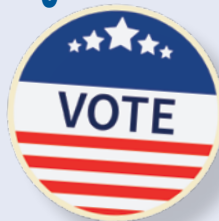

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true of school boards, city councils, and congressional seats — every seat where a few thousand dedicated bloc votes can flip the outcome. Muslim groups are coordinating like a military operation.

In New York City, the mayoral race had nonstop nationwide coverage, but **only 42% of registered voters showed up to vote**. However, **of nearly one million Muslims in the city, 93% voted** in the election, according to polls from the terrorist-tied Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR).

Thus, Zohran Mamdani became the city's first Muslim mayor because mosque

leaders instructed Muslims to vote for him while half the city slept.

That's the power of Muslim voting blocs.

New U.S. Muslim Voting Push

A national initiative ahead of the November 3rd midterm elections is encouraging Muslims to vote. The Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR) recently launched MuslimsVote, which provides registration information, personalized election information, polling places, voting rights information, civic engagement resources, and more.

Of the estimated 8+ million Muslims in America, more than 2.5 million are registered to vote.

According to CAIR, Muslims have "the power to shape elections, especially in key swing states. But millions more eligible Muslim voters must register, show up, and make their voices count."

CAIR has identified 12 states with concentrated Muslim communities where Muslim voters can make an impact: Arizona, Florida, Georgia, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, and

Wisconsin. **The outcomes of races in these states "will decide control of the U.S. House and Senate," CAIR stated.**

"Our mobilization is not symbolic — it is decisive."

David Lane, founder of American Renewal Project, makes a similar argument. For decades, he's encouraged Evangelicals and pro-life Roman Catholics to vote. He's also encouraged pastors to run for office. "If we stay home, candidates who oppose Biblical values will win and then draft and pass legislation to codify into law their values," Lane stated. "We're asking the living God to move into the public square of America."

While winning elections is important, Lane focuses on a bigger goal: "We all know that politicians are not going to save America, nor will Wall Street or even our powerful military. If America is to be saved, Biblical values must reign supreme. They must be returned to the public square." ☆





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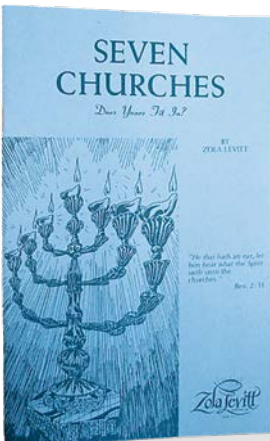

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generations of Hebrews. But this interpretation disregards the entire arc of Scripture.

A Dynasty Promise

A serious Old Testament scholar knows that the Abrahamic Covenant wasn't a one-man arrangement. This dynasty promise was everlasting, to "*a thousand generations*" (Deut. 7:9; 1 Chron. 16:15). The Lord's commitment to bless Abraham's seed — his descendants — is reiterated in subsequent covenants.

God promised Isaac:

Sojourn in this land, and I will be with you and bless you, for to you and to your offspring I will give all these lands, and I will establish the oath that I swore to Abraham your father. I will multiply your offspring as the stars of Heaven and will give to your offspring all these lands. And in your offspring all the nations of the Earth shall be blessed (Gen. 26:3–4).

Same covenant, next generation.

God reaffirmed it to Jacob:

...I am the LORD, the God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac. The land on which you lie I will give to you and to your offspring. Your offspring shall be like the dust of the Earth, and you shall spread abroad to the west and to the east and to the north and to the south, and in you and your offspring shall all the families of the Earth be blessed (Gen. 28:13–14).

Abraham, Isaac, Jacob — three generations, one unbroken covenant.

Psalms 105:8–11 seals the case:

He remembers His covenant forever, the word that He commanded, for a thousand generations, the covenant that He made with Abraham, His sworn promise to Isaac,



which He confirmed to Jacob as a statute, to Israel as an everlasting covenant, saying, "To you I will give the land of Canaan as your portion for an inheritance."

This isn't a promise to one man. It's a covenant made to Abraham, renewed to Isaac, confirmed to Jacob, and declared forever to the nation of Israel.

Balaam and the Blessing of the Nations

In Numbers 24, Moab's King Balak hired the pagan diviner Balaam to curse Israel. Instead, Balaam blessed the twelve tribes: "*Blessed are those who bless you, and cursed are those who curse you*" (Num. 24:9).

Balaam's words echo Genesis 12:3 and 27:29. Though Abraham had died centuries earlier, the blessing-and-cursing principle is applied without hesitation to the living nation of his descendants. The promise did not die with Abraham.

The Church in Genesis

Before turning to history, here's a reasonable question: If the Abrahamic Covenant extends to Israel as a nation, where do gentile Believers* fit in? The answer is hiding in plain sight in Genesis 12:2–3.

* "Believers" is short for "believers in Yeshua/Jesus as Messiah."

God makes two distinct promises to Abraham. First, Abraham will become *“a great nation”* — that is, Israel, the physical descendants through Isaac and Jacob. Second, God promised that *“in you all the families of the Earth shall be blessed.”* One is a nation; the other is the multitude of nations. Yet the promises are complementary: Israel is the vehicle through which God’s universal blessing travels. That’s why God changes Abram’s name to Abraham in Genesis 17 — he will be *“the father of a multitude of nations”* (Gen. 17:4).

In Galatians 3:8, Paul quotes Genesis 12:3 and explains that God preached the Gospel in advance to Abraham. Through Abraham’s seed — ultimately, the Messiah Jesus — all nations would be blessed with salvation. The Church fulfills the second half of God’s promise in Genesis 12. Gentile Believers are “all the families of the Earth” whom God mentioned. This isn’t a cancellation of the covenant with Israel, but its completion.

Let History Speak

In the Balfour Declaration of 1917, the British government expressed support for a Jewish homeland in Palestine — one of the last great acts of an empire that controlled roughly a fourth of the Earth’s landmass. It was said that “the sun never sets on the British Empire.” For decades, under leaders with strong Evangelical sensibilities, Britain championed Jewish restoration to their ancient land.

Then Britain turned.

In May 1939, the British government issued the White Paper, heavily favoring Arab demands. It limited Jewish immigration to 75,000 over five years, ended Jewish land purchases, and effectively closed the Holy Land’s doors even as Jews fled Nazi persecution across Europe. This breathtaking betrayal came precisely when the Jewish people needed refuge most.

What followed is striking. In 1940, the

British Empire still held a quarter of the world’s population and a fifth of its landmass. Yet within two decades, more than 20 British territories gained independence; by 1980, only a few remained under British control. The sun began setting on the empire almost immediately after Britain slammed the door on the Jewish people.

Meanwhile, America — long shaped by a deep Biblical heritage and a Puritan identification with Israel’s story — stepped into the void in 1948 and championed the founding of the modern State of Israel. President Harry Truman, a student of Scripture, recognized Israel just 11 minutes after its declaration of independence on May 14. In the decades that followed, the U.S. became the undisputed dominant world power — economically, militarily, culturally, and technologically. For nearly a century, no nation on Earth has come close.

Anecdote or Evidence?

Cynics will note that empires rise and fall for many reasons — wars, economics, nationalism. That’s true, and no honest theologian claims that the blessing-and-cursing principle operates like a vending machine. Still, the trajectory is undeniable. The nation that championed Jewish restoration rose to global preeminence.

The nation that betrayed the Jewish people and locked them out of their homeland as the Holocaust unfolded lost its empire within a generation.

That isn’t merely anecdote — it’s a pattern consistent with what Scripture promises. The promise did not die with Abraham but passed to his seed — renewed through Isaac and Jacob, reaffirmed through the pagan prophet Balaam, and written across the history of nations ever since.

Tucker Carlson is free to dismiss that pattern. But dismissing it won’t make it disappear. ☆

Halloween: Unmasked!

Autumn is here — with cooler breezes, pumpkin-spice lattes, bright foliage, and the end of the fall Feasts of the Lord. Unfortunately, October concludes with an insulin-boosting, sugar-filled pagan celebration that many mainstream Christians embrace: Halloween. We're not pointing fingers, so put down your pitchforks. However, please allow us to share the Biblical truth behind Satan's poorly veiled counterfeits so you might better understand why we "*abstain from every form of evil*" (1 Thess. 5:22).

Our parents were the first Believers in our immediate family line. Our Jewish mother was an orphan whose past holds more mystery than detail. Our father's family of intellectuals and musicians took an *educated* approach to religion — our grandfather became a high-ranking Buddhist, while our grandmother consulted departed spirits and extraterrestrials as a witch. So as kids, we got "Happy Halloween" cards and assigned spirit guides from them rather than birthday gifts.

Thankfully, our parents learned to combat the forces of darkness through the power of God's Spirit. Our mother worked in deliverance ministry, helping those escaping the occult and secret societies live a life of freedom in Messiah.

After we filmed in Israel last year, the Holy Spirit directed us to England and Ireland to teach many vital lessons,

including the Druid festival of Samhain (Halloween's origins). We arrived at Stonehenge — the world's most venerated Druid pagan site — on November 1, the highest satanic holy day. We encountered much spiritual opposition, but it was necessary for us to equip the Body of Messiah to counter deception and evil.

God's Opposition

Scripture clearly opposes dabbling in Satan's spiritual counterfeits: Leviticus

19:31; 20:27;
Deuteronomy
4:15-19; 18:10-12; 1
Chronicles 10:13;
2 Chronicles 33:6;
Revelation 2:14;
9:21; 21:8; 22:15.

Those Scriptures also detail many who practice so-called dark arts. *Menachesh* (sorcerer or diviner) has the same root as *nachash* (the serpent in Gen. 3). The verb means to "hiss, whisper, or utter enchantments." Diviners studied nature's signs to foretell

the future. Yeshua rebuked the Pharisees for this practice (Matt. 16:1-4). *Meonen* ("fortune tellers" or "omen readers") gave supernatural insight through demonic power, while a *qosem* was a diviner who interpreted omens and communicated with spirits (like Balaam the sorcerer, Num. 22-24). A *Sheol Obh* consulted demons (an *Obh* is a soothsaying demon).

Such "mediums" consulted familiar spirits to become guides to a host. A *yidoni* ("knowing one") is a soothsayer. A *Doresh el-Hammethim* (necromancer)

consults the spirits of the dead. A *Chobher chebher* is a spell-binder — speaking an incantation or spell to summon or (supposedly) trap an evil spirit. God continually warned the Israelites to reject such Satanic activity.

Occult in the Church

Though we attended a Christian high school, we had classmates who read horoscopes and studied astrology. Many experimented with Ouija boards, tarot cards, or crystal balls. Girls boasted that they summoned Bloody Mary at sleepovers. These are reminders that **Satan deceives society into accepting witchcraft, magic, and supernatural powers as harmless folklore**. He especially targets our children through books, movies, music, video games, phone apps, and holidays that include occult elements.

A subtle form of “practical witchcraft” has also infiltrated the Church.

In 1 Samuel 15:23, the prophet Samuel confronts King Saul with a profound spiritual truth: *“For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft [divination], and stubbornness [arrogance] is as iniquity and idolatry [teraphim].”*

Rebellion supports illegitimate authority, elevating man’s power over God’s sovereignty. Without submission to God’s authority, we function under the devil’s influence — witchcraft. Lucifer’s rebellion in Heaven originated from his pride. The fruit of pride is arrogance and stubbornness. Proud people make idols of their own opinions, placing their actions, thoughts, and will above God’s.

Legalism in congregations opens the door to witchcraft by elevating human self-righteousness and rigid self-

imposed standards above God’s grace, mercy, and love. Men then judge based on their own values and works rather than God’s forgiveness. Gaining artificial authority through human effort to rival God’s supremacy mirrors Lucifer’s original sin. As Romans 2:4 teaches, God’s goodness — not human legalism — leads people to repentance.

Control or Freedom?

At its core, witchcraft centers on control. People seeking to control override others’ free will because of their own fear, jealousy, or pride. Witchcraft controls through manipulation, intimidation, and domination. Insecure people influence others covertly through manipulation. Those who consider themselves strong seek to control others through intimidat-

tion. Both groups aim to dominate.

Ultimately, Satan seeks to take our freedom and force us to do his will, leading to slavery.

In contrast, God gives humans free will; the Holy Spirit never tries to control us.

Let’s pray for God to remove the blinders from our eyes and fill our spirits with His Word so that we can avoid Satan’s schemes. Scan the QR code (at right) to view a list of our past teachings on Halloween, the occult, and witchcraft. ✨

Media Attacks and Distortions

Israel is the first nation to be attacked by the world media.

Propagandists of all sorts have used radio, television, and newspapers for political reasons and, of course, they still do. Seldom, however, has an entire country been attacked on all fronts by virtually all media. As one of the world's most peaceful democracies and most successful enterprises, **Israel shouldn't be portrayed as a war-torn, beleaguered, desperate, dangerous place. It's simply not the truth.**

The subject came to my mind because of the recent problem with Firestone tires. I read a letter to *The Dallas Morning News* titled "Media Creates Hysteria Over Tire Recall." The writer, employed by a fleet leasing company that has over 300,000 vehicles on lease, took the position that Firestone couldn't help itself at the moment because of the media "hysteria" over the problems with its tires. He didn't rule on the case but simply asserted that the media is no help to anyone with their trumpeting of dramatic statistics and constant overstatements.

While I'm not sure about the tire situation, as a media worker for over 30 years, I'm aware of the power of the written word or broadcast. When used properly — such as to dispassionately cover legitimate news events, election campaigns, or even the weather — the media are useful to society and are, indeed, one of the strong points of a democracy. A free press is essential to sensible, day-to-day living. Yet many people in the world are suffering without one, including in China, North Korea, Cuba, and the Arab countries. Thus, one third to one half of people worldwide are receiving "managed news."

Sometimes this is true in the U.S., as well. On certain subjects, we Americans get distorted messages. Obviously, reports of robberies, fires, and assaults on the local evening news waste everybody's time

and contribute little to our lives. But my subject is the Holy Land. And my personal problem with the media is that they invariably favor the Arab position over the Israeli.

This is easy to explain. I've said it before, but it bears repeating: A great deal of advertising space on American media is purchased by petro-dollar products, such as oil and gasoline, plastics, cosmetics, etc. Any business naturally wants to cater to its better customers, and so the Arabs — important oil suppliers — get almost a free ride. Thus, **very few media people see the Israeli side of things. Add to this the anti-Semitism found throughout the world, and you have a real bias against Israel.**

But here's the Biblical side of things. God promised Israel to His friend, Abraham, and to Abraham's seed through Isaac and Jacob as an "everlasting covenant," and that's all there is to that. There can be no violation at any time by anyone without serious consequences. When Anwar Sadat received the conquered territories in Egypt in the Camp David Accords in the late '70s, he was actually taking a part of Israel God had promised to the Chosen People ("*from the river of Egypt...*" [Gen. 15:18](#)). Sadat was assassinated. When Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin of Israel gave part of the land — also promised to the Jews — to Arafat and his henchmen, Rabin was also assassinated.

The Biblical principle here is that we cannot change the borders of the Promised Land. It is not an ordinary land. It is God's country. We change its borders at peril of extinction. The ancient Babylonians, Persians, Greeks, and Romans — all mighty empires at one time — changed the borders of Israel. Now they are all extinct!

In the future, the whole world will attempt to change the borders of Israel in the fiasco called Armageddon, which will



mark the end of God's patience. The King will return, and the Land will be restored as promised in the Scripture noted above. And no one on Earth will ever change it again. Jerusalem will never be a divided city, not in the 1,000-year Kingdom and not even in eternity, when it will appear as the New Jerusalem and be with us forever and ever.

Meanwhile, the media continue to cut and slash at a land that is modern, beautiful, and running like a watch, constantly disparaging it in print and in electronic

reports. Our *Levitt Letter* publishes writers who take the other view, simply because the Israeli side of things is so seldom presented in print or other media.

As far as I'm concerned, **loving Israel is one of the most holy, Godly, and spiritual pursuits that can happen in a Christian life.** It is my heart and soul, and I give myself to it completely. And in the Kingdom to come, I will be ready to reside there along with the rest of the Church, because I paid fitting attention to it in this life. ✨

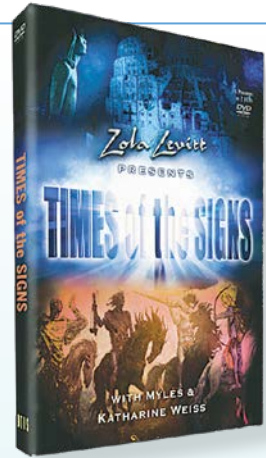

Behind the Scenes

In the July 2026 Levitt Letter, the BBB's article "[Turkey: Mission Possible!](#)" (pp. 6–7) features photos of them flying in a hot air balloon over Pamukkale, hiking Mount Ararat at 10,000 feet, and preparing to teach Bible at Laodicea. The following statements from Caleb are highlighted:

- "In hindsight, this divine timing was perfect" — regarding having postponed their Turkey shoot [for our now-broadcasting [Return of the Nephilim TV series](#)] from Fall 2025 to Spring 2026.
- "Yet each obstacle only confirmed that God was directing us toward a very special purpose." — relating to Iran's incessant missile and drone attacks causing repeated flight cancellations for Joshua and Caleb, our Israeli film crew, guest teachers, and a cameraman.

Below are excerpts from a heartfelt email that Caleb wrote to fellow staffers, which nicely complements the BBB's July Levitt Letter article. How inspirational to see them rejoicing in their travails as well as victories while working for the Lord! Not to mention tirelessly sharing the Gospel far and wide during their filming expeditions (Matt. 9:37–38; Mark 16:15; 2 Tim. 4:2; Ps. 96:3) — Mark

Good afternoon, everyone.

Joshua and I are once again stateside, still reacclimating to our time-zone. I'm happy to be back at home, giving you a summary of our spring TV production in Turkey.

We thank God that the trip was a resounding success! We filmed everything that we needed, as our Heavenly Father was faithful to divert and alter our schedules and preconceived ambitions to complete all the episodes on our schedule.

The footage we filmed is technically stunning — beyond our customary quality, thanks to our new camera lenses and video formats. Physically, Turkey's beauty in the spring is breathtaking, resembling a fantasy film or video game more than reality. Snowcapped mountains, lush green valleys filled with blossoming flowers, and unique geology cover the breadth of Turkey's unique topography.

Spiritually, the country is as dark under Islamic dominance as one could imagine. Istanbul has more mosques than I've seen in my entire life. Throughout the country, we noticed an obviously wide cultural split between hardcore Muslims and secular Turks. The country's youth are searching; they aren't satisfied with the state religion. Thus, the mission fields there are ripe for harvest — someone just needs to bring them the Gospel!

Through the Internet, Turkish people can access more unfiltered media than Syrians. However, the news on television and in public venues is still vastly curated propaganda. None was more prevalent than what we witnessed during our ventures to several "holy" sites such as the Hagia Sophia, a fifth-century basilica turned mosque, where **an army of "helpful" security and**





information nazis attentively listened to every word our guide spoke to ensure that it aligned with their altered rendition of Islamic history.

Filming at the sites of the Seven Churches (Rev. 2–3) was beyond difficult, requiring God’s supernatural intervention so we could teach what was needed. Thanks to treacherous windstorms at Pergamum, rainstorms at Ephesus, late-rising security at Smyrna, and frigid temperatures at Thyatira, we were able to declare our Biblical content boldly on location without intervention from security or nosy officials. Even when we were deterred at a small site of ancient Philadelphia, a friendly security guard allowed us access to film at alternate sites. He even led us to the grounds of an ancient temple that we thought we wouldn’t be able to access. God’s faithfulness was always on display.

The ancient Carchemish site on the border of Syria is a powder keg of turmoil since it lies on a Turkish military base. Half of the ruins extend across the border. The place was closed to the public, and the main road had collapsed due to the rainy season. Surprisingly, the curator gave us a personal tour of

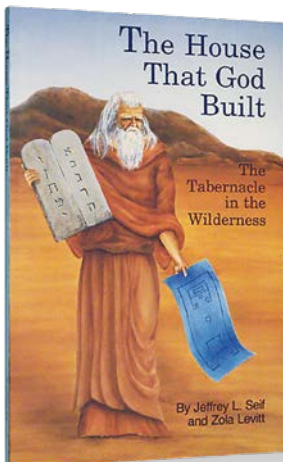
the area when he learned that we had traveled all the way from Texas.

While many of our filming locations are on the bucket list for many Christians, **Mount Ararat is the foremost site I’ve longed to visit since I was a child.**

Thunderstorms on the only day we had scheduled to ascend the mount worked to our advantage. A mild rainy, snowy, sleeting deterrent cleared out when our cameras were ready to roll. Cloud cover facilitated filming on the snowy cliffs, whereas bright sunlight would have created excessive glare. The awe-inspiring view from Ararat, reflective of God’s unbreakable covenants, left me intermittently speechless. —Caleb

Dear Reader: ZLM’s humble office staffers appreciate how Joshua and Caleb treat them like fellow Christian soldiers. The same goes for independent vendors whom our ministry hires to help with on-location TV shoots. For example, all of our *Lobstermen* TV series crew that the BBB hired in Maine not only became Believers but also either reduced their rates drastically or outright volunteered their time and equipment. Amazing!

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On the night before His crucifixion, Jesus prayed in Gethsemane. Beyond an ordinary prayer, Jesus understood the magnitude of what was coming: *“And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground”* (Luke 22:44). Jesus experienced what is medically termed “hematidrosis,” a Greek compound word meaning “blood” and “sweat,” or “bloody sweat.”

During times of extreme emotional stress, hematidrosis can occur when tiny blood vessels in the sweat glands rupture and mix blood with perspiration.¹ This leaves the skin extremely sensitive, which would have made Christ’s sufferings all the more acute and painful. Notably, **Luke the physician was the only Gospel writer to record this detail**, consistent with other medical notations throughout his account of Christ’s life and ministry.

Though rare, hematidrosis is documented throughout history. Three centuries before Christ, Aristotle referenced it in both humans and animals. In the 15th century, Leonardo da Vinci described a soldier sweating blood before battle. Modern medicine has studied 76 cases, all linked to extreme stress or anticipated trauma. This is precisely what Luke described when he used the Greek word *agonia* (“agony”).

Even before entering Gethsemane, Jesus was *“overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death”* (Matt. 26:38; Mark 14:34). As the sinless Second Person of the Godhead, Jesus foreknew that He would bear the weight of humanity’s sins; He would endure God’s full wrath as the atoning sacrifice for sin (Rom. 3:25; 1 John 2:2). This caused the Father

to turn away when Jesus hung on the Cross, as evidenced by three hours of supernatural darkness and Jesus’ cry, *“My God, My God why have You forsaken Me”* (Matt. 27:45–46). In the Garden, Jesus also foresaw the betrayal, denial, scourging, and crucifixion. These dreadful expectations caused such extreme anguish that His body responded with bloody sweat.

Christian author and researcher Dr. Dave Miller observes:

...Even before Jesus endured the torture of the Cross, He suffered far beyond what most of us will ever suffer. His penetrating awareness of the heinous nature of sin ... and the extreme measure necessary to deal with it, make the Passion of Christ beyond comprehension.²

Some Bible commentators wrongly treat Luke 22:44 as figurative — as though Jesus merely sweated profusely. But Luke’s language argues otherwise. The Greek word *thromboi* (“great drops”) refers to clotted blood, and *hosei* (“like” or “as it were”) denotes condition, not mere comparison. As Greek scholar Henry Alford explained, Luke’s intent was “to convey the idea that the sweat was ... *like drops of blood*; i.e., *colored with blood*.” To read it as simply heavy sweating is, according to Alford, to “make the insertion of αίματος [“blood”] not only superfluous but absurd.”³

Jesus’ bloody sweat reminds us that His emotional sufferings were as real as His physical sufferings. To accomplish salvation, Jesus first resolved it with great agony in Gethsemane. Then, He enacted it by His atoning death on the Cross at Calvary. ✨

During our 60th Gospel outreach in June, August Rosado and I visited the major shopping mall in Tiberias, where we met **Agas**. Despite the language barrier, Google Translate helped us communicate with this Israeli woman.

We explained the Jewish Gospel and how through Messianic prophecy, foretold and fulfilled, God certified Israel's Messiah as *Yeshua min Nazarit* (Jesus of Nazareth). Agas accepted from us a free complete Hebrew Bible so that she could discover this truth. We also gave her a list of major Messianic prophecies that Yeshua fulfilled — prophecies that Israel has long waited for One to fulfill (Matt. 11:3).

Now, may she accept Him who gave sight to blind people, made the lame walk, cleansed lepers, enabled the deaf to hear, and raised the dead. Blessed are those who don't stumble in unbelief over Him (Matt. 11:6).

The Lord then opened the door for August and me to talk with **Edan**. We told her how Jesus fulfilled the Jewish Scriptures that foretold that the Messiah must suffer, rise from the dead to enter His glory, and return to a regathered and restored Jewish nation to rule and reign over all the Earth (Isa. 53; Luke 24:26; Deut. 30:1-5; Rev. 20:2-6). Edan was grateful that we traveled internationally to share the Good News with her. She said that she looked forward to studying the complete Bible that we gave her.

That afternoon, we visited Tabgha in the lower Galilee — the traditional site where Jesus fed over 5,000 people (John 6:2-13). **Nathanial**, a Jewish man, ap-

proached us and asked what happened here. Stunned at this divine encounter, August and I detailed Yeshua's miracle with the loaves and fishes. Interestingly, Nathanial was traveling with his Christian friend **Philip**.

We explained that much of Yeshua's ministry occurred in the Galilee. Then, we confirmed how God offers every person salvation and eternal life with Him through faith in the life, death, and resurrection of Yeshua the Messiah. *Ruach HaKodesh* (the Holy Spirit) persuaded Nathanial to accept a Hebrew Bible and Messianic Gospel tracts so that he can fully understand the importance of what God in the flesh accomplished in the Galilee region some 2,000 years ago, which continues to have saving repercussions.

Thank you for your gifts to this ministry, which enable us to take Yeshua's Good News to His people in Israel. Please pray for those who heard our witness, that they will accept the forgiveness and life that comes only through faith in Yeshua. ✨

Young Evangelicals Visiting Israel: “We Should Not Stay Silent”

Oklahoma native Hayden Jones first experienced anti-Semitism when someone spat on him at the U.S. Capitol for wearing a yellow ribbon in solidarity with the Israeli hostages being held by Hamas in Gaza.

The 22-year-old Christian grew up in a pro-Israel home. Though he studied at a private Christian university in Tulsa, he was largely sheltered from campus demonstrations that followed the Hamas massacre on October 7, 2023. Thus, Jones was shocked to encounter pro-Hamas and pro-Hezbollah supporters while working in Washington, D.C. “It showed me that there is a loud, vocal minority and a silent majority where most people are sitting on the fence,” he explained.

Jones recently joined other Christian students and young professionals, mostly from the U.S., in a weeklong tour of Israel. The event was aimed at countering declining support for Israel among young Evangelicals.

Many visitors stated that the Bible came alive for them in Israel. “I felt I was stepping into the place I read about for years in my Bible,” commented Pedro Martins, 24, of São Paulo, Brazil. “This trip has made me understand that I should not stay silent.”

Maisie Skiles, 23, who’d witnessed much anti-Israel activity in her native California, didn’t know what to expect on her first visit to Israel. “The most surprising thing for me was how at home I felt,” she noted.

One of the highlights for her was a visit to the Western Wall where people were united in prayer. “As a Christian, I was crying next to a woman very different from me,” Skiles added. “It made it seem like a call to action for me.”

This was the third visit to Israel for Avery Williams, 27, of Dallas, Texas. She works for Eagles’ Wings, an international Evangelical group that organized the trip. “To come and see the land and see the freedom and diversity that exists is so opposite of the mainstream narrative that is common on social media.”

For many, the tour highlight was a Shabbat dinner with Jewish families in the Jerusalem-area community of Efrat. They noted that the communal reverence of the family gathering was often lacking in their own societies, save for Christmas.

As the group traveled, participants hummed a version of John Denver’s 1971 song *Take Me Home, Country Roads*, replacing the refrain with the words, “Shalom, shalom, we are home.” ✡

One of the greatest of sins is to forget who you really are—a prince or princess of God. Forgetting who you are leads to forgetting who the Lord is, just as forgetting who the Lord is leads to forgetting who you are. Therefore, the Lord constantly tells us to remember and not forget the call of His heart, the message of His love.

Heeding this message is difficult in our fallen world, since God does not want our relationship with Him to be trivial. Our hearts must be tested in "desert places" (Deut. 8:16) until they cry out, *"You are my LORD; I have no good apart from You"* (Ps. 16:2). As Abraham Heschel said, *"God is of no importance unless He is of supreme importance."*

There is no compromise on this point: We are to love the Lord with all our heart, with all our soul, and with all our strength.

King David envisioned the Divine Presence standing before him, as close as his right hand. David *"set the LORD always before [him]"* (Ps. 16:8a), which means that he consciously chose to regard all he did in relationship with the Master of the Universe. David's focus made his heart steadfast and unshaken during the great trials of his life. He understood that *"all things work together for good to those who love God"* (Rom. 8:28). David's awe over God's abiding presence grounded him

in reality, therefore he neither feared nor flattered men. The Lord was his Rock and his Salvation.

There are two great questions God always is asking us. The first is "Who do you say that I am?" The second is "Do you love Me?" Being in a love relationship with God is the goal of life, the "end of the Law," and the reason we were created. But we cannot truly love God apart from understanding His passion for us. The Lord is the Jealous God, a Consuming Fire Who desires all of our heart upon the altar (Luke 9:23).

The message of the Cross is that our lives matter to God. We are *am segulah* — a treasured people — called to walk in the zeal of God's love (1 Pet. 2:9; Titus 2:14). Your life has great value; you are significant, and you are truly loved by our Heavenly Father. There is a "future and a hope" reserved for you (Jer. 29:11); there is *"a white stone, and on that stone will be written a new name that no one can understand except the one who receives it"* (Rev. 2:17). *"Trust in the LORD with all your heart..."* (Prov. 3:5). Is there anything more important than setting the Lord always before you? Is there any ill for which this is not a sure remedy? Even if war should rise against you, in this will you find confidence. Therefore, set the Lord always before you; fix your heart upon Him and find comfort in the power of His love. ☆

The Stones Cry Out DVD Set

Twelve 30-minute TV programs on 3 DVDs

Archaeological discoveries continue to validate the Biblical record. To film “dig sites” and interview experts, Zola journeyed to Israel and Jordan. Just as our Lord said about this remarkable Land, *The Stones Cry Out*.

The Tunnel Zola walks the tunnel under the western edge of the Temple Mount. We get a journalist’s perspective of the Palestinian uproar that erupted when the tunnel was opened to the public in 1996.

A Tale of Two Temples An unearthed marketplace shows the Roman destruction of the Temple. Mount Gerizim to the north hosts the excavation of a Samaritan temple patterned after the Jerusalem Temple.

Rulers in Stone Caesarea, on Israel’s Mediterranean coast, has yielded first-century finds such as the first extra-Biblical reference to Pontius Pilate, and a full-size Temple replica. At Tel Dan, the “House of David” has been confirmed archaeologically.

The Jerusalem That Was Bible Lands Museum houses a model of Jerusalem as it would have looked in 586 B.C. In the City of David, we examine a four-room house, typical architecture for ancient Israelites.

Past and Future Destruction Ongoing excavations at Hazor have unearthed Canaanite idols and confirmation of the city burning as recorded in Joshua 11. The Valley of Armageddon holds prophetic archaeological significance.

Archaeology and the Scriptures In Jerusalem, Zola explains the history of the Citadel, also called “David’s Tower.” We talk with the Israel Antiquities Authority.

Cities of the Past Zippori was a thriving cultural center in Galilee that probably influenced Jesus as a boy in Nazareth. Ekron was one of five prominent Old Testament cities of the Philistines.

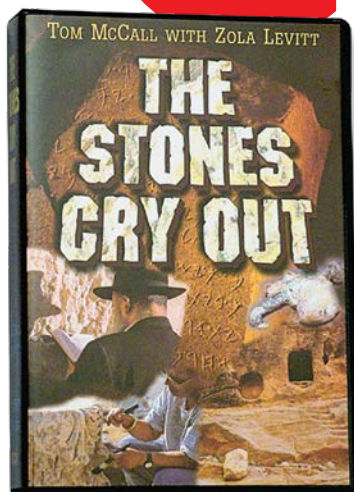
Shadows from the Past A chamber of tombs, near the Garden Tomb but dated to the time of the First Temple, helps us understand burial customs of that day. We visit the Qumran cave where the first Dead Sea Scroll was found.

A Tale of Three Cities In Biblical times, a business relationship existed between three Jordan Valley cities: Beit Shean, Rehovot (west of the Jordan River), and Pella (east of the Jordan River). We visit excavations in each city.

The Rose Red City The ancient Nabataeans were famous for their skill in rock carving. Petra, their capital southeast of the Dead Sea, is the “rose-red city” that’s known for its magnificent buildings carved into the native rock.

A Man Crucified On display at the Rockefeller Museum in Jerusalem, a man’s heel bone that was pierced by a nail is the first archaeological proof of Roman crucifixions in Israel.

Truth from the Stones Zola discusses how the artifacts shown throughout this series illuminate Scripture, and how Believers can be encouraged when *The Stones Cry Out*.

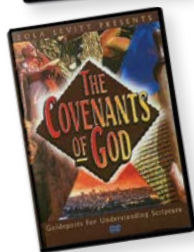
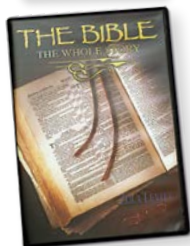
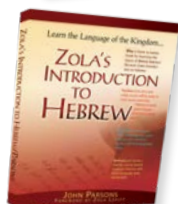

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Secrets of the Scrolls DVD Set (7 progs. on 2 DVDs)

In 1947, a Bedouin boy in search of a lost goat threw a stone through the narrow opening of a cave. Hearing the sound of breaking pottery, he entered the cave and happened upon a 2,000-year-old treasure. He had discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls. *Secrets of the Scrolls* gives a historical account of these treasured manuscripts and presents some remarkable revelations. The authors of the Scrolls were intensely Messianic and appear to have documented the fulfillment of prophecy in the person of the Messiah. Terms such as “son of God,” “branch of David,” “stripes or piercings,” “being put to death,” and “raising the dead” all strike a familiar chord. Quite possibly, these incredible Scrolls represent the first extra-Biblical revelation of Jesus Christ in history.



The Scrolls — A New Revelation We quickly produced this half-hour program when the Scrolls first became widely accessible for study. Zola quotes from the Associated Press news release and emphasizes the significance of access.

The Scrolls: Part 2 Within days of our first program's broadcast, Dr. James Tabor phoned Zola to initiate a series of interviews that would unveil one of the 20th century's most dramatic revelations. This program is the first of these interviews. A professor of Religious Studies at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, Dr. Tabor delivers an incredible lesson.

The Scrolls: Part 3 During this interview, Dr. Tabor refers to several books about the Scrolls, including *The Complete Dead Sea Scrolls in English* by Vermes (Penguin Press), *The Dead Sea Scriptures* by Gaster (Anchor Doubleday), and *A Facsimile Edition of the Dead Sea Scrolls* (2 Volumes) by Robert H. Eisenman and James M. Robinson.

The Scrolls Special This program consolidates the first three programs and delivers their powerful message in only thirty minutes. Later discoveries in Scrolls research inspired the three following programs.

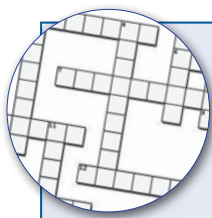

Dr. Robert Eisenman, a professor of Middle East religions at California State University at Long Beach, discusses the fascinating history of the Scrolls.

In Search of Answers Dr. Eisenman recaps his quest to gain access to the Scrolls. Dr. Tabor describes his archaeological team and how they map the caves in Qumran.

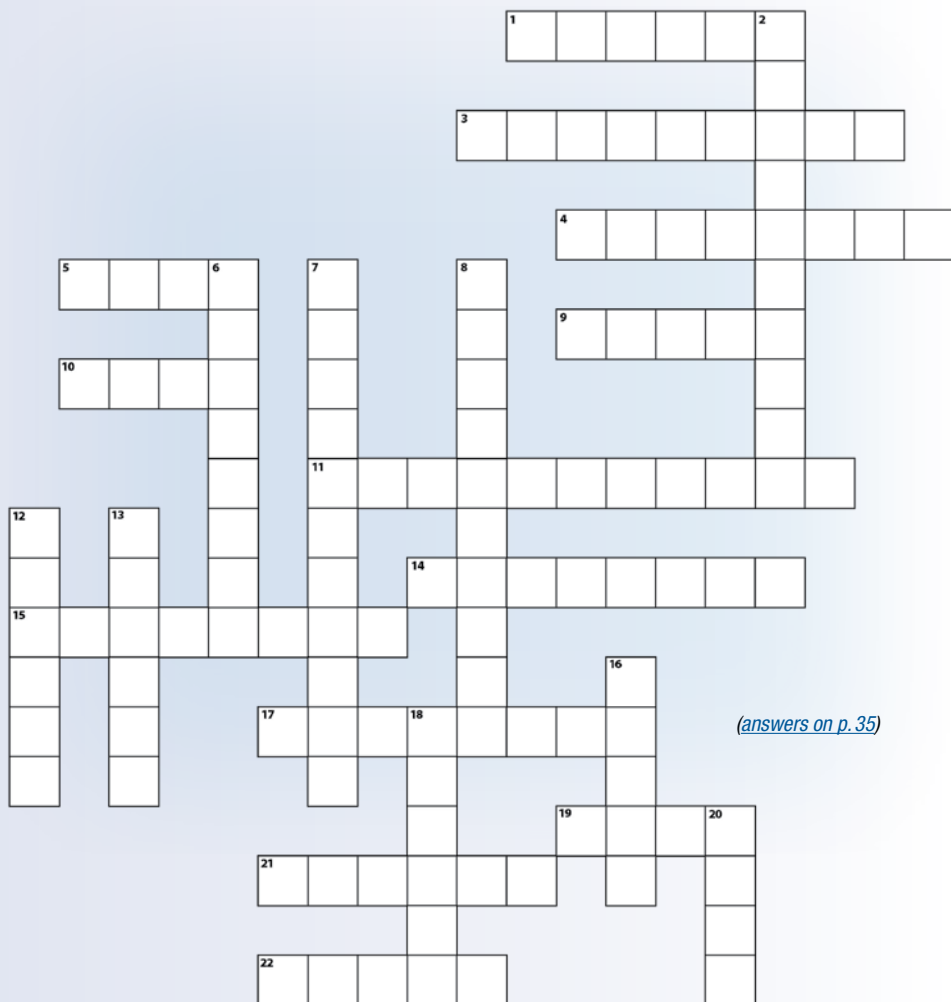
Prof. Michael Wise An in-depth interview with a professor of Aramaic, the language of Yeshua. University of Chicago Professor Wise helped translate the fragments when they were first released and enthusiastically discusses The New Jerusalem text, telling how the future will be.

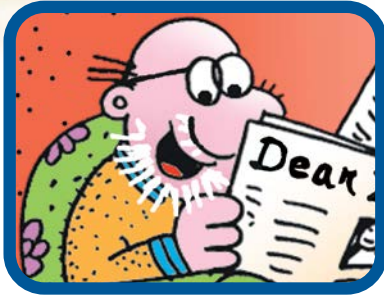

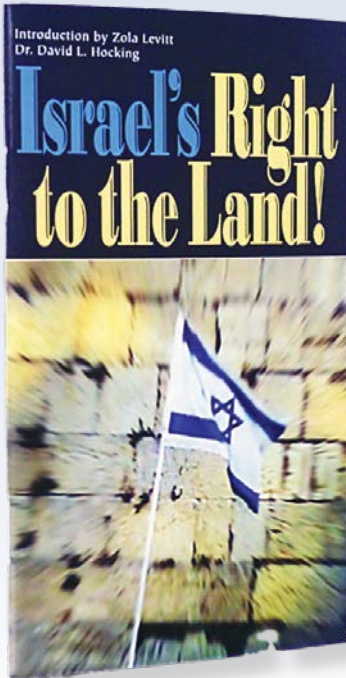

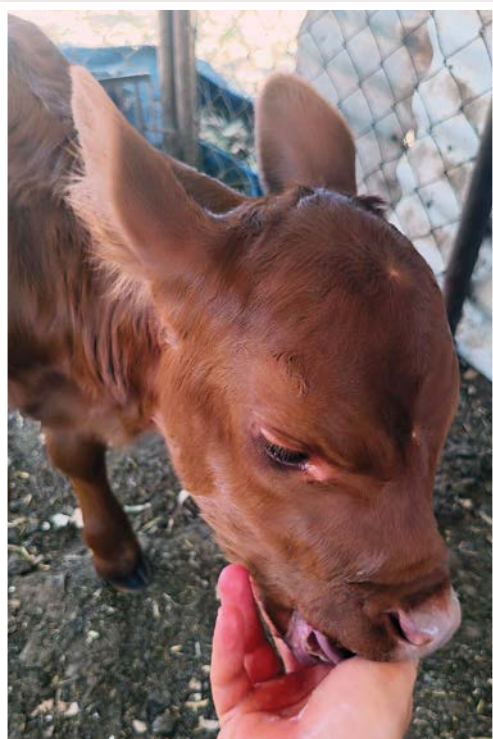

Second Red Heifer Born in Israel

The red heifer born in July

In July, the National Red Heifer Institute announced the birth of a second red heifer in Israel within roughly six weeks. Institute officials described this as another significant step toward restoring the Biblical laws of purification connected to a future Temple.

The new heifer was born in the Golan Heights just before Tisha B'Av (a day of communal mourning that began at sunset on July 22). **In addition, two red heifers were inseminated in Ancient Shiloh** as part of the Institute's ongoing effort to establish a full herd.

Shai Givon, the breeder whose herd produced the new heifer, believes that the timing is no coincidence. "I feel that we are living in a historic era. The Jewish people are more attuned than ever to the Temple and to restoring purity to Israel. God is opening doors and opportunities that have not existed in 2,000 years."

Because physical blemishes could disqualify the animal for the ritual described in Numbers 19, no ear tag was placed on the calf at birth. However, the heifer was born as the female twin of a male calf, raising questions about a possible internal reproductive defect. Rabbi Azariah Ariel, head of the Institute's Beit Midrash, stated that the matter will undergo careful review. "There is a real question as to whether a birth defect that is not external and visible on the cow's body disqualifies her unblemished status."

Institute leaders say that interest in the Temple continues to grow throughout Israel. Yehuda Ben Tzvi noted that educational programs have reached thousands of people and described "a tremendous public awakening around the Temple."

Givon believes that the recent developments point to something even greater. **"We are on our way to raising a full herd of red heifers.** The team at the Institute expected potential heifers to be born this season, but her birth so close to Tisha B'Av gives the strong sense that God is pressing us to accelerate the path toward building the Temple. The real question is whether we want to."

God's Word is clear that a Third Temple will be built. Each new red heifer development keeps that reality in the public eye.

As prophetic news continues to break, we can rest assured that history will unfold exactly as the Bible has foretold. God's prophetic timeline has never failed, and it never will. ☆

Startup Provides Drone Attack Warning System to Israeli Army

Israeli startup Magos Systems, a developer of AI-native radar technology, will supply Israeli defense ground forces with its early-detection alert system against fast-evolving unmanned aerial threats, including fiber-optic drones.

Fighting on multiple fronts over the past three years, Israel has struggled to fend off explosive drone attacks in southern Lebanon and on the northern front. The Iran-backed Hezbollah terror group's unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) incursions provide a constant threat to Israel's security. On June 19, Hezbollah launched an explosive-laden drone that caused the deaths of an Israeli tank battalion commander and three soldiers.

Though drones are slower-moving and usually less destructive than rockets or missiles, they are difficult to detect and track since they often fly at low altitude. Drones also pose a challenge because defenders must deploy various assets to intercept their weapons.

Founded in 2010 by electrical engineers Aviel Kisliansky, CEO, and Amit Isseroff, VP R&D, Magos has developed an early-warning, radar-based technology system to help protect ground forces against low-flying aerial threats. The lightweight radar system is based on beamforming technology and com-

bines advanced algorithms to classify moving objects as drones, birds, or vehicles. The technology filters out false alarms and alerts defense teams only when necessary.

"By fusing radar detection data with information from cameras deployed in the field, the system delivers real-time, multi-dimensional situational awareness of both ground and aerial threats," Kisliansky stated. "The new system enables simultaneous, highly accurate classification of people, vehicles, and drones, while maintaining reliable performance in challenging weather conditions and effectively filtering out false alarms caused by wildlife, including birds, and other environmental movement."

Magos' drone detection system has passed rigorous evaluations by clients in Israel and worldwide. The company has manufactured and deployed thousands of radar systems across more than 70 countries in North America, South America, and Europe. Among its customers are defense facilities, government sites, and critical infrastructure sites, including energy and power facilities, solar farms, ports, data centers, and logistics hubs. ☆



Reducing Deep Stomach Fat Improves Brain Function

In a groundbreaking study, published in *Nature Communications*, researchers from Israel's Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Leipzig University, and Harvard University discovered that inner abdominal fat could lead to brain atrophy and cognitive decline.

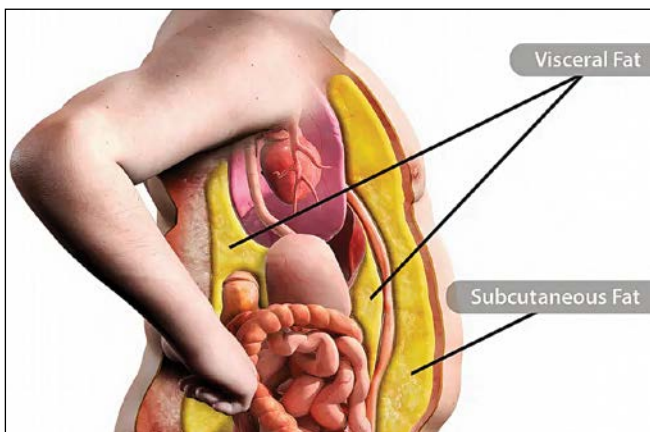
The research focused on ectopic adipose tissue — visceral fat that wraps around organs in the abdomen, unlike subcutaneous fat under the skin. Dr. Dafna Pachter, the study's lead author, noted that this type of fat “is very dangerous,” affecting brain health more than body mass index or body weight.

Researchers followed 533 middle-aged and older adults for 5 to 16 years who ate a Mediterranean-style diet rich in vegetables, fruit, fish, and chicken, with no red meat. Participants also consumed green tea, walnuts, and Mankai (duckweed), a nutrient-dense plant that's grown commercially only in Israel.

“The research showed that a reduction in visceral fat, even for 18 months, could decrease brain atrophy 5 and 10 years later,” Pachter noted, regardless of how much weight the participants lost.

The study, which began in 2010, involved employees at the Shimon Peres Negev Nuclear Research Center in Dimona. Participants received three meals a day and underwent ongoing MRI testing, blood tests, and cognitive assessments.

Researchers found that participants with the highest internal abdominal fat showed an expansion of the brain's ven-

tricles — fluid-filled spaces that signal accelerated aging and dementia risk.

Lower visceral fat accumulation also correlated with higher scores on the Montreal Cognitive Assessment, which evaluates memory, attention, and language to detect mild cognitive impairment and early dementia. Since MRI tests aren't routinely available, Pachter emphasized that measuring waist circumference is a simple way to evaluate abdominal fat. As waist circumference decreases, abdominal fat also declines.

A healthy waist circumference is generally under 35 inches for women and under 40 inches for men.

According to Pachter, lifestyle changes can help reduce visceral fat: moderate aerobic exercise, reducing simple carbohydrate intake, and adopting a green Mediterranean diet. High-intensity interval training (HIIT) can also be effective.

She concluded that good nutrition protects the liver and heart, which “is the best way to protect our brains.” ☆



UN's Guterres Faults Israel, Ignores Turkey

UN Secretary-General António Guterres applies inconsistent standards when discussing Israel and Turkey. In August, he condemned Israel for violating Syrian sovereignty in the Golan Heights. Yet during a July visit to Cyprus, he made no mention of Turkey's 52-year occupation of Northern Cyprus — despite multiple UN Security Council Resolutions on the issue.

Guterres “continues to apply a blatant double standard toward Israel,” noted Danny Danon, Israeli ambassador to the

by Israel of the 1974 Disengagement of Forces Agreement are unacceptable and must stop.”

Israel liberated the Golan Heights from Syria in a defensive effort during the 1967 Six-Day War and annexed the strategic mountainous area in 1981. President Donald Trump has backed Israeli sovereignty over the Golan since 2019. [Editor's note: In August, Colombia's President Abelardo de la Esparriella also recognized Israel's sovereignty on the Golan Heights.]

UN. “When Israel is involved, he is quick to condemn and demand immediate action. Yet when it comes to Turkey's decades-long occupation of Northern Cyprus, in clear contradiction to UN resolutions, the tone suddenly shifts.”

During his Syria visit, Guterres stated that “Syria's sovereignty, independence, unity, and territorial integrity must be fully respected” and that “violations

The 1974 Disengagement Agreement between Israel and Syria established a buffer zone, mandated prisoner exchanges, and created the UN Disengagement Observer Force to monitor the ceasefire.

Following Syrian President Bashar al-Assad's regime collapse in late 2024, Israel assumed positions beyond the



buffer zone. The Jewish State cited instability and concerns over new Syrian leader Ahmed al-Sharaa, previously designated a terrorist by the U.S. and UN.

On July 27, Guterres stated: "I have just landed in Cyprus to express my commitment to support for Cypriot communities in the search for a comprehensive and sustainable settlement of the Cyprus issue. ... Only Cypriots, through their leaders, can build it."

Guterres made no mention of Turkey's occupation and didn't elaborate on the "Cyprus issue."

Jonathan Conricus is a senior fellow at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies and a former Israeli military officer. He noted that the secretary-general's statements are not surprising. Instead, they are "indicative of systemic bias against Israel, which has permeated almost all parts" of the UN.

Danon added, "Firm demands are replaced with vague calls for cooperation and reconciliation, and Turkey's name is omitted from official statements. Israel expects the secretary-general to demonstrate the same integrity and fairness toward all nations.

"As long as Israel continues to be judged by a different set of standards, confidence in the United Nations and its institutions will continue to erode."

Conricus asserted that Guterres "doesn't apply similar standards when it comes to conflict resolution related to Israel and other active conflicts."

He added, "Guterres shows himself to be a complete stooge and an absolute failure in upholding the UN charter and providing any type of global leadership."

Guterres, who has a documented history of denouncing Israel, became persona non

grata in the country after appearing to justify Hamas' atrocities on October 7, 2023. ☆

140 French Immigrants Arrive in Israel

In August, 140 new immigrants from France arrived in Israel aboard a special flight carrying dozens of young families. Among the passengers were 80 infants, children, and teens who are expected to begin the coming school year in Israel's education system.

The group included three sets of twins — ranging from 4 months old to 11 years old. The oldest passenger was an 85-year-old woman who fulfilled a lifelong dream of making *aliyah* [the immigration of Jews to Israel] and reuniting with her children, who already live in Israel.

About 2,400 immigrants from France arrived in Israel between the beginning of 2026 and the end of July, an increase of more than 30% compared with the same period last year.

According to the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration and The Jewish Agency, **more than 7,000 French immigrants have made aliyah since the October 7, 2023 terror attacks.**

"It's so moving to see young families choosing to make *aliyah* to Israel,

especially now," noted Aliyah and Integration Minister Ofir Sofer. "They are choosing to raise their children here, in the State of Israel, the home of the Jewish people."

Israeli Group has Helped 6,000+ Women Choose Life

Over nearly four decades, an Israeli pro-life organization has helped more than 6,000 women choose life instead of abortion during crisis pregnancies. Sandy Shoshani of Be'ad Chaim (Hebrew for "Pro-Life") explained that the organization's **Operation Moses program assists women throughout Israel** by offering practical and emotional support throughout pregnancy and after childbirth. Currently, Be'ad Chaim is helping about 150 pregnant women.

Shoshani explained that the group advertises "so every woman in crisis pregnancy would know that there is an opportunity for help and that she can choose life." Be'ad Chaim also supports mothers for an entire year after their babies are born by providing furniture,



clothing, diapers, formula, counseling, and encouragement.

The organization believes in the value of every human life, pointing to Jesus' love for children and God's calling before birth. "Imagine how much Jesus loves these little ones," Shoshani asserted. "It's hard to imagine that [anyone] would decide that they have no right to live."

Shoshani acknowledged the challenges that many women face, including poverty, trauma, war, family breakdown, and uncertainty about the future. Thus, the ministry seeks to meet those needs through practical support as well as emotional encouragement.

Many mothers later express gratitude for the help they have received. One woman who chose to continue her pregnancy wrote: **"I was about to abort my baby because I thought I couldn't cope.** And with your encouragement and help and support, I now have the best thing that ever happened to me."

Faith remains the ministry's driving force. "The love of God and the grace of the Messiah Jesus compel us to love others."

Insurance Company Demands Driver Remove "Jesus Loves You" from Car

A Christian driver in Birmingham, England was told to remove "Jesus

Loves You" messages from his car if he wanted to keep his insurance.

Simeon Chandra, 35, added the hand-made messages on his 2009 Nissan.

Yet GoSkippy Insurance "declined the modification done on the vehicle" and threatened to cancel his policy unless the stickers were removed.

Chandra was "shocked, surprised, and upset" at the company's response. "The message on my car is very simple: 'Jesus Loves You.' It is not abusive, political, hateful, or commercial. It is a message of hope.

"We see all kinds of messages, flags, and slogans in public life. But when a Christian puts a peaceful message

on his own car, suddenly it appears to become a problem," he added.

Raised in a family of Indian heritage, Chandra became a Christian while a university student. His father was a Hindu before converting to Christianity; his mother became a Christian after experiencing healing of an injured leg at a church service.

Though he removed the stickers to maintain his insurance, he's considering legal action against GoSkippy for violating his rights to freedom of religion and expression. ✨

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Archaeology Debunks the Israel “Colonizers” Libel

The libelous claim that Israel is a colonial project causes harm to Jews worldwide and isn't rooted in reality. **Archaeological evidence reveals a Jewish community in the Land of Israel for millennia.** Despite misleading and anti-Semitic arguments that Jewish people are colonizers, Zionism — the Jewish self-determination movement — serves as a model for decolonization.

Ancient Accounts of Israel and the Jewish People

An Egyptian artifact from 1200 B.C., the **Merneptah Stele**, commemorates Pharaoh Merneptah's victories over the Israelites. An inscription, “Yisrael, his seed is scattered,” affirms the longstanding Jewish presence in the region.

The **Black Obelisk of Shalmaneser III**, an Assyrian artifact from 841 B.C., records King Jehu's tribute payment to the Assyrians after they conquered the Kingdom of Israel. This obelisk contains the only known contemporary image of an Israelite king.

Another relic is the **Tel Dan Stele**, discovered in northern Israel and dating to the ninth century B.C. It contains an Aramaic inscription mentioning the Kingdom of Israel and the “House of David” — the oldest non-Biblical account of the Davidic dynasty. This stele corroborates Jewish communities in the Land of Israel over 2,000 years ago.

Two silver amulets discovered in Jerusalem's Ketef Hinnom area, dating to the

late seventh or early sixth century B.C., are the oldest known copies of Biblical text, predating the Dead Sea Scrolls by almost 400 years. Inscribed with the priestly benediction from Numbers 6:24–26, they underscore the Jewish people's deep roots in the region.

Return from Exile

King Cyrus of Persia allowed Jews to return to the Land of Israel after decades of exile (Ezra 1:1–11), recognizing the imperative for indigenous people to be restored to their homeland. His policy is documented in the **Cyrus Cylinder**, written on clay in 538 B.C.

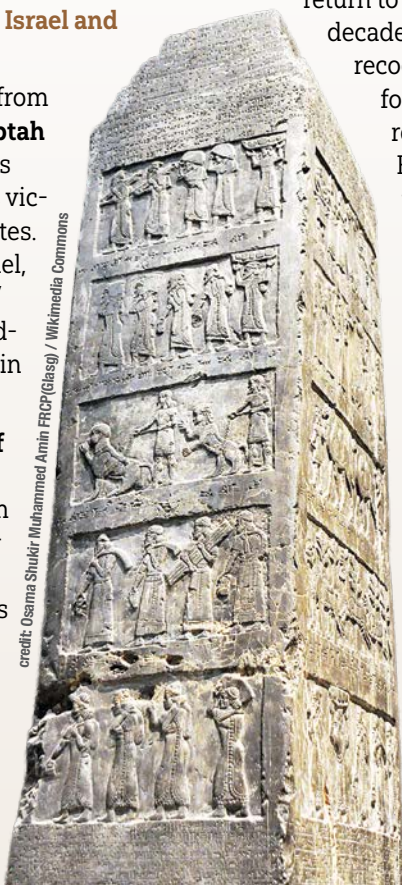
Bullae discovered in the City of David feature Hebrew inscriptions from the sixth and seventh centuries B.C. The small clay seals reflect Jewish presence in Judah, where Jews participated in economic and administrative activities. These artifacts bolster Biblical accounts of the First Temple Period (circa 1000–586 B.C.).

The Roman Era

The Arch of Titus in Rome, constructed in A.D. 81, depicts the Roman pillaging of Jerusalem as Jews were exiled from

their homeland — again — and religious artifacts were looted. A menorah featured on the arch inadvertently highlights the existence of a Jewish community in the land during Roman rule.

Excavated in the 1960s, the Masada fortress serves as a powerful symbol of Jewish resilience. This was King Herod's first-century B.C. stronghold, where Jewish rebels stood against the Romans.

It remains one of Israel's most popular tourist sites and a poignant reminder of the Jewish connection to the Land of Israel.

Historical Documentation

Flavius Josephus, a first-century Roman-Jewish historian, provided detailed accounts of Jewish life in Judea. In *Antiquities of the Jews*, Josephus detailed Jewish property and economic activities in Roman-controlled Judea. His comprehensive records are another source underscoring the continuous Jewish involvement in this land.

Lasting Jewish Practice

The Dead Sea Scrolls, discovered between 1947 and 1956, provide arguably the most compelling evidence of the Jewish people's enduring connection to their land. These manuscripts, dating from the last three centuries B.C. through the first century A.D., include the earliest known copies of entire books of the Bible written in Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek. Their survival over two millennia affirms the enduring legacy of Jewish scholarship and commitment to preserving sacred texts.

Israel is the Jewish Homeland

When British ships landed in North America in the 16th century, they didn't find Shakespeare plays or ancient English coins. That's because colonial powers aren't indigenous to the places they colonize. In contrast, **Jews have**

maintained a continuous presence in Israel since Judaism's inception, despite numerous conquerors that have expelled Jews from their

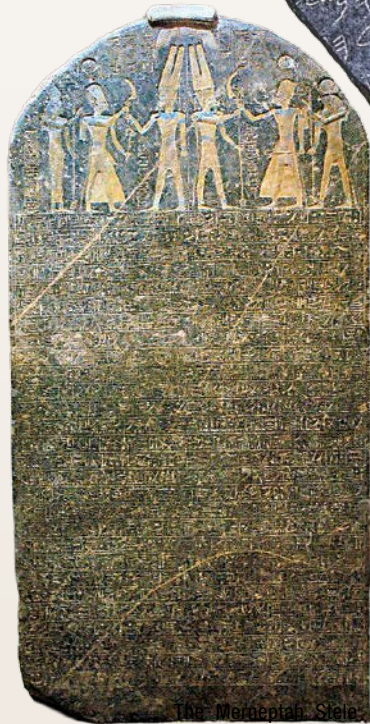
land. These exiles are thoroughly documented in Jewish literature, cultural evolution, and continuous archaeological findings.

Failed attempts to eradicate the Jewish people from their land have re-inforced the urgency of a lasting Jewish nation. ✡

Bookstore Cancels Jewish Author's Book Launch on Cancel Culture

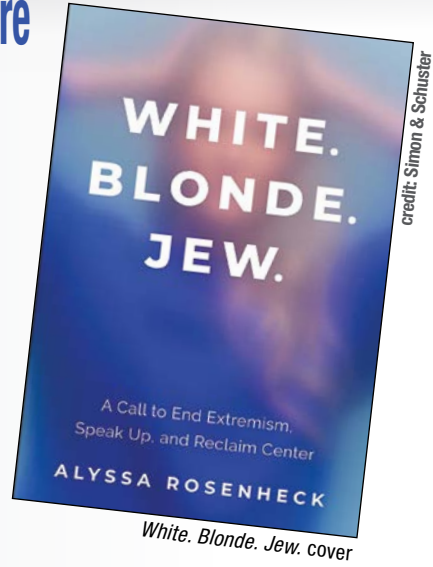
Because of an online pressure campaign from anti-Zionist activists, Nashville's Bell Bird Books canceled a launch event for Alyssa Rosenheck's new book *White. Blonde. Jew.* The cancellation was ironic given the book's subject matter. *White. Blonde. Jew.* grew directly out of Rosenheck's reporting trips to Israel and the Gaza envelope following the October 7, 2023 terror attacks. She met with combat veterans, freed hostages, and families affected by the war.

Rosenheck, a Nashville-based photographer and bestselling author, learned days before the scheduled August 20 event that the store wouldn't promote her or the launch. Without explanation, the bookstore then deleted its publicity for the book.

Rosenheck has become an increasingly prominent figure in Jewish advocacy work well beyond this book. A founding member of Artists Against Antisemitism and a 2025 recipient of the ADL's "Hero Against Hate" award, she has traveled to Israel three times as a post-war delegate, worked with the AJC, ADL, and CUFI, and helped expose and reverse a BDS resolution in her hometown of Nashville.

"As a proud Jewish author who values free speech ... I'm saddened and deeply disappointed," Rosenheck stated. "This episode raises important questions about whether our society truly values ... freedom of speech and the ability of authors to express controversial or unpopular views without being canceled."

Deb Campbell, Nashville director of Israel365, warned: "Anti-Semitism is showing up in our own communities, and we cannot be silent when Jewish people are targeted. As Christians, our connection to the Jewish people is deeply rooted in Scripture, and ... carries a responsibility to stand beside them.

... I want Alyssa and Nashville's Jewish community to know they are not alone."

Emmy-winning actress Patricia Heaton publicly backed Rosenheck on social media. Heaton wrote that Bell Bird Books previously promoted its commitment to "a diverse slate of authors and perspectives from all walks of life. Except for Jews, I guess. I'll be buying Alyssa's book elsewhere. Hate has no place in Nashville."

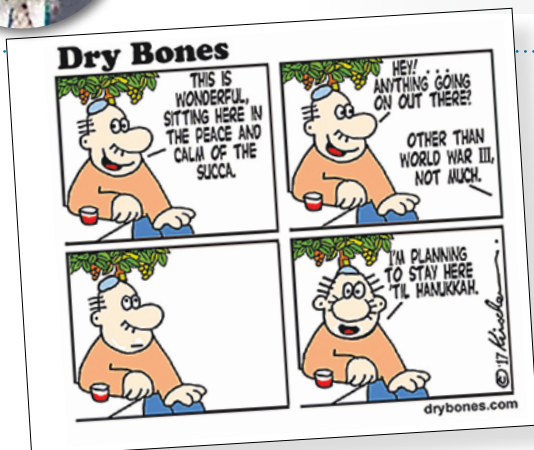
The Anti-Defamation League pointed to a broader trend: "This is yet another example of how anti-Semitism is increasingly being repackaged as anti-Zionism ... with campaigns to isolate Jewish authors and intimidate the institutions that host them."

Bell Bird Books owner Mary Ann Weprin, whose husband is Jewish, later denied an anti-Semitic motive. "This was never about an author, her Jewish identity, or censorship," Weprin wrote on Instagram. "My concern was whether my small neighborhood bookstore could responsibly host an event that appeared likely to require heightened security." Still, she committed to sell the book. "I have read Alyssa's book. We will always carry her book because I believe people should read, think, question, and decide for themselves." ☆
