The Doctrine of Demons

A Roman Catholic bishop in the Netherlands issued a statement urging Catholics to refer to God as "Allah."

Martinus "Tiny" Muskens, the bishop of Breda, argues that God doesn't mind what you call Him: "The Almighty is above such discussion and bickering." It is common in the Arab world where Christian and Muslim Arabs use the words God and Allah interchangeably, he said.

Bishop Muskens is not without allies in his quest to rename God: **Ibrahim Hooper**, spokesman for the Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR) backs the idea as a way to "help interfaith understanding"—or something.

"It reinforces the fact that Muslims, Christians, and Jews all worship the same God," Hooper said. "I don't think the name is as important as the belief in God. I think that's true for all faiths."

Christians and Jews worship a Living God. As a Living Entity, God cannot be "reinvented" to suit somebody else, since He already is Who He is. God doesn't need to claim to be someone else to confirm His legitimacy.

Allah evidently does. If Allah were a living entity, then Islam wouldn't try to remake him as someone he is not. Allah cannot be the God of Scripture unless the God of Scripture suffered a bout of schizophrenia in the sixth century.

Russian Navy to Re-open Bases at Syrian Ports

For the first time since the fall of the Soviet empire, Russia plans to establish permanent bases in Syria as part of a large arms deal between the two countries. Reports indicate that the Russian Navy plans to resume operations at the Syrian ports of Tartus and Latakia. The port agreement and recent arms deal were made possible after the two parties resolved a dispute over Syria's \$11 billion debt to Moscow. Israeli defense officials fear Russian ships will carry out spying missions on Israel's latest communications and weapon systems. ★

That a Christian bishop would advocate there being no difference between Islam's "Allah" and the Judeo-Christian "God" is striking testimony to a deep spiritual blindness, one that seems to be increasingly casting its shadow over diseased sectors of today's churches.

Flight 93 Memorial: Giant Mosque

The planned crescent-shaped “memorial to heroes” of Flight 93 in Pennsylvania is nothing less than a huge outdoor mosque that pays homage to Islam, charges Alec Rawls, who is trying to expose the Islamic and terrorist-memorializing features in the Flight 93 National Memorial.



The primary feature, he says, is the giant central crescent design. A person facing into this half-mile wide crescent will be oriented almost exactly at Mecca.

That is significant, Rawls said, because a crescent that Muslims face to point them in the direction of Mecca—called a *mihrab*—is the central feature around which every mosque is built.

Rawls said it seems impossible such startling revelations could go unreported, but Pennsylvania newspapers have ignored him.

He learned from a reporter at the *Pittsburgh Post Gazette* that editors knew about the Mecca orientation of

the giant crescent in September 2005 when the design was first unveiled. But the editors decided the information should not be published, accusing critics of being paranoid bigots.

Rawls claims leaders of the project countered his information by lying to the Flight 93 families. Memorial Project Superintendent Joanne Hanley told Rawls she was not concerned about the Mecca orientation because it’s not “exact.” “But,” says Rawls, “it’s an easy matter to check the orientation of the crescent.”

Rawls gave Kirk Swauger of *The Tribune-Democrat* (Johnstown, Penn.) the address of an Islamic website—Islam.com—that has a Mecca direction calculator. When Swauger placed the resulting Mecca-direction graphic over the memorial site plan, Swauger concluded, “Yup. It points to Mecca.”

Another feature, Rawls says, is a separate section of the wall—centered exactly on the bisector of the giant crescent—that is in the exact position of the star on an Islamic flag.

He says there also are 44 inscribed glass blocks placed along the path that Flight 93 followed to the ground, matching the number of passengers, crew—and terrorists.

As Rep. Tom Tancredo, R-Colo., wrote in a letter to the National Park Service, “Regardless of whether or not the invocation of a Muslim symbol by the memorial designer was intentional or not, it seems that such a symbol is unsuitable for paying appropriate tribute to the heroes of Flight 93 or the ensuing American struggle against radical Islam that their last historic act and the ‘Let’s Roll’ effort have come to symbolize.” ★

Israeli Flag Found Burned

Cornerstone Baptist Church in Fort Worth, Texas, lowered all three flags in front of the church building to half-staff in honor of Lady Bird Johnson.

The following Tuesday morning, the Texas and U.S. flags flew as they usually do. But on the far right hung the tattered remains of an Israeli flag. At the base of the flagpole was an overturned trashcan where someone had stood to reach the lowered flag. The Star of David in the center of the Israeli flag had been burned away.

The incident will be investigated as criminal mischief, not a hate crime,

because the Israeli flag is not a religious symbol, said Lt. Dean Sullivan, a police spokesman. Police have no suspects, he said.

The Rev. Bobby Herrel, the church’s pastor, said Cornerstone Baptist began flying the flag in July

2006 to show solidarity with the Israeli people during the conflict with Lebanon. Since then he has received emails thanking the congregation for the gesture, he said. About a month after the flag went up, the church was visited by the director of public affairs at the Israeli Consulate in Los Angeles.

Flying the Israeli flag is both a political and religious statement, Herrel said. “Apparently there are some very anti-Semitic attitudes here in Fort Worth.”

Note: ZLM’s office manager sent two free flags to Cornerstone Baptist—one to replace the burned one plus a spare for backup. And we will continue to replace however many flags they need. We have distributed thousands of Israeli flags over the years, and presently offer them on page 32. —Mark ★

The Lowdown on Stockbrokers

Dear Mark:

Please don't lump all stockbrokers into one pot. My husband has been a stockbroker for 25 years and in the years since we were both born again in 1984 and married in 1985, he has not taken advantage of one single customer. One of my greatest blessings has been to hear him say that he could have had a great commission, but he didn't do any business because it would not have benefited his clients. We both believe and try to live according to Proverbs 22:1 "A good name is to be chosen rather than great riches..." Honest, God-fearing stockbrokers do exist. We, too, agree that being debt free is a biblical principle, and we are. God bless you and your ministry,

Dear M.S.—

Perhaps it was a mistake for my article (*Sidestepping Your "Friendly" Stockbroker*; August '07 *Levitt Letter*; www.levitt.com/newsletters/2007-08.pdf) to vilify stockbrokers rather than their industry, which fosters conflicts of interest that torpedo investors. That your husband has to choose between feeding his family and benefiting his clients is a colossal pitfall. The book *License to Steal* (Anonymous & Harper, 1999) reveals that brokerage firms recruit stockbrokers based on how much they earn for the firm—*not* for the client. More often than not, human nature becomes the culprit as brokerage firms weed out low-producing

brokers. **Warning: stockbrokers are salesmen, *not* neutral advisors.**

Financial expert Scott Burns (www.dallasnews.com) points out that even the most competent, best-intentioned stockbrokers are incapable, in the long run, of outperforming low-expense index funds. **Note:** the worst of stockbrokers are highly skilled at masquerading as "boy scouts"—the epitome of wolves in sheep's clothing.

Why do brokerage firms insist to exempt themselves from civil litigation—an avenue of recourse that suffices for grievances against doctors, lawyers, and tobacconists? (That's right, Dear Reader, every stock brokerage contract contains an NASD—National Association of Securities Dealers—Arbitration Clause.) Once a complaint is brought, both the brokerage and the investor have unlimited strikes in their selection of panelists to adjudicate the arbitration. Consequently, the brokerage can eliminate from the pool any panelists whose past judgments were unfavorable to brokerage firms. The panelists get paid for serving on panels and quickly figure out that if they want future work, they had better not come down too hard on brokerage firms. The downside of a brokerage getting caught mistreating its clients, I believe, is paltry enough that brokerages, on a theoretical level, owe it to their own shareholders to play hardball with customers.

To help you abide by Matt. 25:14-30 and Luke 19:12-27, please review my article, mentioned above, and consider Scott Burns's advice about investing in low-cost, broadly diversified mutual funds at Vanguard. ★



Albert Einstein inhabited a world wracked by social unrest and political intrigue.

Commenting on precarious social dynamics—or interpersonal physics—he said, “Great spirits have always found violent opposition from mediocrities. The latter cannot understand it when a man does not thoroughly submit to hereditary prejudices but honestly and courageously uses his intelligence.” He believed that intelligent, energetic, proactive people will always be opposed by reactive and mediocre sorts who forcefully resist upward mobility, preferring to rely on familiar base prejudices—as is the case today.

“Why do the nations rage?” asked the psalmist in Psalm 2, noting, “rulers take counsel together against the Lord and against His anointed.” The writer of Psalm 83 similarly observed, “They have taken crafty counsel against Your people... They have said: ‘Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation, that the name of Israel may be remembered no more.’” In these and other passages, biblical writers gave voice to the same reality that Einstein observed: *upward-moving righteous sorts will find themselves pressed by stagnant and downward-moving sorts.*

What Einstein described as a social dynamic, the Psalms construed as a religious dynamic—a spiritual battle. Because people bent on destroying

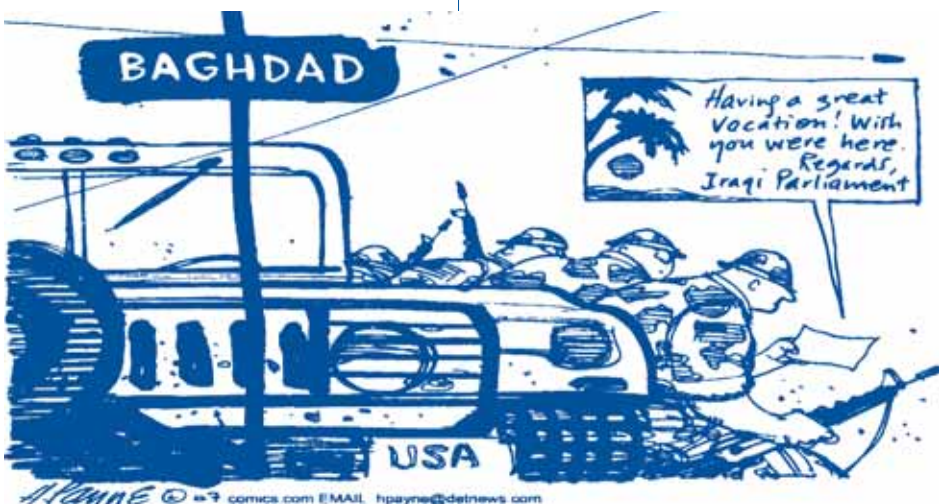


Jewish life and property were the issue for both Einstein and the Psalmists, I have to wonder if there is a spiritual component to this oft-repeated, age-old dynamic—one that presses individuals to rage against Hebrews—Germans in one case, Arabs in another.

I think there is. In both cases, people were/are jealous of Jews, who tend to be successful in life.

Why do Jews fare well? I believe that Scripture-based living produces a more successful outcome than is possible in either Koran-based living, as with the Arabs, or with a secular-based, political vision, as with the Nazis. Though not politically correct to say so, I believe that Bible-based living is superior to any other way of being. Scripture teaches us to love the people in the world, whereas other systems tend to rage against others. Scripture teaches readers to help the world, whereas the other systems encourage followers to help themselves to it, and to blame others for what they don't have and can't get.

Much as I cannot abide those who blame the Jews for the world's problems, neither am I kindly disposed toward those who categorically blame the Arabs. In fact, I believe that the act of blaming is best left to God and to children: God because He knows all the facts; children because they don't know any better. I'm not for blaming! For those who are neither God nor children, I think it best to be proactive and entrepreneurial, and engage the world with faith, optimism, virtue, value, and industry. Others will cry foul because we are successful, and will blame us because they aren't. We'll need to protect ourselves against them, of course—and pursue our vision without their permission.

Tension abounds around these very issues and this *Levitt Letter* gives voice to the aforementioned dynamics. Hope you enjoy and are better informed on how to pray.

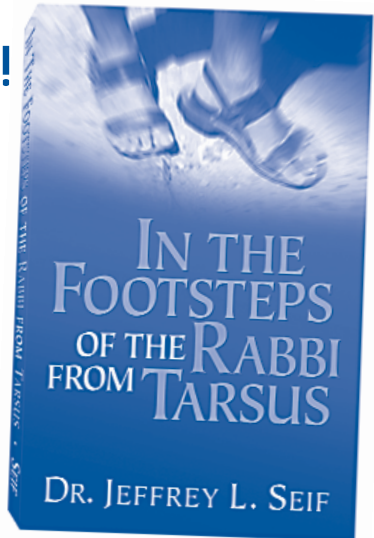

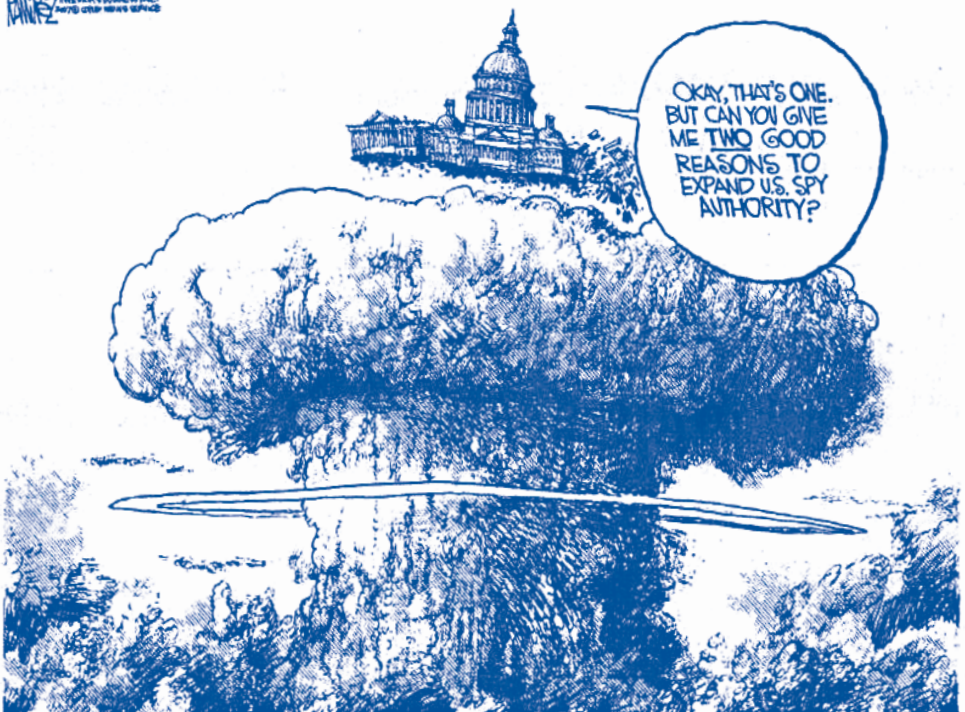

Reviving the Dead Sea

The Dead Sea is dying, receding some 2.5-3 feet each year. Dr. Clive Lipchin, research director at the Arava Institute for Environmental Studies in Israel's Southern Arava Valley, said, "Environmental issues cannot be contained within one nation, but require interaction between nations." Indeed, the Dead Sea and the water systems that supply it affect the nations of Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, and Syria, as well as the Palestinian Authority. However, fixing the problems may be easier said than done, especially when some of those governments aren't even on speaking terms.

Water is a precious commodity in the Middle East. According to Dr. Lipchin, every country in the region is facing a critical shortage with annual demand often exceeding supply. Due to rising populations, countries have begun extracting more water from the sources that supply the Dead Sea. Dr. Lipchin said that the unimpeded Jordan River should deliver 1,200 million cubic meters (mcm) of water per year to the Dead Sea. However, due to human intervention, only about 275 mcm/year actually make it there. People often fail to see, he said, "that nature is also a consumer of water"—as are agricul-

ture, industry, and domestic uses—and that water needs to be allocated to nature in order to maintain the delicate environmental balance in the area.

According to Dr. Lipchin, the Dead Sea is very deep and will never totally disappear, but something must be done to stop the sea from receding further. The World Bank is sponsoring a proposal to build **a canal that would carry water from the Red Sea to the Dead Sea**. However, filling the Dead Sea is only a side benefit of the project's real purposes: hydroelectric power and fresh drinking water. Water from the Red Sea would travel 155 miles before dropping to the lowest point on dry earth. The falling water would pass through turbines, producing hydroelectric power. The water would then move to a desalination plant that would produce an estimated 550 mcm/year of fresh drinking water.

The waste brine from the desalination process would be carried by a canal and dumped into the Dead Sea. This leftover water would contain a salt content denser than the Dead Sea as well as residual chemicals from the desalination process. Experts hope to begin soon a \$10-15 million feasibility study to determine if the estimated \$5-10 billion project will work, and also its effects on the ecosystems of both the Dead and Red Seas. Dr. Lipchin said that while the project could be funded and built within 10 years, it would only be able to maintain the level of the Dead Sea, which by that time could shrink another 30 feet. ★



Darkness In Gaza

When a syndicated column by Anthony Lewis, a consistently anti-Israel, pro-peace-process reporter, appeared in *The New York Times* (May 1996) exposing Arafat's oppressive PLO regime, Zola was surprised by Lewis's about-face and wrote an open letter to him, published in the June 1996 *Levitt Letter*.

Dear Mr. Lewis,

During our 1994 correspondence, you asked in your letter of July 12 how I "would deal with the two million or so Palestinians in the West Bank and Gaza." I answered you and pointed out that people who are fortunate enough to live in a democracy can cooperate and prosper along with that democracy. I gave the example of my father (and probably yours) who was not a co-religionist with the majority of Americans when he came here, but who assimilated to mutual benefit into this culture. To date, you have not answered that letter.

Mr. Lewis, the real issue is not religion or land, but democracy versus dictatorship. You have always taken the side of the Palestinian dictatorship, and now you are compelled (and honest enough) to report that "People are intimidated. There is an overwhelming sense of fear. The PLO regime is corrupt, dictatorial, oppressive." The Palestinian Dr. Eyad R. Sarraj, whom you quote, claims that "during the Israeli occu-

pation, I was 100 times freer." You detail Dr. Sarraj's reports of arbitrary arrests, systematic torture, and repression of human rights in Gaza.

Mr. Lewis, why are you surprised? I am one of probably thousands of people who warned you of this obvious development during the years of the "peace negotiations." Why didn't you listen? Now the chickens have come home to roost, and the best I can say for you is that you're at least willing to report the facts, contrary as they may be to your previous positions. "The mood in Gaza is not a healthy one... people feel alienated, depressed, hopeless." It's going to get worse as the PLO's dictatorial powers increase. The so-called peace process has done irreparable damage, dooming a much smaller Israel to absorbing constant terrorist attacks from sectors you favored giving to the PLO.

I still would answer your question of what I would do with the Palestinians the same way as I did two years ago, but with much less confidence in Israel's future. My answer then was, "with limited autonomy and not a giveaway of Jewish land." The giveaway, however, has been largely accomplished and now we can only draw a hard line in the sand and enter a period of prolonged conflict against a much stronger and better-located enemy than we had in the *intifada*. The future of Israel is in grave doubt, and thus so is the future of Jewish people everywhere. ★



Sunshine Soldiers and Fair Weather Friends

In Psalm 15:1, the biblical writer rhetorically asked: “Lord, who may abide in Your Tabernacle?” I am unaware of the Tabernacle having apartments for the general population, and am forced to conclude that the author is speaking metaphorically; thus his question is: “Lord who may enjoy your good graces, and the security and protection that go along with them?”

In v. 2, speaking the “truth” is lauded as a means of securing Divine favor, as is refusing to “backbite,” in v. 3, and refusing to wrong a neighbor. The writer then places a premium on “despising a vile person” in v. 4, and follows saying that an integrity-based person “who keeps his promises even when it hurts” has merit. The author’s summary is significant in v 5: “He who does these things shall never be moved.”

With America’s political energies invested in developing an “exit strategy” from Iraq, and with the State Department’s premium on pursuing relationships with Arabic states in the Middle East in anticipation of that withdrawal, one wonders if the aforementioned principles are being disregarded. I worry that they are.

Arms deals to Israel’s enemies and diplomatic maneuvering that seems to push Israel to give more concessions to those enemies make me wonder if

America’s policies are leading us to hop into bed with the vile. I read the political process as pressing America to betray and backbite its only real neighbor and friend in the region—Israel.

I’m all for dialogue; however, I would be more open to it were the talking partners to abandon their anti-Israel invective and, by their words and actions, formally accept Israel’s right to exist, opposing those hell-bent on Israel’s destruction. Absent that, one wonders what is to be gained in the long run, save some false hope that our brand new “friends” will raise arms against their long-standing brothers in support of America and Israel. I think this is fantasy.

Scripture teaches us to choose our friends carefully and to deal with associates prudently. Scripture teaches us to keep the wicked at an arm’s length, and not to be eager to sell them arms and extend our arms to them, all the while betraying our true friends. We do well to keep this in mind, and not embrace false hopes and fantasy as a means to overcome the day’s challenges. ★

The quality isn’t striking. Even so, the inside look of the “religion of peace” is revealing for those who might wonder what imams and Muslim fanatics say behind closed doors.

“To The Jew First” Mission Trip to Israel: Summer – 2007

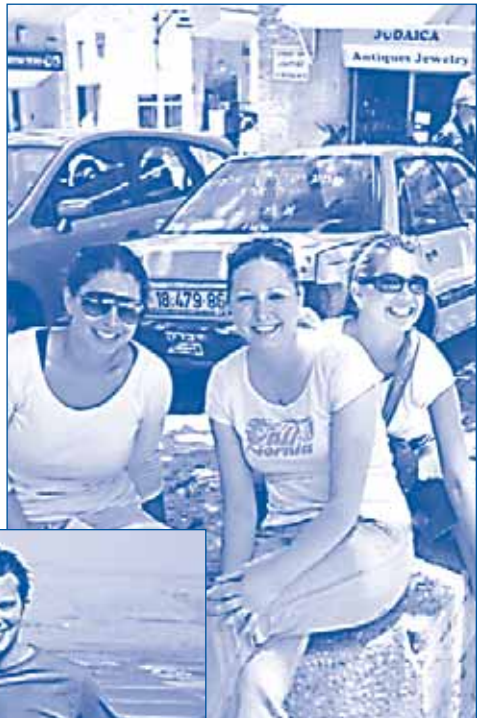

Headline News: Jewish Cardinal Laid to Rest

The *kaddish* (Jewish prayer for the dead) mixed with rites of the Roman Catholic Church, as Jews and Christians alike bade farewell to Cardinal

Jean-Marie Lustiger (at left), the former archbishop of Paris, who was born Jewish. Lustiger, 80, was buried at the majestic Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris.

Born Aaron Lustiger in 1926 in Paris to Polish immigrant parents who ran a hosiery shop, he was sent to the town of Orleans, 80 miles south of the capital, to take refuge from the occupying Nazis. There, Lustiger converted to Catholicism in 1940, taking the name Jean-Marie. Two years later, his mother was deported to Auschwitz where she was killed. Though a Catholic, Lustiger never lost sight of



his Jewish roots. At his request, a marble plaque inside the cathedral will bear the inscription: "I was born a Jew. I

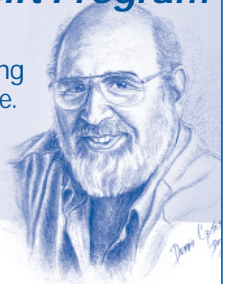
received the name of my paternal grandfather Aaron. Christian by faith and by baptism, I remained a Jew, as did the Apostles."

Some time prior to Cardinal Lustiger's death, a contingent of Messianic Jews visited him in France. Though sick at the time, he received the brethren gladly, thrilled to learn of other Jews who believed in Jesus. I cannot reconcile a variety of Roman Catholic teaching with my biblical understandings. In last month's *Levitt Letter*, Dr. Tom McCall did a masterful job of succinctly delineating some of those differences. Nevertheless, differences notwithstanding, it is a blessing that Cardinal Lustiger reminded others of the Christian faith's Jewish roots. — Jeff Seif

Christians Crucified by Terrorists in Iraq

Dutch lawmaker Joel Voordewind



Christians in Iraq, including converts from Islam and people involved in mixed-faith marriages, are being crucified by Muslim terrorists, according to a Dutch member of parliament studying the war-torn country.

Several Iraqi Christians “are nailed to a cross and their arms are tied up with ropes. The ropes are put on fire,” Joel Voordewind told *BosNewsLife*, an on-line news agency focusing on Christians and Jews in difficult circumstances.

According to the site, Voordewind described how a person who “survived” a crucifixion “even showed holes in his hands,” apparently from nails.

Voordewind said victims of the crucifixions are “in most cases Christian converts who abandoned Islam, or people who are involved in mixed-religion marriages.”

He did not specify how many Christians have been crucified in recent weeks and

months, as an official report is expected soon. Voordewind is slated to present his findings to the Dutch Minister of Foreign Affairs.



The report comes as thousands of Christians are said to be fleeing Iraq due to ongoing threats and violence against them. In August, over 80 people were killed in bomb blasts in the northern Iraqi city of Kirkuk. Most of the casualties resulted from a suicide truck bomb that detonated near the offices of the Kurdish political party led by Iraq’s President Jalal Talabani.

BosNewsLife says Voordewind was part of a Dutch delegation visiting several countries in the Middle East, including Syria, where several lawmakers held talks with the terrorist group Hamas. ★

Christian Zionists: Ahmadinejad is New Hitler

Thousands of members of Christians United for Israel headed to lobby Congress on behalf of the Jewish state. The group's founder, the **Reverend John Hagee**, declared, "We support Israel because we are Bible-believing Christians," and the world needs to see that "the sleeping giant of Christian Zionism has awakened." The entire Christian world kept quiet during World War II and allowed the genocide of the Jewish people, he said. "This time we will not be silent."

At "A Night to Honor Israel" banquet, Hagee called on President Bush to move the U.S. embassy in Israel from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem. He also called for American divestment from Iran, which he compared to Nazi Germany as a threat to the Jewish people.

Hagee said Middle East tensions shouldn't be blamed on Israel, but on Islamic radicals and moderate Muslims who won't condemn them. He continued to warn against Iranian President Ahmadinejad, calling him the new Hitler and saying the Iranian president will use a nuclear bomb to destroy Israel the first chance he gets.

"Ahmadinejad must be stopped," Hagee said, calling on the United States to attack Iran immediately.

Gary Bauer also spoke at the rally saying, "You are Ahmadinejad's, Hamas's, and Hezbollah's worst nightmare because you support Israel. They are telling you to give back the Land. We are telling you, don't give back one inch."

Israeli Ambassador to the U.S., Salai Meridor, told the protesters, "We must end the madness. We must make it clear to the Iranians that all our options are on the table and there is no way they will be allowed to hold nuclear weapons."

Israeli Economy Robust

Deutsche Bank says, "We continue to view Israel as one of the most robust economies in Europe, Middle East, and Africa region (EMEA). The growth picture is solid, the debt burden has declined, and the currency is competitive."

The bank adds, "The external picture is particularly solid with Israel the only non-oil EMEA country projected to record a current account surplus in 2007; the trade deficit has actually narrowed in spite of the deteriorating terms of trade position. Even stripping out the "large transfers" balance, which mostly comprises receipts from the U.S., the current account remains in surplus."

Deter Attack: Threaten to Bomb Mecca

Colorado Rep. Tom Tancredo asserted that bombing holy Muslim sites would serve as a good "deterrent" to prevent Islamic fundamentalists from attacking the United States. He warned that another terrorist attack would "cause a worldwide economic collapse."

"If it were up to me, I'd explain that an attack of that nature on this homeland would be followed by an attack on the holy sites in Mecca and Medina," Tancredo said. "That is the only thing I can think of that might deter somebody from doing what they would otherwise do. If I am wrong, fine, tell me, and I would be happy to do something else. But you had better find a deterrent or you will find an attack."

A deputy spokesman for the State Department told CNN that the congressman's comments were "reprehensible" and "absolutely crazy." Tancredo was widely criticized in 2005 for making a similar suggestion.

It is radical, I concede. If you can think of other deterrents against terrorism please write to us. It might be good to collect a list of possible responses. Being "soft" doesn't seem to be working.

This reminds me of a legend about General John "Black Jack" Pershing who, in the Philippines, supposedly stemmed Islamic terrorist attacks by executing terrorists with bullets dipped in the blood and fat of pigs. The idea was that they would not be able to enter Heaven even though they died as martyrs. —Mark

Saudis Ban Tourists' Bibles, Crosses

Despite a series of initiatives aimed at generating foreign tourism, the Saudi Arabian government continues to bar Jews and Christians from bringing items such as Bibles, crucifixes and Stars of David into the country and is threatening to confiscate them on sight.

"A number of items are not allowed to be brought into the kingdom due to reli-

gious reasons and local regulations," declares the website of Saudi Arabian Airlines, the country's national carrier.

After informing would-be visitors that items such as narcotics, firearms, and pornography may not be transported into the country, the website adds: "Items and articles belonging to religions other than Islam are also prohibited. These may include Bibles, crucifixes, statues, carvings, items with religious symbols such as the Star of David, and others."

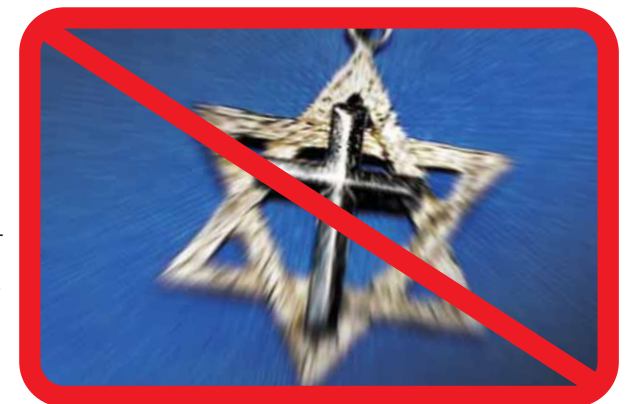
Contacted by the *Post*, an employee of Saudi Arabian Airlines in New York, who would only give her name as Gladys, confirmed this rule was in force. "Yes, sir," she said, "that is what we have heard, that it is a problem to bring these things into Saudi Arabia, so you cannot do it."

An official at the Saudi Consulate in New York, who declined to give her name, told the *Post* that anyone bringing a Bible into the country or wearing a crucifix or Star of David around their neck would run into trouble with Saudi authorities.

"You are not allowed to bring that stuff into the kingdom," the consular official said. "If you do, they will take it away," she warned, adding, "If it is really important to you, then you can try to bring it and just see what happens, but I don't recommend that you do so."

Asked to explain the policy, the official said, "Every country has rules about what can or cannot enter."

This past summer, the Saudi government-run Supreme Commission for Tourism announced a number of steps, such as issuing group visas to foreigners through tour operators and granting longer entry visas, in the hopes of boosting the number of foreign tourists to 1.5 million annually by 2020.



Israeli Power Plant Produces Electricity from Manure

A new power plant in the Hefer Valley has begun to produce electricity from manure and other organic waste. The plant will generate 2 to 2.4 megawatts/hour by the end of the year.

The Tambour Hefer Ecology Plant is located near Hadera. The Hefer Valley Cooperative Society is accomplishing two goals through the plant: reducing pollutants generated by the communities' 12,000 dairy cows, and using 600 tons of manure generated daily to produce electricity. ★

In Modern Hebrew the word *todah* means “thanks,” though in Biblical Hebrew the root (*yada'*) means to “praise” or even “confess.” The phrase *hodu la'Adonai* might better be translated as “give praise to the Lord,” or “acknowledge the Lord,” or even “confess to the Lord.” The acknowledgement of God’s goodness is the fitting response to the truth about who God is and what He has done. We are instinctively grateful when we understand that our life is a gift given to us by the love of God.

Note that the psalmist praises God because “his mercy endures forever.” The word *chesed* means loyal devotion, faithful love, and steadfast passion. Ruth was praised for her *chesed* when she loyally remained by her mother-in-law Naomi’s side, despite the hard circumstances of her life. God’s goodness is like that to us as well. He never leaves nor forsakes us, despite the difficulties we often face.

Of the thirteen attributes of the Lord listed in Torah, two are joined together. God is said to be *rav chesed ve-emet*, “abounding in faithful love and truth” (Ex. 34:6). Faith confesses that God’s steadfast passion is eternally present for us—despite the circumstances of our present condition. And that’s another reason to say, *hodu la'Adonai ki tov!*

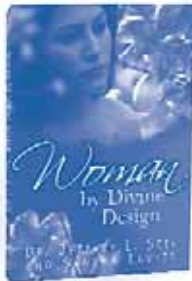


Dear G.J.H.—

Could you tone it down? You're making us look naïve." I can see why you would take issue with this.

Even the sophisticated can be deceived, particularly when placated with rosy

dialogue. This process of conquering first through negotiation and then with warfare is precisely the Palestinians' plan against Israel—and against you and me in the States. I do think you are ill-informed if you think that encounter groups will suffice as a response to this process. As for whether being a pacifist makes one more Christ-like, Jeff weighs in on this in his new book, *Guns & Moses* (offered on page 31). I'd be interested in your study group's response to his book. —Mark

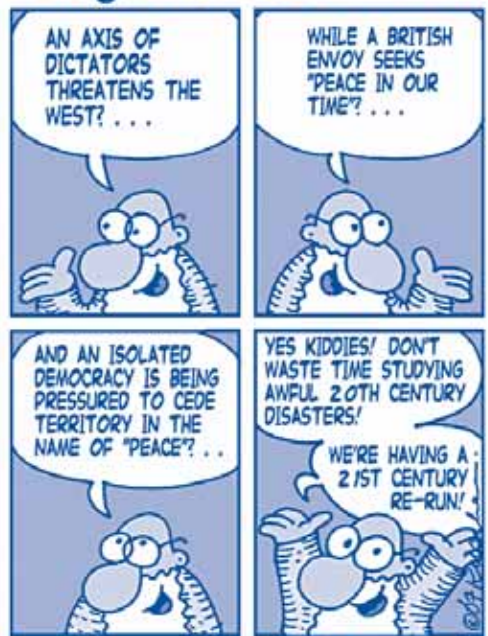
D.&H. —Lovers of Jews and Little Old Men

Why Did Mega-Church Invite Jimmy Carter?

The head of a pro-Israel ministry is baffled as to why a mega-church would invite former President Jimmy Carter to address its recent leadership conference. The former president was among those invited to speak at the 2007 Leadership Summit hosted by Willow Creek Community Church in South Barrington, Illinois, which is pastored by Bill Hybels. Other speakers included former Secretary of State Colin Powell, author John Ortberg, and British management guru Marcus Buckingham. The conference saw 80,000 in attendance and was beamed into 176 sites via audiovisual technology.

The church website informed viewers that Carter is recognized worldwide for his leading work in conflict resolution, diplomacy, and humanitarian work. But Jan Markell of Olive Tree Ministries takes issue with that assessment, noting that Carter has roamed the world delivering negative messages about America.

“He stands up for dictators. He has not been pro-American in his diplomacy. He failed the Shah of Iran in 1979, which allowed Ayatollah Khomeini in, which resulted in our war on terror,” she says. Markell says even some of his former staff members believe Carter is anti-Semitic. “That is why 20 staff associates on the Carter Center staff resigned,” she asserts. “They felt that [Carter’s] book *Palestine—Peace Not Apartheid* was filled with, they said, ‘lies and fiction.’ And many of

them felt that Carter is just plain anti-Semitic,” she adds. She cannot help but question the judgment of Hybels and Willow Creek for inviting someone like Carter to address the leadership conference.

“Here we have a supposedly evangelical church, that being Willow Creek, bringing in somebody who really does not like the Jews,” Markell remarks. “Well, I’m sorry, [but] Jesus was a Jew. Our Bible—from Genesis 12 through Revelation—is all about the Jews. And yet this man is one of the featured speakers at the leadership forum.” The ministry leader says the decision to feature Carter as a speaker makes no sense to her.

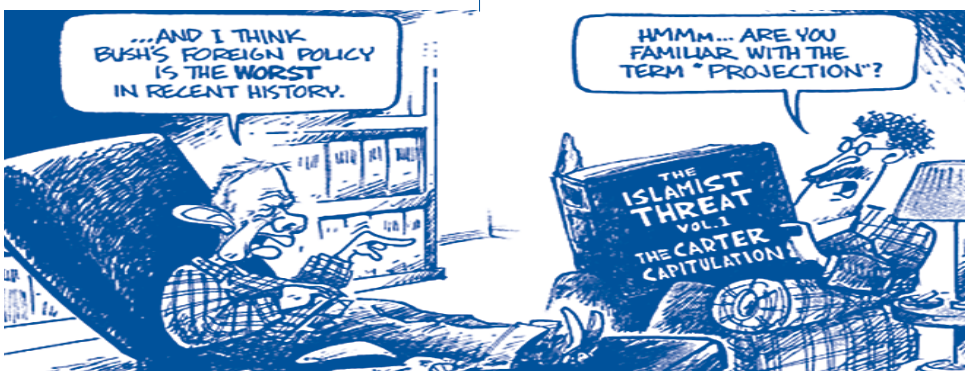
IKEA Maps Show Golan as Syrian

Israel to Give Up Temple Mount?

Palestinian negotiators drafting an agreement behind the scenes with Prime Minister Ehud Olmert's office have made clear they will not accept any final peace deal with Israel unless the Jewish state forfeits the Temple Mount, Judaism's holiest site. According to an Israeli newspaper, Olmert is willing to discuss joint Israeli-Palestinian control over the Temple Mount complex.

A chief Palestinian negotiator said, "There can be no agreement with Israel unless we get complete sovereignty of the Mount. Once Palestinian control over the [Temple Mount] is fixed, then we will make assurances for Jewish visits to the site."

Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas' Fatah organization has been hammering out a final agreement for presentation in November at a U.S.-backed international summit regarding the Middle East.

Issues already discussed between Israel and the Palestinians reportedly include the division of parts of Jerusalem and debates regarding permanent borders between Israel and the PA. Many in Jerusalem speculate that the U.S. will push for intense Israeli-Palestinian negotiations leading to a Palestinian state.

With a year-and-a-half left in office, President George Bush and Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice have been urging meetings between Abbas and Olmert to establish a framework for momentum leading to a breakthrough at November's conference. Olmert and Abbas have been meeting bi-monthly in summits brokered by the U.S.

Asked whether Olmert is willing to forfeit the Temple Mount in an agreement with the Palestinians, a spokesman for the prime minister had no comment. The Temple Mount is the holiest site in Judaism. Muslims say it is their third holiest site.

The talk of behind-the-scenes negotiations follows a report stating Israeli President Shimon Peres has quietly drafted a plan for the Jewish state to evacuate and transfer to the Palestinians nearly the entire West Bank and several Arab Israeli cities located within territory that is undisputedly Israel's according to the international community.

The West Bank is strategic territory that runs alongside Jerusalem and is within rocket range of Tel Aviv and Israel's international airport. It is home to many biblical Jewish communities and some of Judaism's holiest sites.

It is worth noting that Israel already has given up to Islam control of the Temple Mount. Years ago, Israel ceded to the Muslims the practice of administering affairs at the site. These affairs have included maintaining pilgrim rights

of Muslims, true. They have also included destroying archaeological remains underneath, which attest to the pre-Islamic, Israelite presence there, and of using the Holy Site to start the riot that marked the beginning of the “Second *Intifada*.” It now appears that a desperate Israeli Prime Minister is offering to give officially to Islam what was already given to them in practice, with the anxious hope that he can get from them what they will never ever give in return: peace and the acceptance of Jews in a state that bears our biblical name —Israel.

How many times does the Koran mention Jerusalem? Zero. How many times does authoritative, Islamic literature mention war, conquest, subjugation of people, and reduction of their status to slaves and the like? Got a calculator?

Cease-Fire Saved Hezbollah From Defeat

A Hezbollah officer interviewed by Israel's Channel 10 TV said that the terror group was saved by the Olmert government's decision to call a cease-fire. “The cease-fire [at the end of the Second Lebanon War] acted as a life jacket for the organization,” the terrorist said. He explained that the group would have surrendered if the battles had continued for another 10 days.

He described the condition of Hezbollah's equipment and morale at the end of the fighting, saying they were running low on food, water, and arms. Muslim Brotherhood Project

The Project: a program of cultural invasion and eventual conquest of the West that virtually mirrors the tactics used by Islamists for more than two decades.

A document detailing The Project was recovered in a raid by Swiss authorities in November 2001, two months after the horror of 9/11. Limited since then to the top-secret world of Western intelligence communities, information regarding The Project is finally being made public in a book by a Swiss journalist, Sylvain Besson of *Le Temps*. One Western official described The Project as “a totalitarian ideology of infiltration which represents the greatest danger for European societies.”

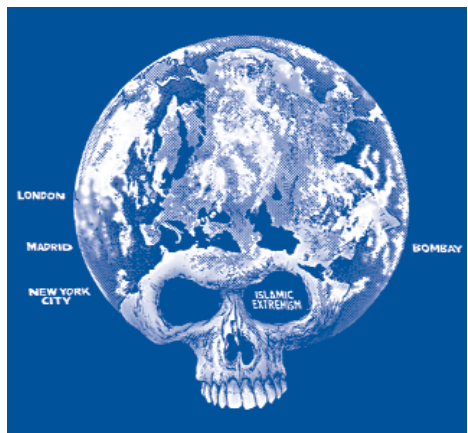
The 2001 raid of a villa in Switzerland targeted Youssef Nada, director of the Al-Taqwa Bank of Lugano, who had an active association with the Muslim Brotherhood for more than 50 years and who admitted to being one of the organization’s international leaders. The Muslim Brotherhood, regarded as the oldest and perhaps the most important Islamist movement in the world, was founded in 1928 and is dedicated to the credo, “Allah is our objective. The Prophet is our leader. Koran is our law. Jihad is our way. Dying in the way of Allah is our highest hope.”

U.S. and Swiss investigators had been looking at Al-Taqwa’s money laundering for a wide range of Islamic terrorist groups, including al-Qaeda, Hamas (the Palestinian affiliate of Muslim Brotherhood), the Algerian GIA, and the Tunisian Ennahdah.

Seized during the raid of Nada’s villa was a 14-page plan written in Arabic and dated December 1, 1982, which outlines a 12-point strategy to “establish an Islamic government on earth” — identified as The Project. According

to Nada, the unsigned document was prepared by “Islamic researchers” associated with the Muslim Brotherhood.

What makes The Project so different from the standard “Death to America! Death to Israel!” Islamist rhetoric is its flexible, multi-phased, long-term approach to establishing Islamic domination over the West. Calling for various tactics—including immigration, infiltration, surveillance, propaganda, protest, deception, political legitimacy, and terrorism—The Project has served for more than two decades as the “master plan.” A number of examples throughout Europe—the political recognition of parallel Islamist government organizations in Sweden, the “cartoon” *jihad* in Denmark, the Parisian car-burning *intifada*, and the 7/7 terrorist attacks in London—indicate that the plan has been overwhelmingly successful.



The following tactics and techniques are a few of the many laid out in The Project:

1. Adopting the total liberation of Palestine from Israel and the creation of an Islamic state as a keystone in the plan for global Islamic domination;
2. Using deception to mask the intended goals of Islamist actions;
3. Cultivating an Islamist intellectual community (think-tanks and publishing “academic” studies) to legitimize Islamist positions;
4. Avoiding open alliances with known terrorists to maintain the appearance of “moderation;”
5. Inciting hatred by Muslims against Jews and rejecting any discussions of conciliation or coexistence with them;
6. Inflaming violence and keeping Muslims living in the West “in a *jihad* frame of mind.” ★

Israeli Oral Insulin Trials

Insulin, a hormone that helps control glucose levels in the body, is a protein that breaks down in the digestive system, making absorption of insulin into the blood circulation weak, and the idea of oral insulin treatment problematic.

Dr. Miriam Kidron, a scientist from Hadassah University Hospital in Jerusalem, has spent 25 years of research and a great deal of pure determination due to poor funding in an effort to bring an oral insulin for diabetics to market.

Diabetes is a condition in which the body cannot effectively control the level of glucose in the blood. It can lead to serious complications such as heart disease, strokes, amputations, eye and kidney damage, and premature death. It is a modern epidemic and requires constant and often unpleasant monitoring and drug therapy.

In the U.S. alone, 20.8 million people (seven percent of the population) are known to suffer from diabetes, and the number is growing dramatically as obesity—one of the causes of the disease—rises.

Kidron's son, Nadav—a lawyer by training—founded Oramed Pharmaceuticals after his mother came to him two years ago and told him that she and her fellow researchers from the Diabetes Unit of Hadassah had

made a breakthrough in their research. The company is now in the midst of phase I clinical trials at Hadassah for what promises to be the world's first oral insulin treatment for Type 2 diabetics.

The capsule has been specially engineered to protect the insulin from the destructive effects of gastric juices. The insulin it delivers goes straight to the liver, which stores insulin and controls the dose being delivered to the body, and from there is sent out into the bloodstream.

"The advantage of this," said Kidron, "is that the route of the insulin from our

capsule imitates the real route taken by the body. When you inject insulin it goes straight to the bloodstream and the liver has no control over it. Hence you become insulin dependent.

In our case, the liver only releases the amount of insulin that the

body needs. Our insulin complements the insulin that the body is already able to produce so that a patient never becomes insulin dependent. It mimics the physiological delivery of insulin. It's a real revolution."

If the capsule works it could possibly benefit tens of millions of people worldwide.

Fatah Legislator Sent Suicide Bomber

A Fatah member of the Palestinian Legislative Council was convicted of having been an accomplice in a suicide bombing in Tel Aviv five years ago in which an Israeli woman was killed.

According to the indictment, the suicide bomber who blew himself up in a coffee shop in the city in March 2002 made his way to Israel from the Nablus home of PLC member Jamal Tirawi, who received U.S. weapons and coordinated security with U.S. intelligence agencies.

Tirawi was convicted of the deliberate murder of Rachel Tcherkhi, an Israeli woman who died in the attack. The Fatah member is also accused of recruiting potential suicide bombers. He was arrested in May 2007 in Nablus's Balate refugee camp along with three members of Fatah's military wing, the al-Aqsa Martyrs' Brigade. ★
