Why Are Jews Targets of Hate Crimes?

In the words of Eric Dinowitz, a Jewish politician in New York City, "Hate is on the rise — and the high-profile cases on the news are often the endpoint of hate." Speaking particularly about hatred and violence against Jewish people, he added, "We see the assaults in Hell's Kitchen and Times Square. We see mass murders at synagogues and supermarkets. And what this report card shows us are those seeds of hate are the precursors to physical violence."

Dinowitz was referring to the 2023 Digital Terrorism and Hate Report Card from the Simon Wiesenthal Center. (See sidebar article.)

What motivates such attitudes and actions? Why do Jews, among all racial and religious groups, remain the greatest hate crime target? And why are Jews targeted by both White Supremacists and Black Supremacists?

False Claims

One group noted in the report was the Black Hebrew Israelites. They claim to be

Increasing Social Media Anti-Semitism, Holocaust Denial

The Simon Wiesenthal Center recently released its 25th annual "Digital Terrorism and Hate Report Card." The report warns especially of increased

anti-Semitic and racist messaging that calls for violence against Black, immigrant, and Jewish residents.


Part of the report grades social-media companies on their failure to curb online hate. Google and YouTube received a "B-"; Facebook and Instagram received a "C"; TikTok got a "D"; Twitter a "D-"; and Telegram an "F." Amazon earned a "C" on the report card.

the Simon Wiesenthal Center, stressed that TikTok is of prime concern, though not for the politics behind its Chinese ownership. "It's solely the fact that they have something like 1 billion users. A good percentage of those are young people... in the neighborhood of 30% to 40%." Eaton cited TikTok postings by Holocaust deniers and minimizers, and a hateful meme of Anne Frank, next to material lauding school shooters, racists, and other bigots.

Eaton added, however, that the largest amount of hateful content is found on Telegram. Meanwhile, the report criticizes Twitter, which had largely cleaned up ISIS and white supremacist-heavy content, for allowing Nazis and Holocaust deniers back on the site under its current management.

The report also calls out Amazon for



its "monetization of hate." The e-commerce site includes items for sale including swastika jewelry and a skull mask associated with neo-Nazi groups, which are linked together through Amazon's "other people bought this" algorithm.

Eaton explained that online hate hasn't just evolved or shifted to different sites. It's getting worse—and rapidly so. "It's gone more mainstream," he emphasized, adding that there are "people [who] are posting and seeing this stuff [who] would have never done it even two or three years ago."

the true Israelites, even supplying a chart that purports to connect the 12 Tribes of Israel to various people groups in North and South America. But they also deny that the Jewish people (including me) are true Jews.

In their eyes, we are the "synagogue of Satan" (based on a misinterpretation of Revelation 2:9 and 3:9) and "white Edomite devils." (According to this cult, Jacob's son Esau, also called Edom, was white, and White Jews today are his devilish descendants.)

Regularly, we receive comments like this on our YouTube channel: "Hitler is an Idumean [= Edomite] devil like yourself Dr. Brown. The holocaust never happened. So stop lying to the world." This was posted by someone named "The Tribe of Levi"!

If that's not enough, according to the Black Hebrew Israelite chart used by the Sicarii — the most militant sect among them — the people of Haiti today are the tribe of Levi!

I recently debated the leader of the Sicarii regarding "Who Are the Legitimate Children of Israel? Ashkenazi Jews or the 12 Tribe Chart?" During the debate, I challenged him on his rhetoric, including his words from February 2022:

"That's the future of this world. Black and Latino people ruling the world. [Jesus Christ] is a big angry black man, a black man who the whites of his eyes are red and He's ready to come and kill. He wants to stomp people's brains out of their cranium. He wants to step on you people's heads until your brains come out."

I assure you that "you people" includes those of us who are not people of color, especially White Jews.

My quotation of these words at the end of the debate only brought a smile to his face, along with lots of affirmation from his followers in the large chat. (There were as many as 4,500 people watching at once on the host's channel.)

A Serious Issue

But this is no joking matter. In March 2022, data released by the New York Police Department revealed that anti-Semitic hate crimes the previous month were up 400%. One news article noted, "Many of these incidents targeted Orthodox people dressed in

distinctive clothing, like the Jewish man who was punched in Bed-Stuy on Feb. 7 while walking on Shabbat."

And what is a typical Black Hebrew Israelite response to this? "This Edomite [meaning me, when I referenced such crimes during the debate] showed himself to be a devil. He said 'fake' Jews are being attacked by African Americans."

Words Have Consequences

Attitudes of hatred will lead to acts of hatred. But the question remains: Why? Why the Jews?

When I debunk the nonsense of the "12 Tribes Chart," I feel no animosity toward any of the peoples on the chart, including Mexicans (who are supposedly the lost tribe of Issachar!) or the Seminole Indians (supposedly the lost tribe of Reuben!) or African Americans (supposedly the tribe of Judah!). And, based on the comments I see when I address these things, no one who agrees with me feels animosity because of these people being fake Israelites. (To be clear, there are Black and Hispanic Jews. But, the information on the chart should be rejected as utterly false.)

Yet when the Black Hebrew Israelites call Ashkenazi Jews (and other Jews) "fake Jews," it triggers visceral hatred and anger towards us. Why?

Reasons and Responses

First, these Black Americans, who have suffered greatly at the hands of White Americans in the past, have fastened their resentment and anger on White Americans today, in particular White Jews.

Second, anti-Semitism is demonic and needs no rational explanation. As Sigmund Freud commented in 1927, "With regard to anti-Semitism, I don't really want to search for explanations; I feel a strong inclination to surrender my affects in this matter and find myself confirmed in my wholly nonscientific belief that mankind on the average and taken by and large are a wretched lot."

What we can say with assurance is that we must confront these hateful attitudes and ideologies wherever we find them, since they will not go away on their own. And we must determine to overcome hatred with love and lies with truth. It's a long battle, but it's a winning strategy.

In a world where most people are screaming for equality on every level, such hatred saddens and confounds me! —Kirsten

Stolen!

When my purse was stolen in December 2007, while I sat at a Barcelona hotel lobby computer, I couldn't figure out why the Lord had allowed it to happen.

As I was working on the computer, I spotted two guys standing by a parked car outside, and a blond guy at the other computer station about 10 feet away. Then, I saw the blond man get up and leave. Later I realized that he was the one who took my purse even though I felt nothing. I still don't know how he got it.

I got up to leave about 20 minutes later. As I grabbed my coat, I realized



that my purse that had been underneath the coat was gone! The hotel manager looked my direction when I loudly stated, "My purse is gone!" The thief had taken my passport, driver's license, phone, and money.

When my family members returned to the hotel, my daughter-in-law and granddaughter saw my agitated estate. My oldest son immediately used the same computer I'd been on to search for a number to cancel my phone.

My youngest son, daughter-in-law, and I took the Metro to the police station at night in a rough part of town to report the incident. I completed their form, got a copy, and then went back to the hotel. I could not sleep well for several days as I continued to relive the incident and ask *why* the Lord allowed this to happen to me.

About a week after returning home, I received my cell phone bill and saw seven calls that were made by the thief. An Internet search on those numbers came



up empty. I thought that it was odd, however, that he used my phone without using a country code. Then, I noticed a calling pattern.

The Reason

I decided to report those numbers to the Barcelona police. I found the police department's website, where I posted the numbers. I also reported the information to the U.S. Consulate.

Approximately ten days after emailing that information, I watched Good Morning America and heard, "Breaking news out of Barcelona: A terrorist ring has been caught." I heard an audible voice saying, "That is the reason I allowed your purse to be stolen." The hairs on my neck and arms stood up! And each time I retell the story, those hairs stand up again.

There has been an amazing resurgence of the nonsense called, variously, "Replacement Theology," "Dominion Theology," and so forth, in tandem with the insistence on a Middle East peace conference. Theological anti-Semites rejoice as Israel gets a political black eye. In order to make Israel look like the bad guys, [President George H.W.] Bush and [Secretary of State James] Baker constantly

style that nation as intransigent and difficult. Unbelievably, they also characterize the murderous dictatorships surrounding Israel as reasonable. Trading With the Arabs

The whole world awaits the pleasure of a few Arab thugs. I'm beginning to wonder if this is what we got for Israel — the release of a few unfortunates. If we have traded away the Promised Land to the Arabs for our hostages, we have made the spiritual mistake of the millennium. We look ridiculous thanking terrorist regimes for their good manners in returning those they kidnapped, and even crazier blaming Israel for any of this.

Israel does not take hostages. It is being pressured to release bona fide criminals to pay for those innocents incarcerated in Lebanon at rates like one hundred to one. And we celebrate Syria each time a hostage is simply driven there to be dispatched to his own country, as if that primeval "government" had anything to do with the goodwill.

Prior to the Russian problem, which changed all the headlines, the administration was reaping huge benefits in good publicity for the odd release of a hostage here and there. Again, we had the Kennebunkport effect: Bush was fishing as the results of paying off Arab kidnappers rolled in. But watch carefully for whatever we paid in this most recent round of negotiations with the hostage takers (with whom we are pledged never to negotiate). Just watch what the Israelis are forced to give up this time as they pay our bill.

The Problem

One commentator stated, 'The problem seems to be Israel's insistence on holding its prisoners." I personally thought the problem was kidnapping by the Arabs. In 1985 Israel gave up 1,100 *prisoners* (not innocent hostages) for three captured Israeli soldiers. No one seems to notice that that democracy has begged for years to merely hear news of their seven missing soldiers. Israel, which values human life, will likely agree to release 400 prisoners for more news of their seven MIAs. It's hardly in question that we have paid the kidnappers — that's what kidnappers work for: ransom money (though Arab cultures give glory for hostage taking, too). While the United Nations is working on the fate of these six

or seven people still incarcerated in Lebanon, 40,000 children per day continue dying in the Third World.

What's Coming

We live in prophetic times during which the world is setting up the Tribulation Period. Animosity toward Israel is only to be expected. Our Lord, a full-blooded Israeli, told His Israeli



disciples, "Ye shall be hated of all nations..." (Matt. 24:9). In order for such a minuscule nation of relatively unimportant people to become despised globally, a lot of hatred has to be generated beforehand. Evidently, that is what we're seeing happen. I'm only sorry, as an American, that our administration is being used in this regard.

Apparently, the antiChrist will justify his invasion of Israel (see 2 Thess. 2:3–4) by a world attitude that we help put in place. Our liberal churches—the natural constituency of the "son of perdition"—are eagerly subscribing to the new anti-Israel attitudes, even to the point of sending aid to Israel's enemies. Our Lord will remember their awful works in His name when He pronounces His judgment upon them: "Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these My brethren, ye have done it unto Me" (Matt. 25:40).

What is Glorification?

Glorification is the future aspect of salvation. It is the completion of the ordo salutis (Latin for "order of salvation"), as the Apostle Paul noted in Romans 8:29–30.

The Order of Salvation:

- Salvation begins with election —
 God's act of determining or choosing based
 upon a person's calling to hear the Gospel
 (John 6:44; Rom. 8:30; Eph. 1:4–5).
- This is followed by justification becoming right with God by repentance (turning from sin) and faith in Jesus Christ (Rom. 3:21–26).

- Next comes sanctification the process of a Believer growing in holiness to become more like the Lord Jesus (2 Pet. 3:18).
- The final process in a Believer's salvation is glorification At the return of Jesus Christ, all saints (those who have been saved) will be transformed our lowly bodies will become like His glorious body (Phil. 3:21). "It has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is" (1 John 3:2).



When Jesus returns, all dead Christians will be physically resurrected from their graves. All living Believers will be caught up with them to meet the Lord in the air (1 Thess. 4:14–17). This blessed hope is noted in Titus 2:13. We will all be transformed with glorious new bodies — the mortal changed to immortal and the corruptible changed to incorruptible (1 Cor. 15:52–54).

This blessed hope should spur us on to holiness, just as the Lord Jesus desires for us and enables us: "Everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure" (1 John 3:3). According to Romans 8:30, the future glorification of Believers is an accomplished fact in God's mind, though it's yet to occur.

Floyd H. Barackman, writing in *Practical Christian Theology*, noted: "Glorification speaks of the completeness of Gospel Believers (Romans 8:23; 13:11) ... when Jesus returns for His Church ... and later for [future] redeemed people when He returns to Earth to establish His millennial kingdom (Rev. 20:4–6; Matt. 8:11)."

At glorification, redeemed humanity will be restored to a perfect state, like Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden before the Fall. Unlike in the beginning, however, the redeemed will exist forever in this sinless, perfect state! Creation will also one day experience this glorified state. After Christ's millennial reign on Earth will come a new Heaven and a new Earth (Rev. 21:1), without imperfection. At that time, God's glory will permeate everything, and God will "be all in all" (1 Cor. 15:28).

"For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified."

—Romans 8:29-30





Gospel Ministry in Jerusalem

During our October 2022 Gospel outreach to Israel, we spent time in Jerusalem. After praying at the Western Wall, August Rosado and I walked to the Jewish section of the Old City. God led us to a small art gallery where we met **Michal**, who was friendly and open to us.

We explained to her that there are prophecies proclaiming that the Messiah would be the Son of God and divine (Psalm 2:7; 110:1). Michal was willing to accept Yeshua as God's Son, but like many Jews, could not accept that He was divine. Therefore, we noted the Messianic prophecy of Micah 5:2, which foretold that the King Messiah, who would be born in Bethlehem, would also be the eternal God.

Michal responded that the majority of Jews don't reject Jesus as being a great rabbi. Rather, they reject the Christian faith because of how His followers carried out violence in His name against the Jewish people. August and I agreed with her in principle but added that such mistreatment was largely done by counterfeit Christians. In contrast, true Believers in Yeshua love His ethnic people for the sake of Messiah, God, and His Word (Romans 9:4–5).

We encouraged Michal to read both Testaments of the Bible to discover that God has given Messianic prophecy to identify the one and only true Messiah. We added that Yeshua is the only Person in Jewish history to fulfill all of the prophecies related to Messiah's First Coming. And, Yeshua the Messiah will fulfill the remaining prophecies of the Second Coming at His return to Israel.

Michal gladly accepted a copy of the complete Hebrew Bible from us and said that she would read it. She also welcomed our offer to visit her again when we return to Israel in 2023. At that time, we hope to talk about what she is learning from the Bible and Messianic Gospel tracts that we gave her, which prove that Jesus is the Son of God—the Divine Messiah who came and is coming again.

Bashing Israel Pays Really Well, Admits Anti-Israel Activist

Norman Finkelstein is a former professor who is known for his defense of the Palestinian cause and fierce criticism of Israel. Recently, he admitted that there is good money to be had due to the age-old conflict, which helps perpetuate the clash rather than bring peace to the region.

Anti-Israel activist Norman Finkelstein, son of Holocaust survivors

"Whenever a cause has gone on so long as this one has, people develop an investment in its perpetuation," Finkelstein asserted in an undated video clip. Canary Mission, which documents anti-Semitism and anti-Israel activism by students and staff at North American universities, recently publicized the clip from one of Finkelstein's speeches.

"There are 10,000 NGOs [non-govern-mental organizations] in Ramallah now," explained the former academic whose expertise is in the Arab-Israeli conflict. Finkelstein openly sides with the Palestinians in his many books on the subject. "That means 10,000 organizations [that] are paid for by foreign countries, mostly European, to 'facilitate' the peace process. And if you're in an NGO, compared to the salaries of ordinary Palestinians, it's quite good."

"Ramallah [has] a pretty impressive lifestyle now," he continued with a

half-smile. "And so, you develop a stake in perpetuating the situation... you don't even want to think about realistic solutions, because part of you doesn't even want it to end."

He readily acknowledged that he was one of those who was so invested. "I have to admit myself—let's say it

ended tomorrow, what am I going to do tomorrow? I have to fight that."

In the past, Finkelstein made tens of thousands of dollars a year speaking to Palestinian solidarity groups in the U.S. and Canada. A decade ago, however, he came out against the Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) movement. Finkelstein says that BDS's anti-Israel agenda is backed by international law but "hypocritically" ignores the fact that international law

established Israel as a Jewish state, and thus it has a right to exist.

Since then, his once-solid popularity plummeted among the Palestinian faithful, even though the son of Holocaust survivors never stopped bashing Israel. He has famously claimed that Israel exploits the Holocaust to justify its "crimes" against the Palestinians, compared Israeli treatment of Palestinians to that of the Nazis, called the country a "satanic" state, and declared his solidarity with the Hezbollah and Hamas terrorist organizations.

Finkelstein has also said that while the "pragmatic" solution to the Middle East conflict is that of two states, the preferable one is that of one binational state. Nonetheless, he acknowledged that this would be tantamount to Israel giving up "its existence, its rationale, and the security of all its Jewish citizens."

Read Hebrew right to left!



All of us have unhealed parts— "hidden faults" (נָס'תּרוֹת) of which we are not fully aware. Thus, King David

prayed, "Who can discern their errors? Cleanse me from secret faults" (Ps. 19:12). We are cleansed by confession, that is,

by looking within our hearts to uncover deeper motivations. If we are honest with ourselves, we may discover, for example, that we are angry or fearful people, despite how we otherwise would like to regard ourselves.

If you find yourself unable to release something, such as pain or failure from the past, remind yourself that you must do so if you want to move ahead with your life. When we focus on how things could have been different, we become enslaved to the past. The goal of *teshuvah* (repentance) is to turn back to God for life. To do this, however, we must be willing to let go of what makes us sick.

The Hebrew word translated "errors" (נשָׁגִיאוֹת) comes from a root word (שַׁגָּראוֹת) that means "to wander, stray, or transgress." David's question is rhetorical: Who can discern their errors?" The answer is that no one can ... apart from the Lord's help.

David sought to be cleansed from his

"secret faults." These are not actions that he did in secret; rather, they were unknown or unconscious to him. These are "mindless" sins—unthinking offenses, hidden dispositions, and character defects and actions - that a person unwittingly commits, perhaps because of the influence of unseen spiritual forces of evil. These are the "secret sins" set in the light of God's face (Psalm 90:8). They stem from the sluggish darkness of the human heart, and can lead to death and ruin: "The heart is deceitful above all things, and incurably sick; who can understand it?" (Jer. 17:9). How many of us, after all, are always fully aware of what we are doing when we are doing something? How many of us are completely transparent both to ourselves and before God, with no unclear motives?

We must always be vigilant regarding our habits, subconscious desires, or conflicts of the inner life. These seek to work against us, along with the trauma of our past and the present devices from the enemy of our souls. May the Lord give us the desire to be healed and the willingness to seek healing from Him, even if parts of ourselves seem to resist that healing. Amen.

"We know that if God should put to the test our faithfulness to Him, we know well that at the moment of testing, He Himself must hold on to us, that is, we know that at bottom we are unfaithful, and that every instant it is He who at bottom holds us."







The Stones Cry Out DVD Set

Twelve 30-minute TV programs (3 DVDs)

Archaeological discoveries continue to validate the Biblical record. To film "dig" sites and interview experts, Zola journeyed to Israel and Jordan. Just as our Lord said about this remarkable Land, *The Stones Cry Out*.

The Tunnel Zola walks the tunnel under the western edge of the Temple Mount. We get a journalist's perspective of the Palestinian uproar that erupted when the tunnel was opened to the public in 1996.

A Tale of Two Temples An unearthed marketplace shows the Roman destruction of the Temple. Mount Gerizim to the north hosts the excavation of a Samaritan temple patterned after the Jerusalem Temple.

Rulers in Stone Caesarea, on Israel's Mediterranean coast, has yielded first-century finds such as the first extra-Biblical reference to Pontius Pilate, and a full-size Temple replica. At Tel Dan, the "House of David" has been confirmed archaeologically.

The Jerusalem That Was Bible Lands Museum houses a model of Jerusalem as it would have looked in 586 B.C. In the City of David, we examine a four-room house, typical architecture for ancient Israelites.

Past and Future Destruction Ongoing excavations at Hazor have unearthed Canaanite idols and confirmation of the city burning as recorded in Joshua 11. The Valley of Armageddon holds prophetic archaeological significance.

Archaeology and the Scriptures In Jerusalem, Zola explains the history of the Citadel, also called "David's Tower." We talk with the Israel Antiquities Authority.

Cities of the Past Zippori was a thriving cultural center in Galilee that probably influenced Jesus as a boy in Nazareth. Ekron was one of five prominent Old Testament cities of the Philistines.

Shadows from the Past A chamber of tombs, near the Garden Tomb but dated to the time of the First Temple, helps us understand burial customs of that day. We visit the Qumran cave where the first Dead Sea Scroll was found.

A Tale of Three Cities In Biblical times, a business relationship existed between three Jordan Valley cities: Beit Shean, Rehovot (west of the Jordan River), and Pella (east of the Jordan River). We visit excavations in each city.

The Rose Red City The ancient Nabataeans were famous for their skill in rock carving. Petra, their capital southeast of the Dead Sea, is the "rose-red city" known for its magnificent buildings carved into the native rock.


A Man Crucified On display at the Rockefeller Museum in Jerusalem, a man's heel bone that was pierced by a nail is the first archaeological proof of Roman crucifixions in Israel.

Truth from the Stones Zola discusses how the artifacts shown throughout this series illuminate Scripture, and how Believers can be encouraged when *The Stones Cry Out*.

It wasn't until adulthood, after I surrendered my life

to Yeshua and started my journey of faith, that I started to learn how to live Torah observant and recognized the traditions I was taught as a child.

I live in the Adirondack mountains of upstate New York, with no access to Messianic fellowship or teaching. From B.C.: Thank you for my continued subscription to the *Levitt Letter*. I always learn a lot from it, even though I've been studying the Bible for over 30 years. Keep up the excellent work!

Can you tell me if Greece is primarily a Christian nation, or is it still polytheistic, as my friend claims? Also, do you know if there are many Jewish people in Greece now?

Dear B.C.,

Pew Research shows that as of 2017, 90% of Greece was Orthodox Christian with 3% other Christian, 2% Muslim, and 4% unaffiliated (atheist, not religious, etc.). There are some Greeks who believe in the ancient polytheism, but this number was only about 2,000 in 2005.

Before WWII, about 77,000 Jews lived in Greece, but 60,000 perished in the Holocaust. As of 2020, the Jewish population was between 4,000 and 6,000. — Greg H., levitt.com webmaster







Heating & Cooling Your House with Humidity

What if you could heat or cool your home just by pulling the desired comfort level from the air? Israeli startup ThermoTerra is turning that vision into reality by harvesting energy from fluctuations in humidity.

"Water vapor in the air that's absorbed onto or into an absorptive material transfers a significant amount of energy," explained Dror Zchori, the company's founder and CEO.

We know this intuitively. When water evaporates, it causes a cooling effect. We see this in the human body — when we're hot, we produce sweat. As sweat evaporates, it keeps us from overheating. But when

water vapor is absorbed or condenses on a material, the opposite occurs—it generates heat.

On a hot day, ThermoTerra's technology brings ambient warm and dry air



into a home or office.
Using special materials that can absorb a large amount of water — hempcrete, silica gel, or

wood wool insulation are especially effective — the system uses humidity variations to "charge" the insulation in the building's walls. This becomes drier in winter or damper in summer, and then air is forced through the material to release hot or cold air as necessary. By constantly passing such ambient air through its system, ThermoTerra smooths out the peaks and valleys so that both temperature and humidity cycles are shallower, resulting in greater comfort.

The system is controlled by sensors embedded in the walls. Smart algorithms monitor when to bring in hot or cold air



and when to release it, learning owner preferences and automatically adjusting the temperature accordingly. It can also utilize weather forecasts. "If it's hot now but the system knows that in a week it will be cold, it can store water in advance." Zchori noted.

ThermoTerra requires integrating a structure of ducts and conduits into a new wall. In existing buildings, a new façade with built-in insulation and ducts can be added to the walls. Though the technology takes up a few inches, Zchori explained that it can reduce heating and cooling costs by at least half.

A smart fan inserted into the wall, controlled by the algorithms, moves the hot or cold air around as required. This is the only part of the system that requires electricity.

The need for technologies like Thermo-Terra is indisputable: Some 40% of the world's building energy is spent on heating and cooling, and buildings represent 30% of the world's energy usage.

Zchori estimates it will cost around \$3,400 to install the system in a home of about 1,000 square feet. \Rightarrow

Using Avocado Seeds to Treat Skin Conditions

A compound developed from discarded avocado seeds can repair damage to human skin caused by UV radiation, pollution, aging, and other stressors. Israeli startup AvoMed manufactures PFA (polyhydroxylated fatty alcohols) from avocado seeds. These fats enhance personal care products and treat skin conditions such as psoriasis.

Avocado seeds, which can make up almost a fifth of the fruit's mass, are a byproduct of the food industry left in factories that produce guacamole, frozen avocados, avocado oil, and other products. The PFA extraction is a clean and zero-waste process. Any residue from the process yields high nutritional values as animal feed.

AvoMed also develops a line of PFA-based cosmetics aimed at those interested in the care, relief, and protection of the skin using natural materials. Its products have been studied by many academic institutions in Israel, including the Technion and Weizmann Institute, as well as by the Skin Axis laboratories in New Jersey.

The U.S. alone consumes over 2.7 billion pounds of avocados each year. Discarding the seeds, which comprise 13–18% of the fruit, is an expensive process that requires controlled treatment. In the process of a seed's natural decomposition, an active substance is released that pollutes the soil. AvoMed, however, utilizes avocado seeds and makes it possible to turn the waste treatment costs into profit for companies. This also benefits the environment by preventing further waste.

The company has four registered and approved patents in Israel and the U.S. In addition, four patent registration applications were submitted in the European Union, the U.S., and China, which are in various stages of approval. Founded in 2016, AvoMed is based in Rosh Pina, Israel.



Groups Urge UN to Reject Anti-Semitism Definition

Sixty groups that often oppose Israel recently urged the United Nations (UN) to reject the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance's (IHRA) working definition of anti-Semitism. The definition—adopted by 39 countries, including the U.S.—"has often been used to wrongly label criticism of Israel as anti-Semitic," the groups stated in their letter addressed to UN Secretary-General António Guterres and Under-Secretary-General Miguel Ángel Moratinos.

Signatories include the Presbyterian Church (USA), with some 1.19 million members, and the global

ministry arm of the United Methodist Church, which has a membership of more than 12 million, as well as the American Civil Liberties Union, Human Rights Watch, and the Palestinian Center for Human Rights.

Three Israeli-designated terror organizations also signed the letter.

"If the UN endorses the IHRA definition in any shape or form, UN officials working on issues related to Israel and Palestine may find themselves unjustly accused of anti-Semitism based on the IHRA definition," added the groups.

Earlier this year, Gilad Erdan, Israeli Ambassador to the UN, stated: "The U.N. was founded upon the ashes of the Holocaust. It was established to ensure such darkness would never be felt by humanity again. Yet, when it comes to fighting anti-Semitism, sadly, the U.N. ignores its purpose. When it comes to anything related to Israel, this organization is very quick to respond and condemn. When it comes to Jew-hatred, the silence is deafening. The double standard is disgraceful."

Israel is a Leader in Volunteering

Almost half of the population (42.5%) of Israel volunteered their time in 2022.

The annual survey on volunteerism in Israel revealed that Israel is one of the leading countries in volunteering, along with Canada (79%), Britain (63%), Australia (57%), and New Zealand (51%). Those





countries ranked ahead of Switzerland (39.9%), the Netherlands (39%), and the U.S. (25%).

Most Israeli respondents noted that they preferred to volunteer in areas of welfare and assisting disadvantaged populations, followed by education, health, environment, religion, and social change.

The study indicated a balance between males (42.6%) and females (42.2%). Among age groups, 34% aged 18–34 said they volunteered on a regular basis. This compares to 47.9% of people aged 35–54 and 42% of those who are 55 and older.

Israelis with post-secondary education and those with higher-than-average incomes reported higher rates of volunteering. Sector-wise, the highest rate of volunteering was reported among the ultra-Orthodox (60%).

Commenting on the survey, President Isaac Herzog said, "Today, perhaps more than ever, it is up to us to boost social involvement and choose to see what unites us and brings us closer, not what divides and separates us."

Palestinian Arab Saves Jewish Couple from Ambush

A young Jewish couple had a narrow escape recently after Palestinian Arabs attempted to ambush them on a road near Karmei Tzur, north of Hebron.

Amichai and Nitsan Baron were driving home on a highway through the Judean Hills around 3:00 a.m. when they encountered a "heap of rocks" on the road. "I tailed a Palestinian car whose driver had also seen the rocks and swerved, but I didn't make it and ended up hitting the rocks," noted Amichai.

A number of Palestinian Arab youths appeared suddenly and started throwing rocks at the Barons' car. At that time, "M," a local Arab whose home overlooks the site of the incident, heard what was happening and went outside to call to the Barons to seek refuge in his home.

"At first, we were scared to go into his house, but then we realized that he genuinely wanted to help us," Amichai added. "I don't want to think about what might have happened otherwise, if he hadn't been there for us."

The Barons alerted security forces and a number of soldiers soon arrived to escort them in a military vehicle from M's home to their home. They left their vehicle behind, but when they returned for it the following morning, they found that it had been smashed with rocks and set on fire.

Ancient Pottery Found in Cave Near Popular Beach

A team of Israeli archaeologists felt like they had entered a set of an Indiana Jones film, or perhaps DreamWork's *Prince of Egypt*, after discovering a burial cave containing dozens of intact objects from the time of Pharaoh Ramses II—thought to possibly be the pharaoh of the Hebrew Exodus from Egypt. The cave was uncovered just south of Tel Aviv in the Palmachim National Park, near one of Israel's most popular beaches.

The ancient burial cave was discovered by chance during work by the Nature and Parks Authority for the development of the park and after a tractor hit a rock, unexpectedly revealing the cave's ceiling.







Frozen in time

Dror Citron, an official with the Israel Antiquities Authority (IAA), was the first to identify the space. He also descended into the cave that seemed frozen in time. It contained dozens of whole pottery and bronze vessels just as they were placed during the burial ceremony, about 3,300 years ago.

The vessels were burial offerings, buried with the dead in the belief that

they would be used by them in the next world. The cave was carved in the shape of a square, and in the center of its ceiling was a pillar.

"This is a once-in-a-lifetime find," explained Dr. Eli Yanai, an IAA expert on the Bronze Age. "It's not every day that you see an Indiana Jones set—a cave with vessels on the floor that haven't been touched in 3,300 years. We are talking about the Late Bronze Age. These are precisely the days of the famous king, Ramses II—the one some identify with the story of the Exodus."

What the findings reveal

Since the cave was intact, Yanai said that it can provide a complete picture of burial customs in the Late Bronze Age. "In the cave, mainly dozens of pottery vessels of various sizes and shapes were left. Among them, there are deep and shallow bowls, some of which are painted red, cooking pots, jugs, and clay candles that contained oil for light," he explained.


Israeli archaeologists think that the jugs and other vessels were made on the coasts of Lebanon and Syria, the area of Tyre and Sidon, with pottery that might have come from Cyprus.

The findings in the cave date to the 13th century B.C., a period during the 19th Egyptian dynasty and the rule of Ramses II who placed an Egyptian administration over the land. There was free trade during that period across the region, and the findings prove that, Yanai added. They reveal that the ancient residents of Yavne along the Palmachim coast were integrated into the trade that was conducted along the Mediterranean shores.

Spreading like wildfire

The IAA said that since the discovery of the cave — and despite attempts to keep a media blackout on it — word got out and some people gained access and stole some of the objects.

"Rumors about the discovery of the cave spread through the scientific world like wildfire, and we received many requests from researchers to join the archaeological dig," explained Eli Eskosido, IAA director general. "Unfortunately, during the time before the cave was sealed, and despite

guarding it, a number of archaeological items were stolen from the cave, and the matter is under investigation."

Eskosido added that the IAA would soon "formulate the method of carrying out the required research and conservation at the unique site, which is a celebration of the archaeological world and the ancient history of the Land of Israel."

Anti-Semitism

Michigan City's Elected Leadership Riddled with Anti-Semites CTY OF



America's first all-Muslim city council in Hamtramck, Michigan passed a proclamation in February "opposing military aid to all repressive governments." While making ambiguous statements about "the right of every occupied nation to gain freedom, sovereignty and independence," the declaration specifically mentions the plight of "the Palestinian people."

The resolution was a poorly-concealed attempt to demonize the State of Israel. Moreover, it came from a city government steeped in anti-Semitism and hatred of the Jewish state.

Surrounded by inner-city Detroit, Hamtramck is a century-old enclave with a growing Muslim majority. In 2021, the city elected an all-Muslim city council and mayor. The new leadership quickly implemented controversial reforms, including passing an at-home animal sacrifice ordinance.

Both current and former city leaders are deeply immersed in anti-Israel activism. Their social media accounts are flooded with everything from offensive conspiracy theories to hateful tropes about Jews and Israel.

Last July, an investigation of Mayor Amer Ghalib revealed startling anti-Black and anti-Semitic Facebook posts. Besides mocking George Floyd protesters as alcoholics and thieves, the mayor accused Arab leaders and their followers of being secret Jews and "liked" a Facebook comment referring to Jews as "monkeys" who tax "the air we breathe." When residents confronted the mayor about the offensive posts, Ghalib denied any wrongdoing and called his critics "parasites." He subsequently deleted his Facebook history.

City council member Khalil Al-Refai's Facebook page documents his attendance at multiple "Free Palestine" protests. In at least two posts regarding Israel, Al-Refai offered a

prayer to "plant firmly our feet and give us victory over the disbelieving people." One post includes an image of a masked Palestinian armed with a stone and a slogan that mocks Israel for failing "to win" against a poorly armed and underfunded enemy.

The social media account of Nayeem Choudhury, another city council member, includes video of a burning Israeli flag and violent clashes between Israelis and Palestinians. In 2016, Choudhury shared a post claiming, "Jews are much safer under Muslims then (sic) Zionism." More recently, he deplored "massacres, genocide, and innocent children being killed by Israel every day."

A deeply offensive image shared in 2021 by council member Mohammed Hassan depicts a monkey with Jewish sidecurls and wearing a cap with the Star of David and text that reads: "Israel the real terrorist!!!"

From repeating tropes about Jewish power to making bombastic and blatantly false accusations of genocide and apartheid to depicting Jews as monkeys and infidels, Hamtramck's elected leaders have embraced the worst forms of anti-Jewish bigotry.


