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## Reopening the Ancient Pilgrimage Road in Jerusalem JNS.org

In September, U.S. Secretary of State Marco Rubio and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu reopened the Pilgrimage Road in Jerusalem. The broad stone route — used during the Second Temple period — connected the Pool of Siloam, where pilgrims purified themselves in ritual baths, to Judaism's holiest site, the Temple Mount.

Jerusalem "is forever our city," Netanyahu declared at the ceremony in the City of David. "It will never be divided again, and there will be no Palestinian state."

"Any unilateral action can be met with unilateral action," Netanyahu added, referencing recent calls by European nations to acknowledge a Palestinian state.

Also speaking at the ceremony, Mike Huckabee — U.S. Ambassador to Israel — said that the stones of the ancient site "100% validate that the Jewish people not only belong here now, but they have belonged here for 4,000 years, since the time God said to Abraham: This is yours."

"Tonight, the rest of the world comes to say: welcome home, and may no one ever, ever attempt to take your home from you," he added.

The unveiling of the ancient road, "an event of historical and cultural importance to the Jewish people," marked the conclusion of a "highly successful visit to Israel by U.S.

Secretary of State Marco Rubio," according to a statement from the Israeli Prime Minister's Office.

Rubio, in a post on X, called the road "an enduring cultural and historical bond" with Jerusalem and a "powerful reminder of the Judeo-Christian values that inspired America's Founding Fathers."



The ancient road runs roughly 650 yards and is now open on both ends. Huckabee noted on X that the attendees became the first to make the pilgrimage from the City of David to the Temple Mount in 2,000 years.

Rubio met for several hours with Netanyahu at his Jerusalem office. Also attending the meeting were Israeli Foreign Minister Gideon Sa'ar, Israeli Strategic Affairs Minister Ron Dermer, Israeli National Security Adviser Tzachi Hanegbi, and Yechiel Leiter, Jerusalem's envoy to the U.S., along with Huckabee.

"Mr. Secretary, Marco, your visit to our eternal and undivided capital of Jerusalem is a powerful affirmation of a powerful bond," Netanyahu stated following the closed meeting.

Jerusalem and Washington will continue to "protect our common civilization, because we are engaged in a battle of civilization and barbarism," Netanyahu vowed.



questions. The
Lord is the One to
whom we ultimately
give thanks. The psalm
uses the sacred name of
God. He is the one, eternal,
self-existent, Creator, Sustainer,
and Redeemer. Our Thanksgiving
holiday involves a lot of things, but the
fundamental thing — the most basic
thing — is to give thanks to God.

But why should we thank Him? Again, the psalm reminds us — "forget not all His benefits." Benefits refer to blessings, which we too easily forget. Luke 17:11–19 recalls how Jesus once healed 10 lepers. Of those, only one thanked Him. Many people are like the nine lepers. We experience many good things throughout the year, but often we forget to thank God for them. Sometimes we think that we're entitled to them. But we're not.

When the psalmist says, "Bless the LORD, O my soul," he is talking to himself. He's exhorting his own soul, giving it a pep talk to not forget.

What benefits or blessings does he have in mind? He actually makes a list, which is a good way to not forget. His list includes forgiveness, healing, saving,



Knowing the Who and the why, the practical question for most of us is — how? How can we cultivate a grateful heart? The psalmist answers by listing his benefits — counting his blessings.

## Here are three specific actions you can take to develop a grateful heart.

Begin with daily thanks. Try ending your day with thanksgiving. Several years ago, my wife and I decided to dump the late-night television. Often, the last thing we do before retiring is to name five things that we each are grateful for from









the day. That's a great way to go to sleep. It sets our minds on a track to awaken in the morning with a new outlook.

Next, try weekly thanks. We worship with our church weekly. Worship involves a lot of things, but certainly it should include thanksgiving for God's goodness to you. Before I leave for my church gathering, I usually reflect on the blessings of the week. I bring my own thank offering with me — a weekly thanksgiving list — one of the most important things I bring to church.

Finally, give yearly thanks. A new habit I've been working on is to keep a yearly thanksgiving list. Throughout the year I record these items in my planner — good things, important things, even hard things. If I write them down, I won't

forget. I aim to have a list of 50 things to thank God for on Thanksgiving Day. Our family even sets five kernels of corn at each place setting on the Thanksgiving Day dinner table, asking each person to name five things they are thankful for this past year.

The psalmist made a list. He seemed to know the importance of counting his blessings and the secret of developing a grateful heart.

Who do we thank? Why should we thank Him? How do we thank Him? Those questions from the movie *Avalon* are wonderfully answered in Psalm 103:2. "Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits." Before the Christmas rush this year, try counting your blessings. \$\Pi\$

Imagine being one of the prophets whom Yeshua transported into the future. While you would see futuristic events occurring, your mind wouldn't have a frame-of-reference for 21st-century technology. Without God's Spirit, such men might've suffered heart attacks just witnessing a single TikTok dance for the first time! This might be why God showed so many future visions in symbolic imagery. What ancient Jew could fathom such shocking incidents as men marrying their AI girlfriends, shootings over chicken nugget shortages, or self-driving cars kidnapping their passengers?

We may joke about the idiocy that causes us to lose faith in humanity, but Satan has deceptively dropped man's base instincts to our lowest common denominator: self-worship. The Spirit of this Age has reached full strength. Many people want to be social media "influencers," showcasing the most ridiculous trends, life-hack tutorials, and extreme visual

appearances to garner the world's attention. Typically, only the most extreme diatribe, video, or visual goes viral with millions of views and likes (unless you're a kitten playing peek-a-boo). Satan knows a direct attempt to get man to worship him only works with Satanists. But if he can draw our focus away from God and onto ourselves, our self-idolatry automatically moves to the devil's altar.

Being on the frontlines of ministry, we hear statements that range from hate-filled anti-Semitism to

anti-Semitism to perverse and unbiblical doctrines. So many people who claim to be Believers\* apparently write their own Bibles (or beliefs) based upon what seems right in their own eyes, just as the Israelites did (Judg. 21:25). Yet when truth is relative, someone's "personal truth" can easily infringe upon the freedoms, rights, and

In Matthew 7:12, Yeshua expressed what we know as the "Golden Rule," which encourages us to do unto others as we'd want them to do to us. Such good deeds are produced as a result of God's Spirit working through us. Conversely, the Jewish sage Rabbi Hillel is credited for his "Silver Rule": "What is hateful to you, do not to your neighbor: that is the whole Torah...." But this avoidance of doing bad doesn't lead to doing good to others. It's the product of a self-centered doctrine, in contrast to Yeshua's desire that His followers focus on the needs of others, which is sacrificial love.

With the Church and society hitting what seems to be the depths of moral decay, one would think that the only place left to go is up — for things to improve and get better. Truly, God is no respecter of persons (Rom. 2:11)!

We have predicted that an alliance would be formed between Iran and Russia preceding the invasion of Israel foretold by the Prophet Ezekiel (Ezek. 38–39). His prophecy tells of a major assault on the Holy Land from the north and gives the Biblical equivalent names of Russia and a number of allies as the invaders. In the past decade or so, we have watched the shifting alliances of the Middle Eastern nations in view of Ezekiel's predictions. Libya and Ethiopia have certainly come into line as allies of Russia and arch-enemies of Israel (Ezek. 38:5). The missing piece of the puzzle is Persia, comprising modern Iran.

The Persian Gulf is practically going up in smoke. Recently, shooting developed between the U.S. and Iran, and an escalation of the conflict seems quite likely.

Iran has no friend anywhere. The Ayatollah's fanatic regime has pitted his nation seemingly against the whole world. Currently, Iran is lashing out at ships of many nations and exchanging real blows with Iraq and the U.S. It's difficult to think that Iran has an ally anywhere in the world; even the Muslim countries regard that nation with revulsion and embarrassment.

But Iran is very important today. Some two-thirds of the world's oil supplies are in the Persian Gulf region, where Iran is a major producer. Even the superpowers have to cultivate a strategic area like the Gulf. And Iran really needs a friend among the superpowers. It's difficult to see how the Ayatollah's forces can go on and on, alone against a multitude.

The U.S. might well have made a powerful ally of Iran's since historically that has been the case. Only 10 years ago, the U.S. was on friendly terms under the Shah, and even Israel and Iran got along and traded fairly and peaceably. But now Iran has rebuffed her former friends and stands alone. The mining of the Gulf and the firing on U.S. ships has made any relationship foreseeable in the near future impossible.

Thus, this may be the time that Iran turns to Russia. It doesn't seem likely but given the

tremendous geopolitical forces in the world today, those two may find that they need each other. Russia has been disappointed lately in Afghanistan and is pulling out, having failed to consolidate that nation and occupy it. And yet, communism needs constant expansion — particularly into the Middle East, with its oil supplies, warm-water ports, and strategic location. A map of the contested area shows that Russian purposes in the Middle East would be even better served by a relationship with Iran than by the occupation of Afghanistan. Iran is closer to the oil supplies and closer to Israel.

Although they don't see eye to eye on very many subjects, the Russians and Iranians share a fierce animosity toward Israel and its faithful ally, the U.S. In addition, Iran and the Soviet Union share a border. It's difficult to see an alliance happening at this point between Russia and Iran, but "birds of a feather flock together" and mutual political interests have historically made strange bedfellows.

I always recommend that Believers have a working knowledge of prophecy. There are many recent books on the subject of End-Times events but none that I can recommend more at this point than our own *The Coming Russian Invasion of Israel*. It was updated recently to include the dramatic outworkings of events leading to this cataclysmic upcoming war.

This book, your newspaper, and the Book of Ezekiel should keep you updated on the fastest breaking prophecy fulfillment in the world today.  $\, \diamondsuit \,$




## Wise As A Serpent

## **Overcoming Crooked Insurance Claim Denials**

It has been many moons since my last Serpent installment, inspired by Yeshua's advice to be "wise as serpents, and harmless as doves" (Matt. 10:16). Luigi Mangione, 27, was neither wise nor harmless last December when he fatally shot Brian Thompson, the CEO of UnitedHealthcare. This "symbolic takedown" expressed his rage against corporate greed and initiated a public debate about the industry.

Shell casings at the murder scene had the words deny, defend, and depose written on them — referring to tactics that insurance companies use to avoid paying claims. How many consumers, endlessly experiencing the runaround by their own health and homeowner insurance companies, quietly identified with Mangione's frustration?

This question brings to mind the 1997 film *The Rainmaker.*<sup>1</sup> According to gemini. google.com, here's the plot summary:



The film, based on the John Grisham novel, tells the story of Rudy Baylor (Matt Damon), an idealistic young lawyer fresh out of law school. With no job prospects, he takes on a lawsuit against a massive, corrupt health insurance company named "Great Benefit."

His client, Donny Ray Black, is a young man dying of leukemia. His family's health insurance claim for a life-saving bone marrow transplant was repeatedly and systematically denied by Great Benefit, operating on a "deny all claims" policy to maximize profits. Rudy, aided by a scrappy paralegal (Danny DeVito), faces off against the insurance company's army of experienced, well-funded corporate lawyers. This classic underdog story exposes a broken system where a corporation's bottom line is valued over human life.

Applying the movie's theme to today's undeniable reality, gemini.google.com notes:

The central conflict of *The Rainmaker* — a powerful insurance company prioritizing profits by systematically denying claims — is a theme that remains highly relevant today, particularly in the context of homeowners' insurance.

Following major natural disasters, such as hurricanes, wildfires, or floods, homeowners often file legitimate claims for damage to their property. However, many consumer advocates and legal experts have noted that insurance companies frequently employ tactics to deny, delay, or underpay these claims. These tactics, which echo Great Benefit's behavior in the movie, include:

- Claiming damages are pre-existing
- · Misinterpreting policy language
- Requiring excessive documentation
- Bad faith

In essence, *The Rainmaker* reflects a very real and ongoing struggle.







In a Senate hearing last May, Senator Josh Hawley (R-Mo.) intensely guestioned executives from large insurance companies like Allstate and State

Senator Josh Hawley Farm. The hearing also featured testimony from a) homeowners whose claims were denied after natural disasters, and b) whistleblowers who were adjusters for those companies.

Visit YouTube to watch the 41-minute video "Chairman Hawley Exposes Major Insurance Companies for Ripping Off Policyholders."2 You can't watch much of the video without agreeing that today's insurance industry is wrought with widespread and systematic fraud.

Decades ago, my father Zola received credible advice from a friend in real estate who knew the insurance industry only too well. His word to the wise was that homeowner insurance companies notoriously appoint adjusters who, "Scout's honor," resemble Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts yet routinely lie through their teeth. While these are harsh words, please let me explain — and share my solution that has worked twice!

In April, my roofer advised that I file a hail damage claim with my insurance company of many years, Safeco/Liberty Mutual. True to form, they appointed a polite and personable representative to assess the damage. Then, to my disappointment, the adjuster cheerily declared how lucky I was that though the hailstones were large enough to blast through the plexiglass patio cover, the roof's blistering was attributable to normal aging. Balderdash! My roofer was outraged.

I quickly advised the underhanded adjuster that I would once again hire an independent adjuster and take the **claim to arbitration** — and as I did with my prior claim, prevail in arbitration, and get a new roof.

Dear Reader: Homeowners with legitimate claims should learn how to contact their state insurance board to get a list of independent adjusters whom they can hire to go up against the insurance company's adjusters. Each of the two parties' adjusters then assess the claim's validity and present their points of view to an independent umpire. In my case, the damage was so obvious that my insurance company's adjuster, facing my adjuster, conceded and obligated Safeco/ Liberty Mutual to pay.

My prior claim adjuster's email is info@ KARRCPAU.com, and this year's adjuster is David@Manor-Consulting.com. These adjusters — the Chuck Norrises of their trade — are in most of the South Central states. No, my insurance company won't reimburse my out-of-pocket expenses for these adjusters. The process took five months, and I have been awarded ~\$28,000 minus the deductible. This will include an initial payment and then a supplemental payment once I file for it after replacing the roof. The roofer, mind you, gets no money until the job is completed.

Next, I may file a complaint with the state on both claims so that Safeco/Liberty Mutual will likely pay faster on my next claim. I hope that this article will help you prevail on a future claim, and perhaps you will share a small portion of your "winnings" with ZLM.

**P.S.** Policyholders struggling to receive approval or payment on health insurance claims can hire medical billing advocates, patient advocates, medical claims services, or health insurance attorneys. 🛭 🌣

## Ask the Chaplain

# What is the Evidence of Being Born Again? Part 1

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The Apostle John wrote his first epistle to those who have been born again into God's family. The phrases "born of God," "born of Him," or "begotten of Him" occur nine times in the Book of 1 John (2:29; 3:9; 4:7; 5:1, 4, 18); these recall Jesus' words to Nicodemus as recorded in John's Gospel. Therefore, in the Book of 1 John, the Apostle noted five characteristics of new birth — traits that every born-again Believer will display.


The **first** evidence of being born-again is an enduring trust that Jesus is the Messiah (Christ): "Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God ..." (1 John 5:1). Abiding faith in Jesus Christ involves more than knowledge (in the mind); it also includes an ongoing commitment to trust and follow the Savior. God's Holy Spirit is the Agent of this faith — He activates the belief that leads to new birth (John 3:7–8).

The **second** trait of the new birth is the avoidance of habitual sin: "Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin ..."
(1 John 3:9). This does not imply that we can become sinless in this life — John previously asserted that anyone who makes such a claim is a liar (1 John 1:8). Instead, the Greek word translated "commit sin" means to regularly practice sin. A Believer is no longer habitually enslaved to sin because God's "seed" (1 John 3:9)

dwells in that person. This seed is the new nature — the life of God that is without sin, created after the image of Christ — that God implants in every Believer. But while God places His seed or nature within every Believer, that person's old sin nature battles against the new nature. In Romans 7:14–25, Paul addresses this inward war that all Believers fight. Whereas unbelievers revel in sin as a habitual lifestyle, true Believers loathe sin; they confess their sin, seeking to be forgiven for it and cleansed from it through the keeping power of Jesus Christ (1 John 5:18).

The **third** indication of being born again is living a righteous life. "Every one that doeth righteousness is born of Him" (1 John 2:29). Doing righteousness refers to obeying God and living according to His Word — His right standards. Thus, to live a righteous life means keeping the commandments of Christ, whereby we show that we have experienced new birth. Obedience to Jesus' commands shows our love for God, as our Lord noted in John 14:21: "He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him." \$\prime\$

Through the Scriptures, Raphi will learn that salvation is of the Jews (John 4:22).

Later, as August and I enjoyed a delicious meal at the Tipsy Café, we talked with the owner **Gedaliah**, who made *aliyah* (a Jewish person immigrating to Israel) from New Jersey over a decade ago. Gedaliah, along with his sister and her husband, listened to our testimony about the Jewish roots of the

New Testament based on the Messianic prophecies of the Old Testament. We explained how both Testaments testify that Yeshua is the Messiah who came previously and is soon coming again to Israel to redeem the nation and establish His Kingdom over all the Earth (Zech. 12–14; Rev. 20:4–6).

Gedaliah listened with curious appreciation and

happily accepted our gift of the Hebrew Scriptures, including the *Brit Hadashah* (New Testament). After his sister explained that he was from the Tribe of Levi, August pronounced the Aaronic blessing over Gedaliah (Num. 6:24–26).

# **Charlie Kirk: Gaza Proved Two-State**

**Solution is a Deadly Mistake**

World leaders and the UN are once again pressuring Israel to accept a two-state solution, claiming that it's the only path to peace. But critics, like the late conservative commentator Charlie Kirk, argued that Israel already tried that model in Gaza — and the result was Hamas terror, not peace.

On September 12, 2025, the UN General Assembly voted 142–10 to endorse a declaration demanding "irreversible steps" toward a two-state solution. France's Emmanuel Macron and several other European governments have announced plans to unilaterally recognize a Palestinian state, hoping to force Israel's hand.

The U.S. and Israel opposed the declaration, with U.S. officials calling it a "gift to Hamas."

Meanwhile, in Israel, more politicians are calling for the annexation of Judea and Samaria rather than risking another Gaza-style withdrawal.

Kirk's central argument was that Israel already tested the two-state model in 2005. "Israel pulled out of Gaza completely... They had a two-state solution. What happened? Hamas happened. They were democratically elected," Kirk explained. "A two-state solution means that people like that will win again."

Since then, Hamas has turned Gaza into a terror fortress — launching tens of thousands of rockets, digging cross-border tunnels, and ultimately unleashing the massacre of October 7, 2023. As Kirk put it: "Israel never should have given up their rights to Gaza. It was one of the biggest mistakes Israel ever made."

U.S. officials have echoed this warning, stressing that international moves to impose statehood only strengthen Hamas rather than peace-seeking moderates.

Kirk also warned that the push for Palestinian statehood threatens not only

Israeli lives but also Christian access to their holiest places. He pointed to Bethlehem as an example of what happens when sacred sites fall under Muslim rule. Once a majority-Christian town, Bethlehem has seen its Christian population plummet while pilgrims face harassment and restrictions. "It's very hard for Christians to go to the birthplace of Christ, Bethlehem. It's controlled completely by Arab Muslims. It's very dangerous," Kirk noted.

If Judea and Samaria were ceded, sites like the Mount of Olives, the Garden of Gethsemane, and the Garden Tomb could face the same fate. Today, only Israeli sovereignty guarantees free access to Jerusalem's holy places for Christians, Jews, and Muslims alike. Surrendering that territory would put these sites under the control of the same forces that turned Bethlehem into a no-go zone for many Believers.

Israel's critics insist the two-state solution is the only viable path forward. Yet the Gaza withdrawal shows that surrendering land only strengthens extremists and endangers civilians. As Israel's Ambassador Danny Danon warned at the UN, when Hamas and its backers celebrate, the world should see the truth: Such moves empower terror, not peace.

The Apostle Paul foretold that the time before the "End of Days" would be "perilous" and full of unrelenting human depravity and lawlessness (2 Tim. 3:1–5). Yeshua warned that apostasy would abound and that the hearts of many would be cold and unfeeling (Matt. 24:12). In light of the raging spiritual war going on all around us, the following needs to be emphatically restated: "The important thing is to not lose your mind."

The mind is the "gateway" to your heart, so it is essential to guard your thinking by immersing yourself in the truth. Therefore, "not losing your mind" means being grounded in what is real; it consequently means understanding your identity and provision as a child of God. "God has not given us the spirit of fear, but of power and of love, and of a sound mind" (2 Tim. 1:7). A "sound mind" is literally a *delivered* mind, healed from chaos and despair. The Greek word for "sound mind" (sophronismos, σωφρονισμός) comes from a verb meaning "to be made safe," in the sense of being under restraining influence of the Spirit of God. The closest Hebrew word might be *musar* (רסומ), or "moral discipline."

Part of the task of "guarding your mind" is being able to discern between good and evil. "The fear of the LORD is to hate evil" (Prov. 8:13). As the prophet cried out, "Hate what is wrong, love what is right" (Amos 5:15). We must love the truth and abhor the lie (Ps. 119:163; Prov. 12:22; Zech. 8:19).



Tolerating sin in a world ripe for judgment is a tacit form of "collaboration" with the enemy. The Lord is clear on this point: "Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, and who turn darkness into light and light into darkness, to those who turn bitter into sweet and sweet into bitter. Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes, and shrewd in their own sight!" (Isa. 5:20–21). The truth sets people free, but this presupposes the ability to discern how we become enslaved to deception. Therefore, we are instructed: "You are to distinguish between the holy and the common" (Lev. 10:10).

Someone who loves you will help you to stay honest with yourself: The truth of God's moral law is likened to a father's moral correction that leads his child to life (Prov. 6:23).  $\diamondsuit$ 



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

## Josiah and the Last Reformation book


The last days of the Kingdom of Judah relevantly parallel the Last Days in which we as Believers are living today.

#### Josiah and the Last Reformation

In the book, you quote Revelation 2:9 — "... the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan." Does this pertain to those in Messiah Yeshua (who is inward) being no longer gentiles in the flesh (Eph. 2)? Can I, for instance, consider myself a spiritual Jew even though my ancestors are from European stock?

Regarding your question: No, you are not of the synagogue of Satan because you are a gentile by blood. You have been grafted into the Olive Tree (Rom. 11:17) by the blood of Yeshua. Now that you are a part of the commonwealth of Israel, your citizenship cannot be revoked.

I believe that in Revelation 2:9, Yeshua was referring to non-believing Jews who were persecuting the Church. Romans 9:6–7 declares: "For they are not all Israel who are of Israel, nor are they all children because they are the seed of Abraham." Those Pharisees and religious Jews who rejected Yeshua, the New Covenant, and becoming a completed Jew were, in essence, rejecting their own Jewishness. Again, this is referring to being a Jew spiritually, as opposed to one's bloodline, but it shows how much the spiritual inheritance truly matters.

God will never reject or break His Abrahamic Covenant with the Jews, even if they rejected Yeshua. Some people can't distinguish between the Earthly and the Spirit, so they jump on the Replacement Theology bandwagon, pointing to portions of Galatians and Scriptures such as Romans 9:6–7. But God has already promised the establishment of a Kingdom in Heaven (which we have chosen by Spirit) and a Kingdom on Earth (promised to the Jewish ethnicity through the Davidic Covenant). #### A Tale of Two Raptures on YouTube

From N.W.: During the Tribulation, will there be people left behind from the Church, or are they the people who come to the knowledge of Yeshua during the Tribulation? Is it because of the 144,000 that were sealed? I've heard a teaching that said the saints in the Tribulation are the ones who weren't prepared and are from the Church. I just want to understand. I appreciate your videos.

Shalom N.W.,

Scripture distinguishes between the Church and the saints (those who believed on Elohim during the Age of the Law, before Yeshua arrived and began the Age of Grace). At the Rapture, the Church is caught away into Heaven and goes to the Marriage Supper of the Lamb, and the Age of Grace ends. During the Tribulation, we see similarities to the Age of the Law. Immediately, we see the Beast persecute the saints before he commits the abomination of desolation.

It appears that those who had a "mental assent" or belief in God and claimed to be Christians but were never born again go into the Tribulation with a repentant heart, ready to fight the Beast and speak truth. But it's not enough just to believe that Jesus is Lord; you must surrender your life to Him, repent, and be born again. James 2:19 declares that even the demons believe in one God who is Lord over all. But they are not justified by this belief, and they are not repentant.

In Revelation 6:9, we see the souls of those saints who died during the Tribulation for declaring the truth of Jesus. They are justified by their act of faith and gain access to Heaven. Then God gives them a white robe for their sins to be covered and forgiven. After the abomination of desolation, the 144,000 are sealed and go out evangelizing the whole world about the Gospel of Jesus. Many are saved during this last half of Tribulation (which is often referred to as "the Great Tribulation") and are beheaded for not receiving the mark of the Beast.

# IDF "Kills" Gaza Boy, who Later Gives an Interview

In late May, Anthony Aguilar — a retired Green Beret who worked with the Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF) — claimed that he witnessed an incident so inhumane that it seemed destined to be remembered as one of the cruelest war crimes in history. There was just one catch: It wasn't true.

Aguilar stated that a young Gazan, whom he called Amir, approached him seeking some food. After receiving a bag of lentils, Amir kissed Aguilar's hand in gratitude and then departed, with everyone feeling happy. But Aguilar's happiness was soon shattered when Israel Defense Forces (IDF) soldiers fired on aid recipients and killed Amir. "Shot to the torso, a shot to the leg — dead," he told the BBC. "I've never seen such brutality."

That statement was true — he never did, because his story about the boy's death was a lie. Amir — whose real name is Abdul Rahim Muhammad Hamden but who goes by Abboud — later appeared in a TV interview, alive and unharmed. Fox News reported that he "was hiding out with his mother." Why was he hiding? Because if he had appeared, Hamas would likely have killed him, so as to preserve the propaganda of Aguilar's tale.

While interviewing the boy and his mother, Fox News journalists noted that they "appeared excited ahead of their planned extraction from the Gaza Strip." Abboud observed placidly: "Outside the Gaza Strip is nice."

Initially, Aguilar stated that the killing happened outside GHF aid site Secure Distribution Site-1 (SDS). Then, he claimed that it happened near SDS-2, but later said that it was outside SDS-3. Such contradiction happens when you make up a story.

The GHF, who doubted Aguilar's story from the beginning, fired him and sought to find the boy and determine what really happened. They finally found him by using facial recognition software based on video from Aguilar's body cam.

Apparently, the boy did receive lentils and did kiss Aguilar's hand in gratitude, but Aguilar's other statements were not true. What was his motive in spreading such monstrous lies? What drives his apparent hatred for the Jewish state? Will he be questioned?

In any case, the damage is done. Because millions heard Aguilar's claims, many people believe that Israel is committing genocide and that the IDF perpetrates war crimes with a blood-chilling casualness. The lie has gone several times around the world by now. The truth has finally finished tying its shoes and is making the rounds as well, but it won't have the same distribution. Nevertheless, Amir/Abboud's story stands as a warning to be extremely skeptical about reports that confirm the establishment media's biases.

## Israeli Scientists Pioneer Breakthrough in Glass Folding

A remarkable discovery by Israeli researchers at Tel Aviv University could transform the future of optics, computing, and advanced sensing. Scientists have developed a novel technique — called "photonic origami" — to fold ultra-thin sheets of glass into microscopic three-dimensional shapes on a chip using nothing more than a focused laser.

The innovation came entirely by accident. While trying to identify where an invisible laser beam hit a glass surface, graduate student Manya Malhotra turned up the power as instructed by her professor, Tal Carmon. Rather than glowing as expected, the glass bent and folded with perfect precision. This became the foundation for what is now hailed as a major leap in photonics — the science and technology of generating, detecting, and manipulating light.

ner than a human hair. Among the structures they created were helices, spirals, and mirrors all formed in under a millisecond.

The implications are immense. In smartphones, a single folded-glass zoom lens could replace multiple fixed-focus lenses, reducing hardware complexity while enhancing image quality. In computing, this technique may pave the way for microphotonic circuits — tiny devices that use light to transmit and process data faster and more efficiently than traditional silicon-based electronics.




Manya Malhotra discovered photonic origami by accident.

"Existing 3D printers can't make surfaces smooth enough for high-performance optics," said Carmon, a professor at the School of Electrical Engineering. "But our method allows glass to fold into shapes with less than one nanometer of surface variation — perfect for guiding light without distortion."

The researchers used controlled laser heating to briefly liquefy a specific region of the glass. Surface tension, stronger than gravity at this scale, pulls the molten region into a precisely curved fold. The result is astonishing: ultra-smooth, transparent, three-dimensional glass microstructures just 0.5 microns thick, about 200 times thin-

Medical diagnostics, environmental sensors, and industrial technologies also stand to benefit. Folded glass waveguides and mirrors can be embedded in chips for real-time, ultra-precise sensing in compact form factors.

"This opens up new possibilities that were previously unattainable in integrated optics," stated Carmon. "We can now build micro-zoom lenses, ultra-compact mirrors, and optical circuits that work with light instead of electricity.

# **Green-Med Diet Linked to Slower Brain Aging**

consume can shape how their brains
age. Researchers tracked nearly 300
adults for 18 months in Israel — using
whole-brain MRI and blood proteomics
— seeking to answer a simple question:
Can a dietary pattern — especially
a green-Mediterranean plan rich in
mankai (a nutritious duckweed), green
tea, and walnuts — shift the brain's
"biological age" and the proteins tied
to decline?

The trial, part of the long-running DIRECT PLUS project, compared three eating plans while scanning participants at the start and end of the intervention. Using machine-learning models, the researchers estimated each person's MRI-based brain age and compared it with chronological age—the so-called brain age gap. Participants whose brains looked "older" on MRI showed distinct changes in panels

of circulating proteins. Two molecules stood out: Galectin-9, linked in prior literature to inflammatory microglial signaling, and Decorin,

a matrix protein found at higher levels in patients with early Alzheimer's disease. People assigned to the green-Med group saw Galectin-9 fall and the rise of Decorin slow, pointing toward a biological pathway by which diet may influence neurodegeneration.

The work builds on earlier publications from the same cohort reporting slower brain atrophy and better glycemic control — both known risk factors for cognitive decline — under Mediterranean-style eating. While the authors do not claim diet alone prevents dementia, they argue that pairing MRI with large-scale protein mapping offers a practical way to monitor how lifestyle moves the needle long before symptoms emerge.

Results of the study were published in September in the peer-reviewed journal Clinical Nutrition. 🌣

learning of Charlie Kirk's assassination was one of denial. "I pride myself in confronting reality. This was one of the rare cases when I was unable to do so."

Despite his young age — 31 — Kirk was recognized as one of the most impactful young representatives of conservative thought in America and beyond. In 2012, he founded Turning Point USA, a nonprofit American organization that advocates for conservative politics on high school, college, and university campuses.

Prager, who is paralyzed from a serious injury in November 2024, was very influential in Kirk's life. For Prager, Kirk had become his voice.

"As an American, as a Jew, and as Dennis, I am devastated at the assassination of Charlie Kirk," he noted. Prager praised Kirk as one of the nation's strongest defenders of its founding principles.

"We have lost the most articulate spokesman for America and its unique value system," he added, describing the country as rooted in both Jerusalem and Athens—Judeo-Christian values and the Greek tradition of reason. Recounting Kirk's tireless tours across campuses—where he debated students, wielding both knowl-

edge and clarity — Prager noted that he had often watched these exchanges with gratitude. "America's youth in particular have lost a moral and intellectual leader, one who would, perhaps, have one day become their president."

From a Jewish perspective, Prager emphasized Kirk's unique role in championing Israel and Jewish communities abroad. "As a committed Jew, I thank God regularly that a non-Jew, a committed Christian, became one of the few great public spokesmen on behalf of Israel [and] the Jewish communities outside of Israel," he added, noting that Kirk's mastery of facts and eloquence were unmatched.

On a personal level, Prager described Kirk as a faithful friend, especially during his months of hospitalization after the fall that left him paralyzed. He recalled how Kirk's visits drew hospital staff to his room. "When members of the nursing staff heard that Charlie Kirk was visiting me, my room became the most popular one in the hospital," Prager commented. He added that Kirk shared the manuscript of his forthcoming book with him, dedicated to Prager, which advocates for



Shabbat observance for Christians and Jews alike.

The broadcaster concluded with a tribute to Kirk's widow, Erika, and their two children. "For one of the first times in my 20 years with my wife, Sue, I have seen her sob uncontrollably," he wrote. "The loss to us personally, and to the country generally, is immeasurable."

Prager was asked what it means when, in 2025, a targeted shooting can take place on a university campus — a setting where students should be free to debate ideas without fear.

"Increasingly, [it is] a world without a

functioning conscience," he stated. "The left's assault on the Judeo-Christian value system and broader American value system dedicated, in the words of the Declaration of Independence, to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness, has resulted in the moral chaos that pervades our universities."

He added that Kirk's presence on campuses had offered hope. "Charlie Kirk gave us reason to believe that this could be reversed. Witness the number of students who came out to hear him at Utah

Valley University and virtually every other university at which Charlie spoke. And witness Charlie sitting outdoors, responding to students expressing the left's contempt for America and Israel."


Prager was asked how he would describe Charlie Kirk to someone unfamiliar with him. "That they missed knowing one of the few truly great men of our time," he observed. "The good news is that thanks to the Internet, they can still know him and therefore know the magnitude of the loss of Charlie Kirk."

On whether the assassination might discourage public voices, Prager warned, "It might. That is precisely one of the things the assassination of Charlie was designed to do — not only silence a uniquely effective voice, but to intimidate all those who want to hear such voices."

Reflecting on his own recovery period, when he had time to consider history and faith, Prager was asked what century we are living in. His reply was blunt: "Whatever century was characterized by an assault on reason and Judeo-Christian values."

## **Ancient Village Emerges from Ashes**

A wildfire in late July swept through the Betiha Nature Reserve on the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee, laying bare hundreds of soot-covered mounds that may mark the long-lost village of Bethsaida.

After the flames raged for 17 hours, vegetation that had hidden the terrain burned to ash, revealing rock fragments, pottery shards, and part of a column — evidence of public buildings in what had been viewed as a modest fishing settlement.

"Each of these hills could be an ancient room," said Mordechai Aviam, head of the Kinneret College excavation. Walking the charred ground, Aviam pointed to blocks and a pillar drum that had been invisible before the fire.



Excavations at el-Araj, widely considered the leading candidate for Biblical Bethsaida, began in 2016 and entered their ninth season this past summer. Aviam directed the archaeology while

R. Steven Notley oversaw historical research. Volunteers arrived from around the world, including a Hong Kong family whose 12-year-old son first visited the site at age two.

The blaze stopped just short of a tarp covering the apse of a fifth-century Byzantine church-monastery, leaving the fabric unscorched. The church stands above a Roman-period settlement, and between them lies a Crusader-era sugar factory that reused Byzantine walls.

Lower layers yielded fishing gear, Roman ceramics, and the remains of a bath complex. "We are looking at a prosperous lakeside community during the time of Jesus," noted Aviam. He added that the steady flow of Roman pottery suggested an intact first-century layer below.

Findings at el-Araj have undermined the traditional identification of nearby et-Tell as Bethsaida; Aviam and Notley argued that et-Tell's elevation and distance from the water do not match the lakeside village described by the Gospels and by Josephus. El-Araj, situated on the shore, has produced limestone vessel fragments typical of Jewish households from the Second Temple period.

Links to the Apostolic Era continued to appear. Volunteers recovered Greek letters referring to Peter, and a mosaic inside the Byzantine church hailed him as "the prince of the Apostles." Historians commonly identify Bethsaida as the birthplace of Peter, Andrew, and Philip.

With vegetation cleared, the team marked new trenches aimed at exposing additional Roman-period houses and public buildings that Herod Philip planned to incorporate into the city of Julias.

# Belgian Doc Suspended for Anti-Semitic Social Media Posts After Patient Scandal

A Belgian hospital suspended a radiologist after investigators discovered a stream of anti-Semitic material on his social media accounts. The decision, however, came only days after the hospital defended the doctor who recorded a girl's Jewish heritage as though it constituted a clinical problem.

In August, *Israel Hayom* revealed that **Dr. Qassim Arkawazy** — a radiologist in Knokke, Belgium — <u>listed</u> "Jewish (Israeli)" under the "current problems"

section of a nineyear-old girl's medical report. The child had been admitted after falling and injuring her forearm.


but conceded it "could be seen as offensive." Hospital officials later announced that the child's digital file had been updated but stopped short of issuing disciplinary measures.

Belgian Jewish leaders called the explanation insulting. The Jewish Information and Documentation Center, a Belgian NGO monitoring anti-Semitism, filed formal complaints and pressed for a full investigation. Under mounting pressure, the hospital reversed course, acknowledging that Arkawazy's conduct violated both ethical and professional standards.

According to *The Algemeiner*, Arkawazy — a Shi'ite Muslim originally from Iraq — repeatedly shared virulently anti-Semitic content on Facebook in the months following Hamas's October 7 massacre in Israel. Disturbing posts included an AI-generated illustration

portraying Hasidic Jews as vampires preparing to devour a sleeping infant and a cartoon depicting babies decapitated by the point of a Star of David. In addition, Arkawazy's Facebook page was steeped in Islamist propaganda and anti-Zionist conspiracy theories.

This evidence prompted AZ Zeno to issue a new statement: "The doctor involved was suspended with immediate effect so that the investigation can proceed calmly and thoroughly."

While Jewish groups welcomed the hospital's eventual decision, the fact that Arkawazy was initially defended raises troubling questions about institutional reflexes when confronted with anti-Semitic behavior. This and similar scandals throughout Western countries reflect the normalization of anti-Jewish



animus in spaces where neutrality and ethics should reign supreme.

As *The Algemeiner* report documented, similar controversies have erupted in recent months:

In Italy, two medical workers filmed themselves discarding medicine manufactured by Israeli pharmaceutical giant Teva in a performative protest against Israel. The video circulated widely online, raising questions about patient safety and professional integrity.

A British doctor allowed to return to work in August had previously praised Adolf Hitler during an anti-Semitic tirade and made racist remarks about a colleague. Separately, University College London Hospitals NHS Trust was forced to apologize after anti-Israel posters — reading "Zionism is Poison" and "Free Palestine" — were displayed on hospital property, leaving Jewish patients afraid they would receive substandard care.

Fatimah Mohamied, a midwife in the UK who celebrated Hamas's atrocities on October 7, 2023, resigned after her social media posts were exposed. She has since filed a lawsuit against her former hospital employer, claiming her rights were violated.




An anti-Semitic Al-generated post that Qassim Arkawazy shared on his social media account

In the Netherlands, police launched an investigation into nurse Batisma Chayat Sa'id, accused of threatening to administer lethal injections to Israeli patients.

As anti-Semitism infiltrates medicine, the question is stark: Can Jewish patients still trust that the professionals tasked with saving their lives will treat them with equal care?

#### Israel's Plan to Save the Sea of Galilee

Israel plans to pump desalinated seawater from the Mediterranean into the Sea of Galilee, which is the country's main freshwater reservoir. Officials aim to reverse years of drought and falling water levels. A series of droughts pushed the lake dangerously close to the "black line" — the level at which water extraction becomes ecologically harmful and could cause irreversible damage.

By early November, the Water Authority expects to pump up to 1.3 million gallons of water per hour, with a long-term plan to expand to 3.9 million as additional infrastructure is completed.

The desalinated water will travel 62 to 93 miles, drawn from plants in Ashdod, Hadera, and other coastal sites. The project required upgrading pumping stations, constructing new pipelines, and reinforcing reservoirs, at a cost of around \$297 million.

"This is a historic event that has never been done before anywhere in the world," noted Firas Talhami, head of the Water Authority's northern region. "The project will restore the Zalmon stream as a perennial waterway, reviving plant and animal life.

#### Israeli Company's Tool Stops Scams in Progress

An Israeli cybersecurity company says it
can stop most scams before the potential
victim completes the transaction.

Israel-based BioCatch typically fights financial crime by tracking patterns in human behavior. The company has now launched Scams360™, its latest AI-driven tool designed to detect and block "authorized push payment" (APP) fraud in real time.

APP scams trick victims into willingly transferring money to criminals, often through emotional or high-pressure tactics such as romance, investment, or impersonation schemes.

Instead of focusing solely on transaction data, Scams360 looks at how a customer interacts online. It analyzes thousands of subtle cues — hesitation before typing, unusual mouse movements, typing speed changes, long pauses, or even the presence of a phone call during a banking session — to spot signs of manipulation.

BioCatch claims that it now monitors over 15 billion online sessions each month, protecting more than 500 million people worldwide.

"Already, we're seeing a 50% improvement in detecting scams that don't involve impersonation," noted Ayelet Eliezer, BioCatch's Chief Product Officer. "Our alert rate is also among the best in the industry, which means fewer false alarms and lower costs for banks — while stopping more fraud in real time."

The Global Anti-Scam Alliance estimates that scammers steal over \$1 trillion from consumers every year — a figure expected to rise as criminals use generative AI to enhance their schemes.

BioCatch helped one U.S. bank prevent \$100 million in scam losses in 2024.

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
