalition forces crushed Iraq's army in the Gulf War, Scowcroft urged Bush senior to leave Saddam Hussein in power, rather than roll on to Baghdad. A few months later, when Saddam responded to a US-encouraged uprising of Kurds and Shiites by massacring tens of thousands of people, Scowcroft and Bush stood by, doing nothing. Why rock the boat?

On the basis of that same cynicism, Scowcroft went to China six months after the horrific Tiananmen Square crackdown on dissidents, and "toasted those who ordered the massacre."

Human rights? Not important. Democracy? Irrelevant. For realists like Scowcroft, standing up to tyrants is simply "too risky, too dangerous, and too unpredictable." Risky it is, but what the realists don't understand is that some things are worth fighting for. ❖

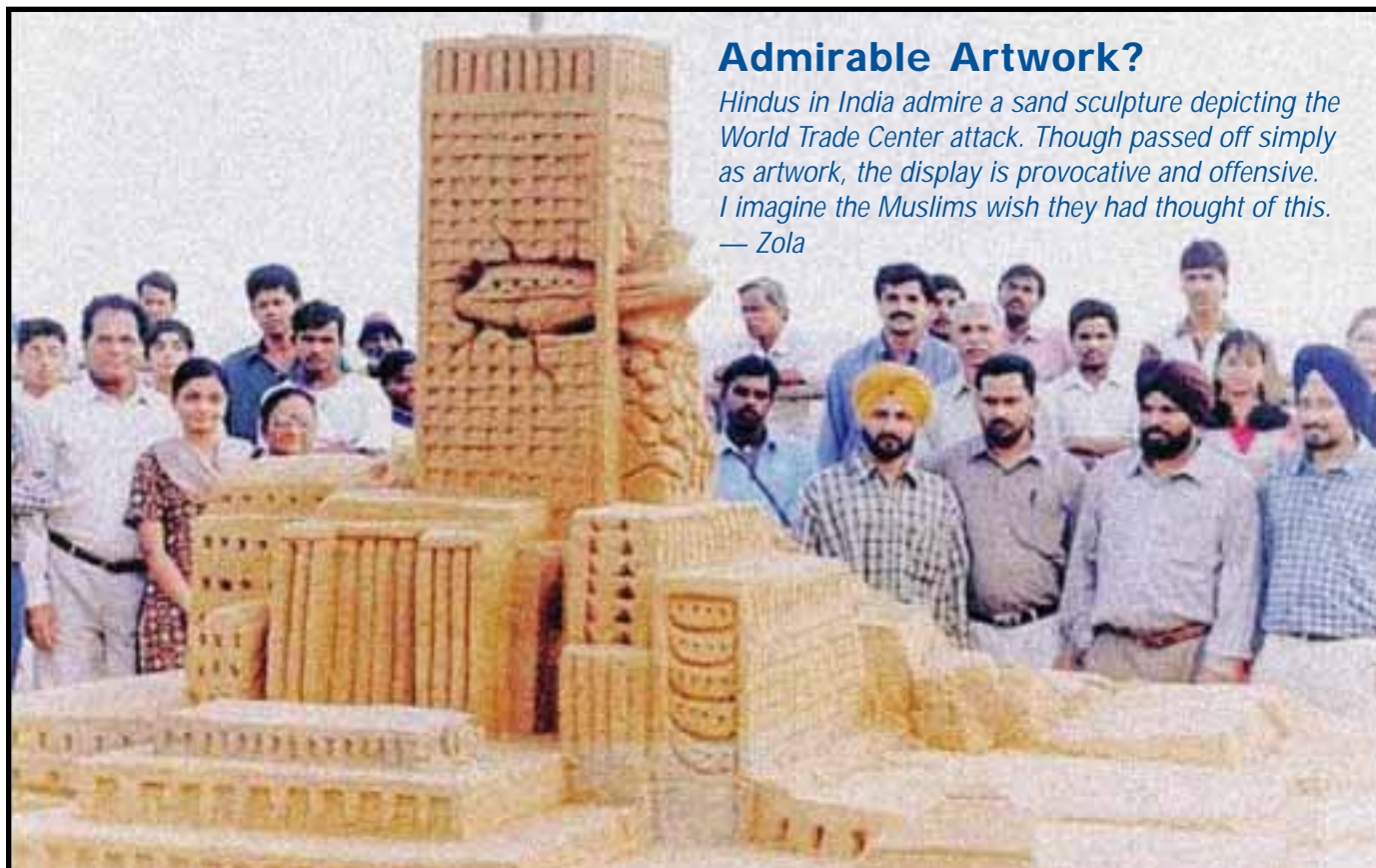
