going to be peace.


They don't care. They live in the day."

good a time: sunbathing, swimming, café-hopping, profiting from start-up companies, and utterly disconnected from "politics." These points scream: Israel does not fit in; if Israelis were only more impoverished, more indolent, they might be recognized as indigenous to the region, a true part of the Middle East.

These are Vick's thoughts, not mine.

Of course, Jews are the original Palestinians and the most indigenous of the region's inhabitants; yes, there are many impoverished Israelis, both Jews and non-Jews. But, why doesn't Vick also point out that Palestinians are leading the high life on the West Bank, in sumptuous villas on both the West Bank and in Gaza; that they, too, are sunbathing, swimming, shopping, dining out, and relaxing at the beach—at least as much as the Muslim thugs who run the lives of Palestinians will allow it?

Vick and his editors at *TIME* seem to think that showing photos of Israelis at leisure—lounging on a beach, playing with one's baby in a stroller, sitting at a café—are proof that Israelis simply don't care about peace with the Palestinians.

Vick writes that real estate is booming, as is business in general. Israeli "brainiacs" have helped their nation avoid the economic disasters that have plunged Europe and America into a recession. Is Vick aware that he is counting on the world's long-held resentment about Jewish creativity, genius, and scientific and economic success? Or because Jews seem to "know something," maybe they are channeling God directly and thus, the deck is stacked against non-Jews. Vick presents Israel's success as somehow unseemly because it makes other nations look bad. Does he harbor the suspicion that Jewish prosperity has been stolen from non-Jews?

Buried in Vick's four-page cover piece

are snippets of truth: that Israelis are weary of peace negotiations that never succeed because the Palestinians do not want peace; that Arabs and Palestinians want to destroy the Jewish state and as many Jews as possible. But Vick fails to convey that negotiations cannot work as long as the Islamic propaganda against Jews and Israel continues to turn out children who hate Jews and who become human homicide bombs, snipers, kidnappers, Kassam rocket launchers, etc.

Here is what Vick utterly fails to comprehend: The

Israelis are actually showing the entire world how to embrace life, even as they live, trembling, in the shadow of death. They are teaching the world how to love life more than they fear death.

The Jewish insistence on life may be the key to our survival as a people despite ceaseless persecution. It might be the model for all humanity in an era of genocides, civil wars, torture chambers, tyrannies, and totalitarian regimes. Why is *TIME* turning things on their head and refusing to recognize the courage and the heroism of Jewish Israelis who choose to live in the moment when the moment is all they have? Against all odds, the Jews simply refuse to give up.

Vick does not seem to know how high the Jewish population growth was in the DP [displaced persons] camps right after the Holocaust. Can he comprehend that permanently endangered Jews—who have survived as a people for nearly six thousand years—the Chosen People—have always chosen life in the moment, have chosen to seize life with both hands, even as they memorialize their dead and make sense of their persecution in a way that illuminates this particular hell for all humanity?

I hope that people understand that *TIME* magazine—and other media in the Western world—can no longer be trusted to tell the truth.

On April 1, 1933, a week after Hitler became dictator of Germany, he ordered a boycott of Jewish shops, banks, offices, and department stores. But the boycott was mostly ignored by German shoppers and was called off after three days. However, the unsuccessful boycott was followed by a rapid series of laws that robbed the Jews of many rights.

On April 7, "The Law of the Restoration of the Civil Service" was introduced, which made "Aryanism" a necessary requirement in order to hold a civil service position. All Jews holding such positions were dismissed or forced into retirement.

On April 25, a law against the overcrowding of German schools placed severe limits on the number of young Jews allowed to enroll in public schools.

On June 2, a law prohibited Jewish dentists and dental technicians from working with state-run insurance institutions

On September 28, all non-Aryans and their spouses were prohibited from government employment.

On September 29, Jews were banned from all cultural and entertainment activities including literature, art, film, and theater.

In October 1933, Jews were prohibited from being journalists and all newspapers were placed under Nazi control.


Jews have been victims of such policies before. They have been

world are feverishly lobbying artists, universities, churches, retailers, unions, municipalities, and other institutions to adopt BDS.

Any public figures, retailers, institutions or organizations that adopt or defer to BDS policies should themselves be boycotted.

They should be boycotted because they advocate destructive rather than constructive measures. BDS is anti-coexistence, undermines peace efforts, and does nothing to help Palestinians begin state-building, improve their lives, or move toward reconciliation.

BDS policies are fundamentally anti-Semitic even though some of the movement's advocates are Jews. The campaign uses the propaganda techniques and imagery of classical anti-Semitism, once applied to individual Jews, now to the Jewish State. Boycott activists strip away all context for Israel's actions, such as ongoing terrorism and the virulent ideology that propels it. They put a microscope on Israel to detect its flaws, and expect it to live up to standards they do not expect of any other nation. They never call for BDS against nations that systematically commit war crimes and human rights abuses, such as Iran, Sudan, Lebanon (apartheid practices against Palestinians), or Turkey (occupation of northern Cyprus and repression of its Kurdish minority).

Where was the outrage of the boycotters, who claim to be champions of social justice and human rights, when Palestinian suicide bombers targeted innocent Jewish men, women, and children, and Hamas fired thousands of rockets from Gaza into Israel, murdering toddlers? Where were they when Ahmadinejad denied the Holocaust even as he called for genocide against Jews? Their callous indifference and implicit support of the murdering of Jews is both morally perverse and anti-Semitic.

They should be boycotted because they endorse the agendas of the dictatorial regimes and radical Islamist groups who are enemies of human rights, social justice values, tolerance, and modernity. These states and groups like Hamas oppress women, their own citizens, and persecute religious and other minorities.

Boycotting means that any university that does not unequivocally denounce campus divestment campaigns should not receive another nickel from donors who care about fairness, the survival of Israel, and modern liberal values. Recording artists who refuse to perform in Israel should be labeled as extremists. and fair-minded people should stop buying their records and attending their concerts. Consumers should boycott any retailers who refuse to stock Israeli products, and support the new Stand With Us campaign, "BIG" and "RIG," acronyms for "Buy Israeli Goods" and "Request Israeli Goods."

It is time to expose the distorted values that drive the BDS movement, and its alliance with the most repressive and dangerous forces in the world today.



From Caveman To Rabbi

Shalom. I am **Eitan Shishkoff.**I have lived in the
Haifa Bay area of
Israel for nearly
18 years. Through



this column, it will be my pleasure to open a window into life in Israel. First, a little of my background.

Connie and I married 41 years ago and spent our honeymoon in a cave in New Mexico. Yes, we were hippies—both Jewish, and both seeking a way to change the world. We had already taken part in anti-war demonstrations, psychedelic drug use, and a rock-blues band. None of those seemed to succeed in transforming the world or ourselves. The 1960s' winds of change then blew us all the way to the remote mountains of the Southwest. There, we sought to live like the Pueblo and Hopi tribes, growing corn, beans, and squash.

Our homes were made of rocks, logs, and mud. We lived without electricity for six years, cooking and heating with a wood-burning stove. And while there were many false illusions about the spiritual/political statement we were making by "living on the land," we were also being drawn to the Creator through the drama of His creation. When a dear friend was murdered by a total stranger, it

shattered the Garden of Eden we were aiming for.

Then God stepped in, sending young, hip messengers who had found "the answer" in Yeshua. As they spoke, I was gripped by a vivid vision of the Messiah dying on the cross. Through eyes of endless love, He touched the depth of my soul, revealing the Gospel of salvation, without a word. That very night, I yielded my life to the One who had suffered in my place, taking the full weight of my guilt.



That was 1972. The next several years saw rapid change. We moved to town to attend Bible college. Reading the New Testament account of the Last Supper, I realized that it was a Passover Seder that Yeshua was leading (duh!). Thus we rediscovered our Jewish heritage and began to celebrate the Feasts of Israel with their Messianic significance. While serving Beth Messiah Congregation in the Washington, D.C. area (1981–1992), we awakened to the ancient prophets' call to return to Israel. Skewed News From Mainstream Media

From the International Jerusalem Post: A Palestinian woman's baby was delivered by Israeli soldiers last week.

Shurouk Ghazi, 22, from the village Tilt in southern Samaria, set out for a hospital in Nablus accompanied by her husband when she went into labor. Stopping at an army roadblock near Kedumim, her husband informed soldiers his wife was about to give birth. The regional army doctor was summoned, and Ghazi was transferred to an army ambulance.

En route to the hospital, the army doctor delivered a 3.5 kg baby girl (about 7-1/2 lbs.).

It has always struck me that the vast majority of ordinary residents do not have any quarrel in Israel. Believe it or not, I think there are more arguments between groups in America than there are between Israelis and Palestinians. It is those in leadership over there who are fighting, and a few hotheads, but trust the media to interview only selected people, just as they film only at selected sites. Of course, the selections are meant to promote the idea of a crisis and terrible tension.

I don't think the media have ever mentioned the Good Fence, on the border with Lebanon. It is the place where Israeli soldiers and doctors have treated Arab men, women, and children for nearly twenty years. It all started one day-because medical care is not up to snuff in southern Lebanon—when a Lebanese woman at wit's end handed her sick and crying baby over the fence to an Israeli sentry standing guard, and begged him to provide medical care for the infant. A precedent was set by that act, and its tradition has continued year in and year out with thousands being treated. CNN reporters and other foreign

journalists have driven past the Good Fence time and again without filming the goings on or interviewing the participants.

There comes a time when the media can actually be an enemy to the ordinary people. I think we're living through one of those times.

When CNN films Palestinian ambulances screaming up to street riots, they don't bother to tape the part where the guns are unloaded from the backs of the ambulances. They also don't note that the ambulances typically drive away empty, only to return bringing back more weapons. They rarely carry the wounded. Again, medical care is lacking in Arab-held territories.

I hope that Baby Girl Ghazi will grow up to be one of the vast majority who appreciate being able to live in the democracy of Israel and will remember that Israeli soldiers and an army doctor brought her into this world. I hope she will not be one of those who are "educated" by Arafat's [now Abbas's and Hamas's minions to hate her neighbors. It wouldn't hurt to offer a prayer for this child who so well represents real cooperation between peoples at a time when the whole world is being told that no such thing exists between Israelis and Palestinians.



Controversy Over City

Israel Today

The Jerusalem Municipality has approved a plan to develop a protected area of the City of David that has in recent decades been illegally occupied by Arab squatters. The City of David, located in the predominantly Arab neighborhood of Silwan, comprises the original city of Jerusalem conquered by King David over 3,000 years ago. Today, it is home to a small, but growing Jewish population that lives alongside the Arabs.

Since the time of the Ottoman and British
Mandate governments, the lower part of Silwan
was kept wooded, and no construction was
allowed in order to preserve its historical
uniqueness. But over the past 10 years or so,
some 90 houses have been built without
permits by Arab squatters in the area known as the King's Garden.







Jerusalem Mayor Nir Barkat recognizes that the Arab squatters have been living there for decades, and his plan to return King's Garden to a green area takes their situation into account. According to the plan, 66 of the 90 illegal structures will be retroactively approved, and alternative plots of land will be given to those who are evicted. Nevertheless,

Palestinian and left-wing Israeli elements, in eager partnership with the international media, have focused solely on the fact that a number of Arab families will be forced by Israel to leave "their" homes. Israel is taking immense heat over the plan, despite the fact that the homes were built illegally on state-owned land, that the municipality is going to retroactively approve two thirds of the homes anyway, and that the remaining squatters will be receiving gifts of land despite having broken the law.

Barkat explained that by catering to the squatters, the municipality is making its job of restoring the green area far more difficult. Most of the illegal homes were built without proper infrastructure, which means the municipality must now install plumbing and electricity for already-existing structures. It also means the proposed park and other public areas will be much smaller than originally intended.

Jewish lawmaker Uri Ariel of the right-wing National Union party says that when it comes to building violations in Jerusalem, there is more discrimination against Jews than Arabs. "There are fewer than 50 illegal Jewish structures, while the number of illegal Arab buildings is estimated in the thousands," he said. "Demolition orders for Jews are rushed up, while those for Arabs happen much more slowly."

The mayor is demanding that the fate of Beit Yonatan, an apartment building constructed illegally by Jews in Silwan, be the same as that of the illegal Arab buildings in Silwan. This puts the courts and the government in the sticky situation of choosing between equal application of the law and appearing the international community and the Palestinians.

DESTROYING JEWISH HISTORY

More than a quarter of a million Christians visit Jerusalem's Garden Tomb every year. The holy site is believed by many to be the place where Jesus rose from the dead. But now, the sacred ground is in danger of being damaged by a Muslim construction project. Garden Tomb Director Richard Meryon showed the 15-foot wall being built above the tomb.



"In the last few weeks the cemetery above has built this wooden construction into which they are now ready to pour hundreds

of tons of concrete on top of our wall," he explained.



"Just beneath (the wall) we have three or four areas where Christians are worshipping every day. So we have the potential here in heavy rain or in snow, or even in one of those earth tremors that Jerusalem is famous for—you only need one of those events to happen and this new wall could collapse," he said. "It could kill 200 visitors, pilgrims, and tourists in the garden worshipping."



The new wall also violates three local build ing codes and does not have a city permit. The structure is supposed to be built three feet away from any existing structure and permission is required. "They have never sought my permission," Meryon said. "We have been in active discussion and I am now negotiating with them. I cannot allow them to build this wall until they prove to me beyond all reason able doubt that this wall is going to be safe."

A spokesman from the Muslim cemetery said they do not have a license, but claim the new wall is safe. The mayor's office also said officials will make sure the building is legal so Jerusalem can remain open to tourists.

"We walk through the garden, we're hearing groups of people praising God, worshiping Him in every language from everywhere, and we have taken people through the garden literally from every corner of the globe," one tour guide said.

And the concrete wall is not the only construction Meryon is worried about. He said recent digging on top of Golgotha next to the Garden Tomb threatens the hill known as the Place of a Skull. Many believe Jesus was crucified there. "Golgotha is mentioned in John 19, where Jesus was led outside the city walls... into a place called Golgotha." Meryon said. "Above Golgotha, in the last few days—bucket by bucket, load by load—a lot of dirt has been imported above the rock and below those graves on the skyline," he added. "I've known for some weeks that they were thinking of building a minaret up there." Meryon wants to make sure Golgotha and the Garden Tomb remain intact.

"This is a very important Christian holy site," he said. "And we just want to live here in peace and provide this amazing opportunity for Christians all around the world to come here and continue to worship and be exposed to the Gospel."

ISRAEL'S CONTRIBUTIONS IN MEDICINE

Routine Blood Tests Could Replace Colonoscopy

Tel Aviv University (TAU) researchers have discovered that routine blood tests can provide an early warning for colorectal cancer.

Anemia, a common blood disorder characterized by low hemoglobin levels, has long been associated with those suffering from colorectal cancer. It doesn't happen suddenly, however—and Tel Aviv University researchers say they have found that gradually decreasing hemoglobin levels can actually indicate a potential for colon cancer years in advance.

Graduate student **Inbal Goldshtein,** who works with
Dr. Gabriel Chodick and
Dr. Varda Shalev of TAU's

School of Public Health and Maccabi Healthcare Services' Department of Medical Informatics, says that paying close attention to routine blood test results can be an effective screening system for colon cancer. Though some 50,000 Americans are expected to die from colon cancer in 2010, better screening, leading to early diagnosis and effective treatment, can


significantly reduce those numbers, she says.

Goldshtein's study, recently published in the *European Journal of Cancer Prevention*, shows that most patients with colon cancer have a history of consistently declining hemoglobin levels up to four years before being diagnosed with the disease. Until now, only a sharp decrease in hemoglobin levels was sought out as an indicator of colon cancer. But Goldshtein and her fellow researchers have discovered that it's the continuous, long-term decline that may announce the onset of the disease.

Specifically, a declining trend of more than 0.28 grams per deciliter every six months over a four-year period was observed—and as a result, may serve as a warning of illness on the horizon. The next step, says Dr. Shalev, is to create an algorithm that will automatically detect suspicious declines in hemoglobin levels, advising physicians to send their patients for further testing.

Ben Franklin Was No Anti-Semite

Al Aqsa (Hamas-Gaza) TV is continuing its unabated televised anti-Semitic incitement with an interview that claims U.S. founding father Benjamin Franklin warned Americans about the Jews.

The claim, made in an Arabic-language interview by United Arab Emirates Creativity Center director Dr. Ali Al-Hamadi, was translated by the Middle East Media Research Institute (MEMRI).

"If you read about the literature and heritage of America, you will see that they consider former U.S. President (sic) Benjamin Franklin to be one of their greatest minds," Al-Hamadi began. "When you read about U.S. heritage, you encounter words written in ink of gold. The Americans endorse the words of Franklin, but when he talks about the Jews, they ignore his words completely."


"He (Franklin) lived in 1779, and delivered a famous speech. Addressing the American people, he talked about an immense danger that faced them. He said: 'Do not think that by achieving our independence, the United States is safe from all danger. There is an immense danger...'

"These were his words. 'An immense danger faces the American people— the proliferation of Jews in the United States.' He went on to say: 'The Jews are devils and bats. We must expel these sinners...' These are his words, not mine. 'We must expel this group of sinners from the United States, and if you don't do this immediately, our future generations will curse you, when they find themselves under the boots of the Jews.'"

It turns out, however, that Al-Hamadi's claim is based on a classic anti-Semitic canard called The Franklin "Prophecy,"

a falsified document debunked many decades ago. A 2004 report issued by the U.S. Congress, "Anti-Semitism in Europe: Hearing Before the Subcommittee on European Affairs of the Committee on Relations" describes the fake on page 69:

The Franklin "Prophecy" is a classic anti-Semitic canard that falsely claims that American statesman Benjamin Franklin made anti-Jewish statements during the Constitutional Convention of 1787. It has found widening acceptance in Muslim and Arab media, where it has been used to criticize Israel and Jews..."



But it was actually proven false as far back as 1954, when the New York-based Anti-Defamation League issued a detailed refutation of the hoax, which apparently first appeared in 1934.


As for Benjamin Franklin, his liberal attitudes towards people of all religions were well known; in fact, his donation of five pounds of his own money to the building of a synagogue in his city during the fundraising campaign of the Hebrew Society of Philadelphia is clearly documented.

Numerous historians and biographers of the founding father have denounced the so-called "speech." Among them is J. Henry Smythe, Jr., compiler of *The Amazing Benjamin Franklin*, who labeled the canard a "libel of the Jewish race, unjust both to Jews and to the name and fame of Benjamin Franklin. I have investigated this calumny and find no historical basis."

No Place For Democracy And Human Rights In Islam www.AsiaNews.it

As the world mobilizes against the stoning of Sakineh Mohammadi Ashtiani, the 43-year-old woman convicted for adultery and killing her husband, Iranian police continue to threaten and arrest journalists and human rights lawyers. Dozens of university professors are fired and pro-reform students are beaten. The reason is simple. "Democracy, freedom, and human rights have no place" in Islam, said Mesbah Yazdi, who heads Shia Taliban, in a speech reprinted in Rooz, an online Iranian news website.

Speaking before members of paramilitary groups, soldiers, and his followers, the cleric said that Iran "is not a place to back down for cultural reasons against people promoting corruption."



In a veiled reference to Sakineh and others, he added, "sexual or moral deviants or promoters of any other kind of corruption must be suppressed."

Mesbah Yazdi is a member of the Association of Teachers of Kom Theological Center and a great supporter of Ahmadinejad. In fact, "When the president received the supreme leader's confirmation, obeying him is like obeying God," he said.

A similar extremist vision explains recent events in Iran, where dozens of students, followers of pro-reform Ayatollah Dastgheib, who was against Ahmadinejad's re-election, were beaten in Shiraz's Koba Mosque.



Pro-democracy activists are also concerned about the firing of 40 professors from Tehran University. The activists have slammed the professors' removal, calling it a case of "political cleansing" of the faculty that led the Green Wave movement that opposed the results of last year's presidential election. Indeed, Science Minister Kamran Daneshjoo said repeatedly that the universities would not tolerate professors who are not "in tune with the Islamic Republic regime."

For Mesbah Yazdi, anyone who opposes the Islamic Republic of Iran and President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad is an "enemy of God" (mohareb).

Human rights activist **Shiva Nazar Ahari** (pictured), who is the editor of the Committee of Human Rights Reporters website, has recently found out what that means.



Arrested on 14 July 2009, a month after Ahmadinejad's re-election, she was released on bail on 23 September of the same year. Re-arrested on 20 December and charged as a *mohareb*, she is still waiting to go to a trial.

Badrolssadat Mofidi, secretary general of the Iranian Journalists Association, is another prominent figure accused of being a *mohareb*. He was recently sentenced to six years in prison and five years without the right to work as a journalist.

Immigrants come to America seeking to attain a lifestyle that is limited by constraints within their birth nation. But they understand that becoming a U.S. citizen requires allegiance to a new country—and an obligation to abide by its laws. As immigrants have come to our shores, none ever sought to bring their own laws with them to trump ours—until now.

America's greatness has been enhanced for centuries by immigrants possessing a good work ethic in need only of a level playing field. Embracing what their new country stands for, they have ultimately assimilated, coming to understand that success for all is based on equality for all. 
anathema to Islam.

Erdogan calls assimilation "a crime against humanity" because the "humanity" he embraces includes only Islam's believers. Muslims in foreign lands are instructed to isolate themselves for the sake of purity—from non-believers.

What many people fail to understand is that Muslims embrace "reverse assimilation." This is the process by which the influence of the host population is eventually marginalized due to the disproportionately high growth of an immigrant population which then seeks to impose its beliefs on the host. Simply put, it is the guest who comes to a host's home, grows his family until it outnumbers the host's family, and then takes over that home.

In 1948, the world community unanimously agreed to a UN declaration that human rights are universal. In 1981, Muslim countries distanced themselves from this, claiming to follow *sharia* [Islamic] law, which limits such rights primarily to Muslim men. That same sharia law is now being applied in host countries—including the U.S.—under pressure from growing, unassimilated Muslim populations.

Muslim supporters of the Ground Zero mosque raise the Constitution with one hand to claim that religious freedom protects its construction. But hidden in the other hand is *sharia* law, which they seek to impose against non-supporters. Mosque supporters need to understand they cannot have it both ways. We need to understand that as well.

Help, Lord!

Make haste to help me, O Lord my salvation – Psalm 38:22



Often the only prayer we have is "Help, LORD!" I use this one on a *daily* basis, that is, whenever I am confronted with the truth of my own condition...

The word translated "hasten" comes from the Hebrew word "chush," which means to hurry, to act quickly, or to come quickly. The Psalms often plead urgently, "hasten to help me" (chushah l'ezrati).

An old Jewish prayer says, "O LORD, I know that You will help us; but will You help us before You will help us?" Although God sometime tarries, He declares, "I am the LORD; in its time I will hasten it" (Isa. 60:22).

Is it time, LORD? Will You *now* restore the kingdom to Israel? But as Jesus said, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by His own authority" (Acts 1:7). We are left waiting for ultimate God's answer: His glorious coming to fulfill our salvation.

We live in an "already-not-yet" state of hopeful expectation. In Modern Hebrew the word *teshuvah*, often translated "repentance," means "an answer." It is the mind's turning to a *sheilah*, a question, attending to it with honesty in the pursuit of truth.

Often trials in our lives function as God's questions to us, and we are asked to answer them with the *teshuvah* of settled faith.


The last words recorded of Jesus are: "Surely I come *quickly*" (Rev. 22:20). This is immediately followed by the last prayer given in the Scriptures: "Even so, come, Lord Jesus."

Banks Seek Customers' Help To Stop Online Thieves

Banks want consumers to help protect their deposits from thieves. About 80% of U.S. households bank online. However, it is less safe than visiting a branch. Cyber attacks have become alarmingly sophisti-

cated and pervasive. Bankers now expect consumers to continually monitor their online accounts for unauthorized transactions. Banks have invested heavily in cyber defenses, and they've reimbursed account holders who can prove they've been ripped off.



Cyber theft has evolved into a multibillion-dollar global industry. There are nearly 70,000 "banking Trojan" programs—malicious software designed to pilfer online accounts. Eighty-five percent of big banks incur losses from cyber attacks on consumer online accounts. It's an arms race. Solutions last only until the next kind of attack evolves. If you're caught in the middle, the loss could be yours.

A San Diego personal trainer barely dodged a recent attack. An email from her bank advised her that all future emails would go to a new email address, per her online instructions. She'd never requested such a change, however. A clerk informed her that \$5,800 was about to be transferred from her savings account to a woman—whom she didn't know! Payment was stopped.

A computer virus probably let the attacker access her account, change the email address, and initiate the bill payment. The bank authorized the transfer because the



thief knew the answers to the trainer's "secret questions"—such as her mother's maiden name and the city of her birth.

The cyber underground makes powerful hacking tools and tutorials available via an organized support infrastructure. Cyber thieves purchase account log-ons from data thieves. They find coding security holes in Web browsers. Internet Explorer, Firefox, Google, and Apple Safari enable users to surf the Internet. But browsers simply aren't designed for secure financial transactions. Cyber thieves craft banking Trojans that inject software code into the Web browser. Then the attacker takes control of online banking sessions, altering what the account holder sees and making stealthy transactions.

The current online banking systems are at least one full generation behind current cyber crook techniques. One banking Trojan infiltrated a victim's Web browser when he clicked on a corrupted Web link in an instant message. The Trojan watched for when the victim accessed his online bank account and sent a copy of the user name and password to the attacker. It also automatically injected a "spoofed" (looks real, but isn't) bank form into the legitimate banking Web pages. Cyber criminals can steal credentials for thousands of accounts at a time with very little effort. Customers must know how to defent themselves. They must always protect passwords. ensure the bank has up-to-date contact information, and regularly review their accounts.

Verification devices that operate separately from the browser ensure secure transactions no matter what is on the customer's PC. Unfortunately, banks are a long way from widely distributing such devices. Banking and security experts say a consumer backlash is necessary to change the banking industry's current approach.

Stopgap solution from Mark: Use online banking for only your smallest "convenience" account. Keep savings, money market, and other larger accounts away from online banking.

The issue arises because at the time he wrote the Book of Romans, he had not yet been in Rome.





Because of the horrors he saw when liberating the Ohrdruf and Buchenwald camps in Germany, General Eisenhower ordered that all the civilian news media and military combat camera units be required to visit the camps and record their observations in print, pictures, and film. As he explained to General Marshall, "I made the visit deliberately, in order to be in a position to give first-hand evidence of these things if ever, in the future, there develops a tendency to charge these allegations merely to 'propaganda.'" 
How Much Blood Makes One A Jew?

A NATO Grant for a Saltfree Water Bridge

Israel and Jordan share environmental problems, but regional politics and prejudices often prevent them from solving them together. A new North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) grant set up to develop two inland water desalination plants—one in Israel and one in Jordan—not only gets two Middle East universities collaborating, but the end-product could help to quench the region's thirst. It could also boost an under-used new technology that promises to save both water and energy the world over.


Super Battery

Israel Today

An Israeli research team has developed a new battery that produces thousands of hours of power from an abundant and non-polluting fuel source—sand. The team is led by Professor Yair Ein-Eli of the Department of Materials Engineering at the Technion in Haifa.

Because of its small size, .3 inch (1 cm), this new device could replace the batteries used in hearing aids. It also has the potential to be used in laptop computers, providing hundreds of hours of power with a single charge. The prototypes contain a silicon power source that reverts back to its original form as sand.

REVOLUTIONARY INVENTION Professor Yair Ein-Eli says his battery may last 6,000 hours!



"In our current study, we show that at 600 hours it had used only 10 percent of the energy; so we are talking about 6,000 hours," said Ein-Eli, who believes that his invention could ultimately evolve into a battery for electric cars and solar panels. "It's a dream, but dreams may come true if you work at them."

Has God Rejected Israel?

There is only night or day. Everything else, whether dawn or twilight, leans towards either day or night. The same thing applies to our attitude toward Israel. We either bless Israel or we curse it (Numbers 24:9). It is not possible to be indifferent toward Israel.

In other words, there are just two camps. One teaches that God has abandoned the nation of Israel and set up the Church in its place. This is known as Replacement Theology. The other says that God will never abandon His people Israel. Both camps cite the Bible, but the former ignores the context.

For example, opponents of Israel refer to Jeremiah 7:29: "The Lord has rejected and forsaken the generation of His wrath." The rejection of Israel was an issue even in the prophet's time, as God bemoans in Jeremiah 33:23–24: "Have you not observed what this people have spoken, saying, "The two families [Judah and Israel] which the Lord chose, He has rejected them?""


Friends of Israel on the other hand quote Judges 2:1: "I brought you... into the land (Israel) which I have sworn to your fathers; and I said [or promised], 'I will never break My

covenant with you."

God confirms this in Jeremiah 31:37: "Thus says the Lord, 'If the heavens above can be measured and the foundations of the earth searched out below, then I will also cast off all the offspring of Israel for all that they have done."

The Bible is full of promises from God

The answer is in the timing—whether God has rejected Israel *temporarily* or *permanently*. The early Christians in Rome also had a problem with this issue, for Paul responds to the question as to whether God has rejected His people Israel with a clear, "May it never be!" (Romans 11:1). However, a few verses later, he writes that God *has* rejected His covenant people for a limited time through the "partial" hardening of their hearts. Why? So that during this period, salvation may come to the gentiles (11:25–29).

This rejection, however, is *temporary*; it will only last "until the fullness of the gentiles has come in"—i.e., until the full number of the chosen gentiles has entered the Church of God. Then "all Israel will be saved." At that point, God's *permanent* covenant with His people Israel will be restored. The bottom line: When God speaks of His rejection of Israel, this is only a temporary state.

One-Sided Narrative

The Israeli human rights group Gisha has produced an online interactive game called *Safe Passage* that grossly distorts restrictions on movement for Palestinians between the so-called "West Bank" and Gaza. The player is asked to choose the role of a Gaza businessman, student, or man who married a West Bank woman and now lives there with his family.

In all three scenarios, the player is presented with harsh restrictions on movement and relocation that make running a business, going to school, or maintaining a family nearly impossible. For instance, the Palestinian father is expelled from the West Bank and sent back to Gaza by the Israeli military. Separated from his wife and young son, the player seeks a legal basis to persuade Israel to allow him to return to his family, but he is rebuffed at every turn.

Each time the military rejects the arguments, a related legal decision is presented that depicts Israel as an uncaring oppressor arbitrarily restricting freedom of movement to Palestinians.

What is conveniently ignored is why these restrictions exist at all. Prior to the Second *Intifada* (uprising) in 2000, there was very little restriction



on movement or relocation between the West Bank and Gaza. Palestinians from both territories found plenty of relatively well-paying jobs in Israel. It was only after Palestinian terrorists exploited this freedom of movement to gun down, blow up, and otherwise murder Israeli civilians that the army cracked down.


International law supports these measures. While it is required to grant residents of one territory freedom of movement to reach another territory where they may work, study, or have family, that freedom can be severely restricted should those making use of it pose a threat to the residents of the territory they are passing through (International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, Article 12:3).

Furthermore, prior to 1967, it was no easier for residents of Egyptian-controlled Gaza to relocate to the Jordanian-ruled West Bank, or vice versa. That Gaza and the West Bank make up a single territorial entity and that their people are the same "nation" is a very recent historical phenomenon.

The Jordan River Drying Up Israel Today

The world's most famous river, the Jordan, is a shadow of the legendary body of water crossed by Joshua and the Israelites when they entered the Promised Land (Joshua 3). According to a report by Friends of the Earth Middle East, large parts of the river in which Jesus was baptized could dry up by 2011.

"Since much of the river is a closed military zone and off limits to the public, most people simply do not know that the river is drying up," said the report by a team of Israeli, Palestinian, and Jordanian environmentalists. "Israel, Jordan, and Syria have diverted its upstream waters for domestic and agricultural uses, leaving precious little fresh water for the river and its once thriving ecosystem."

The report recommends that Israel and Jordan rehabilitate the river with water from the Sea of Galilee and treated wastewater. The dilemma is that the lake is already depleted and wastewater is needed for agriculture. So once again, it seems that the only thing that can save the Jordan River is rain!

West Bank Children Tour Israel www.upi.com

A program initiated by the Israeli army gives Palestinian children from the West Bank a chance to visit Israeli tourist sites, an army officer said. The aim of the program is to show Palestinians there is a side of Israel in addition to the one portrayed in Palestinian media, a senior officer in the army's Central Command told the Hebrew daily *Maariv*.

Last year, 5,500 Palestinian children participated in the program and so far this year 22,000 Palestinians have visited Israel, the newspaper said.

"The majority of Palestinian children were born prior to the second intifada or during it and know Israel through the negative images shown on their television," the officer said. "The Palestinian children are accompanied by adults and visit Israel in tour buses without any security presence," the officer added.

Lt. Col. Ofer Meital, head of the Coordination and Liaison Office in areas surrounding Jerusalem, told the newspaper the majority of children have never seen the sea.

"The aim of the project is to show children there is another way of life on the other side of the security barrier," he said.

Among the most popular sites is the beach at Bat Yam, where surrounding rock formation provides a pool of shallow water allowing children who don't know how to swim to enter the water. Other venues that have proven popular are the amusement park in Tel Aviv, the Safari Park in Ramat Gan and the cities of Jaffa and Acre, the report says. The snow-covered Mount Hermon in the north is a popular venue to visit in the winter months, the report said.

Abbas: No Compromise On Jerusalem, Borders

Palestinian Authority President **Mahmoud Abbas** rejected Prime Minister **Benjamin Netanyahu's** talk about an "historic compromise" and said there would be no compromises on core issues such as Jerusalem and borders.

Abbas also reiterated his rejection of Netanyahu's demand that the Palestinians recognize Israel as a Jewish state. "We're not talking about a Jewish state and we won't talk about one," Abbas said in an interview with the semi-official *Al-Quds* [Arabic name for Jerusalem] newspaper. "For us, there is the State of Israel and we won't recognize Israel as a Jewish state."

Abbas said that in recent meetings with leaders of the Jewish community in the U.S.,

he made it clear that the Palestinians would not recognize Israel as a Jewish state. "I told them that this is their business and that they are free to call themselves whatever they want," Abbas said. "But [I told them] you can't expect us to accept this."

Abbas said that by raising the issue of Israel's right to be a Jewish state, Netanyahu was seeking to "strip" Israeli-Arabs of their rights and turn them into illegal citizens. He said that Netanyahu's goal was also to block any chance of Palestinian "refugees" from returning to their original homes inside Israel.

Asked about the possibility of dismantling the PA, Abbas said he did not rule out such an option if he reached the conclusion that the peace talks are hopeless. However, he stressed that this option was not on the table at present.



Muslim Azerbaijan's Brave Support of Israel

In so many ways the world is a giant schoolyard playground. Islam and Sex in the Afterlife

Islamic extremists quote the Koran to justify violence. They believe the words in the Koran are not open to interpretation by man. As the words are Allah's, communicated to the Prophet Mohammed through the Archangel Gabriel, they have only the meaning Allah—and not man—intended.

Yet many words and phrases in the Koran are open to interpretation due to man's imperfection in understanding Allah's intent. Resolving this interpretation is difficult, as no single authoritative, spiritual leader exists for all Islam. While Muslims rely on the Koran for spiritual guidance, a schism within Islam after Mohammed's death left Sunnis and Shias adhering to different beliefs and interpretations due to these ambiguities.

But these ambiguities provide the vehicle by which Islamic extremists issue their violent interpretations of Allah's words. Lost upon followers: in offering their interpretation, the extremists violate their own basic tenet that the Koran's words are those of Allah alone. If, as Islamic extremists suggest, the Koran is given Allah's interpretation alone, upon what basis do they claim the right to interpret Allah's message?

It is interesting to examine an origin of modern day Islamic extremist thinking, which, ironically, was triggered in the U.S. by an act of kindness seeking to include a visiting Muslim scholar.

Egyptian educator Sayyid Qutb came to the U.S. in 1948 to study the educational system. Invited to a church social dinner and dance, he fumed as he watched women dancing suggestively close to their male partners. A confirmed bachelor unable to find a woman of sufficient "moral purity and discretion" to marry, Qutb-in an article very critical of America's immorality-recorded his observations: "The dance floor was replete with tapping feet, enticing legs, arms wrapped around waists, lips pressed to lips, and chests pressed to chests. The atmosphere was full of desire."

Qutb's revulsion over America's animalistic sexuality dominated many of his later writings, which claimed only Islam offered salvation from the West's decay. Returning to Egypt in 1950, he went on to lead the fundamentalist Muslim Brotherhood—before being executed in 1966 for plotting against the government. His writings and ideas ultimately were an inspiration for Osama bin Laden, shaping al-Qaeda.

It is interesting to compare Qutb's criticism of Western moral decay to the debauchery of the afterlife the Koran promises loyal followers. What Qutb witnessed in America was quite tame in comparison.

Nuclear Scientist Sees No God-Science Conflict

Nuclear scientist Gerald Schroeder ('59, SM '61, PhD '65) sees no conflict between religion and science. On the contrary, he sees them as linked. He's explored that link in several books, including *Genesis and the Big Bang* and *The Science of God*, and writes about the Bible and science for many prominent journals.

"For years, I never considered the relationship," Schroeder says. "Then, as our kids asked questions, I started to study biblical philosophy. The deeper I dug, the more amazing the confluence between ancient biblical commentary and modern scientific discoveries—with no bending of either the Bible or the science."

Schroeder also sees little conflict between Judeo-Christian religion and the possession of nuclear weapons for national defense: "Unilateral nuclear disarmament is a path to global war," he says. "Don't just pray for peace. Work for peace."

A chance meeting in 1962 with physics professor Robley Evans, a nuclear-medicine pioneer, led to Schroeder's thesis work on radioactivity. That research, in turn, led him to a role working with the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission on disarmament and radiation control in the 1960s.

Schroeder, who was also the first foreigner to serve as a science advisor for the People's Republic of China after the Cultural Revolution, continues to consult with the governments of several nations. In addition, he lectures worldwide and teaches classes on science and the Bible at the Aish HaTorah College of Jewish Studies in Jerusalem.

Schroeder, who has lived in Israel since 1971, bicycles to work through old Jerusalem. The country "is a pressure cooker," he says, but has a "fantastic emphasis on family and kids." Schroeder and his wife, author **Barbara Sofer**, have five grown children.

His move to Israel—where he joined the Weizmann Institute of Science and then the Volcani Research Institute at the Hebrew University—followed seven years on MIT's faculty, where he worked in the physics department's radioactivity center.

"MIT opened every door," Schroeder says. "It may have even convinced Barbara to marry me. I am fully beholden to MIT. Not the facts that we learned in the classes, but the approach to being willing to confront seemingly impossible problems."
