In the early 1990s, I attended a dinner in New York City sponsored by a Jerusalem foundation. It was highlighted by a dialogue between Henry Kissinger and Fouad Ajami, which was moderated by Dan Rather. (Ajami was a Lebanese-born university professor who often appeared as a talking head on TV as an expert on the Middle East.) At one point that evening, Prof. Ajami noted that when Saddam Hussein used nerve gas on his own people, the U.N. said *nothing*. But when Israel uses tear gas, it draws international rebuke.

It's the same today, except worse. Much worse.

Israel experiences the most horrific bloodbath in any one day since the Holocaust, with details too sickening to repeat yet again, and who gets blamed? *Israel!* 

In the words of the infamous document signed by 31 student groups at Harvard, "We, the

### Most Palestinians Support Terrorism Against Jews, Hate U.S.

A poll conducted in November 2023 found that the overwhelming majority of Palestinians not only support the October 7 terrorist attacks against Israel but also hate the U.S.

The poll by the Arab World for Research and Development surveyed 668 Palestinians in the West Bank and Gaza Strip as Israel conducted

military operations to root out the terrorists responsible for the attacks.

Key findings from the poll:

- 86.7% now have a "decreased" conviction of wanting a "peaceful solution" with Israel. Only 9.1% have an "increased" conviction.
- 68% said that their support for a twostate solution has "decreased." Only 22.9% said that it increased.
- 89.5% say that their "conviction" for wanting to coexist with Israelis has "decreased." Only 7.2% say that it has increased.
- 98% say that their "sense of pride as a Palestinian" has increased since the terrorist attacks, including 94.3% who said that they felt that way to a "great extent."
- 75% of Palestinians directly said that they supported the brutal October 7 terrorist attacks — in which babies were beheaded or burned alive, entire

families were massacred, women and young girls were violently raped, soldiers beheaded, and more — against Israel. 59.3% said that they "extremely support[ed]" the attacks.

- 76% said that they viewed the Hamas terrorist organization positively while only 22.3% viewed Hamas negatively.
- 97.3% viewed Israel very negatively.
- 97.6% viewed the U.S. very negatively.
- 84.2% viewed the Islamic Jihad terrorist organization positively.
- 64% viewed Iran negatively (perhaps because they want Iran to join the fight against Israel).
- The Palestinians mostly hated all other surrounding countries and groups, including the U.N., E.U., International Red Cross, Russia, China, Islamic countries, media entities, and more.



undersigned student organizations, hold the Israeli regime entirely responsible for all unfolding violence."

But of course. Israel is always to blame. The leadership of the people who were murdered, slaughtered, butchered, incinerated, and raped are to blame not the murderers, the slaughterers, the butchers, the pyromaniacs, the rapists.

Israel drops more than one million leaflets throughout Gaza City, urging the civilians to flee to the south. Israel makes tens of thousands of phone calls — yes, calls to individuals on their phones and sends out tens of thousands of text messages, warning, "We're going to bomb your neighborhood. Please get out so you can be safe."

Hamas, in contrast, urges their people to stay, or blocks them from leaving, putting up roadblocks to stop them and allegedly confiscating car keys and shooting their own people dead. Hamas leadership even asserts that they welcome the death of their own people.

In short, Israel seeks to minimize civilian casualties in Gaza while Hamas seeks to

maximize civilian casualties there, but Israel is guilty. Israel is to blame.

As expressed by Brendan O'Neill on the Spiked website (Spiked-Online.com):

"So let me get this right. If Israel bombs Hamas targets in Gaza, it is recklessly endangering civilian life. But if it gives civilians fair warning to move away from certain areas, it is engaging in ethnic cleansing. If it drops bombs in built-up suburbs, it is committing a war crime. But if it advises civilians to leave those builtup suburbs before the bombs come, it is also committing a war crime. If it attacks northern Gaza, that's genocide. Yet when it advises civilians of northern Gaza to leave first, that's 'forced transfer,' which is to say: genocide.

"Everything Israel does is a war crime. Everything. Killing civilians — war crime. Trying not to kill civilians — war crime. Bombing populated areas war crime. Giving a population time to leave before dropping bombs — war crime. The surrealism of these screams of 'genocidel' every time an Israeli

soldier so much as picks up his gun was brought home by two headlines in *The Independent* last week, published just 10 hours apart. Israel is engaged in 'collective punishment in Gaza,' claimed the first. 'Israel accused of "trying to ethnically cleanse Gaza Strip" as one million ordered to evacuate,' stated the second."

But of course. Israel is always to blame.

That's because the spirit that animates the demonizing of Israel is the same spirit that animates Jew-hatred in general.

- Jews are hated for being rich *and* for being poor.
- Jews are hated for being powerful (they're trying to take over the world) and for being weak (those miserable, wretched Jews).
- Jews are hated for being religious (they think they're better than us) and for being secular (they're trying to fit in as if they were just like us).
- Jew are hated by Communists *and* by Fascists.
- Jews are hated when they are victims *and* when they are victors.
- Jews are hated for not fighting back (why did they go as sheep to the slaughter under the Nazis?) *and* for fighting back (they're guilty of ethnic cleansing and genocide!).
- Jews are hated when they are in exile (there's a reason they've been expelled from so many countries) and when they're in their homeland (they are evil occupiers who don't belong there).
- Jews are hated by Black supremacists *and* White supremacists.

And Jew-hatred has a strong tradition in both Christianity and Islam.

It's always those dirty Jews/Zionists!

And lest you think this is just a matter of rhetoric — a matter of mere words — consider this: On November 4<sup>th</sup>, I wrote an article entitled, "Wake Up World Before Jewish Blood is Shed In Your Country."

One day later, on the very day the article was posted, Paul Kessler, a

69-year-old, Jewish, pro-Israel protester was struck on the head by a pro-Palestinian protester. He died as a result of his injuries. It only took one day!

That is why I will not be silent at such a critical time in Jewish history, not to mention world history.

What about you?

Will you use equal weights and measures, or will you go along with the spirit of the age? [Please see "Do Jewish Lives Matter" on p.13.]

By all means, Israel can be criticized along many lines, and true friends of Israel are more than happy to share their comments, their criticisms, and their concerns.

But this unequal, unfair, unethical demonizing of Israel and the Jewish people must be confronted and exposed, especially when the nation faces yet another existential threat.

On Saturday, October 7, 2023, I looked at Facebook as I woke up. While scrolling through status updates, an Israeli friend's post immediately caught my attention: "ISRAEL IS AT WAR." Shocked and confused, I wondered what on Earth was happening.

The comments revealed the devastation that Israel experienced while David and I slept. The more I read, the more I was grieved by the harsh realities in Israel. The unexpected events thrust my mind, heart, soul, and spirit into an unexpected and unknown future.

David and I were scheduled to leave for Tel Aviv the following week with a group of Zola Tours pilgrims. Our suitcases were packed, and we were finalizing the details to meet our group at JFK airport. We were excited to lead them on the trip of a lifetime to the land where Jesus lived, walked, and died for us. Suddenly I realized that the war would likely suspend our October tour. Then, I wondered if we would ever return to the Holy Land. That thought weighed heavily on me.

Realizing that the crew from *Our Jewish Roots (OJR)* was filming that day in Jerusalem, I contacted Andrea at Berg Productions. "Have you seen the news? What's happening? Has our team said anything?" Hamas's barbarism tragically shattered a peaceful Shabbat in Israel. The *OJR* crew was caught in the midst of this horrific crisis. Meanwhile, the world had yet to learn about the brutal atrocities of that day.

Since that morning, life as we know it has changed drastically. You and I see disgusting anti-Semitic acts across the globe. Especially in civilized societies, where honorable people desire peace and equality, somehow the Jewish people are not allowed either of these. We live in an era where, for too many people, wrong is considered right and right is considered wrong. With the ongoing Russia-Ukraine war approaching two years, life seems to have turned upside-down. Many Believers\* and unbelievers continue to wonder: Where will all of this violence and chaos lead us?

Thank you for standing with us in Israel.





# The Most Anti-Israel Writing I Have Ever Read

In my recent tour to Israel, I noted reactions to anti-Semitic speeches and events throughout the world. In particular, the remarks from the obnoxious prime minister of Malaysia about the old story of the Jewish plot to take over the world. Oddly enough, when I returned to Dallas, I read a letter to the editor in the *International Jerusalem Post* to find the champion anti-Israel, anti-Semitic statement of perhaps all time, which I humbly submit to you below.

This letter is the most anti-Israel writing I have ever read. It also is unique in that every single sentence from top to bottom is untrue. However, Israelis and Americans should consider what would make a "moderate" leader from a nearly fully developed nation like Malaysia spew such venom.

People all over the world, not just Muslims, are sickened by the refusal of Israel to withdraw fully and finally to the 1948 borders and recognize the friendly sovereign nation of Palestine, which exists in the West Bank and Gaza.

Fairly or not, the actions of your nation since 9/11 are viewed around the world as a genocide (dare I say Holocaust?) of the proud, enslaved Palestinian people. The global community cannot understand why the Israelis are the only people blinded to the fact that the Palestinians have nothing other than their lives remaining to compromise with. At least the American public can be forgiven their ignorance, given the extreme bias of their domestic media.

You, the people of Israel, have the sole ability to solve the Middle Eastern problem, but a refusal to see reality and compromise looks set to plunge the world into WWIII.

First, "hatred based on race or religion" is popular with people throughout the world and is not really repugnant these days. The prime minister's comments were not derided except for a few Jewish people and friends of Israel. The prime minister is not "moderate," nor is his nation "nearly fully developed."

"People all over the world" are not sickened by Israel's refusal to withdraw to "1948 borders." No one has even requested this, not even the Palestinians. What is discussed are the 1967 borders, when Israel, attacked on three sides, defended itself valiantly, and then wisely held on to virtually empty "West Bank" land in order to create a buffer against such attacks in the future.

In addition, the Palestinian entity is not "friendly," "sovereign," or a "nation." This is not a "genocide" or "holocaust"; as a matter of fact, the Palestinian's self-inflicted wounds have cost them (by their own reports) some 2,000 people, while they have murdered 800 innocent Israeli civilians. Six million Jewish people were killed during the Holocaust, and it is extremely offensive to hear such ludicrous comparisons. In addition, the Palestinian people are neither "proud" nor "enslaved." They live in the freest of all Middle Eastern countries, and that goes without saying.

The Palestinians do not seek a "compromise with" their lives or anything else. They seek the eradication of five million Jews. The American public does fall under an "extreme bias" regarding Israel in our "domestic media." The bias, however, actually runs the opposite way — it is anti-Israel and pro-Palestinian.

The people of the Palestinian society have the "sole ability to solve the Middle Eastern problem," and we have cited it many times. Starting tomorrow morning, they should simply not leave their homes to murder the Jewish people, and likewise the day after that, and the day after that, and so forth for a thousand years. There would not be a shot fired from Israel's side, nor any objection to the Palestinian people if they would stop their murders. It's as simple as that.

As far as WWIII goes, Israel simply doesn't matter. All the negative publicity in the world will not overcome the fact that this relative handful of people, smaller than the population of some American cities, makes no difference to world affairs or commerce. It is doubtful that Israel has any effect on world peace, war, or anything else.

The statement that "history records the great Jewish people as maligned and victimized" is the only one that comes close to the truth. Though history doesn't fairly record the victimization of the Jews, those who malign and victimize the Jewish people are like the writer of this letter, whose bizarre, "stand-on-hishead" view of the Jewish world causes such effects.

# How many First Coming prophecies did Jesus the Messiah fulfill?

Jesus affirmed that all of Scripture including Moses, the Old Testament writings, and Prophets — testifies of Him (John 5:39). The Bible revolves around Jesus; thus, He is the dominant theme of Bible prophecy. As Revelation 19:10 asserts, *"the testimony of Jesus is the Spirit of prophecy."* 

Messianic prophecy generally relates either to the Lord's First or Second Coming. Reputable Bible scholars differ on the number of Messianic prophecies in Scripture. In the Encyclopedia of Biblical Prophecy, J. Barton Payne estimated that over 500 Old Testament verses either point or allude to the coming of Messiah. Alfred Edersheim, a Messianic Jewish author, identified over 450 Old Testament verses about the Messiah. While the numbers vary based on how one views or defines a prophecy, Bible scholars can conservatively affirm that Jesus fulfilled at least 300 prophecies during His First Coming.

Jesus of Nazareth fulfilled both direct and indirect Messianic prophecies. GotQuestions.org notes some ways to identify prophecies in Scripture related to the Messiah:

Compare Scripture with Scripture. Some Messianic prophecies in the Old Testament are identified by New Testament writers. Matthew is especially helpful in linking Old Testament prophecies to their fulfillment in the life of Christ. Jesus' birth is the fulfillment of Isaiah 7:14 (see Matthew 1:18–25). Jesus' flight to Egypt turns out to be the fulfillment of an indirect prophecy in Hosea 11:1 (see Matthew 2:15). Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem is linked to Zechariah 9:9 (see Matthew 21:1–11). Jesus' death on the Cross fulfilled many Old Testament prophecies, including Psalm 34:20 and Zechariah 12:10 (see John 19:31–37).

At times, Jesus guoted a Messianic prophecy and applied it to Himself. In the synagogue in Nazareth, Jesus read a Messianic passage from Isaiah 61 and said, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing" (Luke 4:21). Just before His arrest, Jesus guoted Zechariah 13:7, stating that prophecy is about to be fulfilled (Matthew 26:31). He also quoted Isaiah 53:12 (in Luke 22:37). When we study the whole of Isaiah 53, we discover that much of that chapter corresponds directly to Jesus' passion. When Jesus quotes an Old Testament passage and says that He is the fulfillment of it, we know for sure that passage was Messianic.

God oversees history — past, present, and future — according to His perfect plan. At just the right time, God sent His Son Jesus Christ to this Earth to accomplish salvation for all who trust Him. Jesus is the One foretold by Moses and the Prophets centuries before His birth in Bethlehem. If Christ Jesus fulfilled all of the First Coming prophecies of Scripture, then we can be certain that our Lord will fulfill the remaining prophecies at His glorious return.



### A Note from Mark Do Jewish Lives Matter?

name AISH stands for *Aish HaTorah*, which is Hebrew for "The Fire of Torah." As Zola used to say, I couldn't have written this better myself. —Mark

In the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, universities in America, including elite Ivy League schools, imposed a Jewish quota, denying many qualified and worthy applicants entry simply because they were Jewish. For example, A. Lawrence Lowell, president of Harvard University from 1909–1933, labeled the growth of Jewish students at Harvard as the "Jew problem." He asserted that too many Jewish students at Harvard would "ruin the college." He proposed reducing them by imposing higher standards of admissions to members of "the Hebrew race."

Now, 100 years later, while Jews are admitted to college campuses, many are not welcome and safe there. In October, Jewish students locked themselves in the NYU Cooper Union library as other students chanted "Free Palestine" outside the doors and held signs while threateningly banging on the glass windows.

In October, threatening statements about Jews on a Cornell University online discussion board prompted officials to have police guard a Jewish center and kosher dining hall. They found Jewish students hiding in their dormitory rooms. Jewish students at Columbia University stated at a press conference that they had been subjected to anti-Semitic incidents — including death threats — in October. Countless stories, unfathomable months ago, are becoming the norm on campuses. It is shocking that professors who endorse the same ideology of hatred also encourage and embolden many of the hateful students. These professors attach their names and credentials to letters blaming Israel for October 7 and/or unequivocally supporting Hamas! Reactions of disgust and statements of support for the Jewish students have come from many people. But the national outrage or mass movements that we have seen confronting other forms of hate and bigotry have not emerged.

### Jews Aren't Being Paranoid

To appreciate how relatively muted the reaction has been, consider the appropriate national outrage if the Black student center closed because it couldn't be secured against racists who threatened Black students and Black students needed to hide in their dorm rooms. Imagine Muslim students or LGBTQ students having to lock themselves in the library due to being taunted and threatened.

Campuses are not the only place where anti-Semitism is on the rise. In the United States, anti-Semitic incidents have increased a mind-boggling 400% since October 7 compared with the same period the previous year.

Jim Gaffigan posted: "Does anyone else feel the need to call all their Jewish friends and say, Okay, you weren't being paranoid?" Gaffigan is a popular comedian, but his observation is no joke.

### Where's the Sweeping Outrage?

- Where is the birth of a movement to stand with Jews while explicit, vile threats grow against them?
- Where are the demands to defund campuses?



• Where is the call to cancel anti-Semites and Hamas sympathizers?

God's Chosen People and those who love the Bible would like to believe that the overwhelming majority on campuses, throughout America and around the world, are decent and moral — disturbed by what happened to Israel and the ripple effects elsewhere. Being disturbed is not enough, however, and sitting on the sidelines is unacceptable. As Shai Davidai, an assistant professor at Columbia whose passionate speech about campuses not being safe for Jewish students stated eloquently, "To the silent majority: I think we need to talk about your silence."

We need all good people to speak up, confront anti-Semitism and anti-Semites, and be intolerant of the intolerable. We need a #JewishLivesMatter movement — a sweeping campaign to confront anti-Semitism and protect Jews everywhere.

Elie Wiesel once stated:

We must take sides. Neutrality helps the oppressor, never the victim. Silence encourages the tormentor, never the tormented. Sometimes we must interfere. When human lives are endangered, when human dignity is in jeopardy, national borders and sensitivities become irrelevant. Wherever men and women are persecuted because of their race, religion, or political views, that place must — at that moment — become the center of the universe.

The position we as a people are collectively in right now should motivate us to speak up and fight for ourselves. We must think about how we feel, what we are going through, and remember this experience when another group, race, or minority finds itself confronting its bullies. If even small gestures are meaningful to us, we must express them to others who need to know they aren't alone or on their own. If solidarity matters, we must stand with those who are targeted in the future.

In this urgent time, as Jews around the world — not only in Israel — are in crisis, we are fair and just in expecting more from the world, in demanding outrage, support, and solidarity. And at the same time, we must demand of ourselves to take this experience and feeling and to be a blessing for others who will need us to be outraged and support and stand in solidarity with them. 🜣

Our great need is to have heart, to find strength, resolution, and steadfast determination to walk boldly during these heartless and depraved days (2 Tim. 3:1-5). We are not without God's help, of course. Yeshua said that Ruach HaKodesh (רוח הקודש), the Holy Spirit, would be "called alongside" (παράκλητος) to comfort us on the journey. The English verb "comfort" literally means "to give strength" (from com- ["with"] and fortis ["strong"]). A similar idea is expressed by the verb "encourage" — that is, to "put heart (i.e., 'core') within the soul." In Hebrew, the word "courage" is expressed by the phrase ometz lev (אומץ לב), meaning "strong of heart" — an inner quality of the will rather than of the intellect. Our faith is the victory that overcomes the world (1 John 5:4; see also 1 John 4:4).

But we must be vigilant. If the devil can't devour you, he will try to drive you insane. He will lie to you about who you really are. He will harass you and vex your soul. He will whisper fearful things in your ear. He will make what is small seem big and what is big seem small. He will raise dark suspicion within your soul, causing you to walk in mistrust. He will remind you of your sins to make you feel ashamed and dirty. He will hiss that you are unlovable and unworthy. He will Read Hebrew right to left!

argue on behalf of your flesh that you deserve better than this. He will tempt you to seek relief in cisterns of emptiness and futility. Most of all, he will try to cast a spell to make you forget that you are truly a beloved child of God. The devil seeks to drive you into the exile of loneliness and despair. *"Submit yourself therefore to God"* (James 4:7) and refuse to heed voices of fear or shame. *Da lifnei mi attah omed* (דע לפני מי אתה עומד) — "Know before whom you stand!"

Godless fear is the devil's primary tool and the underlying motive behind sin itself (Rom. 14:23). Beloved, "do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good" (Rom 12:21). Always focus on Yeshua, the Light of Torah (האור התורה) and the true Wisdom of God (הכמה אלהים): "Whoever has My commandments (מצותי) and keeps them, that is the one who loves Me. And the one who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and will manifest (i.e., "shine within" — from ev, "in" +  $\varphi \alpha i v \omega$ , "shine") Myself to him" (John 14:21). There it is the Source of the Light that overcomes all darkness; the Power behind the armor of God. Yeshua is the Beginning, the Center, and the End of all true meaning from God. Blessed is His Name forever and ever. £Υ






The Treasury at Petra, likely a tomb built for the Nabataean King Aretas IV



## Blast-Proof Panels Protect Israelis Without Safe Room

Thousands of rockets have been fired at Israel from the Gaza Strip since the start of the war on October 7. While many Israelis can take cover in reinforced concrete rooms built into their apartments and houses, more than 1.6 million homes in the country do not have such shelter.

Since 1992, Israeli law has dictated that a bomb-proof room (known as a *mamad*) must be installed in all new residential and industrial buildings. But millions of citizens, living in homes

constructed before 1992, are vulnerable to rocket fire or falling shrapnel after the missiles are knocked out of the sky by Israeli defenses.

Israeli startup Ortech Defence Systems has developed patented wall panels that are designed to protect any room in any kind of building against blast hits, fragmentation, and even forced entry.

The panels, which can be installed in a room within a week, are made from a combination of polymers and fiberglass

that are constructed over steel beams. The room's windows and doors, however, cannot be reinforced by the panels and must be replaced with airtight, steel versions used in conventional secure rooms.

Avida Stern, VP of business development at Ortech, said that tests conducted by the Israel Defense Forces found that rooms reinforced with the company's wall panels were able to withstand the detonation of over 1,763 pounds of TNT.

Using a little over ¼ inch of material, Stern stated, "We're giving a room the strength of a protective shelter." He added that the Ortech solution can be used in any building, even those where concrete shelters cannot be installed due to their weight.

Since the war began, Ortech's wall panel solution has been in high demand. But meeting orders has been a challenge since the start of the war. Its main manufacturing facility is located at Kibbutz Karmia, one of the Gaza border communities that was attacked by Hamas on October 7. For several weeks, the area was sealed off as a closed military zone.

The Home Front Command, the military unit responsible for preparing Israeli citizens for conflicts and disasters, assured that Ortech's solution is 97% as effective as a *mamad*, but stressed that a *mamad* is still the best solution.  $\Rightarrow$ 



### Medicine in Israel Shockwave for Kidney Patients

Around 800 million people worldwide — including some 37 million Americans — suffer from chronic kidney disease (CKD). Despite more than a million people dying from CKD a year, few treatment advancements have developed in more than a decade. The only actual treatment has been dialysis, which dramatically reduces the quality of life for CKD patients.

### Until now.

The Nephrospec device shows promise in treating CKD by promoting new blood vessel formation and restoring damaged tissue function. Its patented shockwave technology — electro-Hydraulic Acoustic Therapy (eHAT) — is an acoustic wave treatment with much less intensity than traditional shockwave treatment that could cause kidney damage. Existing for test his shockwave treatment for CKD. A significant study was conducted through the Mayo Clinic and financed by the National Institutes of Health, showing that what the company thought could theoretically work from animal studies "is more than a reality. The results were above our expectations," Spector said.

Six patients were treated with Nephrospec, providing the device's first safety and efficacy data. In 2021, the U.S. patent office granted a patent for the method of this technology.

Clinical trials for Nephrospec are being conducted in the Philippines, Israel, the U.S., and Europe. Because most studies using eHAT have focused on animals, these clinical trials in human subjects



almost two decades, eHAT has proven effective in treating a variety of disorders.

In several animal studies, eHAT has improved healing in tissues, ultimately healing kidney tissue, preserving kidney function, and delaying CKD progression. It can also attract stem cells into injured kidneys for tissue repair.

The Israeli company Curespec was founded in 2020 by Avner Spector. With a degree in mechanical engineering, he has worked in the medical device field since the 1980s. Several years ago, his friend's wife suffered from kidney failure. Her illness prompted Spector to

are essential for understanding the use and effectiveness of eHAT in the real world.

"A kidney transplant costs nearly \$500,000 to perform," Spector noted. "If we could save that money or at least improve the possibility of the transplant to succeed, the effects would be dramatic."

He added, "My dream is to see this technology delay dialysis by at least two to four years for patients." The eHAT is also proving effective at reducing blood pressure and the probability of a stroke, which is often linked to kidney failure.

# Greek Diner Owner Boycotted, Threatened for Backing Israel

the helpers. You will always find people who are helping."

One of those helpers is Peter Tsadilas a gentile of Greek ancestry — and owner of the Golden Globe Diner in Huntington, New York. "My best friend, who is Jewish, came over one night, crying to me," Tsadilas explained. "His son was on medical leave from the Israeli Army and was in America visiting his father. He went back to Israel and was going to do another semester of college. When the terror attacks occurred on October 7<sup>th</sup>, his father called and said, 'Son, come back now.' His son replied, 'No, Dad, I'm staying to fight.""

Tsadilas decided he had to do something to show support for Jews and Israel amidst the war. "I put up four Israeli flags around the diner, and pictures of the hostages. I started by posting pictures of the kids under 10 years old. ... After doing the kids, I started to put up the older hostages as well, and it filled up about half the window."

Afterward, three new employees quit without notice. He also lost a lot of Middle Eastern patrons. "But the real issues began when DoorDash stopped picking up my food. I got backlash from DoorDash clients. They told DoorDash I was promoting hate and killing babies. I didn't get any orders for nine days. My restaurant was removed from their app." That changed, however, after Tsadilas threatened to take legal action.

A local Hebrew school administrator saw the flags and decided to come in. She told Tsadilas, "I wasn't hungry. I couldn't find parking, but I want to stop in and have some eggs to support you." She took a picture and sent it to others, and as Tsadilas explained, "Then it took a life of its own."

Having the backing of the Jewish community has been crucial for Tsadilas. The backlash unfortunately hasn't stopped with DoorDash's short-lived boycott. The phone at the diner rings constantly with death threats.

But Tsadilas refuses to back down. "I want to try to get all the Greek restaurants to jump on board and support Israel," Tsadilas declared. "The first one is always the hardest. We are going to

> approach the 500 Greek diners in the tri-state area." He added that he would personally pay these restaurants to put up flagpoles to display Israeli flags and pay for the upkeep and service of them throughout the year.

# Muslim Woman Praises Israel for Helping Her Succeed

As the Israel-Hamas war continues to ravage the region, one Israeli-Arab-Muslim woman is speaking out, lauding the Jewish state for helping her to succeed. Had it not been for Israel, the Stanford University alumna asserted, she would likely be impoverished.

While many have focused on radical, Islamic fundamentalism following Hamas's attacks on Israel on October 7, Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez (D-N.Y.) pointed fingers at Christian extremists.

"What angers me about the GOP's attempts to turn the United States into a far-right Christian theocracy is how dishonest they are about it," she wrote in 2019. "At least be forthright about your desire to subvert and dismantle our democracy into a creepy theological order led by a mad king."

# **Greek Psalm Inscription Found in**



The 2023 archaeological dig at Hyrcania Fortress

Archaeologists working at a Israel Antiquities Second Temple-era structure in the Judean Desert, about 10 miles southeast of Jerusalem, recently unearthed a rare inscription paraphrasing part of Psalm 86 in Greek. Painted in red, under a cross on the side of a large building stone, the inscription reads: "Jesus Christ, guard me, for I am poor and needy. Guard my life, for I am faithful to you." It was written in Koine Greek — the language of the New Testament. In the original Hebrew psalm, known as "A Prayer of David," the first section reads, "Hear me, Lord, and answer me."

A community of Byzantine Christian monks founded in the 5<sup>th</sup> century A.D. is likely responsible for the adapted Psalm 86 inscription. Dr. Avner Ecker of Bar-Ilan University, who helped decipher the inscription, noted that the writing contains small grammatical errors, indicating that the writer "was not a native Greek speaker, but likely someone from the region who was raised speaking a Semitic language."



In addition to the psalm adaptation, archaeologists found a similar inscription nearby. These may be the only Koine Greek Psalm inscriptions ever discovered on stone, rather than on parchment or other materials, the archaeologists noted.

The pilot dig, which occurred in early 2023, was the first "methodological, academic archaeological excavation" undertaken at the site. Previously, European archaeologists made a few short visits there when Jordan controlled the area, the last of note being in the 1950s. At that

To

time, a Belgian archaeologist discovered a trove of papyrus documents.

The Hyrcania Fortress, dating from the Hasmonean dynasty (second to first

them, he ended his explorations because of weather conditions. Gutfeld's efforts over several years, after 2000, yielded some small First Temple-era artifacts,



but researchers are uncertain why the tunnels were built.

Michal Haber, the other Hebrew University archaeologist leading the dig, explained that King Herod is known to have imprisoned his enemies — whether real or imaginary in Hyrcania. One of the theories is that the tunnels were a slave labor project that was unfinished or undertaken as a form of punishment

centuries B.C.), was part of a series of hilltop desert fortifications. Later, King Herod expanded and refurbished the fortress, as he did with the more wellknown Masada and Herodium sites.

After Herod's death in 4 B.C., Hyrcania fell into disuse, until the small Byzantine Christian monastery was founded there at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> century A.D. This monastery, called *Kastellion* ("Little Castle" in Greek), survived the later Islamic conquest of the area around 635 A.D. and was in use until the early 9<sup>th</sup> century.

Since that time, the abandoned site was largely in ruins, with crumbling monastery buildings lying atop the ancient Herodian and Hasmonean structures.

### An "Indiana Jones moment"

Dr. Oren Gutfeld, one of the lead archaeologists, has a long history at the site. In an "Indiana Jones moment" in 2000, he explored two tunnels at the base of the hill. These "completely man-made," stepped tunnels slope downwards one to a depth of 394 feet, and the other to 262 feet — but both then reach a dead end.

A British scholar first discovered the tunnels in 1960. Unable to excavate

to keep the prisoners busy, she added.

When Gutfeld returned around 2015 for further exploration, he found the site on top of the hill "pristine." That visit prompt-

ed the current organized explorations, which he stressed would not have been possible in earlier years due to logistical issues associated with the remoteness of the site, which is located in the "West Bank." Another excavation is planned for early 2024.

The site also

## NYC Teacher Indoctrinates Preschoolers to Hate Israel

A New York City preschool teacher instructs parents on how to indoctrinate young children with hatred of Israel and support Palestinian terrorism. Siriana Abboud teaches in P.S. 59 in midtown Manhattan. She is also the founder of the online Allusio Academy, providing curricula, workshops, and consultation

on how to brainwash four-yearolds with the Palestinian canard that the Israelis are outsiders who have stolen the land from the Arabs and are



engaging in genocide.

"These teach-ins are a safe space for you and your child to learn about the Palestinian struggle for freedom," she emphasized on her sign-up sheet

In the past, Abboud referred to Jews as "terrorists" and "colonizers" of their own historic homeland, arguing that Israel's security barrier is "an apartheid wall." She openly stated, "There can be no peace so long as Zionism exists."

One item Abboud promoted on her website (which has since been removed) is the anti-Semitic book P is for Pales*tine*. An entry for the letter "I" states that it represents "Intifada, Arabic for rising up for what is right, if you are a kid or grownup!"

In late October, Abboud posted a picture of some ruins in Gaza after the IDF struck Hamas targets. She wrote that the "fascist ethnostate" of Israel had acted "with absolute zero impunity" (instead of "complete impunity").
