Christian Arabs Are Vanishing



Christian Arabs, including Christian Palestinians, are vanishing. Although

all Palestinians believe that their enemy is Israel, they are like victims of Stockholm Syndrome, who identify with their tormentors.

In Iraq, where Christians—and formerly Jews—have lived for millennia, they are being driven out. The Jews, 750,000 of them, were expelled from the Arab world, and some lynched, in 1954. Now it is Christian Arabs—including Palestinians—who are being hunted down and either killed or driven out. Assyrian Christians in Iraq are being given four choices: change their religion, leave the country, pay the *jeziya* (tax levied on non-Muslims), or line up and be shot.

Thankful for Our "Judeo-Christian" Values

Judeo-Christian values in America have a basis in the Declaration of Independence:

"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness..."

Our Founding Fathers separated church from state, but they wisely did not separate God from state; they acknowledged God as the source of our rights, and, in fact, they were careful to place biblical morality directly into our founding documents and laws, and into our values and culture precisely to help prevent a future of totalitarian or tyrannical rule in America.

In Judeo-Christian America one finds the idea of equality before God and the law, but not government-forced economic equality. Modern European culture has stressed the value of economic equality rather than liberty, and its governments unjustly enforce the

Muslim. Jerusalem, where only 12,000 Christians remain, is facing the possibility that there will be no Christians "in the homeland of Jesus Christ himself" according to the Greek Orthodox archbishop in Jerusalem. In Bethlehem, Christians were once 85 percent, down now to 20 percent. In Egypt, Christians were once 10 percent of the population; now

they are 6 percent.

The situation in Iraq is particularly painful. Before the 2003 war, there were Assyrian and Chaldean Christians, some Armenians and Palestinians who were finding work there. They made up 1.2 million of the country's 25 million people. Now half of them have fled Iraq, and most of the rest have fled to Kurdistan or elsewhere in the country. The Roman Catholic relief organization claims that there are only 25,000 Christians left in Iraq, and over half of the 1.7 million Iraqi refugees in Jordan and Syria are Christian

What is sad about this is that, in a way, the Christians, particularly the Palestinian Christians, have brought



this on themselves. They have made common cause with their Muslim neighbors —and persecutors— and never acknowledged their persecution until European colonization unmasked the problem. Under European colonization and mandates, for the first time since the Muslim conquest, minorities were given status under the law that was not accorded them under *sharia* law. The very country of Lebanon was carved out specifically to give persecuted Christians a place of their own in the otherwise hostile Middle East.

Despite what should be obvious to Christian Arabs, that their existence in the Muslim world has always been either tenuous or downright dangerous, they still identify with their tormentors and condemn the usual Middle East demons—Israel and the U.S.

THANKFUL—continued ...principle. This has led to failed European inventions such as socialism and communism. European cultures have frequently been tied to authoritarian and totalitarian systems dating back to the Roman Empire. Even European Christianity was, for a time, contaminated by its links to authoritarian rule. American Judeo-Christian culture, on the other hand, has been linked to honoring life, liberty, and creativity from the outset; deriving its wisdom from the lights of reason, common sense, and both the Hebrew Bible and New Testament Christian Bible.

This does not represent some form of tyranny of the religious majority or an injustice; it was in fact the wisdom of our Founding Fathers to stand in opposition to tyranny and injustice by acknowledging the source of our rights—those rights originating from God rather than from King George III, or for that matter from the Soviet or Chinese Politburo, or a courthouse, or a legislature. It should be evident that if our sacred human rights are derived from government, they can also be removed by government.

America is a melting pot of diverse people including Christians, Jews, Muslims, Buddhists, and atheists; and from the Judeo-Christian perspective, all made in God's image. We have in America a multiethnic society, and that is good. What is unhealthy for America is for it to become Balkanized—divided into small, quarrelsome states—which is very likely to happen with the atrophy of Judeo-Christian American culture and values.

Worse yet would be for America to adopt the toxic values that exist in some parts of the world and which are endemic in some foreign cultures. Our Judeo-Christian values have been with us from the beginning and they have made us strong and successful. They should be kept central to the American spirit and culture even as we become more multiethnic. Honoring foreign cultures is desirable, but we should never tolerate the values of violence, coercion, totalitarianism, supremicism, bigotry, or intolerance; values which are sadly endemic in some foreign cultures. We must recognize that our culture, too, is worth preserving.

"...Submit Or Die!"

An open letter issued by a group of 138 Muslim scholars, clerics, and academics issued an "invitation" to the



Vatican, the archbishop of Canterbury, and other Christian leaders to "make peace" with Islam.

Gushed *Newsweek*, "It argues that the most fundamental tenets of Islam and Christianity are identical: love of one (and the same) God, and love of one's neighbor."

The mainstream media embraced the letter as vindication of their long-held



The First Muslim Conquest of the Holy Land

With the New Age mantra "All we are saying is give peace a chance" vigorously imposing itself upon the world's collective consciousness, modern Israelis are being pressed to give up another "piece" of Israel on a chance of securing world "peace." Let's pause and reflect upon whether there really will be "peace on Earth" in exchange for a "piece" of Jewish earth, or whether the implied promise is a worthless delusion.

To come to terms with this modern question, I'd like to consider what happened when ancient Christians and Jews first lost Israel to the Muslims — many, many years ago...

After Mohammed's death in 632 A.D., his commanders gathered neighboring Arab tribesmen from Hijaz, Najd, and Yemen who were commissioned for the *jihad*—the "Holy War." In 634 A.D. followers of "the prophet" attacked Gaza in the interest of securing some profit—in the name of the prophet.

Marauding bands of Islamic brigands easily overran the countryside because, in response, Jewish and Christian town dwellers in Jerusalem, Jaffa, Nablus, Beth Shean, and elsewhere simply closed the doors of their cities and retreated into "lockdown mode" behind their walls. All was lost, and it was only a question of time until famine claimed them before the Islamic sword most certainly would.

They didn't have a plan and they lost their vision of God's plan.

Prior to the Islamic invasion, the Byzantines doled out bribes and negotiated treaties with the Muslims at their borders, keeping the Islamic hordes at bay. One Christian governor, named Farwa, is said to have converted to Islam, perhaps to placate them. Attempts at appeasement notwithstanding, and seeing an opportunity to fulfill Mohammed's (not to mention their own) interest in domination, the Muslims were eventually able to exploit the Christians' lack of a coherent strategy for defense, which precipitated some of the most savage early clashes between Byzantines and Muslims.

In 634, Sophronius—the Christian patriarch of Jerusalem—lamented that people in the towns were "chained and nailed for fear." The previous contract between the Muslims and the Byzantine Jews and Christians purchased nothing save some false security. Ultimately, many, many thousands of Jews and Christians were mercilessly slaughtered.

No doubt, many of the living counted the dead to be more fortunate. Jewish and Christian survivors were sold into slavery. Captured women were passed around as pleasure-objects for the Muslim hordes who used and abused them. Women were even raped in the presence of their own husbands—to humiliate them both, and attest to the Islamic triumph!

City life declined considerably in the Holy Land as the number of cities declined from fifty-eight to seventeen. Farmland mismanagement precipitated soil erosion, which contributed to the abandonment of farming enterprises. Incessant intertribal warfare between the various Arab-Muslim "brothers" was a problem as well. The Arabs were eventually bested by their own ineptness, and social forces of their own making pressed them backward to their wandering, nomadic existence. They conquered Israel by the sword, only to relinquish much of their gain due to their inability to manage themselves or others.

A civilized world retreated into barbarism.

Referring to the Muslim destruction of holy places, historian Moshe Gil describes the desecration and destruction of the Church of the Holy Sepulchre (first in 614, then again in 1009) as follows: "They dismantled the Church of the Resurrection to its very foundation... they destroyed Golgotha... as well as all the sacred gravestones.

They even tried to dig up all the graves and wipe out all traces of their existence ... The authorities took all the other property belonging to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre and its pious foundations. Thousands of churches... were destroyed."

The Byzantines opted for a treaty with the Muslims that proved completely ineffectual, did it not? The border arrangements whereby Arabs would live in the outer lands, separated from the Jews and Christians, seemed to be only a convenient mechanism by which the Muslims were able to purchase time to effect their own grand scheme—the complete conquest of Israel. When we consider both the nature of the Islamic movement and the movement's history in the Holy Land, we recognize that the notion of carving up Israel piece by piece and giving it to the Muslims to secure a peace belongs to the realm of fanciful imagination. Assuring ourselves that progress in the region will be made on the heels of worthless treaties seems to be an exercise in self-deceit—not to mention a disayowal of biblical vision and virtue.

When we give away our future for a parcel of false security in the present, we not only sell our children down the river, but we give away part of our own humanity in the process. If we give "pieces" for "peace," we'll only have to pick up the "pieces" again later. This is a lesson from yesterday. We need to learn it today.

Silence In Syria, Panic In Iran

When one of India's top-ranking generals assigned to liaise with the Iranian military returned to New Delhi after several days in Tehran—he was amazed.

"Everyone in the government and military can only talk of one thing," he reported. "No matter whom I talked to, all they could do was ask me, 'Do you think the Americans will attack us?' 'When will the Americans attack us?' The Iranians are in a state of total panic."

The mullahs were freaking out in fear. Why? Because of the silence in Syria.

Back in September, Israeli Air Force F-15s and F-16s conducted a devastating attack on targets deep inside Syria near the city of Dayr az-Zawr. Israel's military was silent about the identity of the targets. Speculation in the world press followed. Why would the Syrian government be so tightlipped about an act of war perpetrated on their soil?

Syria has been spending vast sums on Russian anti-aircraft systems, considered the cutting edge in aircraft interception technology. Syria now possesses more than 200 anti-aircraft batteries of different types, some so new that they have been installed in Syria before being introduced into Russian operation service. An F15/16 attack on Dayr az-Zawr is not a tip-

penetration of Syrian airspace. And guess what happened with the Russian super-hyper-sophisticated cutting edge anti-aircraft missile batteries when that penetration took place on September 6th. Nothing. The systems gave no indication of aircraft invading Syrian airspace. The Israelis and U.S. blinded the Russian anti-aircraft systems so completely the Syrians didn't even know they were blind-



ed. Now you see why the Syrians were scared speechless. They thought they were protected—at enormous expense—only to discover they are defenseless.

Thus the Great Iranian Freak-Out—for this means that Iran is just as defenseless as Syria. A lot of folks in the Israel Defense Forces headquarters in Tel Aviv and the Pentagon are enjoying the mullahs' predicament. Let's face it: scaring the terror masters in Tehran out of their wits is fun.

So, what was attacked near Dayr az-Zawr? It was a partially constructed nuclear reactor modeled on one used by North Korea to create its stockpile of nuclear weapons fuel. But the identity of the target is not the story—the primary point of the attack was not to destroy that target. It was to shut down Syria's Russian air defense system during the attack. Doing so made the attack an incredible success. Syria was shamed and silent. Iran is freaking out in panic.

Mosque or Church?

Along the road from Jerusalem to Bethlehem sit the remains of a very unique Byzantine church. The Byzantines ruled the Land of Israel from 324-640 AD and as Christians, changed the status of the backwater province of Judea into one of the most important places in their empire. They built extensively and Christian pilgrims came to see the many churches and monuments connected to the life of Christ, including the Kathisma Church.

Kathisma in Greek means "seat" and the church was built in the mid-fifth century AD to honor the place where Mary was said to have sat on a rock and rested on her way to Bethlehem before giving birth to Jesus. The rock was removed later to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem. What remains is the base of that rock, surrounded by the ruins of a large church. The Kathisma Church was constructed in an octagonal shape focused around the rock base, the center of the church measuring 141 x 170 feet. Four chapels with very impressive mosaic floors were built into the outer ring of the church surrounding its focal point, the rock base.

The Kathisma Church is one of the oldest churches built in dedication to Mary and is believed to have inspired the design of several other churches in the land, including the one surrounding Peter's house in Capernaum. It's also believed that the church inspired the design of one of Jerusalem's most

recognizable features today, the Dome of the Rock Mosque on the Temple Mount.

Built some 200 years after the Kathisma Church, the Dome of the Rock is an octagon-shaped building focused around a portion of exposed bedrock of Mount Moriah. Jews believe that this rock is the binding place of Isaac and the place from where the entire world was created; Muslims believe it is the place where the Prophet Mohammed ascended to paradise. The Dome of the Rock is the only octagonal mosque in existence, and its location is only a few kilometers from the Kathisma Church.

After the Muslims took control of the Land in 640 AD, they immediately set out to decrease the influence and importance of Christianity and replace it with Islamic presence and rule. There is evidence that a small portion of the Kathisma Church was converted into a mosque, indicating that Muslims were aware of the church, its design, and importance. Sometime after the completion of the Dome of the Rock Mosque in 691 AD, the Kathisma Church was destroyed and the tradition of the place where Mary sat was lost. However, one of Islam's most important mosques continues today atop the holiest place in Judaism, inspired by the design of a Byzantine Christian church.

Your information on stockbrokers is way off base—and promoting one investment company like Vanguard is dangerous. You should contact organizations like Kingdom Advisors www.kingdomadvisors.org to get a better understanding instead of issuing a blanket bashing of stockbrokers. M.E.

My information about stock brokerage firms stems from personal experience and years of reading and studying acclaimed financial experts like Christian financial counselor Larry Burkett (1939–2003), Scott Burns (www.dallasnews.com/business/scottburns), and Daniel Solin, author of *The Smartest Investment Book You'll Ever Read: The Simple, Stress-Free Way to Reach Your Investment Goals.*

Timothy Harper's book *License to Steal: The Secret World of Wall Street and the Systematic Plundering of the American Investor* reveals that most brokerage firms are all about making money for themselves, not giving a lick about clients. An elite stockbroker revealed that he viewed his investors' nest eggs as nothing more than vehicles for making all the loot he could for himself. (A shark does not hate the fish he eats anymore than you hate a hamburger that you devour for lunch. Nor does he care how the fish comes out of the transaction.) Big business is

under the gun to maximize profits, and top executives collect major bonuses on net earnings in the *short* run. Human nature and societal pressures dictate that it pays to exploit investors.

Burns and Solin claim that even dovish brokers (from Kingdom Advisors or wherever) cannot outperform the broadly diversified, low-expense propositions at Vanguard. Dear Mark.

In the 1990s, our family had three brokerage accounts worth a total \$14,000,000. Our financial advisor told us we were fine for the rest of our lives. In 2001, he confessed to defrauding us and 60 other investors. He went to jail for seven years. Our accounts were worth only \$4,000. We were forced into arbitration, but got no money back. The lawyers involved in this process were nothing short of vipers. Our home is now for sale, and we receive only \$1,000 per month from Social Security. I would like to write a book about all the deception and fraud. C.L.

While the United States continues to struggle to shore up democracy in Iraq, it proceeds to undermine the likelihood that the region's first democracy will endure.

At every negotiating session, Israel is pressured into making concessions for "peace" and receives more war in response. Mostly this is because of the wishful thinking in the West that has replaced sound policy. Why should the Palestinians make concessions when they are drawing closer to their objective of eradicating Israel by throwing stones and bombs and stonewalling negotiations?

In an address to the Israeli Knesset, President Shimon Peres reaffirmed the flaw in Western thinking: "...even if there are some who express doubt at the ability of the Palestinians to achieve peace, the impression must not be created that Israel has doubts regarding the need and the willingness to achieve full peace." So it's not about hard bargaining resulting in the preservation of Israel with defensible borders and the cessation of terrorist attacks, it's about "impressions"?

While details of a "joint declaration" by Israel and the Palestinians on a final status agreement remain secret, some information has leaked. One report has Prime Minister Ehud Olmert preparing to divide Jerusalem by allowing Arab East Jerusalem to come under Palestinian control. The holy sites, now

administered by Israel and open to all (which was not the case when Jordan controlled East Jerusalem prior to 1967), would be internationalized.

According to the report, "the drafters are planning to call for a withdrawal by Israel to the 1967 lines," thus making Israel more vulnerable than ever to heavily armed Arab states and Palestinian enemies and leaving it completely exposed to infiltration from the East.

Infidel Israelis, Americans, and Europeans will not dissuade those sworn to destroy Israel. President Bush had promised former Israeli Prime Minister Ariel Sharon he could expect U.S. support to maintain defensible borders. In the plan now being discussed, Israel's borders would be indefensible.

The real intentions of Israel's enemies can be summed up in the "phased plan" for the destruction of Israel expressed in 2000 by Palestinian Minister of Supply, Abd El Aziz Shahian: "The Palestinian people accepted the Oslo agreements as a first step and not as a permanent arrangement, based on the premise that the war and struggle on the ground is more efficient than a struggle from a distant land... for the Palestinian people will continue the revolution until they achieve the goals of the '65 revolution "

The "'65 Revolution" refers to the founding of the PLO and the publication of the Palestinian Charter, which calls for the destruction of Israel through armed struggle.

"Pay Or Die!"

Nabil Comanny and his family endured the dead bodies in the streets, the roaming kidnap gangs, and the continuing power failures. The Christian family stayed in their suburban Baghdad neighborhood after their Muslim neighbors fled the daily fighting between Sunnis and Shiites.

But when a hand-scrawled note appeared on their door telling them to convert to Islam, pay \$300 a month for "protection" or die, they realized they had to leave their home of 11 years. Islamic militants are increasingly targeting Christians, especially in the capital, forcing an exodus that has cut deeply into the long-standing minority community.

The last Iraqi census (1987), counted 1 million Christians. National aid groups estimate between 300,000 and 600,000 remaining Christians among an estimated 25 million people.

Mr. Comanny, a 37-year-old journalist, said he began to worry last spring when militants posted documents across the neighborhood ordering all residents to follow strict Islamic law, including all-enveloping black *burqas* for women.


In the end, most Christian families paid

a bribe, Mr. Comanny said, "because it gave them time to prepare to leave." Because militants frequently attack families returning home to fetch their belongings, Mr. Comanny paid an insurgent contact 1 million Iraqi dinars (\$800) for safe passage from the neighborhood. Today, the Comannys live in the New Baghdad section where hundreds of Christian families have relocated. The families move cautiously among a majority Shiite population, which relies on the Mahdi Army militia for protection.

Christians in Baghdad once mixed easily with Muslims, sharing cookies at Christmas and joining Muslims for the daily evening dinner during Ramadan. Amer Awadish, a 47-year-old taxi driver, said those relationships saved his life. After a handwritten warning was delivered to his apartment, a lifelong neighbor appeared at his door and advised him to leave immediately.

"This man used to kiss my mother on the forehead in public," Mr. Awadish said, referring to a common gesture of respect toward elderly women. "He was too ashamed to kill me because of that."

Many would leave the country if they felt there was somewhere to go. "If the U.S. and Europe open their doors, the Christians in Iraq will be finished. They will all leave," said William Warda, the founder of Hamorabi, a Christian-led human rights group in Iraq.

The Lord My Help By John J. Parsons



חוּשָׁה לְעֶזְרָתִי אֲדֹנָי הְשׁוּעָתִי:

Make haste to help me, O Lord my salvation – Psalm 38:22(3h)

Help, Lord!

Often the only prayer we have is "Help, LORD!" I use this one on a *daily* basis, that is, whenever I am confronted with my own inability.

The word translated "hasten" comes from the Hebrew word "chush," which means to hurry, to act quickly, or to come quickly. The Psalms often plead urgently, "hasten to help me" (chushah l'ezrati).

An old Jewish prayer says, "O LORD, I know that you will help us; but will you help us *before* you will help us?" Although God sometime tarries, He declares, "I am the LORD; *in its time* I will hasten it" (Isa. 60:22).

Is it time, LORD? Will you *now* restore the Kingdom to Israel? But as Jesus said, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority" (Acts 1:7). We are left waiting for God's ultimate answer: His glorious coming to fulfill our salvation.

We live in an "already-not-yet" state of hopeful expectation. In Modern Hebrew the word *teshuvah*, often translated "repentance," means "an answer." It is the mind's turning to a *sheilah*, a question, attending to it with honesty in the pursuit of truth.

Often trials in our lives function as God's questions to us, and we are asked to answer them with the *teshuvah* of settled faith.

The last words recorded of Jesus are: "Surely I come *quickly"* (Rev. 22:20). This is immediately followed by the last prayer given in the Scriptures: "Even so, come, Lord Jesus."

The LORD will indeed help us, since He is faithful and true, and His salvation is secure. May He come speedily, and in our day. Amen.



"...There Is A Jew Behind Me, Come And Kill Him..."

When the former leader of the Islamic Center of Cleveland, Fawaz Damra, was linked to funding of terrorists and deported in a very high-profile case, you might have expected that the new imam of the Islamic Center would be more moderate.

Think again: Cleveland's *Plain Dealer* headlined, "Ohio's largest mosque hires Egyptian hate sheikh to replace deported terror cleric Fawaz Damra." Not mentioned in the report is Ahmed Alzaree's anti-Jewish rants. According to Tom Blumer, a blogger for the *Plain Dealer*, in a 15-second Google search he came across a particular sermon dated March 7, 2003 where Alzaree offers this encouragement to his followers:

"Dear brothers and sisters, the talk about the Day of Judgment is long and full of things that will confuse the human mind and put fear in the hearts of the faithful. Every day that comes is much worse than the day before as we get closer to the hour. Among the signs of the approach of Day of Judgment is what the messenger of Allah PBUH [peace be unto him] said: 'The hour of judgment shall not happen until the Muslims fight the Jews. The Muslims shall kill the Jews to the point that the Jew shall hide behind a big rock or a tree and the rock or tree shall call on the Muslim saying: O Muslim, there is a Jew behind me, come and kill him, except the Gharqad tree which will not say, for it is the tree of Jews.'

"Agreed upon. This is to be very soon and close now. We ask Allah SWT [subhanahu wa ta'ala meaning: 'Allah is pure of having partners and he is exalted from having a son.'] not to test us so hard if we live till this horrible moment insha'allah [if Allah wills]."

Exposing A Colossal Hoax

An appeals court judge in Paris has ruled that France 2 TV must release to the trial court the unedited video



footage of the September 2000 shooting of 12-year-old Mohammed al-Dura, who was caught in Palestinian-Israeli crossfire that fueled the outbreak of the second Palestinian *intifada*. Al-Dura's death was turned into a symbol of Palestinian suffering under Israeli force, but the Israel Defense Forces concluded that the boy was not hit by an Israeli bullet. French media monitor Philippe Karsenty was sued for slander by France 2 after calling their edited version of the incident "a hoax."

Karsenty appealed the verdict, and the appellate judge has now ordered the release of the entire 25-minute video for the court to view. France 2's Arab cameraman Talal Abu Rahma has been given time to turn in the footage. Several French and U.S. journalists who have seen the full video believe that Palestinians staged the shooting. A final verdict is expected this coming February.

Ramadan Prayer: "Allah, Kill Americans!"

The Palestinian Authority (Fatah) daily newspaper's political cartoon illustrated a prayer

for the killing of Americans. A Muslim is shown kneeling in prayer facing a U.S. B-2 Stealth Bomber. The words of his prayer are encased in missiles aimed at Americans:

"Allah, scatter them!" "Turn their wives into widows!" "Turn their children into orphans!" "Give us victory over them!"

This prayer for the death of Americans is a special prayer for Al-Qadr Night (the 27th day of Ramadan, noted in the corner of the cartoon), when Muslims customarily pray in mosques throughout the night. The PA and Mahmoud Abbas's Fatah faction identify with those who fight and kill Americans. The most recently published 12th grade PA schoolbooks, for example, call those who fight American soldiers in Iraq "brave resistance."

U.S. Congress Honors Ramadan

The advice by the controversial Council on American Islamic Relations (CAIR) that American Muslims "blitz" their elected representatives with phone calls and urge them to pass a resolution honoring Islam and the Muslim holy month of Ramadan has apparently paid off.

For the first time ever, the U.S. House of Representatives, on a 376-0 vote, passed a resolution giving honor to the Islamic holiday of Ramadan and commending Muslims for their faith. 



Skewering History

The website states: "The American Textbook Council is an independent national research organization established in 1989 to review the history and social studies textbooks used in the nation's schools." www.historytextbooks.org/islam.htm. The biased and politically correct treatment of Islam in school textbooks is alarming because of the impact it has on both the knowledge base and attitudes of American children.

The American Textbook Council examined the coverage of Islam in seven widely adopted world history textbooks used in grades seven through twelve. In February 2003, it published its findings in a review, *Islam and the Textbooks*.

Since 2003, several reports have documented bias and evasions in world history textbooks. Textbooks misrepresent Islam past and present, critics agree. They contain fallacies and untruths about *jihad*, sharia, slavery, status of Muslim women, terrorism, and international security. (bold emphasis added)

Houghton Mifflin's seventh-grade text, Across the Centuries, has come in for singular criticism, but is no worse than competing textbooks. Textbooks make no distinction between sharia and Western law, and they pretend that women are making great strides in the Islamic world, when all evidence indicates otherwise. Social studies textbooks ignore the global ambitions of militant Islam. They fail to explain that Muslim terrorists seek to destroy the United States and Israel. They omit geopolitical goals that include theocracy and world domination by religion.

Islamic organizations led by the Council on Islamic Education act as domestic textbook "censors." Strictly speaking, since only governments censor books, the Islamists are merely agents of suppression, using educational publishers to do their bidding. Publishers ignore those who press them about motives, funding, legal status, and strong-arm tactics on the part of their Muslim "consultants."

The latest evidence of Islamist influence is California's adoption of *History Alive!* The Medieval World and Beyond. The publisher is Teachers' Curriculum Institute, a privately held company trying to gain part of the lucrative California textbook market. Based in Palo Alto and Sacramento, TCI's greatest advantage is being local. The student edition is an ill-written product printed on the cheap. Accompanying instructional materials are simply amateurish.

With History Alive! The Medieval World and Beyond, TCI is trying to sell a text-book to California schools that takes dictation from Islamist sources. The proximate question is whether the state's department of education and state school board will let this happen.

An Apology For Existing?

Pressured for nearly two decades to swap land for peace that never came, Israel will next be asked to apologize to its Arab and Muslim enemies for coming into existence in the first place.

That's what experts in conflict resolution have determined is the most expedient path for the Jewish state to take in turning around enemies who don't accept Israel's legitimacy as a Middle East state

The basis of the argument for an Israeli apology is found in *Science* magazine. In an article written by two researchers from John Jay College's Center on Terrorism and a professor of "human understanding" at the University of Michigan, a new plan for conflict resolution in the Middle East is unveiled.

The researchers, who adamantly describe their work as "science," say they went to the Middle East last February to conduct interviews in Syria, the Palestinian Authority, and Israel to gauge emotional responses over suggestions for resolution of the conflict.

"We found that the use of material incentives to promote the peaceful resolution of political and cultural conflicts may backfire when adversaries treat contested issues as sacred values," they write in *Science*. "Symbolic concessions of no apparent material benefit may be key in helping to solve seemingly intractable conflicts."

As evidence, they quote Ghazi Hamad, a Hamas leader, as saying: "In principle, we have no problem with a Palestinian state encompassing all of our lands within the 1967 borders. But let Israel apologize for our tragedy in 1948, and then we can talk about negotiating over our right of return to historic Palestine."

"In rational-choice models of decision-making, something as intangible as an apology could not stand in the way of peace," writes the research team, comprising Scott Atran, presidential scholar of sociology and senior research fellow at the Center for Terrorism at John Jay College; Richard Davis, research fellow at the Center for Terrorism; and Robert Axelrod, professor for the study of human understanding at the University of Michigan.

The notion that Israel has it within its ability to change the hearts and minds of its enemies is misguided.

Scientists may have found the way to personalize the Israeli anti-MS drug Copaxone according to one's genes.

Copaxone is widely considered the most effective treatment in preventing or reducing relapses in patients with multiple sclerosis (MS) and was the first original Israeli drug to be approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration.



MS is an autoimmune disease in which the body's immune system attacks proteins in the fatty layer surrounding nerve fibers, causing impaired vision and movement disorders. These attacks prevent the conduction of electrical signals through the nerve fibers. Prof. Michael Sela used synthetic molecules designed by future President of Israel Prof. Ephraim Katzir, to curb the attacks.

Medical treatments in general rely on trial-and-error methods to determine the correct dosage, often leading to errors and complications along the way. Scientists performed tests at Weizmann Institute, using Israel's only genome-variation scanning equipment, to determine specific genetic markers and their link with the patient's response to Copaxone. In the future, it may be possible to scan the genome of MS sufferers, to predict the response levels in advance, and to optimize the dosage and treatment protocol to suit each patient personally.

"And I Will Bless Those Who Bless You"

Mrs. Fields has added Christmas cookie gifts to the holiday section of its website in response to heat it received for initially avoiding any men-

tion of "Christmas" products for fear of offending people.

In early October, the American Family Association flew into action when alerted to the omission by a resident of Michigan who called Mrs. Fields's customer service number to complain about the absence of any Christmas products or even mention of the holiday by name.

She was reportedly told by the customer service representative the company did not offer products mentioning Christmas because it did not want to offend anyone.

AFA sent out an "action alert" to hundreds of thousands of its members

nationwide accusing Mrs. Fields of becoming the first company to ban Christmas from products and promotions this year.

"Mrs. Fields wants the business of Christians who celebrate Christmas. but they don't mind if they offend Christians," the AFA said over the signature of Don Wildmon, founder and chairman of the organization.

By the following day, the Mrs. Fields website was offering at least three gift products mentioning "Christmas" by name. Randy Sharp, director of special products for AFA, said the group is still not entirely pleased with the capitulation. "Mrs. Fields is still being politically correct as a company," he said. In give-and-take conversations and e-mails with the company, officials suggested substituting "winter" in place of "holiday" in its promotions.

Last year, giant retailer Wal-Mart was the target of a boycott threat by AFA for dumping the word "Christmas" from all of its store promotions. Wal-Mart later avoided the clash by relenting to use the name of the holiday.

Another Misguided Judge

A law passed by Congress and signed by President Bush clearly requires the State Department to record Israel as the place of birth in passports for American citizens born in Jerusalem, but that requirement cannot be enforced by the courts, a federal judge ruled recently.



For the second time, Judge **Gladys Kessler** threw out a lawsuit brought by an American couple, Ari and Naomi Zivotofsky, on behalf of their son, Menachem, who was born in Jerusalem in 2002. The State Department contends that marking Menachem's place of birth as "Jerusalem, Israel" would upset long-standing American policy that the sovereignty of Jerusalem is an issue to be determined in peace talks between the Israeli government and the Palestinian Arabs.

Soldiers of God

Half of the Israel Defense Forces' young combat officers are religious Jews, according to statistics published in *Maariv*, Israel's second largest daily newspaper.

"This says something very good about the sons of the religious Zionist movement," opines Ben Caspit, the writer of the piece. "They are becoming the IDF's backbone. Their presence in the army is several times larger than it is in the general population."

The entry of the religious Zionists into the officer corps began after the Yom Kippur War when Major-Generals Yair Naveh and Elazar Stern entered service, and "continues with the pre-military academies, which send a sizable percentage of their graduates to the Officers' Course. They do everything willingly, with their entire soul," Caspit says of the religious Zionist soldiers. Alongside them one finds many youths from the socialist-agricultural moshav (co-op) and kibbutz movements, as well as soldiers from new-immigrant and lower-income families who see the military as a chance for upward social mobility.

The statistics are important for Israeli society because the IDF is seen as the nation's backbone and its pride. Since the State of Israel was founded, it has had five native-born Prime Ministers. four of whom were from the military: Yitzhak Rabin, Binyamin Netanyahu, Ehud Barak, and Ariel Sharon. Rabin and Barak both served as IDF Chiefs of Staff, Sharon was a Major-General and Netanyahu was an officer in an elite unit that was commanded by his brother, Yoni, who was himself a military hero killed in the rescue of passengers from a hijacked Air France jet in Uganda in 1976. Thus, traditionally, service as combat officers goes hand in hand with leadership potential.



"Death To The Dictator"

Dozens of students opposed to Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad's human rights record confronted the leader and his supporters at the country's most prestigious university.

The students, defying a broad government crackdown on dissent, accused Ahmadinejad of corruption and discrimination, and chanted, "Death to the dictator!" The president came to Tehran University to inaugurate the academic year, just two weeks after he was confronted by protests during a visit to Columbia University in New York.

Ahmadinejad, widely criticized in the West for questioning the Holocaust and pursuing a nuclear program, cuts a divisive figure at home. His government has tolerated little dissent, arresting students, purging freethinking professors, and cracking down on young men and women wearing Western-style clothing.

"You, Mr. Ahmadinejad, claimed at Columbia University that there is freedom of speech in Iran's universities," one student said over a megaphone. "Then why are three students still in jail?"

"I am here out of curiosity," said Ali, a graduate student in sociology who asked that his last name not be published. "I hate politics. I think in Iran you cannot live up to your own potential, and there are no good prospects for jobs," he said. "I am applying for further education in Europe or the U.S., where I can go and live in a way that I think is right."
